COMPLIANCE

- Agents, High School Coaches, 2-year college coaches & prospective student-athletes (PSAs) may NOT be on the sideline during the game.
- Agents may NOT access the locker room.
- PŠAs (anyone who has started classes for the 9th grade) and enrolled student-athletes may NOT be in any credentialed areas (suites, sidelines, press box, etc.)
- Boosters & Fans may NOT interact with PSAs and are NOT allowed in the recruiting room
- Only Baylor staff, prospects & prospect's guest are allowed in the recruiting room
- Current student-athletes are only allowed when they are hosting a prospect on a visit
- PSAs may NOT be publicized on the video board or announced over the PA system
- Always remember, ask before you act!

STAFF INFO

- Medical Emergencies: Remain calm. Do not move an injured or ill person. Assess the situation
 and send someone to get assistance or call the command post. Stay with the person until medical
 assistance arrives. Provide crowd management around responders once they arrive.
- Basic Safety Information: You are the experts in your area: Please know who to call for assistance, where the nearest first aid station is located, where the nearest exits are located, where law enforcement or security is located and any other special concerns you may encounter.



PROHIBITED ITEMS

 $\overline{\text{Guests may not bring into or possess any of the following items while in the stadium:}$

Bags larger that do not meet clear bag policy, banners and poles, food, beverages**, weapons of any kind, tobacco, umbrellas, strollers, scooters, bicycles, roller skates, skateboards, pets, stadium seats and cushions, laser pointers, artificial noise makers, camera lenses 4" or larger, umbrellas, video cameras & unauthorized banners.

*Exceptions will be made for Guests with special needs (medical)

** water containers (empty or full) may be carried into the stadium. Must be clear. TOP 5
