## STORY LINES

- Baylor opens the 2020 campaign and begins the Dave Aranda era with its lone non-conference game of the season when it hosts Louisiana Tech on Saturday at 11 am CT.
- The matchup will be televised by Fox to a national audience, the first Fox broadcast from McLane Stadium since 2016.
- New head man **Dave Aranda** coaches his first game at Baylor. BU coaches are 13-11-3 in openers all-time.
- With a strong season, senior QB **Charlie Brewer** can become only the second player in Baylor history to lead the team in passing yards four straight years joining JJ Joe (1990-93).
- The Bears are 78-36-4 all-time in season openers. Baylor has won 10 of its last 11 season openers, and has started nine of last 10 years with at least two consecutive victories.
- September 12 is the latest season opener for the Bears since a 27-17 loss to Oregon State on 9/12/1998.
- Last season, BU became the first Power 5 program to win 11 games within two seasons of losing 11 games.
- **Charlie Brewer** has completed greater than 60% of his passes in 21 of 30 starts, including 12 of the last 16.
- Junior linebacker **Terrel Bernard** was named a Preseason All-American by Athlon, and he led 14 Baylor players that earned various Preseason All-Big 12 honors.
- **John Lovett** could become the third player to lead Baylor in rushing for three straight seasons joining Darrell Bush (1997-00) and Walter Abercrombie (1978-81).
- **Charlie Brewer** is one of two returning FBS quarterbacks (Justin Fields, Ohio St.) to pass for 20+ TD and rush for 10+ TD in 2019.
- BU is playing its 119th season of football. BU holds a 607-577-44 (.511) record all-time. Baylor has scored in a school-record 164 straight games — the previous record was 89 games from Dec. 31, 1979 - Oct. 23, 1987.
- Baylor has 13 graduates on its 2020 roster, including 10 student-athletes enrolled in graduate school.
- Baylor quarterback **Charlie Brewer** leads the team with 30 starts, including 18 straight. Corner **Raleigh Texada** leads the defense with 20 career games starts (14 straight).
- The Bears led the Big 12 with four seniors (**William Bradley-King**, **Charlie Brewer**, **Trestan Ebner** and **John Lovett**) named to the Senior Bowl Top 250 list.
- Baylor is 81-16 since 2008 when scoring 30 points or more.

## LA TECH SERIES HISTORY

- Baylor opens up the unorthodox 2020 campaign at McLane Stadium by welcoming Louisiana Tech. BU is 5-1 all-time against the Bulldogs. LA Tech's lone victory in the series came 10-9 in 1992.
- The Bears have won two straight meetings with LA Tech, most recently a 24-16 victory in Shreveport in 1996. Also a season opener, BU rolled to a win behind 92 rushing yards from Jerod Douglas.
- Baylor is 15-12 all-time against teams from the state of Louisiana. The Bears will face La Tech in Waco again in 2022 before visiting Ruston in 2023. BU is 71-35-2 against all Conference USA programs.

## BU WELCOMES FOUR TRANSFERS TO FOLD FOR 2020

- Baylor added four transfer players to the 2020 roster and all four are expected to play key roles this season.
- Outside linebacker William Bradley-King (Arkansas State), who tallied 8.5 sacks and 13.5 TFL in his last season with the Redwolves, and will rush the passer from the JACK position for Baylor.
- Gunnar Royer is a graduate transfer from Division II IUP and will serve as the Bears' long snapper in 2020.
- After transferring from Iowa, Dillon Doyle received an immediate eligibility waiver from the NCAA and will step in at middle linebacker for BU. He played in 13 games with three starts for the Hawkeyes in 2019 totaling 23 tackles.
- Jake Burton joined the Baylor roster from UCLA in late August as a graduate transfer and will start at right tackle. He played in 29 career games in LA, including starting 23-of-24 games from 2018-19.

## SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED FOR FALL

- Baylor coach Dave Aranda took the opportunity in late August to award scholarships to three deserving walk-on players in QB Garret McGuire, LS Thor Rodoni and S Zeke Brown.
- McGuire, the son of associate head coach Joey McGuire, is in his fourth year with the program and plays a valuable role as one of Baylor's primary signalers on game day.
- Brown and Rodoni are both fifth-year players that have each already completed their undergraduate degrees. Brown is pursuing a master's degree in electrical/computer engineering.

## BREWER AMONG BAYLOR'S BEST

- Senior quarterback Charlie Brewer has played in 35 games in his career with 30 starts. The Austin native has passed for 7,742 yards in his career which ranks third in Baylor history (Griffin 10,366; Petty 8,195).
- Brewer has passed for 221.2 yards per game in his career with 51 touchdowns and 20 interceptions. He has completed 64.1 percent of his passes (630-of-983). He also has 18 rushing touchdowns.
- **Brewer has completed 64.1 percent of his passes (487-of-760) in 25 career games against Big 12 opponents.**
- The Austin native has eclipsed 300 yards passing in 11 games, third-most in program history. He trails only Bryce Petty (16) and Robert Griffin III (13).
- Brewer earned a single digit for the first time in his Baylor career entering his senior season. He has completed greater than 60% of his passes in 21 of 30 career starts, including 13 of last 16.

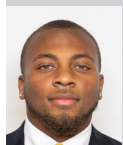

## SENIORS KEY IN THE RUN GAME

- BU's running game in 2020 will be led by a pair of senior single-digits in Trestan Ebner and John Lovett.
- Lovett is the only four-year single-digit honoree in program history. He has led the Bears in rushing each of the last three seasons and enters his senior campaign with 1,673 career rushing yards (20th, BU history).
- The New Jersey native has 16 career rushing touchdowns and six career 100-yard games.
- Ebner is perhaps the most versatile offensive player on the roster with high-level skills as a runner, receiver and returner. He has tallied 1,787 all-purpose yards in his career along with 13 total touchdowns.
- Ebner's 932 career receiving yards are the most by a primary running back in school history. His six receiving touchdowns trail only Ronnie Bull (8, 1959-61).

## TOUGHNESS REWARDED

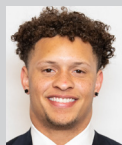

**TERREL BERNARD ANCHORS DEFENSE IN 2020**

- Preseason All-American Terrel Bernard is back as the anchor of Baylor's defense following a breakout season in 2019. Bernard was a All-Big 12 pick last season despite only starting 11 of 14 games.
- Bernard took the reins at middle linebacker midway through the 2019 season and finished with a team-best 112 tackles to go along with 9.5 TFL and 4.5 sacks. He added one interception and three PBU.
- The LaPorte, Texas native is second among returning tacklers in the Big 12, and has 159 stops in his career. Bernard has totaled 12.5 TFL and 5.5 sacks in 27 career games (13 starts).

**BREWER THE CARDIAC KID**

- In his time as Baylor's starting quarterback, Charlie Brewer has led the Bears on five game-winning drives in the fourth quarter, including 2019 victories over Iowa State and OSU. Last year he also led drives to tie the game before ultimately winning in overtime vs. Texas Tech and TCU. Below is a breakdown of those wins.
- **Baylor holds the national lead with seven 4th-quarter comebacks since the start of 2018.**

**TONS OF EXPERIENCE AT WIDE OUT**

- Baylor's passing game will be led in 2020 by a trio of veteran receivers in juniors RJ Sneed and Tyquan Thornton and Josh Fleeks. Additionally, senior Jared Atkinson and fourth-year sophomore Gavin Holmes are going to be counted on as playmakers.
- Sneed, Thornton and Fleeks have combined for 15 touchdowns over their first two seasons and will step up to fill the void left by the departed Denzel Mims and Chris Platt. Atkinson has 16 receptions since 2016.
- Holmes, a fall camp standout, is one of the more intriguing options after missing most of the last two seasons after playing in only nine games as a freshman in 2017. Prior to his freshman year injury he had 13 receptions for 166 yards and three total touchdowns.
- Baylor wide receivers have posted nine 1,000-yard seasons since 2011 including Denzel Mims in 2019.

**MORE BREWER NOTABLES**

- Charlie Brewer is only the fourth quarterback in BU history to throw for 6,000+ yards in his career. He owns the Baylor single-game marks for completions (43) and attempts (63).
- **He is the only returning FBS QB to pass for 20+ touchdowns and rushing for 11+ touchdowns in 2019.**
- Only four returning FBS quarterbacks rushed for 11+ TD last season (Hammond, AFA; Plumlee, UM; Thompson, KSU).
- Eleven times in his career Brewer has thrown for a touchdown and rushed for a touchdown in the same game.
- Brewer is third in Baylor history with 19 career 200-yard passing game. He trails only Robert Griffin III (29) and Bryce Petty (21).
- Brewer ranks third among BU passers since 2000 with a completion percentage greater than 60 in 23 games.
- With three rushing touchdowns against Texas Tech in 2019, the Austin native tied a Baylor QB record set by Bryce Petty in 2014. Brewer has 18 rushing touchdowns in his career, fourth most in BU history.

## 2020 BAYLOR FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

### ARANDA IS ONE OF TOP DEFENSIVE MINDS IN COUNTRY

- First-year head coach Dave Aranda has earned a national reputation as one of the top defensive minds in the country over his 20-plus year career that included stops as defensive coordinator at LSU, Wisconsin, Utah State and Hawaii.
- Aranda led the LSU defense in 2019 as the Tigers posted a perfect 15-0 record and won the National Title with a 42-25 victory over Clemson in CFP National Championship Game.
- Since taking over as the defensive coordinator at Utah State in 2014, Aranda's defenses have given up a touchdown or less in 48 of 108 games.
- In six seasons as a defensive coordinator at a Power 5 Conference school from 2014-19, Aranda's defenses were ranked in the Top 12 nationally in total yards five times. His defenses also ranked among the top 10 in scoring four times in seven years from 2013-19.
- Aranda trying to become the first Baylor coach to take his first team to a bowl since Sam Boyd in 1956.

### MORE ON BREWER'S CAREER

- Senior quarterback Charlie Brewer enters his fourth season at the helm of the Baylor offense with a chance to etch himself in the record book as one of the best at the position in program history.
- Brewer holds a 18-12 record as a starter in 35 career games played. The Baylor modern record for games played by a quarterback is 42 from current Baylor radio analyst JJ Joe (1990-93).

- Preparing Champions for Life is not just a slogan at Baylor and coach Dave Aranda's team is proving it. The 2020 Baylor roster features 13 college graduates including three graduate transfers.
- The list of graduates is as follows: Terrel Bernard, William Bradley-King, Jake Burton, Zeke Brown, Tyler Henderson, Bryson Jackson, Michael McNair, Jalen Pitre, Thor Rodoni, Gunnar Royer, RJ Sneed, Raleigh Texada and Skyler Wetzell.
- Ten of those graduates are enrolled in graduate school in six different master's programs.
- Twelve other members of the BU roster are scheduled to graduate in December. The Bears boast 17 seniors.

### BREWER AS A RUNNER

- Charlie Brewer turned his legs into a weapon over his career. The now senior QB displayed his athleticism and recorded a team-best 147 rushing attempts, third most for a Big 12 QB.
- Brewer led the Bears with 11 rushing touchdowns, second-most among passers in the Big 12 Conference.
- The Austin native ran for 50 or more yards four times in 2019. He set a career-best with 109 rushing yards on 16 attempts in the 2018 Texas Bowl win over Vanderbilt.
- Brewer's 11 rushing touchdowns in 2019 were the third-best total by a Baylor quarterback since 1980.
- His 885 career rushing yards ranks fourth by BU modern era quarterbacks behind Robert Griffin III (2,254; 2008-11), Seth Russell (1,240; 2012-16) and Mark Jackson (940; 1974-76).

### BAYLOR RETURNS A DEEP ROSTER

- The Bears return 11 players combined that have started 10 or more games in their careers, and 31 players with career starts overall. Baylor's nine returning starters overall is the fewest in the Big 12.
- QB Charlie Brewer leads the team with 30 starts, including 18 straight. Corner Raleigh Texada leads the defense with 20 career games starts (14 straight).
- BU features an experienced offensive line that includes Jake Burton (23 starts at UCLA) along with Xavier Newman-Johnson (19 starts), Connor Galvin (15) and Blake Bedier (13). Four others on roster have also made starts for 92 total starts overall.
- Wide receiver Jared Atkinson leads the Bears with 39 career games played. Running back Trestan Ebner is next at 38, followed by safety Jairon McVea and running back John Lovett with 37 each. Nine players have played in 30 or more games in their careers.
