MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- Baylor Captains: Garret McGuire, RJ Sneed, Christian Morgan, Charlie Brewer
- Baylor won the coin toss and deferred to the second half.
- New Baylor head coach Dave Aranda won his first game at the helm, moving Baylor head coaches to 14-11-3 all-time in BU career openers all-time.
- Aranda is the first full time BU head coach since Chuck Reedy in 1993 to win his debut game with the Bears.
- Baylor is now 79-36-4 all-time in season openers. The Bears have won 11 of their last 12 season openers.
- BU has outscored Kansas 533-129 since 2010 with an average margin of victory of 36.7 ppg.

TEAM NOTES

- Baylor improved to 608-577-44 all time. The Bears have scored in a school record 164 straight games.
- With the win, Baylor opens Big 12 play 1.0 for the third straight year and seventh time in eight years
- First-time starters for Baylor included OL Mose Jeffrey, DL Josh Landry, DL Cole Maxwell, OLB Ashton Logan.

• Twelve different players made their first appearances in a Baylor uniform (S Devin Neal, S Mike Harris, S Al Walcott, LS Gunnar Royer, LB Dillon Doyle, OLB Anthony Anyanwu, OL Gavin Byers, OL Mose Jeffery, TE Drake Dabney, WR Jaylen Ellis, OLB Victor Obi, OLB William Bradley-King).

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Trestan Ebner finished with 272 total yards and four total touchdowns (two kickoff return, one rushing, one receiving).
- Ebner is the first player in the 25 year history of the Big 12 Conference to score three different types of touchdowns in a game.
- Ebner is the only FBS player in the last 25 seasons (since 1996) to score a rushing TD, a receiving TD and multiple return touchdowns in a game.
- Ebner is the first player in BU history with two return touchdowns in the same game.
- Ebner is the first BU player since Kalief Muhammad in 1996 vs Oregon State to record a kickoff return TD and rushing TD in the same game.
- It was the first time a Baylor player has recorded a return TD and a receiving TD since Levi Norwood in 2013 vs. Texas Tech.
- The last time Baylor had a player with a rushing TD and a receiving TD in a game was Trestan Ebner vs. Stephen F. Austin in 2019 (two rushing, one receiving).
- The last time Baylor had a kickoff return for TD before tonight was Corey Coleman vs. Iowa State in 2013.
- Ebner's first kickoff return TD of 100 yards ties the BU record for longest return for TD (Muhammad, 1996 vs Oregon State and Robert Quieroga, 2003 vs.Texas Tech)
- It was the first Baylor game with two return TDs since Coleman (kickoff return) and Norwood (punt return) accomplished the feat vs. Iowa State in 2013.
- Ebner's 272 all-purpose yards are the third-most in program history (Terrance Williams, 314 vs. West Virginia all receiving; and Johnny Jefferson, 299 vs. North Carolina all rushing).
- Ebner scored four touchdowns against KU after totaling only five in all of 2019. He has scored 17 touchdowns in his BU career.
- Terrel Bernard recorded a sack for a safety, the first safety by a Baylor player since Bravvion Roy in 2017 vs. TCU.
- It was the first-ever safety by Baylor at McLane Stadium, which opened in 2014.
- It marked just Baylor's second ever safety in a Big 12 game.
- It was the first safety by the Bears against Kansas since James Francis in 1989.
- Bernard led the Bears with eight total tackles (six solo), career bests 2.5 sacks and 3.5 tackles for loss. He has 8.0 career sacks and 16.0 career TFL.
- John Lovett finished with 78 yards rushing, moving him past Glasco Martin (1,687), Larry Hickman (1,713), Paul Mosley (1,718) and Rashad Armstrong (1,721) on the Baylor career rushing list.
- Lovett (1,751) currently stands in 16th place all-time.
- Craig Williams rushed for a career high 61 yards and his second career touchdown.
- John Mayers made his 17th-career field goal, the second-longest of his career (47 yards). Mayers' career long is 51 (2019 at TCU).
- Jairon McVea set a new career high with seven tackles against Kansas.
- Jalen Pitre tied his career high with seven tackles in the game.
- Charlie Brewer made the 31st start of his career and 19th consecutive start at QB for Baylor. He has 19 wins as a starter, fourth most since 1980.
- Brewer has completed 60 percent or greater of his passes in 22 of his 31 starts, including 13 of his last 17.
