STORY LINES

- The Bears look to make it three-straight victories over Kansas State when they host the Wildcats at McLane Stadium on Thanksgiving Weekend. The game will serve as *Preparing Champions for Life* day and Baylor will honor 14 seniors before the game.
- Seniors being honored pregame include **Jared Atkinson**, **Blake Bedier**, **William Bradley-King**, **Jake Burton**, **Trestan Ebner**, **John Lovett**, **Garret McGuire**, **Michael McNair**, **Blake Perdue**, **Thor Rodoni**, **Jay Sedwick**, **Trystan Slinker**, **Raleigh Texada** and **Skyler Wetzel**.
- **Jalen Pitre** has recorded a pick-six in two consecutive games, the first time a Baylor player has had two interceptions returned for a touchdown in a season since **Eddie Lackey** in 2012.
- Baylor freshman running backs **Qualan Jones** (86) and **Taye McWilliams** (31) combined to rush for 117 yards at Texas Tech. Jones made his first career start in Lubbock.
- Baylor leads the Big 12 and ranks 11th nationally in turnover margin (1.00). The Bears have 12 takeaways on the season including seven interceptions and five fumble recoveries.
- Do-everything-back **Trestan Ebner** leads all active FBS running backs with 1,156 career receiving yards.
- BU quarterback **Charlie Brewer** leads the team with 36 starts (24 straight), that total ranks fifth among active FBS quarterbacks. Corner **Raleigh Texada** leads the defense with 26 career games started (20 straight).
- In his first career start at linebacker, converted running back **Abram Smith** totaled 13 tackles with one TFL on the road at Texas Tech. He has 15 tackles on the season.
- Baylor tight ends **Ben Sims** (3) and **Drake Dabney** (1) have scored four total touchdowns in the last five games.
- Senior QB **Charlie Brewer** has passed for 62 touchdowns in his career, tied for the second-best total in Baylor history (**Bryce Petty**, 2011-14). He trails only Heisman winner **Robert Griffin III** (78, 2008-11).
- **Charlie Brewer** is on track to become only the second player in Baylor history to lead the team in passing yards four straight years joining **JJ Joe** (1990-93).
- The Bears' 77 victories since 2011 are second most among all Power 5 programs in the State of Texas, trailing only Texas A&M (80).
- With 153 yards at Texas Tech, **Charlie Brewer** (9,020) became only the second player in Baylor history to pass for 9,000 yards. He trails only **Robert Griffin III** (2008-11; 10,366) on the all-time list.
- **Charlie Brewer** (19) and **John Lovett** (17) need just two and four rushing touchdowns respectively to reach Baylor's all-time top 10. **Bryce Petty** (2011-14) and **Devin Chafin** (2013-15) are tied for 9th with 21 in their careers.

KANSAS STATE SERIES HISTORY

- After its final bye of the season, Baylor hosts Kansas State on Thanksgiving weekend. BU has won two straight meetings with K-State.
- BU trails the all-time series 8-9, dating back to 1969. Since the formation of the Big 12, the series is an even 8-8.
- The Bears lead the series 5-4 in Waco, including wins in five of the last six played at McLane and Floyd Casey.
- Last season, BU rolled to a 31-12 victory in Manhattan behind two touchdowns from John Lovett and a Gerry Bohanon rushing score. James Lynch had three sacks on defense.

UP NEXT

- The Bears make the trip to No. 14 Oklahoma for its final road trip of the season. BU has won only three times in 30 all-time meetings dating back to 1901.
- In Norman, Baylor trails 1-13 with the lone victory coming in 2014 when the Bears rolled to a 48-14 victory behind 231 total yards and two touchdowns by Corey Coleman.
- Baylor dropped two hotly contested games with the Sooners first in a 34-31 heartbreaker at McLane, then in a 30-23 overtime loss in the Big 12 Championship at AT&T Stadium.

EBNER AN ELITE RECEIVING THREAT

- Baylor senior do-everything-back Trestan Ebner has emerged as an all-purpose weapon throughout his BU career whether it is on the ground, through the air or on special teams.
- In 2020, he has 774 all-purpose yards and a team-high five touchdowns. Ebner is third on the team with 18 receptions and second with 224 receiving yards. He is one of three players with two or more receiving TD.
- The senior ranks first in BU history among RB in receiving yards (1,156), tied for first in receiving touchdowns (8) and second in receptions (91). He trails only Brandon Whitaker (120 receptions, 2003-07).
- **Ebner is one of only two Big 12 running backs with multiple receiving touchdowns in 2020.**
- He has been especially dangerous through the air in his career and ranks among active FBS leaders in yards, receptions and touchdowns by running backs.

TIGHT ENDS A WEAPON THROUGH THE AIR

- Baylor sophomore tight end Ben Sims has turned himself into a weapon in the passing game in 2020. The San Antonio native has eight receptions for 101 yards with three touchdowns in four games played.
- He has receptions in his first four games to start 2020, the first time a BU tight end has accomplished that feat since Jordan Najvar (6) and Jerod Monk (4) in 2011.
- Sims had two scores against TCU, the first two TD game for a Baylor tight end since Justin Akers at UConn in 2008. He is the first TE with three TD in a season since Akers had four in 2007.
- In relief of Sims at ISU, Drake Dabney had his first two career receptions and his first career TD. Baylor tight ends have four touchdowns in the last five games. Dabney has six receptions for 57 yards overall.

ABRAM SMITH STEPS IN AT LB

- With junior All-America candidate Terrel Bernard lost for the season due to injury, junior Abram Smith moved into the starting lineup at weakside linebacker against Texas Tech.
- The Abilene native didn't disappoint in his first career start, posting a team-high 13 tackles and one TFL.
- Smith, a converted running back, has played in 25 games in his career with most of his action coming on special teams. He has 23 career tackles and one forced fumble.
- The junior also has 12 carries for 46 yards and a touchdown. He has one catch for three yards.

TOUGHNESS REWARDED

Baylor began a new tradition in 2017 of rewarding the toughest players on the BU roster with single-digit jerseys. The jersey numbers are awarded to the student-athletes deemed by their teammates to be the toughest members of the team. First-year Baylor head coach Dave Aranda has continued this tradition for 2020.



TONS OF EXPERIENCE AT WIDE OUT

- Baylor's passing game has been led in 2020 by a trio of veteran receivers in juniors RJ Sneed and Tyquan Thornton and Josh Fleeks. Additionally, Gavin Holmes has returned after missing 2017-19 due to ACL tears.
- Sneed, who owns 75 receptions and 843 yards in his career, leads the Bears with 27 catches and 349 yards with two touchdowns in 2020.
- Thornton has 8 grabs for 67 yards. In his career, he has 1,203 receiving yards (25th, BU history) and 8 TD.
- Fleeks has 109 yards on 14 catches with one TD in 2020. He has 3 career receiving TD and 2 rushing scores.
- Holmes set a career high with 9 catches at Texas. He is second on the team with 23 receptions in 2020. He missed all but once game in 2018-19 after tearing his ACL twice. He has four career touchdowns.
- Baylor wide receivers have posted nine 1,000-yard seasons since 2011 including Denzel Mims in 2019.

CHARLIE BREWER AMONG BAYLOR'S BEST

- Senior quarterback Charlie Brewer has played in 41 games in his career with 36 starts. The Austin native has passed for 9,020 yards in his career which ranks second in Baylor history (Griffin 10,366).
- Brewer has passed for 220.0 yards per game in his career with 62 touchdowns and 26 interceptions. He trails only Robert Griffin III (78 TD passes from 2008-11). He ranks just outside the top 10 all-time in interceptions.
- **Brewer has a 64.4 (612-of-950) completion percentage in 31 career games against Big 12 opponents.**
- The Austin native has eclipsed 300 yards passing in 11 games, third-most in program history. He trails only Bryce Petty (16) and Robert Griffin III (13).
- Brewer earned a single digit for the first time in his Baylor career entering his senior season. He has completed greater than 60% of his passes in 26 of 36 career starts, including 18 of last 22.

BREWER THE CARDIAC KID

- In his time as Baylor's starting quarterback, Charlie Brewer has led the Bears on five game-winning drives in the fourth quarter, including 2019 victories over Iowa State and OSU. In 2019, he also led drives to tie the game before ultimately winning in overtime vs. Texas Tech and TCU. At WVU in 2020, he led a game-tying drive but the Bears fell in OT. Below is a breakdown of those contests.

MORE BREWER NOTABLES

- Charlie Brewer is only the second quarterback in BU history to throw for 9,000+ yards in his career. He owns the Baylor single-game marks for completions (43) and attempts (63).
- **He is the only returning FBS QB to pass for 20+ touchdowns and rushing for 11+ touchdowns in 2019.**
- Only four returning FBS QBs rushed for 11+ TD in 2019 (Hammond, AFA; Plumlee, UM; Thompson, KSU).
- Eleven times in his career Brewer has thrown for a touchdown and rushed for a touchdown in the same game. Baylor is 8-3 in those games.
- Brewer is second in Baylor history with 23 career 200-yard passing games. He trails only Robert Griffin III (2008-11, 29).
- Brewer ranks 2nd among BU passers since 2000 with a completion percentage greater than 60 in 28 games.
- With three rushing touchdowns against Texas Tech in 2019, the Austin native tied a Baylor QB record set by Bryce Petty in 2014. Brewer has 19 rushing touchdowns in his career, fourth most in BU history.

2020 BAYLOR FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED FOR FALL

- Baylor coach Dave Aranda took the opportunity in late August to award scholarships to three deserving walk-on players in QB Garret McGuire, LS Thor Rodoni and S Zeke Brown.
- McGuire, the son of associate head coach Joey McGuire, is in his fourth year with the program and plays a valuable role as one of Baylor's primary signalers on game day.
- Brown and Rodoni are both fifth-year players that have each already completed their undergraduate degrees. Brown is pursuing a master's degree in electrical/computer engineering.

BAYLOR ATHLETICS LAUNCHES ONE CAMPAIGN

- Baylor Athletics launched ONE, a department-wide campaign focused on uniting the Baylor community around a shared commitment to justice, equality, and love.
- The ONE campaign focuses on Baylor Athletics providing actionable opportunities to address racial injustice and inequalities within our community.
- Baylor Athletics' 19 intercollegiate sport programs, coaches, and staff were challenged to identify at least one initiative or action to move them closer to achieving one Baylor and one community.
- During the 2020-21 seasons, Baylor student-athletes will wear a ONE patch on their jerseys as a visual reminder of our commitment to unifying and promoting change within our communities.

MORE ON BREWER'S CAREER

- Senior quarterback Charlie Brewer is in his fourth season at the helm of the Baylor offense, and has a chance to etch himself in the record book as one of the best at the position in program history.
- Brewer holds a 19-17 record as a starter in 36 starts (41 games played). The Baylor record for games played by a quarterback is 42 from current Baylor radio analyst JJ Joe (1990-93). Joe and Robert Griffin III are tied for the record with 23 all-time wins.
- Brewer's 36 career starts is tied for fifth nationally among active FBS quarterbacks.

BU WELCOMES FOUR TRANSFERS TO FOLD FOR 2020

- Baylor added four transfer players to the 2020 roster and all four are playing key roles this season.
- DE William Bradley-King (Arkansas State), who tallied 8.5 sacks and 13.5 TFL in 2019 with the Redwolves, has 25 tackles, 5.5 TFL, 3.5 sacks and one forced fumble in 2020. He has also added three pass break ups, three quarterback hurries, and a fumble recovery.
- Bradley-King has been selected to the 2021 Reese's Senior Bowl. BU has four Senior Bowl picks since 2019.
- Gunnar Royer is a graduate transfer from Division II IUP and is serving as the Bears' long snapper in 2020.
- After transferring from Iowa, Dillon Doyle received an immediate eligibility waiver from the NCAA. He has started all six games at middle linebacker and tallied 40 tackles with 3.0 TFL, 1.0 sack, one force fumble and one fumble recovery. He had his first career double-digit tackle performance with 11 at Texas.
- Jake Burton joined the Baylor roster from UCLA in late August as a graduate transfer and moved into the starting lineup at WVU. He has played in 34 career games overall, including starting 28 of his last 29.

ARANDA IS ONE OF TOP DEFENSIVE MINDS IN COUNTRY

- First-year head coach Dave Aranda has earned a national reputation as one of the top defensive minds in the country over his 20-plus year career that included stops as defensive coordinator at LSU, Wisconsin, Utah State and Hawaii.
- Aranda led the LSU defense in 2019 as the Tigers posted a perfect 15-0 record and won the National Title with a 42-25 victory over Clemson in CFP National Championship Game.
- Since taking over as the defensive coordinator at Utah State, Aranda's defenses gave up a touchdown or less in 48 of 108 games from 2014-19.
- In six seasons as defensive coordinator at a Power 5 school from 2014-19, Aranda's defenses were ranked in the Top 12 nationally in total yards five times. The units also ranked among the top 10 in scoring four times in seven years from 2013-19.
- Aranda trying to become the first Baylor coach to take his first team to a bowl since Sam Boyd in 1956.
- He is the first full-time BU coach to win his debut since Chuck Reedy in 1993.

2020 ROSTER FEATURES 13 GRADUATES

- Preparing Champions for Life is not just a slogan at Baylor and coach Dave Aranda's team is proving it. The 2020 Baylor roster features 13 college graduates including three graduate transfers.
- The list of graduates is as follows: Terrel Bernard, William Bradley-King, Jake Burton, Zeke Brown, Tyler Henderson, Bryson Jackson, Michael McNair, Jalen Pitre, Thor Rodoni, Gunnar Royer, RJ Sneed, Raleigh Texada and Skyler Wetzell.
- Ten of those graduates are enrolled in graduate school in six different master's programs.
- Twelve other members of the BU roster are scheduled to graduate in December. The Bears boast 17 seniors.

BREWER AS A RUNNER

- Charlie Brewer has turned his legs into a weapon over his career. The senior QB displayed his athleticism and recorded a team-best 147 rushing attempts in 2019, third most for a Big 12 QB.
- As a junior, Brewer led BU with 11 rushing touchdowns, second-most among passers in the Big 12.
- The Austin native ran for 50 or more yards four times in 2019. He set a career-best with 109 rushing yards on 16 attempts in the 2018 Texas Bowl win over Vanderbilt.
- Brewer's 11 rushing touchdowns in 2019 were the third-best total by a Baylor quarterback since 1980.
- His 998 career rushing yards ranks third by BU modern era quarterbacks behind Robert Griffin III (2,254; 2008-11) and Seth Russell (1,240; 2012-16).

Trestan Ebner piled up 272 all-purpose yards and scored four touchdowns, including two on kick returns, to help Baylor (1-0, 1-0) open the Dave Aranda era with an impressive 47-14 win over Kansas in Saturday's season opener at McLane Stadium.

In one of the best all-around individual performances in program history, Ebner scored on kickoff returns of 100 and 83 yards, added a one-yard TD run and also caught an 18-yard TD pass from Charlie Brewer. The senior running back is the first Big 12 player in the league's 25-year history to score touchdowns on rushes, receptions and returns in the same game.

After Kansas (0-2, 0-1) opened the game with a 79-yard scoring drive and the first of Pooka Williams' two touchdowns, the Baylor defense stiffened the rest of the first half and didn't give up another score until the fourth quarter long after the Bears sent in their backups.

Linebacker Terrel Bernard, who had 2.5 sacks, 3.5 stops for losses and a game-high eight tackles, sacked KU freshman quarterback Jalon Daniels for the first safety at McLane Stadium and first for the Bears since Bravwon Roy versus TCU in 2017.

The Bears piled up 352 yards total offense, including 203 on the ground, and averaged better than five yards per play. Brewer, making his 31st career start, was 15-of-23 for 142 yards and one touchdown and added 23 yards rushing on eight carries.

POSTGAME NOTES

- New Baylor head coach Dave Aranda won his first game at the helm, moving Baylor head coaches to 14-11-3 all-time in BU career openers all-time.
- Baylor is now 79-36-4 all-time in season openers. The Bears have won 11 of their last 12 season openers.
- Trestan Ebner finished with 272 total yards and four total touchdowns (two kickoff return, one rushing, one receiving).
- Ebner's 272 all-purpose yards are the third-most in program history (Terrance Williams, 314 vs. West Virginia - all receiving; and Johnny Jefferson, 299 vs. North Carolina - all rushing).
- Prior to today, there had never been a Big 12 player to score three different types of touchdowns in a game. Ebner is the first.
- Ebner is also the only FBS player in the last 25 seasons (since 1996) to score a rushing TD, a receiving TD and multiple return touchdowns in a game.
- Terrel Bernard recorded a sack for a safety, the first safety by a Baylor player since Bravwon Roy in 2017 vs. TCU.

With a chance for its road win ever at West Virginia, Baylor came up inches short on a fourth-and-goal play in regulation and then turned it over in the second overtime, falling 27-21 to the West Virginia Mountaineers Saturday afternoon.

The Bears (1-1), falling to 7-8 all-time in overtime games, tied it up with 1:19 left in regulation on Charlie Brewer's 34-yard TD pass to Josh Fleeks and then matched a West Virginia score in the first OT period with Brewer's 25-yard toss to tight end Ben Sims on the first play.

But, on the first play of the second overtime, Brewer overthrew running back Trestan Ebner on a seam route and was picked off by cornerback Tykee Smith in the back of the end zone.

West Virginia (2-1, 1-1) won it with Leddie Brown's second touchdown run of the day, this one from three yards out, as the Mountaineers bounced back from a 27-13 loss to Oklahoma State on the opening weekend of Big 12 play.

Baylor's defense kept them in it, though, coming up with three first-half turnovers with a fumble strip and recovery by William Bradley-King and interceptions by JT Woods and Terrel Bernard.

POSTGAME NOTES

- Terrel Bernard (14 tackles, 10 solo) recorded his fifth-career game with double-digit tackles.
- Bernard corralled his third-career interception, one of three takeaways Saturday by the Baylor defense.
- Jalen Pitre registered a career-high 11 tackles (all of them solo) along with 2 tackles for loss
- JT Woods intercepted the first pass of his career while recording a career-high 9 tackles (5 solo).
- Charlie Brewer (23-of-38) has now completed 60% or better on passes in 23 of 32 starts, including 14 of his last 18.

Playing their first game in three weeks, the Baylor Bears made things interesting with two fourth-quarter touchdowns but came up short against the Texas Longhorns, 27-16, Saturday afternoon at DKR-Texas Memorial Stadium.

Charlie Brewer, who moved up to No. 2 all-time in career yards passing, completed 30-of-43 passes for 256 yards and had touchdown tosses to John Lovett and Gavin Holmes to give the Bears (1-2) a chance late in the game.

The defense helped the cause with a 32-yard interception return by safety JT Woods that set up the second touchdown and also came up with another stop that gave Baylor the ball back with four minutes left.

Trailing 27-3 going into the fourth quarter, Brewer got clicking on a nine-play, 75-yard drive, hitting 6-of-7 passes for 70 yards and capping it with a short three-yard TD pass to a wide-open Lovett in the left flat.

Baylor's defense came up with the only turnover when Sam Ehlinger took a deep shot down the left sideline. The receiver appeared to be open, but cornerback Mark Milton got there in time to deflect the ball to Woods, who returned it 32 yards to UT's 25.

Five plays later, Brewer connected with Holmes on a seven-yard TD pass, his third career score and first in three years. Holmes, who had missed most of the previous two seasons with knee injuries, had a career-high nine catches for 57 yards.

- With his 256 passing yards Charlie Brewer passed Bryce Petty (8,195) for No. 2 all-time in passing yards at Baylor (8,369).

Trailing 27-0 less than 17 minutes into the game, Baylor football could have thrown in the towel. Instead, the Bears clawed back within 10 of the TCU Horned Frogs and missed on a fourth-down try that could have made things even tighter.

Sparked by big plays, including a 67-yard punt return by Derius Davis, TCU (2-3) held on for a 33-23 victory Saturday afternoon in the Bears' first home game at McLane Stadium in 35 days.

The Bears' comeback started with a big fourth-down stop by Terrel Bernard and Brayden Utley. Ben Sims, who had a career-high four receptions for 40 yards, grabbed a three-yard TD pass from Brewer that made it a 33-14 game.

Feeling a significant momentum switch, Baylor appeared to score another touchdown when Charlie Brewer found Trestan Ebner down the right sideline. But, Ebner stepped out at the 8-yard line, and the Bears had to settle for a 27-yard field goal by John Mayers.

When the defense forced another three-and-out, Baylor came up with a quick answer, with Craig "Squirl" Williams finishing off a five-play, 71-yard drive with a 32-yard touchdown, his third career TD. Brewer missed on the two-point conversion that would have made it a one-score game.

Driving from its own 9-yard line, Baylor marched into TCU territory, but safety Trevon Moehrig broke up a 4th-and-3 pass to Sims. The Horned Frogs were able to run out the last 6 1/2 minutes and escape with the win.

POSTGAME NOTES

- Charlie Brewer (203 yards) passed for over 200 yards for the 21st time in his career.
- RS freshman Yusuf Terry had career highs in catches (2), yards (43) and longest reception (27).
- RJ Sneed hauled in the longest catch of his career for 39 yards in the second quarter. The play was the longest for the Baylor offense in 2020.

Baylor was able to flip the script from the previous three games, jumping out to a 14-point lead in the first quarter and going in at the half up 21-10 on 17th-ranked Iowa State Saturday night at Jack Trice Stadium.

Things didn't go as well in the second half, though, as the Cyclones (5-2, 5-1) ripped off 28 unanswered points and then withstood a furious rally by the Bears (1-4, 1-4) to escape with a 38-31 win in a back-and-forth battle that went down to the wire.

After struggling to get anything going in the third quarter, Baylor's offense got the lift it needed when **Charlie Brewer** hit **Trestan Ebner** for a 58-yard touchdown pass on a gutsy 4th-and-8 call that made it a seven-point game with 8:43 remaining.

That stopped a 28-point scoring spree by the Cyclones that included three Brock Purdy touchdown passes and a 17-yard TD run by Breece Hall, the nation's leading rusher, who finished with 133 yards on 31 carries.

With Brewer completing 22-of-33 passes for 295 yards, the Bears actually finished with a slight edge in total offense, 366-362, and scored 24 points on Iowa State's four turnovers.

POSTGAME NOTES

- **Kalon Barnes** picked up his second career interception in the first quarter. His last INT came back on Oct. 19, 2019 against Oklahoma State.
- **Jared Atkinson** had the longest reception of his career with a 62-yard catch and run in the opening quarter. It was the Bears' longest play of the season.
- **RJ Sneed** tied a career high with receptions and had a career-best 93 yards receiving.
- With his three touchdown passes in the game, **Charlie Brewer** passed Seth Russell (60 - 2013-16) and tied Bryce Petty (62 - 2011-14) for second place all-time at Baylor.
- **Raleigh Texada** had his third INT of his career in the first quarter and returned it a career-best 56 yards.
- **Drake Dabney** had a career day with his first career reception and first touchdown in the first quarter. He finished the day with three catches for 32 yards.
- **Jalen Pitre's** interception return for a touchdown in the second quarter was the first INT of his career and the first pick-six since Ryan Reid at Kansas 2016. The score marked the first defensive TD since Bernard's fumble return at OSU on Oct. 19 last year.

Leading by double digits going into the fourth quarter, Baylor gave up 12 unanswered points and lost a heartbreaker to Texas Tech, 24-23, on a 25-yard field goal by Jonathan Garibay on the last play of the game Saturday night at Jones AT&T Stadium.

The Bears got out to a fast start for the second-straight week with a 26-yard interception return by Jalen Pitre, who has had pick-six returns on both of his interceptions over the last two weeks.

Baylor went into the locker room with a 13-6 lead on a 48-yard field goal by John Mayers and extended that with an eight-yard TD run by Charlie Brewer after a fumble recovery by Dillon Doyle.

Tech cut into the deficit with a one-yard TD run by Tahj Brooks after a Brewer interception, but the Bears answered with a 23-yard field goal by Mayers after Brewer was stopped by linebacker Colin Schooler on a goal-line stop that made it a 23-12 game.

Sparked by quarterback Alan Bowman, who had been benched in favor of grad transfer Henry Colombi from Utah State, the Red Raiders pulled within five on another Brooks TD and tacked on a pair of field goals by Garibay in the final five minutes.

Brewer was 17-of-26 for 153 yards and also rushed for 76 yards on 16 carries. Freshman Qualan Jones, making his first career start, had 86 yards on 21 carries.

POSTGAME NOTES

- With his season-high 76 rushing yards **Charlie Brewer** moved up to No. 3 all-time (998) at Baylor in rushing yards for a quarterback after passing Mark Jackson (1974-76).
- With 153 passing yards, Brewer went over 9,000 for his career with 9,020.
- **Qualan Jones** had a career day with 21 rushes for 86 yards in his first career start. Jones became the first Baylor running back with 20 or more carries since John Lovett (28) against Texas Tech in 2018.
- For the second consecutive game, **Jalen Pitre** picked off a pass and took it back for a touchdown (26 yards). It was the first time since 2016 that Baylor has had two INT returns for TD in same season (Orion Stewart and Ryan Reid). It was the first time a BU player has had two interceptions returned for a touchdown in a season by the same player since Eddie Lackey 2012.
- **Josh Landry** blocked his first career PAT in the third quarter. It was the first PAT blocked for BU since last year vs. Oklahoma State, 2019 (James Lynch).
- With his 11 points in the game **John Mayers** now up to 9th all-time in points, kicking with 143 (passing Ryan Havens - 135, 2003-06).
- First time starter **Abram Smith** set a new career high in tackles with 13.
