TOURNAMENT NOTES

- Baylor improved to 51-15 (.773) all-time in the NCAA Tournament, all coming under head coach Kim Mulkey.
- Baylor is 18-1 all-time in first-round games with 18-straight advances to the second round when making the tournament.
- Baylor's 15 steals were its second-most all-time in an NCAA Tournament game.
- Baylor's 60 rebounds were its second-most in an NCAA Tournament game.
- NaLyssa Smith's 8-9 effort from the floor was the third-best individual shooting percentage (88.9) by a Baylor player in an NCAA Tournament game.
- Baylor's 101 points was its third-most in an NCAA Tournament game.
- Baylor's 38 field goals made were its fourth-best effort in an NCAA Tournament game.
- Mulkey has guided the Lady Bears to 19 NCAA Tournament appearances and 17-straight.
- Seventeen straight NCAA Tournament appearances ranks 12th all-time and is the fifth-longest active streak.
- Baylor is a No. 2 seed, and it marks the 10th-straight year that Baylor is at least a two seed or higher.
- Baylor earned trips to the Final Four in 2005, 2010, 2012 and 2019. Baylor won the NCAA titles in 2005, 2012 and 2019.
- Baylor's string of 16-straight NCAA Tournament appearances ranks sixth-best among active streaks in the NCAA
- Baylor is 4-5 all-time in Elite 8 contests.
- Baylor is 9-5 all-time in Sweet 16 contests.

TEAM NOTES

- Baylor improved to 630-103 (.859) under head coach Kim Mulkey.
- Baylor improved to 2-0 vs. Jackson State all-time.
- Baylor's overall win streak reached 18 games.
- Baylor is 366-27 (.931) since the 2010-11 season.
- Baylor has out-rebounded its opponents in 158 of the last 168 games.
- In 719 of 733 games under Mulkey, the Lady Bears have held their opponent at or below 50 percent field goal shooting with only eight of those efforts coming in the last 15 seasons.
- All 11 Lady Bears played and scored in today's ballgame.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Moon Ursin established a new career high with 24 points.
- Ursin reached double figures for the 32nd game in her career and 19th time this season.
- Sunday's game was **Ursin's** first double-digit scoring performance in an NCAA Tournament game.
- Ursin also tied her career high with three made 3-pointers, all coming in the first quarter.
- NaLyssa Smith dropped 18 points, her personal best in an NCAA Tournament game and fourth-career double-digit scoring performance in the Big Dance.
- Smith grabbed 10 rebounds for her second-career NCAA Tournament double-double.
- DiJonai Carrington's 10 points marked her seventh-career NCAA Tournament outing in double figures.
- Queen Egbo's 10 points were a career-high in NCAA Tournament games.
- Jordyn Oliver had 14 points in her NCAA Tournament debut, it marked the fourth time this season, she's had 10+.
- Oliver had a career-high four steals.
