## STORY LINES

### BAYLOR WOMEN'S BASKETBALL IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

To get to Monday, Baylor beat Jackson State in the first round, 101-52 on March 21, in the program's debut on network television on ABC. The Lady Bears' 60 rebounds and 15 steals were both second-most in Baylor's NCAA Tournament history. On March 23, Baylor beat West Virginia, 90-48, to set a program record for largest margin of victory (42) in the second round. Saturday, Baylor won its first overtime game in the NCAA Tournament with a 78-75 victory over Michigan to advance to the program's 10th Elite 8.

Baylor is competing in its 19th NCAA Tournament appearance for the Baylor women's basketball program, all coming under the watch of 21st-year head coach Kim Mulkey. The only season Mulkey's Lady Bears have missed the NCAA Tournament came in 2003. Baylor is 4-5 all-time in the NCAA Elite 8 with four trips to the Final Four. The Lady Bears have advanced to the national semifinals round in 2005, 2010, 2012 and 2019 while winning three NCAA Championships. Baylor's NCAA titles in 2005, 2012, and 2019 made the program one of three to have at least three championships, joining UConn and Tennessee. Baylor carries a 53-15 (.779) all-time record in the NCAA Tournament, which ranks as the third-best winning percentage in NCAA history. The Lady Bears' 53 wins are eighth all-time and 17-straight NCAA appearances is the fifth-longest active streak in women's basketball.

### LADY BEARS VS. UCONN

Monday marks the ninth meeting between the two schools, and thus far, it's been a see-saw battle with each team exchanging punches in two-game increments. UConn took the first two games of the series, which began in 2010 at the Alamodome in the semifinals round and the Huskies taking a 70-50 win, April 4, 2010. UConn followed up with a win just seven months later in Hartford, Conn., in November of 2010. Baylor answered back with two wins, the first in Waco in December of 2011 and the other in Hartford in February of 2013. UConn took a 4-2 series lead with a win in Waco in January of 2014 and in Storrs, Conn. in November of 2016. Baylor picked up the only two wins over a No. 1-ranked team in each of the next two meetings as UConn held the top-ranked spot in the AP in each of the last two games where Baylor came out victorious. The Lady Bears dealt the Huskies a nine-point loss, Jan. 3, 2019 in Waco and then beat them a season later by 16 in Hartford.

**1,000** The Baylor women's basketball program picked up its 1,000th victory Dec. 1 in Tampa at South Florida. The Lady Bears became the 15th Division I program to accomplish the feat.

**668** Baylor head coach Kim Mulkey has made 668 appearances in the AP Top 25 combined as player at Louisiana Tech, an assistant at her alma mater, and 21 years as Baylor's head coach. She is the active leader in that category and trails only former Tennessee player, assistant and head coach Holly Warlick (693).

**129** Baylor's No. 5 ranking in the *Associated Press* Top 25 marked 129 straight weeks that the Lady Bears have ranked in the Top 10, dating back to 2015.

**STORY LINES**

**BAYLOR'S NATIONALLY TELEVISED MATCHUP ON ABC MAKES HISTORY**

While the Baylor Lady Bears are no stranger to television (337-66 in the Mulkey era), March 21 vs. Jackson State marked the first time in program history that Baylor has played on one of the four major television networks. The Lady Bears and Lady Tigers debuted on ABC with Beth Mowins and former UConn standout Renee Montgomery on the call.

Baylor didn't have to wait long to get its second ABC nod as the network carried Baylor's Sweet 16 overtime thriller with Michigan Saturday.

**LADY BEARS FINALIZE ANOTHER SWEEP OF BIG 12 TITLES**

Baylor's 23 combined conference championships are tied with Stanford for the most in the Power 5 since the 2004-05 season. The Lady Bears' 17-1 record in Big 12 play allowed Baylor to cruise to its 11th-straight regular-season title and 12th overall. Baylor's 76-50 win over West Virginia Sunday solidified the Lady Bears' 11th Big 12 Tournament Championship. The Lady Bears enter the NCAA Tournament as a No. 2 seed, the 10th-straight postseason as a No. 2 seed or higher.

**LADY BEARS IN NATION'S LEAD FOR FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE DEFENSE ... AGAIN**

For four-straight years and five since the 2010-11 season, the Baylor Lady Bears have been the NCAA Statistical Champion in Defensive Field Goal Percentage. It took until Feb. 14, but Baylor leads the category again through 30 games at a .322 clip. The Lady Bears also lead the nation in rebound margin at 19.7.

**BAYLOR TAKES HOME SEVERAL ALL-CONFERENCE AWARDS TO COMPLIMENT 11TH-STRAIGHT REGULAR-SEASON TITLE**

NaLyssa Smith was the ninth Lady Bear in Baylor history to pick up Big 12 Player of the Year honors, and she was a unanimous selection to the All-Big 12 First Team, the league announced March 10. DiJonai Carrington was named Big 12 Sixth Person of the Year and continued the trend of graduate transfers at Baylor winning the Big 12 Newcomer of the Year. She joined Chloe Jackson (2019) and Te'a Cooper (2020) to become the third-straight winner for Baylor, and Carrington was named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

DiDi Richards and Moon Ursin both landed spots on each the All-Big 12 Second Team and Big 12 All-Defensive Team while Queen Egbo rounded out the Lady Bears' selections on the honorable mention team.

**AP POLL RESEARCH SHOWS MULKEY AS ACTIVE LEADER IN TOTAL TOP 25 APPEARANCES AS PLAYER, ASSISTANT AND HEAD COACH**

Longtime women's hoops guru Mel Greenberg put together a list of coaches and players' appearances in the AP Top 25 poll over the years and found that Baylor head coach Kim Mulkey is the NCAA's active leader in appearances at 668 from her time as a player and assistant at Louisiana Tech and her 21-year tenure as head coach at Baylor. She trails only Holly Warlick (693) for most all-time appearances; Warlick played, assisted Pat Summitt and was head coach at Tennessee from 2012-2019.

**COVID-19'S EFFECT ON THE LADY BEARS**

Baylor lost four games scheduled for the Preseason WNIT in Waco in November, along with a Thanksgiving week game vs. Oregon in Las Vegas. Baylor lost its top-10 matchup with UConn Jan. 7.

Moon Ursin, lost her grandmother, Ruby Alexander, to the virus in April after a swift and brief battle with COVID. Kamaria McDaniel, a transfer from Penn State that is having to sit this season, lost her grandfather, Johnny Webster, Sr., in April as well. Kim Mulkey, Jordyn Oliver, DiJonai Carrington and Caitlin Bickle have all had to miss time due to COVID-19 protocols this season.

**RICHARDS RETURNS TO FLOOR AFTER SPINAL INJURY, FEATURED ON ESPN'S SPORTSCENTER**

Oct. 24, Moon Ursin and DiDi Richards collided in mid-air during a practice scrimmage, leaving Ursin with a concussion and Richards with a Spinal Cord Injury Without Radiographic Abnormality (SCIOWRA). Ursin returned to practice after clearing concussion protocol in mid-November while Richards' rehab began immediately after she briefly lost feeling below her knees. Richards was first confined to a walker to assist her in walking, but by mid-November, she was completing individual drills and workouts with medical and strength & conditioning staff. Richards shocked doctors, team medical staff and coaches with the rate of her rehab. Thirty-eight days after the injury, she played 30 minutes off the bench at South Florida Dec. 1. She scored a bucket 13 seconds into her entry, and picked up where she left off last season by leading Baylor with seven assists. Dec. 6 in Fayetteville, Ark., she resumed her starting role, getting her first start at point guard and finished the contest with a game-high eight assists. She led the Big 12 in assists per game in 2019-20, ranked 13th in the nation and had the NCAA's sixth-best assist-to-turnover ratio at 2.9:1.

**THE BAYLOR LADY BEARS REGIME**

**2019 NCAA CHAMPIONS**

The 2018-19 Lady Bears became just the third women's program in NCAA history to win three titles when Baylor beat Notre Dame 82-81 April 7 in Tampa, Fla. **Chloe Jackson's** go-ahead scoop layup with under five seconds left propelled her to NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player honors to go along with a team-high 26 points in the game. The Lady Bears rode the wave of two All-American posts with **Kalani Brown** and **Lauren Cox** each earning multiple all-America honors. The pair led Baylor to its 10th regular-season and tournament championship in the Big 12 and **Kim Mulkey** was honored as national coach of the year by the USBWA, the *Associated Press* and the WBCA.

**2012 NCAA CHAMPIONS**

The 2011-12 Lady Bear season was as perfect as it could be. En route to claiming its second NCAA Championship in seven years, Baylor ran the table, posting an unprecedented 40-0 mark and claiming both Big 12 Conference crowns. **Brittney Griner** and Mulkey swept player of the year and coach of the year honors, earning WBCA, USBWA, Associated Press, Naismith and Big 12 Conference recognition. Baylor was ranked No. 1 wire-to-wire in both polls and raced through conference play with a Big 12-record 18-0 mark. Griner and **Odyssey Sims** were named consensus All-Americans, while **Destiny Williams** was a WBCA All-America honorable mention honoree.

**2005 NCAA CHAMPIONS**

The squad posted a 33-3 record and claimed the Big 12 Conference title with a 14-2 mark. En route to the program's first NCAA Championship, the Lady Bears defeated three No. 1 seeds. **Steffanie Blackmon** and **Sophia Young** were both named All-Americans. In addition to earning Big 12 Coach of the Year honors, **Mulkey** received the New York Athletic Club's prestigious Winged Foot Award.

**NCAA TOURNAMENT STAPLE & 11+-YEAR DOMINANCE**

- The Lady Bears have made 17 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and 19 overall. Those appearances have resulted in three national championships (2005, 2012, 2019), four Final Fours (2005, 2010, 2012, 2019), 10 Elite Eights and 14 Sweet Sixteens.
- The Lady Bears are 23-time Big 12 Champions—most in Big 12 history—capturing 11 consecutive regular season titles, 12 overall & 11 tournament titles.
- Baylor is 368-27 (.931) over the past 11 seasons while posting a 187-9 (.954) mark in Big 12 play and 27-1 (.964) in Big 12 Tournament play.
- 317 of Baylor's 368 wins since 2010-11 have been by 10 or more points, and only 17 times in that span has its winning margin been five or fewer points (most recently five, 67-32, at South Florida, Dec. 1, 2020).
- In Baylor's last 525 games, only five times (Texas, .516 and .515; Stanford, .509; West Virginia, .500; South Carolina, .528) has a team shot 50 percent or above.

**BIG 12 DYNASTY**

- Baylor women's basketball has won a league-leading 23 Big 12 Conference titles, 12 regular season and 11 tournament championships.
- Baylor has run the table in the conference four times (2012, 2013, 2018, 2019). It has only happened six times in Big 12 history (Oklahoma: 16-0 in 2006; Nebraska: 16-0 in 2010).
- Baylor has advanced to the Big 12 Championship game 10 times in a row and 14 times in program history.
- The Lady Bears have won nine of the last 10 Big 12 Championship titles, besting No. 17/20 West Virginia, 76-50, in the 2021 final.

**HEAD COACH KIM MULKEY • 21ST SEASON**



If Kim Mulkey was a stock, investors would find few, if any, dips in the market that would keep them from going all-in. They would just buy, hold and watch happily while their investment compounded. So, what's left to do for the Hall of Fame coach? At this point, any further success for Mulkey is cherries on the top of a giant sundae. Three NCAA national championships, a combined 22 Big 12 regular-season and tournament titles, achieving 600 career wins faster than

any other D1 men's or women's coach, and the pinnacle of individual basketball honors – she was named to the 2020 Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame Class.

Baylor hired Mulkey on April 4, 2000, to overhaul a program that had just seven wins in the 1999-2000 season and 13 losing seasons in the previous 17. Little did anyone know, that hire would lay the groundwork for the third act of Mulkey's career that has outshined the first two.

Mulkey's Lady Bears became just the third program in NCAA history to have at least three national titles when Baylor beat Notre Dame, 82-81 on April 7, 2019. The victory placed Baylor in the most prestigious of companies, joining UConn and Tennessee as the only programs with at least three. That championship was the fifth that Mulkey had been a part of. At Louisiana Tech, she was the starting point guard when the Lady Techsters won the inaugural NCAA championship in 1982, then she was an assistant coach for another title run in 1988.

Nearly five years to the day that Baylor brought in Mulkey, she delivered the athletics department's first women's NCAA title when the Lady Bears' 22-point victory over Michigan State on April 5, 2005, capped an improbable run that saw BU take down three No. 1 seeds. Seven years later, the Brittney Griner and Odyssey Sims-led Lady Bears made history with the first 40-0 season in NCAA history, capped with a win over Notre Dame in the 2012 finals. Keeping with the theme of sevens, Baylor's Chloe Jackson hit a game-winning scoop layup to down the Fighting Irish in the 2019 title matchup once again with 3.9 seconds remaining.

On Feb. 18, 2020, in a win at Texas Tech, Mulkey became the fastest Division I coach (men's or women's) to reach 600 career victories. She accomplished the feat in 700 games in her 20th season as head coach. Adolph Rupp was second on the list as the Kentucky Hall of Fame men's coach achieved 600 wins in his 704th game. UConn's Geno Auriemma was the next-fastest women's coach to reach 600 wins in his 716th game.

Mulkey received basketball's highest honor on April 4, 2020, when she was named to the 2020 class for the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. She joined Kobe Bryant, Tim Duncan, Kevin Garnett, Rudy Tomjanovich, Tamika Catchings, Eddie Sutton, Barbara Stevens and Patrick Baumann as a member of the nine-person class. Although the Naismith is the "trump card" for Hall of Fames, Mulkey was able to call herself a Hall of Famer long before her 2020 induction. She has previous inductions into the National High School Hall of Fame (1985), Louisiana High School Hall of Fame (1986), Louisiana Sports Writers Hall of Fame (1990), Louisiana Tech Athletics Hall of Fame (1992), Women's Basketball Hall of Fame (2000), CoSIDA Academic All-America Hall of Fame (2003), Baylor Athletics Hall of Fame (2007) and Texas Sports Hall of Fame (2010).

Baylor's entire resume under the guidance of Mulkey deserves admiration, however, her Lady Bears since the 2010-11 season soared to a new stratosphere. The program's .932 winning percentage in that span is second only to UConn. Eighteen of the Lady Bears' 21 Big 12 titles have come in that span, including 10 consecutive regular-season championships and eight of the possible nine Big 12 Tournament titles, with the 2020 tournament cancelled due to COVID-19.

Mulkey has also done a phenomenal job of preparing student-athletes for the next level of competition and in life. Of all the Lady Bear players who have started and finished their career at Baylor, those student-athletes have a 100 percent graduation rate. In addition, Baylor has had nine 1st-round draft picks to the WNBA, 19 WNBA draft picks overall, and dozens of Lady Bears who have played professionally overseas.

She is the only person in basketball to have won a national championship as a player, assistant coach and head coach. Mulkey is also the only women's basketball coach, and one of only three in men's and women's basketball, to have a national title as a player and head coach, joining Bob Knight and Dean Smith.

Eight times, Mulkey has taken home "National Coach of the Year" honors from various entities, and she has been selected as the Big 12 Coach of the Year eight times. Mulkey's Lady Bears have made the NCAA Tournament in 18 of 19 opportunities under her tutelage, they have earned four trips to the NCAA Final Four, nine trips to the Elite Eight, and 14 trips to the NCAA Sweet 16, including 11-straight trips.

Baylor's first Big 12 Conference championship came in 2005, which led to a Big 12 Tournament Championship and the school's first NCAA title. Since then, Baylor has swept the regular season and tournament titles in the Big 12 nine times. After a five-year hiatus between regular-season titles, the Lady Bears' dominance began in 2011 with the first of 11-straight.

Mulkey has coached 19 different All-Americans to 85 honors by various entities, and eight players under her watch have received first-team All-America status by either the Associated Press, USBWA, WBCA or John Wooden selections. She saw Brittney Griner (2012, 2013) and Odyssey Sims (2014) take home the Wade Trophy for the nation's top college player, Griner won the John Wooden Award in 2012 and 2013 along with the Naismith Trophy in 2012 and 2013 for nation's top player. Griner won the National Defensive Player, awarded by the WBCA, three-straight seasons from 2011-13, while DiDi Richards took home the award in 2020. Richards also won the National Defensive Player of the Year Award in 2020 from Naismith.

The 2019-20 season marked the fourth-straight year that Baylor led the country in field goal percentage defense. They also ranked first in that category in 2010-11, and save for the 2013-14 season where the Lady Bears ranked 19th in the nation, Baylor hasn't finished outside of the top five in the last decade. In fact, in only 16 of 705 games since Mulkey took over at Baylor for the 2000-01 season, have the Lady Bears allowed an opponent to shoot 50 percent or better in a game.

Mulkey came to Baylor from Louisiana Tech where she spent 19 years as either a student-athlete or coach in the legendary Lady Techster program. During her tenure in Ruston, Mulkey was associated with 11 Final Four squads and three national championship teams. She has either played or coached in the national championship game on eight occasions.

As a player, Mulkey led the Lady Techsters to a 130-6 (.956) record, two national titles and four Final Fours from 1980-84. During that time, the 5-foot-4 playmaker, known for her spectacular passes and French braids, also led Louisiana Tech to its first two national championships (1981 and 1982) and was a part of the USA's Gold medal-winning team at both the 1984 Olympics and the 1983 Pan American Games.

In addition, the summa cum laude scholar was a two-time Academic All-America as a business major. In recognition of her success in the classroom and on the basketball court, Mulkey was inducted into the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-America Hall of Fame in June 2003.

At Hammond High School, she led the basketball team to four-straight state championships, posted a 136-5 record and finished her career with a then-national record 4,075 points. She earned all-district, all-state and All-America honors each of her four years at Hammond High. She also graduated as her class' valedictorian with a perfect 4.0 grade point average. Mulkey has a street named after her in her hometown of Tickfaw, La.

Born May 17, 1962, in Santa Ana, Calif., Mulkey has two children, daughter Makenzie (28) and son Kramer (25).

Makenzie (Robertson) Fuller serves as associate director of basketball operations for the Lady Bears. She was a four-year letter winner on Baylor's basketball team, and during her career the Lady Bears posted an impressive 140-10 record, which included eight Big 12 crowns and an NCAA national championship (2012).

She earned both a bachelor and master's degree from Baylor and married former Baylor football and professional baseball player Clay Fuller in 2015. The couple had Mulkey's first grandchild, Kannon Reid Fuller, in 2018.

Kramer attended LSU, where he played for the highly touted Tiger baseball team. He was a first team All-SEC shortstop and second team Louisville Slugger All-American in 2016, and garnered third-team Collegiate Baseball All-American, honorable mention Perfect Game All-American and second-team All-SEC accolades in 2017. After leading LSU back to the College World Series in 2017, which resulted in a runner-up finish, Kramer was selected in the fourth round of the MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. As of 2020, he has played as high as Triple-A, with his most recent action on the franchise's taxi squad in the COVID-19-shortened season.

Mulkey's autobiography, "Won't Back Down" with Peter May, a retired Boston Globe senior sportswriter, appeared in bookstores Nov. 5, 2007, and the paperback edition became available Sept. 8, 2008.
