- Baylor Captains: Grant Miller, Thor Rodoni, RJ Sneed and Brayden Utley.
- The crowd of 42,529 was the largest home crowd for Baylor since Nov. 16, 2019 vs. Oklahoma

TEAM NOTES

- This was Baylor's first win over a ranked opponent since December 29, 2015 when they beat No. 10 North Carolina in the Russell Athletic Bowl.
- Baylor is now 4-0 for the sixth time in the last nine seasons.
- Baylor improves to 11-9 all time against the Cyclones including a 7-3 mark in Waco.
- The Bears streak of a touchdown in 11-straight quarters was snapped in the 4th quarter. It was the longest streak in a season since 2016.
- Baylor's 31 points were the most allowed by the Cyclone defense in a single game since November 7, 2020 when the Bears scored 31 at Iowa State.
- Baylor has now scored seven non-offensive touchdowns in Dave Aranda's first 13 games, the most in a 13-game span since 2013.
- Trestan Ebner's 98-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in the 3rd quarter tied for the fifth-longest in school history.
- It was the Bears' first kickoff return for a touchdown since September 26, 2020, when Trestan Ebner returned one 83 yards for a touchdown against Kansas.
- The Bears are now eight of nine on fourth-down conversions on the season.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Trestan Ebner notched his third-career kickoff return for a touchdown.
- Ebner became the 25th player in Baylor history with 1,300 receiving yards (1,308), moving him to a tie for 24th on Baylor's all-time receiving yards list.
- Ebner moved past Braford Lewis for 35th on Baylor's career rushing yards list.
- Ben Sims caught his fifth career touchdown pass on Saturday joining Ken Hodge and Ronnie Bo Lee with the third-most touchdown receptions by a tight end in school history.
- . With 25 career catches, Sims moves past Mike McKenzie into ninth place all-time in career recptions by a tight end.
- RJ Sneed became the 26th player in Baylor history with 1,300 career receiving yards (1,308), moving him into a tie for 24th on Baylor's all-time receiving yards list.
- With 44 receiving yards on Saturday, Tyquan Thornton became the 19th player in Baylor history with 1,500+ receiving yards (1,518).
- Thornton moves into 19th-place on Baylor's career receving yards list.
- Quarterback Gerry Bohannon rushed for a touchdown for a third-straight game, becoming the first Baylor quarterback to rush for a touchdown in three-straight games since Charlie Brewer in 2019.
- Garmon Randolph's 4th quarter interception was the first interception of his career.
- Gabe Hall notched his first career sack.
- Al Walcott collected his first career tackle for loss as part of his six-tackle performance.
