- Baylor Captains: Dillon Doyle, Connor Galvin, Cole Maxwell, Xavier Newman-Johnson
- Baylor is now 49-43-3 all-time in homecoming games

TEAM NOTES

- The Baylor defense has now forced a turnover in 15-straight games.
- The Bears recovered their first successful onside kick since Sept. 8, 2018 at UTSA.
- Baylor had zero accepted penalties for the first time in program history.
- Baylor has now won six-straight non-conference games.
- The Bears notched a season-high 47 rushing attempts.
- Baylor recorded 5+sacks for a second game in a row.
- With its sixth win of the season, Baylor is now bowl eligible for the 10th time in the last 12 years.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Abram Smith rushed for career highs in yards (188), carries (27), and touchdowns (3).
- 188 rushing yards are the most by a Baylor player in a single game since Shock Linwood had 237 at lowa State October 1, 2016.
- Smith's performance marked the 14th-best single-game rushing performance in Baylor history.
- Smith is the 20th different player in program history to have at least four 100-yard rushing games in a career.
- Quarterback Gerry Bohanon accounted for a touchdown for a sixth-straight game.
- Bohanon's first-quarter interception snapped a streak of 190 attempts without an interception, to start his career, 19 attempts shy of the NCAA record set by Robert Griffin III.
- With 10 rushing yards, Bohanon moved into 9th place all-time in career-rushing yards by a quarterback (430).
- Dillon Doyle is the first player in program history to record a rushing touchdown, a receiving touchdown and a sack in the same game.
- Doyle's rushing and receiving touchdowns were each the first of his career.
- Doyle's sack was the second of his career and the first since October 31, 2020.
- With his sack in the 3rd quarter, Terrel Bernard tallied 12 for his career, moving him into the top-10 in program history tying him with K.J. Smith, Santana Dotson and Glenn Coy.
- With 95 yards, Trestan Ebner became the 34th BU player with 1,300 + career rushing yards.
- Ebner now ranks 29th in BU history in career rushing yards with 1,375.
- Ebner played in his 54th career game to move into sole possession of second place in career games played. He is now just three games behind the all-time leader Chris Platt (57).
- Jalen Pitre recorded his first sack of the season, and now has 5.5 for his career.
- Tight end Ben Sims set a new single-game high with 52-yards receiving. His previous high was 48 against Kansas State Nov. 28, 2020.
- T.J. Franklin recorded a sack for a second-straight game. He now has five for his career.
- Chateau Reed recorded his career-first tackle.
