STORY LINES

- No. 9/8 Baylor takes hosts Central Arkansas at 7 pm CT Wednesday at the Ferrell Center.
- This is the 4th series meeting. BU is 3-0 vs. UCA, with all three meetings in Waco and decided by 37+ points. The Bears won 107-66 in 2017, 105-61 in 2019 and 93-56 in 2020 (average of 102-61).
- BU has won 15-straight home games, tying the longest winning streak in Ferrell Center history.
- Baylor rolled to an 89-60 win over Nicholls State in Monday's matinee. Freshman Kendall Brown finished 2 rebounds shy of a triple-double (13p/8r/10a), while LJ Cryer had a game-high 20 points.
- Baylor recorded 33 assists vs. Nicholls State, 3rd-most in program history and most since Dec. 16, 2015.
- Baylor opened the season with an 87-60 win over Incarnate Word on Friday. Five Bears scored in double-figures, led by Matthew Mayer (14 points) and LJ Cryer and Kendall Brown (13 points apiece).
- Baylor was No. 8 in the preseason AP Top-25, snapping a school-record streak of 29-straight weeks top-5 ranked. The Bears are currently on a school-record streak of 31-straight weeks top-10 ranked.
- With its No. 8 preseason ranking, BU has been ranked in all 25 spots in the AP Top 25 Poll since 2015.
- BU's 39-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 is the nation's 3rd-longest behind Gonzaga and Villanova.
- Baylor has won 26 straight non-conference games (+21.9 average margin) dating back to Nov. 2020.
- Baylor is 27-1 at home over the last 2 seasons, with the lone loss by 3 to Kansas on Feb. 22, 2020.
- Head coach Scott Drew is in his 19th season at Baylor with a school-record 372 career victories, including a 17-8 mark in NCAA Tournaments, which is the 7th-best mark among active coaches.
- Drew has swept AP and coaches' Big 12 Coach of the Year honors each of the last two seasons.
- BU has led by at least 4 points in all 62 games since the start of the 2019-20 season and built a
 double-digit lead in 53 of 62 games, including 29 of 32 games since the start of last season.
- Baylor went 11-2 vs. AP Top 25 teams last season, including 7-0 against AP Top 10 teams.
- Baylor returned seven letterwinners from the 2021 national championship team, with Flo Thamba as
 the lone returning starter. The four departed starters are all playing in the NBA, G-League or NFL.
- Among BU returners is Matthew Mayer, who made his career-first start in the opener after coming
 off the bench in 93 games over his first 3 seasons. He is on 6-player the Preseason All-Big 12 team.
- The Bears also welcomed back **Adam Flagler**, who came off the bench in 28 games last season and is now starting. He joins Mayer on the Naismith Trophy and Wooden Award preseason watch lists.
- BU also returned LJ Cryer, Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua, Jordan Turner and Zach Loveday.
- BU added Arizona transfer James Akinjo, who is also on the Naismith Trophy watch list and is a
 preseason All-America honorable mention (The Athletic). He was first-team All-Pac 12 last season.
- Baylor welcomed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history (No. 4). Trio of freshmen includes
 5-star Kendall Brown and 4-stars Jeremy Sochan and Langston Love (out for year with injury).
- Baylor also added Fairmont State transfer Dale Bonner and redshirt freshman Dain Dainja.

TEAR INCODE ATTOR

Baylor was picked third in the Big 12 preseason coaches' poll behind Kansas and Texas. The Bears
were picked first last season (finished first) and second in 2019-20 (finished second).

QUICK HITS

- BU is playing its 281st game as a ranked team under Drew BU was ranked in 2 of 2,197 games over the program's 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since January 2010, BU has been ranked in 265 of 402 games.
- Baylor joins Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas as the only programs ranked No. 1 in 3 of 5 seasons since 2017.
- Baylor and Kansas are the only Power-5 schools to win 18+ games every year since 2008.
- BU finished last season ranked top-10 nationally in offensive rebounding pct (No. 8) for a 7th consecutive year.
- BU led the nation in 3-point pct. last season (.413) and ranked 3rd nationally in turnover margin (+5.5) and scoring margin (+17.4). The Bears were also top-10 in scoring (6th, 82.9), steals (9th, 8.9/gm) and assists (10th, 16.9/gm).
- Baylor's streak of 9 consecutive postseasons is tied as the nation's 7th-longest active streak.
- Baylor's 2 losses last seasons were its fewest losses since going 13-0 in 1911-12.
- Baylor is 40-21 in postseason tournaments (conference, national) over the last 13 seasons.
- Baylor's 56-6 record since the start of the 2019-20 season is the nation's best among Power-5 conference teams.
- Baylor has won 20+ games in 12 of the last 14 seasons after recording only three 20-win seasons in the previous 100 years of Baylor Basketball (1946, 1948, 1988).
- Baylor is 14-3 in Big 12 road games over the last 2 seasons (rest of league is 59-99 in B12 road games).
- Baylor is 77-5 when leading at halftime over the last 4+ seasons (47-2 over last 2+ seasons, 24-0 last season).
- In the last two seasons, Baylor has recorded the longest winning streak in the Big 12 Conference's 26-year history (23 wins in 2019-20) and 4th-longest winning streak in Big 12 history (18 wins in 2020-21).
- Baylor has won 90% of its games when leading at the half since 2011-12 (195-21).
- BU is 56-4 when leading at any point in the 2nd half of a game over the last 2+ seasons.
- Baylor is 247-99 over the last 10+ seasons, averaging 24.5 wins per season since 2011-12.
- Baylor's 247 wins since 2011-12 are second-most in the Big 12 behind only Kansas (286).
- Baylor is 338-146 since 2007-08, the first year Drew's staff had a full allotment of scholarships.
- Six of Baylor's players have used or are currently using a redshirt year. Two after transferring to BU (Flagler, Tchamwa Tchatchoua), one before transferring (Bonner) and three as freshmen — Turner, Dainja and Love.
- Ten of Baylor's 11 starting point guards under Drew have earned All-Big recognition (16 of last 17 seasons).
- Baylor is 1 of 10 teams nationally to appear in every postseason since 2012 (7 NCAAs, 2 NITs).
- Baylor has the nation's 10th-longest active streak with at least one 3-point FG made in 964 straight games the
 last time Baylor failed to make a 3-pointer was more than 30 years ago, on Feb. 21, 1990 vs. Texas Tech (0-8).
- BU is 7-1 all-time in Big 12/SEC Challenges, the best record of any team in either league. Combined with a 3-1 mark in the Big 12/Pac-10 Series and 1-0 in the Big 12/Big East Battle, Baylor is 11-2 in conference challenges.
- Baylor has won 7 tournament titles under **Drew** (2007 Paradise Jam, 2011 Las Vegas Classic, 2013 NIT, 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2017 Hall of Fame Classic, 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational and 2021 NCAA Championship).

SERIES HISTORY VS. CENTRAL ARKANSAS

- Baylor is 3-0 all-time vs. UCA, with all three meetings since 2017 and all decided by 37+ points.
- BU won 107-66 in the 2017-18 opener, 105-61 in the 2019-20 opener and 93-56 on Dec. 29 last season.
- Baylor's only deficit at any point in the series came in the first meeting when trailing by 3 points 1:29 into the game. The Bears have led wire-to-wire in the two most recent meetings.
- Flo Thamba and Matthew Mayer are the only Bears to have faced UCA twice. Mayer has a combined 21 points and 4 steals in 28 minutes against UCA, while Thamba has 6 points, 11 rebounds and 2 blocks in 25 minutes.

LONGEST WINNING STREAK IN FERRELL CENTER HISTORY

- Baylor's current 15-game home winning streak is tied for the longest in Ferrell Center history (est. 1988).
- Baylor has twice before won 15-straight at the Ferrell Center Feb. 21, 2015-Jan. 20, 2016 and Feb. 3, 2020-Jan. 11, 2011. This marks the 12th double-digit winning streak in Ferrell Center history (top 8 all in Drew era).

NOTEABLE STREAKS

- Baylor has won 26-consecutive games when leading at halftime (last loss Feb. 29, 2020 at TCU).
- Baylor has won 15-consecutive home games (last loss Feb. 22, 2020 vs. Kansas).
- Baylor has won 15-consecutive non-conference home games (last loss Dec. 18, 2018 vs. SFA).
- Baylor has won 26-straight games when shooting 50% or higher (last loss March 18, 2018 vs. Mississippi State).
- BU has won 45-straight when shooting a higher percentage than its opponent (last loss March 2, 2019 at K-State).
- Baylor has won 28-straight when scoring 80+ points (last loss Jan. 5, 2019 vs. TCU).
- BU has won 23-consecutive games when holding an opponent below 70 points (last loss Feb. 22, 2020 vs. KU).
- BU has won 24-consecutive games when its bench outscores the opposing bench (last loss Feb. 29, 2020 at TCU)
- Baylor has won 15-consective games when **Adam Flagler** scores 10+ points (never lost).
- Baylor has won 8-straight games following a loss (last consecutive losses were March 9-14, 2019)

ONE OF THE GREATEST REBUILDS IN NCAA HISTORY

- Scott Drew became Baylor head coach in 2003, starting of one of the greatest rebuilds in NCAA history.
- Drew was named 2020 NBC Sports National Coach of the Year and 2017 Basketball Times National COY.
- Drew is now in his 19th season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (372).
- Drew is coaching his 588th game at Baylor (372-215). His .634 winning pct. is best in BU history among coaches with 40+ games, and he's the program's all-time wins leader with 171 more victories than any other coach.
- Baylor has a .698 winning percentage (338-146) since Drew's first year with no scholarship restrictions in 2007-08 and a .714 winning percentage (247-99) over the last 10+ seasons since 2011-12.
- Drew (51) is the youngest active collegiate head coach to win a National Championship.
- Baylor is playing its 281st game as a ranked team in Drew's 19 seasons. BU was ranked in 2 of 2,197 games over the program's first 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since January 2010, BU has been ranked in 265 of 402 games.
- Baylor joins Kansas as the only Power-5 teams with 18+ wins in every season since 2008.
- In Drew's first 18 seasons at Baylor, 48 players have gone on to professional careers.

BEARS TEACH LESSON IN SHARING TO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL KIDS VS. NICHOLLS STATE

- With 3,500 local elementary school children in attendance, Baylor shared the sugar to the tune of 33 assists on 37 made field goals in an 89-60 win over Nicholls State on Nov. 15. The 33 assists were 3rd-most in BU history.
- Freshman Kendall Brown (13p/8r/10a) was two rebounds shy of a triple double, while LJ Cryer added a career-high 20 points, Jeremy Sochan had 14 points and Matthew Mayer and Adam Flagler added 12 points apiece.

BANNER OPENER WITH 87-60 WIN OVER INCARNATE WORD

- Baylor had a memorable season-opening 87-60 win over Incarnate Word on Nov. 12, as the 2021 National Championship banner was unveiled and the team was presented with its 2021 rings and in a pregame ceremony.
- Five Bears scored in double-figures, led by Matthew Mayer, who posted a team-high 14 points in his career-first start (94th game played). Freshmen Kendall Brown (13 points) and Jeremy Sochan (10 points) were joined by LJ Cryer (13 points) and James Akinjo (10 points) to account for five Bears in double-figures.

PROTECTING HALFTIME LEADS

- Baylor is 77-5 when leading at halftime over the last five seasons since the start of 2017-18.
- Baylor has won 90% of its games (195-21) when leading at the half in the last 10+ seasons ...
 2-0 in 2021-22, 24-0 in 2020-21, 21-2 in 2019-20, 15-3 in 2018-19, 15-0 in 2017-18, 18-3 in 2016-17, 18-2 in 2015-16, 21-7 in 2014-15, 18-2 in 2013-14, 17-1 in 2012-13 and 26-1 in 2011-12.
- BU has won 40% of games in which its been tied or trailing at the half since 2011-12, going 52-78 in those.

BEARS RETURN SEVEN LETTERWINNERS FROM NATIONAL TITLE TEAM

- Baylor lost four starters from last season's National Championship team, but the Bears returned seven lettermen.
- BU's seven returning lettermen entered this year with a combined 344 games (77 starts) of collegiate experience.

THIRTY-ONE STRAIGHT WEEKS AP TOP-10 RANKED

- BU is ranked No. 9 in the Nov. 15 AP Top 25, extending a school-record streak to 31-straight weeks top-10 ranked.
- With its No. 8 AP preseason ranking, Baylor's school-record streak of 28-straight weeks top-5 ranked was snapped. BU was top-5 ranked in 12 total weeks in program history prior to the 28-week streak.
- Baylor has been in the AP Top 25 a school-record 39-straight weeks, which is the nation's 3rd-longest active streak behind only Gonzaga (97) and Villanova (42).

IMPRESSIVE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS AT HOME

- Baylor is 68-4 in its last 72 non-conference home games dating back to Dec. 12, 2012.
- Baylor is 44-7 in home games against unranked opponents (including Big 12 play) since 2016-17.
- Baylor is 133-16 in non-conference home games in the Drew era, including 107-8 since 2007-08.

ALL FOUR DEPARTED STARTERS NOW PLAYING PROFESSIONALLY

- All four departed starters from last season's National Championship team are now playing professionally.
- Davion Mitchell was drafted No. 9 overall by the Sacramento Kings.
- Jared Butler was drafted No. 40 by the New Orleans Pelicans (traded to Utah Jazz).
- MaCio Teague is playing on the Utah Jazz G-League team.
- Mark Vital is suiting up for the NFL's Kansas City Chiefs.

NATION'S-BEST 17-3 VS. RANKED TEAMS OVER LAST TWO SEASONS

- Baylor is 17-3 against AP Top-25 ranked teams over the last two seasons. BU became the first team since Indiana in 1974-76 to win 10 of 11 games against ranked opponents before the Feb. 27 loss at Kansas ended the run.
- The record includes 11-2 away from home, with neutral wins vs. #17 Villanova (Nov. 2019), vs. #5 Illinois (Nov. 2020), vs. #18 Villanova (March 2021), vs. #10 Arkansas (March 2021), vs. #6 Houston (April 2021) and #1 Gonzaga (April 2021) and road wins at #22 Texas Tech (Jan. 2020), at #4 Kansas (Jan. 2020), at #15 Texas Tech (Jan. 2021), at #6 Texas (Feb. 2021) and at #6 West Virginia (March 2021).
- BU is 6-1 at home vs. ranked teams in the last 2 seasons wins vs. #12 Arizona (Dec. 2019), #18 Butler (Dec. 2019), #14 West Virginia (Feb. 2020), #9 Kansas (Jan. 2021), #17 Oklahoma State (March 2021) and #18 Texas Tech (March 2021), and the lone loss by 3 points to #3 Kansas (Feb. 2020).

DREW'S 17-8 NCAA TOURNAMENT RECORD

- Head coach Scott Drew has a 17-8 record over nine NCAA Tournament appearances, including five Sweet 16s, three Elite Eights, one Final Four and one National Championship.
- Drew's 17-8 record (.680) is 7th-best among active coaches, trailing only Mike Krzyzewski (.764; 97-30), John Calipari (56-19; .747), Rick Pitino (33-22; .730), Chris Beard (.713; 10-4), Tom Izzo (.703; 52-22) and Bill Self (.700; 49-21).
- Drew has guided Baylor to nine of the last 12 NCAA Tournaments. Prior to Drew's arrival, Baylor had been to only four NCAA Tournaments, including just once in the 53 seasons preceding his arrival in 2003-04.
- In 2008, Drew guided Baylor to its first NCAA Championship appearance in 20 seasons (since 1988) and just its second appearance in 58 seasons since going to the eight-team tournament in 1950.

APPEARANCES IN SIX OF LAST SEVEN NCAA TOURNAMENTS

- Baylor appeared in the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time in the last seven tournaments.
- BU is 1 of 16 teams to appear in six NCAA Tournaments since 2014, joining Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan, Michigan State, North Carolina, Oklahoma, Oregon, Purdue, VCU, Villanova, Virginia, Wichita State and Wisconsin.

NINE CONSECUTIVE POSTSEASON BERTHS

- Baylor is on a school-record streak of nine consecutive postseason berths and has appeared in 12 of the last 13 postseasons. BU made seven postseason appearances in the program's 97 seasons prior to the Scott Drew era.
- Baylor is 1 of 10 teams to appear in every postseason since 2012, joining Gonzaga, Iona, Kansas, Michigan State, North Carolina, Oregon, Saint Mary's, Virginia and Wichita State.
- BU earned NCAA Tournament bids in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2019 and 2021 and NIT bids in 2013 and 2018.
- Baylor has appeared in 12 of the last 13 postseasons since 2008. Prior to that, Baylor's only postseason berths were in 1946 (NCAA), 1948 (NCAA), 1950 (NCAA), 1987 (NIT), 1988 (NCAA), 1990 (NIT) and 2001 (NIT).

ONE OF FOUR PROGRAMS RANKED NO. 1 IN THREE OF LAST FIVE SEASONS

- Baylor joins Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas as the only programs ranked No. 1 in three seasons since 2017.
- . BU was No. 1 for the first time on Jan. 9, 2017, spent five weeks ranked No. 1 in 2020 and was No. 1 in the preseason and week 1 coaches' polls this year. All told, BU has been No. 1 for eight weeks since 2017.
- The Bears have been ranked in all 25 AP Top 25 spots during the Drew era (all since 2008).

FORTY WINS VS. RANKED TEAMS IN LAST SEVEN SEASONS

- Baylor has gone 40-35 against ranked teams since the start of the 2014-15 season (17-3 last 2 seasons).
- BU is 58-75 against AP-ranked teams since 2007-08 after going 17-122 in the program's first 101 seasons.
- Baylor has won multiple games vs. AP Top 25 teams in each of the last 14 seasons.
- The Bears have defeated at least five ranked teams in six of the last eight seasons.

2020-21 BAYLOR BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER SUCCESS

- Baylor has posted a combined 165-34 record in November and December games during the Drew era, including an 83-12 mark in November and December games since 2013.
- The Bears are 81-15 in November games and 84-19 in December contests during the Drew era.
- BU is 41-7 in November games since 2013, with the only losses to No. 8 Syracuse (2013), vs. Illinois (2014) in Las Vegas, at No. 25 Oregon (2015), at No. 21 Xavier (2017), vs. Texas Southern (2018), vs. Ole Miss (2018) in Florida and vs. Washington (2019) in Alaska.
- BU is 42-5 in December games since 2013, with the only losses at No. 24 Texas A&M (2015), vs. No. 8 Wichita State (2017), at No. 22 Texas Tech (2017), at Wichita State (2018) and vs. SFA (2018).

SCOTT DREW COACHING TREE

- Three current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew's BU staff.
- Matthew Driscoll is in his 13th season as head coach at North Florida after six seasons as a Baylor assistant.
- Grant McCasland is in his fifth season as head coach at North Texas. He spent five years as a Baylor assistant before taking over as Arkansas State head coach for one season in 2016-17.
- Paul Mills is in his fifth season as head coach at Oral Roberts. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 14 years with Drew, the final eight as an assistant coach.
- All 3 former assistants have led their teams to NCAA Tournaments Driscoll led UNF to the 2015 NCAA
 Tournament, while McCasland took UNT to the 2021 Second Round and Mills took ORU to the 2021 Sweet 16.

BEARS WELCOME HIGHEST-RANKED RECRUITING CLASS IN PROGRAM HISTORY FOR 2021-22

- Baylor signed the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history in November 2020, inking a trio of top-40
 recruits for the 2021-22 season. BU's 2021 recruiting class was ranked No. 4 nationally by ESPN.
- The Bears signed 5-star forward Kendall Brown, 4-star guard Langston Love and 4-star forward Jeremy Sochan.
- Brown was ranked No. 12 nationally, Love was No. 23 nationally and Sochan was No. 40 nationally.
- Brown and Sochan debuted in the season-opener, but Love is out for the year with a knee injury.

48 PRO PLAYERS IN DREW ERA

- In Scott Drew's 18 years at Baylor, 48 of his players have gone on to professional careers.
- Five Bears are currently on NBA rosters Jared Butler (Jazz), Davion Mitchell (Kings), Royce O'Neale (Jazz), Taurean Prince (Timberwolves) and Ishmail Wainright (Suns).
- In addition to the five current NBA players, eight more of Drew's former players have played in the NBA (most recent team) – Quincy Acy (Raptors), Freddie Gillespie (Raptors), Pierre Jackson (Mavs), Cory Jefferson (Suns), Perry Jones III (Thunder), Quincy Miller (Kings), Johnathan Motley (Clippers) and Ekpe Udoh (Jazz).

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Drew is in his 19th season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (372).
- Baylor has had a nation-leading four players selected in the NBA Draft since 2010 who weren't ranked in the ESPN100 out of high school — Quincy Acy, Ekpe Udoh, Pierre Jackson and Taurean Prince.
- Drew has graduated 54 players during his Baylor tenure, averaging 3 graduates per season.
- The Bears have advanced to postseason play in a school-record nine straight seasons (7 NCAA, 2 NIT).
- Baylor is 23-4 in regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, including 4 regular-season tournament titles.
- Drew has won 20+ games in 12 of the last 14 years the Bears had 3 seasons of 20+ wins prior to his arrival.

- Jared Butler (2019, 2020, 2021), Davion Mitchell (2020, 2021), Makai Mason (2019), Manu Lecomte (2017, 2018), Lester Medford (2016), Kenny Chery (2014, 2015), Pierre Jackson (2012, 2013), Tweety Carter (2010), Curtis Jerrells (2007, 2008, 2009) and Aaron Bruce (2005, 2006, 2007) have earned All-Big 12 recognition.

HISTORY OF DEVELOPMENT WITH REDSHIRTS

- Baylor has a track record of success when redshirting players. Davion Mitchell, MaCio Teague, Freddie Gillespie, Mark Vital, Ekpe Udoh, Johnathan Motley, Cory Jefferson, Brady Heslip, Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. and Manu Lecomte have all gone on to professional careers after redshirting.
- Adam Flagler and Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua redshirted in 2019-20 while sitting out to satisfy NCAA transfer rules, while Jordan Turner elected to redshirt in 2019-20. Dain Dainja redshirted last season.

BAYLOR BASKETBALL ON THE RADIO

- Baylor basketball is aired live via the Baylor Sports Network from Learfield on ESPN Central Texas and flagship station 1660AM ESPN Radio (KRZI) in Waco and worldwide on Sirius/XM Radio.
- Games are broadcast by the "Voice of the Bears" John Morris, who was named NSMA 2019 Texas co-Sportscaster of the Year on Jan. 13, 2020, and former Baylor basketball standout Pat Nunley.
- Morris is in his 38th year doing BU broadcasts (27th full-time), and Nunley is in his 41st season as analyst.
