STORY LINES

- No. 5/6 Baylor hosts Mississippi Valley State at 11 am CT on Tuesday on 'Future Bears Day', over 6,000 kids from 33 local schools will be in attendance.
- With the 11 am CT tip-off, BU and MVSU will be the first two teams to play in the 2022-23 season.
- BU has won 15 of its last 16 season openers, averaging 101.3 points per game in its last three.
- Baylor is 63-1 all time against teams from the SWAC.
- Baylor has been in the Preseason AP Top 25 in 10 of 13 seasons since its first preseason ranking in 2010-11.
- Baylor is 38-3 in non-conference games over the last three seasons.
- Entering his 20th season at BU, **Scott Drew** is coming off Big 12 Coach of the Year honors for a 3rd-straight season, joining Gene Keady (Purdue, 94-96) and Jay Wright (Villanova, 14-16) as the only high-major coaches to accomplish the feat.
- Drew enters 2022-23 just 3 wins away from 400 wins at Baylor (Only 8 active coaches have 400 wins at their current school).
- The Bears are 55-9 over the last 2 seasons, the nation's best record by a Power-5 team.
- Baylor is 81-13 over the last 3 seasons, the nation's best record by a Power-5 team.
- Baylor's streak of 10-consecutive postseason appearances is tied as the nation's 6th-longest active streak.
- BU won a school-record 26 regular-season games and finished with its 2nd-most conference wins (14) last season.
- Baylor is playing its 620th game of the 20-year Drew era – more than half (312) have been as a ranked team, a remarkable feat considering BU was unranked for the first 122 games of Drew's rebuild.
- Baylor is 39-4 vs. unranked teams over the last 2 seasons.
- Baylor's 55-9 record over the last 2 seasons is the nation's best among Power-5 teams, and the Bears' 81-13 record over the last 3 seasons is 2nd-best nationally, trailing only Gonzaga (89-6).
- BU is playing its 311th game as a ranked team under Drew – BU was ranked in 2 of 2,197 games over the program's 97 seasons prior to Drew. Since January 2010, BU has been ranked in 296 of 433 games.
- BU won 10+ conference wins for a 9th time in the last 13 seasons after doing so 8 times in 103 years.
- Baylor has won 13+ conference games in 3-straight seasons after never doing so prior to 2019-20.
- **Adam Flagler** returns for his senior season, coming off a career year where he scored in double-figures 25 times. He has scored 10+ points in 22 of his last 24 games played.
- **Flagler** was a unanimous Preseason All-Big 12 selection, after being named to the All-Big 12 second team last season.
- The senior was named a preseason Third-Team All-American by *CBS Sports* and *The Almanac*, and one of two Big 12 players on the Jerry West Award watch list.
- Heralded freshman **Keyonte George**, the highest-ranked recruit in program history, is set to make his Baylor debut.
- The fifth McDonalds All-American in program history, **George** was named the Big 12 Preseason Freshman of the Year.
- BU is just the third program in Big 12 history to have back-to-back preseason Freshmen of the Year.
- Baylor enters 2022-23 as the preseason Big 12 favorite for the second time in three seasons.

QUICK HITS

- Baylor claimed its 7th conference title in program history (1932, 1946, 1948, 1949, 1950, 2021, 2022).
- Baylor is the first team other than Kansas to win back-to-back Big 12 Titles since Iowa State in 2000 and 2001.
- No Big 12 team other than Kansas has won three-straight titles in conference history.
- Selected ninth overall by the San Antonio Spurs in June’s NBA Draft, **Jeremy Sochan** gave BU back-to-back lottery picks for the first time in program history (**Davion Mitchell** 9th overall to Sacramento in 2021).
- The Bears have had 10 picks in the last 10 drafts, which is the most in the State of Texas and second-most in the Big 12 since 2012.
- With **Kendall Brown’s** selection at No. 48 overall in the 2022 Draft, Baylor became one of five schools with multiple picks in back-to-back NBA Drafts.
- BU’s four draft selections in the last two drafts trail only Duke (6) and Kentucky (5).
- BU is 40-3 in home games over the last 3 seasons, with an average scoring margin of +19.1.
- Baylor has sold over 6,000 season tickets this season a record high for the program.
- Baylor has reached the 25-win milestone in each of the last 3 seasons and in 7 of the last 13 years. Prior to that, BU reached 25 wins just once in the program’s first 103 years (25-5 in 1945-46).
- Baylor is 22-6 against ranked teams over the last 3 seasons, including a 13-4 mark away from home.
- Baylor’s 42-8 Big 12 record over the last 3 seasons is the best of any Power-5 team.
- Head coach **Scott Drew** is in his 20th season at Baylor with a school-record 397 career victories.
- Over the last 3 seasons, Baylor is 65-5 when leading at the half and 81-7 when taking a 2nd-half lead.
- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 49-straight weeks top-10 ranked (top-5 ranked in 41 of those).
- BU is on a school-record streak of 57-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 (previous record was 25). It’s the nation’s 3rd-longest active streak behind Gonzaga (115) and Villanova (60).
- Baylor has been ranked in all 25 spots in the AP Top 25 at some point in the last 7 years.
- Baylor has been No. 1 ranked in 4 of the last 6 seasons (Gonzaga, Duke and Kansas are only others).
- Baylor and Kansas are the only Power-5 schools to win 18+ games every year since 2008.
- Baylor has built leads of 10+ points in 33 of 40 games since the start of the 2021 NCAA Tournament (33-6 record).
- BU has built double-digit leads in 78 of 94 games over the last 3 seasons (54 of 63 last 2 seasons).
- BU went 305 days between losses, the longest in program history (March 12, 2021 – Jan. 11, 2022).
- BU had a 36-game non-conference winning streak with 813 days between losses (Nov. 8, 2019 – Jan. 29, 2022).
- Baylor became the first program to start consecutive seasons 15-0 since Syracuse in 2010-11 and 2011-12.
- Baylor’s streak of 10 consecutive postseasons is tied as the nation’s 6th-longest active streak.
- Baylor is 1 of 9 teams nationally to appear in every postseason since 2012 (8 NCAAAs, 2 NITs).
- Baylor is 95-8 when leading at halftime over the last 5 seasons (65-5 over last 3 seasons).
- Baylor has won 90% of its games when leading at the half since 2011-12 (213-24).
- Baylor is 272-106 over the last 11 seasons, averaging 24.5 wins per season since 2011-12.
- Baylor’s 272 wins since 2011-12 are second-most in the Big 12 behind only Kansas (314).
- Baylor is 363-153 since 2007-08, the first year Drew’s staff had a full allotment of scholarships.
- Five of Baylor’s players have used or are currently using a redshirt year. Two after transferring to BU (Flagler, Tchamwa Tchatchoua), one before transferring (Bonner) and two as freshmen – Turner and Langston Love.
- Eleven of Baylor’s 12 starting point guards under Drew have earned All-Big recognition (17 of last 18 seasons).
- Baylor has the nation’s 9th-longest active streak with at least one 3-point FG made in 995 straight games – the last time Baylor failed to make a 3-pointer was nearly 32 years ago, on Feb. 21, 1990 vs. Texas Tech (0-8).

ONE OF THE GREATEST REBUILDS IN NCAA HISTORY

- **Scott Drew** became Baylor head coach in 2003, starting of one of the greatest rebuilds in NCAA history.
- With three more wins this season, Drew will reach 400 career wins at Baylor
- Drew was named 2020 NBC Sports National Coach of the Year and 2017 Basketball Times National COY.
- Drew is now in his 20th season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (397).
- Baylor has a .703 winning percentage (363-153) since Drew's first year with no scholarship restrictions in 2007-08 and a .720 winning percentage (272-106) over the last 10 seasons since 2011-12.
- Drew (52) is the youngest active collegiate head coach to win a National Championship.
- In Drew's first 19 seasons at Baylor, 51 players have gone on to professional careers.
- Was announced as a member of the Texas Sports Hall of Fame Class of 2023.
- He is the 23rd BU player or coach to be inducted into the Texas Sports Hall of Fame
- Will be inducted April 15, 2023 alongside Texas legends like Michael Strahan (Texas Southern), Adrian Peterson (Palestine High School) and Priest Holmes (Marshall high School & The university of Texas)
- Drew is one of 2 active coaches to have won an NCAA Title and an NIT Title. He is the only active coach to have won both at the same school (John Calipari NCAA: Kentucky, NIT: Memphis).

UP NEXT

- Baylor continues its 3-game homestand to open the season with an NCAA Tournament rematch against Norfolk State on Friday at 7 pm CT on ESPN+.
- The Bears then host Northern Colorado on Monday at 7 pm CT on ESPN+.
- BU then heads to the Continental Tire Main Event where it will play Virginia on Nov. 18th and will see either Illinois or UCLA on Nov. 20th.

SUCCESS IN SEASON OPENERS

- Baylor is 17-2 in season openers during the Scott Drew era, with the only losses coming at Texas Tech in 2005-06, when the Bears did not play a non-conference schedule, and in the 2018-19 season opener vs. Texas Southern.
- Baylor is 15-1 in season openers dating back to 2006-07, with an average scoring margin of +30.7.

DELVING INTO THE DELTA DEVILS

- Mississippi Valley State is led by George Ivory in his first season with the Delta Devils.
- The SWAC Hall of Famer was named the 12th head coach in program history in March.
- A 1988 graduate of MVSU, Ivory served three different stints as an assistant at Valley from 1998-02, 2007-08 and 2021-22. He also spent 13 years as the head coach at Arkansas Pine Bluff (
- Ivory's son George Ivory III is a sophomore guard on the team.
- Notable Alumni: Jerry Rice (NFL Hall of Famer), Deacon Jones (NFL Hall of Famer), Ashley Ambrose (NFL All-Pro DB)

NATION'S-BEST 22-6 VS. RANKED TEAMS OVER LAST THREE SEASONS

- Baylor is a nation's-best 22-6 against AP Top-25 ranked teams over the last 3 seasons.
- BU is 9-2 at home vs. ranked teams in the last 3 seasons – wins vs. #12 Arizona (Dec. 2019), #18 Butler (Dec. 2019), #14 West Virginia (Feb. 2020), #9 Kansas (Jan. 2021), #17 Oklahoma State (March 2021), #18 Texas Tech (March 2021), #6 Villanova (Dec. 2021), #20 Texas (Feb. 2022) and #5 Kansas (Feb. 2022), and losses by 3 points to #3 Kansas (Feb. 2020) and #19 Texas Tech (Jan. 2022).
- The record includes 13-4 away from home, with neutral wins vs. #17 Villanova (Nov. 2019), vs. #5 Illinois (Nov. 2020), vs. #18 Villanova (March 2021), vs. #10 Arkansas (March 2021), vs. #6 Houston (April 2021) and #1 Gonzaga (April 2021) and road wins at #22 Texas Tech (Jan. 2020), at #4 Kansas (Jan. 2020), at #15 Texas Tech (Jan. 2021), at #6 Texas (Feb. 2021), at #6 West Virginia (March 2021), at #8 Iowa State (January 2022) and at #21 Texas (Feb. 2022).

TWO-STRAIGHT NO. 1 SEEDS

- Baylor earned its second-straight No. 1 seed last year – the previous high was No. 3 in 2010, 2012, 2015 and 2017 – and if 2020 had been played, the Bears likely would've just become the 11th team all-time to earn 3-straight No. 1 seeds.
- Baylor has earned a top-3 seed in 6 of the last 12 NCAA Tournaments.
- BU is 15-5 in NCAA games as the higher seed, but last year was the first time as a higher seed after the Sweet 16.
- BU is 3-5 in NCAA games as the lower/same seed, though four of those five losses were to top-2 seeds.

NOTABLE STREAKS

- Baylor has taken a lead in 119-consecutive games (last wire-to-wire loss Dec. 1, 2018 at Wichita State).
- BU has won 64-straight when shooting a higher percentage than its opponent (last loss March 2, 2019 at K-State).
- Baylor has won 37-straight games when shooting 50% or higher (last loss March 18, 2018 vs. Mississippi State).
- Baylor has made 2 or more 3-pointers in 147-consecutive games (last on Jan. 2, 2018 vs. TCU).

BACK-TO-BACK BIG 12 CHAMPIONS

- Baylor has won back-to-back Big 12 Championships, claiming its first league titles since the 1950 SWC.
- BU became the first team other than Kansas to win consecutive Big 12 titles since Iowa State in 2000-01.
- Baylor has won seven league titles in program history, the first five in the Southwest Conference – SWC Championships: 1932 (10-2), 1946 (11-1), 1948 (11-1), 1949 (9-3) and 1950 (8-4); Big 12 Championships: 2021 (13-1) and 2022 (14-4). The 1949, 1950 and 2022 titles were co-championships.
- This marks 3-straight years of top-2 finishes; the best prior Big 12 finish was a tie for 2nd (2010 & 2017).
- Baylor’s 15 Big 12 wins in 2020 were the most ever by a team that didn’t claim the Big 12 title.

BAYLOR PARTNERS WITH CITY OF WACO ON \$700 MILLION RIVERFRONT PROJECT

- Baylor and the City of Waco have partnered on a \$700 million riverfront development project, headlined by the \$212 million Foster Pavilion, the future home for Baylor’s national champion basketball programs.
- Foster Pavilion (capacity 7,500) will be located along the Brazos River on the opposite side of I-35 from McLane Stadium.
- Groundbreaking is expected by June 2022, with the pavilion targeted for a January 2024 opening.
- Development Centers for both basketball programs are included in the 245k square foot Foster Pavilion project.

RANKED NO. 1 FOR THIRD-STRAIGHT SEASON

- Baylor reached No. 1 nationally on Dec. 13, 2021, marking a third-straight season with a No. 1 national ranking.
- BU was No. 1 for the first time on Jan. 9, 2017, spent five weeks ranked No. 1 in 2019-20, was No. 1 in the preseason and week 1 coaches’ polls last year and has been No. 1 for five weeks in 2021-22.
- Baylor has now been ranked No. 1 in 14 weekly polls all-time. The Bears are 19-4 when playing as a No. 1 team.
- Baylor joins Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas as the only programs ranked No. 1 in four seasons since 2016-17.

FORTY-NINE STRAIGHT POLLS AP TOP-10 RANKED

- Baylor is ranked No. 5 in the Preseason AP Top 25, extending a school-record streak to 49-straight polls top-10 ranked.
- The last time Baylor was not top-10 ranked in the AP Top 25 was when BU was No. 11 on Dec. 9, 2019.
- BU has been top-5 ranked in 42 of the last 49 weeks.
- Baylor has been in the AP Top 25 a school-record 58-straight weeks, which is the nation’s 3rd-longest active streak behind only Gonzaga (115) and Villanova (60).

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Drew is in his 20th season at Baylor and is the school’s all-time wins leader (397).
- Baylor has had a nation-leading four players selected in the NBA Draft since 2010 who weren’t ranked in the ESPN100 out of high school – Quincy Acy, Ekpe Udoh, Pierre Jackson and Taurean Prince.
- The Bears have advanced to postseason play in a school-record 10 straight seasons (8 NCAA, 2 NIT).
- Baylor is 26-4 in regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, including 5 regular-season tournament titles.
- Drew has won 20+ games in 13 of the last 15 years – the Bears had 3 seasons of 20+ wins prior to his arrival.

BEARS MAKE BIG 12 HISTORY

- In the last three seasons, Baylor has recorded the longest winning streak in the Big 12 Conference’s 26-year history (**23 in 2019-20**), the 3rd-longest in Big 12 history (**21 in 2021-22**) and tied the 5th-longest (**18 in 2020-21**).

SCOTT DREW COACHING TREE

- Four current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew's BU staff.
- Jerome Tang is in his first year as head coach at Kansas State. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 19 years with Drew.
- Matthew Driscoll is in his 14th season as head coach at North Florida after six seasons as a Baylor assistant.
- Grant McCasland is in his sixth season as head coach at North Texas. He spent five years as a Baylor assistant before taking over as Arkansas State head coach for one season in 2016-17.
- Paul Mills is in his sixth season as head coach at Oral Roberts. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 14 years with Drew, the final eight as an assistant coach.
- 3 of the 4 former assistants have led their teams to NCAA Tournaments – Driscoll led UNF to the 2015 NCAA Tournament, while McCasland took UNT to the 2021 Second Round and Mills took ORU to the 2021 Sweet 16.

PROTECTING HALFTIME LEADS

- Baylor is 95-8 when leading at halftime over the last five seasons since the start of 2017-18.
- Baylor has won 90% of its games (213-24) when leading at the half in the last 10+ seasons ...

- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 10-consecutive postseason berths and has appeared in 13 of the last 14 postseasons. BU made seven postseason appearances in the program's 97 seasons prior to the **Scott Drew** era.
- Baylor is 1 of 9 teams to appear in every postseason since 2012, joining Gonzaga, Iona, Kansas, Michigan State, North Carolina, Oregon, Saint Mary's and Virginia.
- BU earned NCAA bids in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2019, 2021 and 2022 and NIT bids in 2013 and 2018.
- Baylor has appeared in 13 of 14 postseasons since 2008. Prior to that, Baylor's only postseason berths were in 1946 (NCAA), 1948 (NCAA), 1950 (NCAA), 1987 (NIT), 1988 (NCAA), 1990 (NIT) and 2001 (NIT).

SECOND-MOST WINS AMONG BIG 12 TEAMS IN LAST DECADE

- Baylor's 272-105 record since 2011-12 trails only Kansas (314-78) among Big 12 teams (thru 3/17/22).

- In Scott Drew's 19 years at Baylor, 51 of his players have gone on to professional careers.
- Six Bears are currently on NBA rosters – Kendall Brown (Pacers), Davion Mitchell (Kings), Royce O'Neale (Nets), Taurean Prince (Timberwolves), Jeremy Sochan (Spurs) and Ishmail Wainright (Suns).
- In addition to the five current NBA players, eight more of Drew's former players have played in the NBA (most recent team) – Quincy Acy (Raptors), Freddie Gillespie (Raptors), Pierre Jackson (Mavs), Cory Jefferson (Suns), Perry Jones III (Thunder), Quincy Miller (Kings), Johnathan Motley (Clippers) and Ekpe Udoh (Jazz).

HISTORY OF DEVELOPMENT WITH REDSHIRTS

- Baylor has a track record of success when redshirting players. **Davion Mitchell, MaCio Teague, Freddie Gillespie, Mark Vital, Ekpe Udoh, Johnathan Motley, Cory Jefferson, Brady Heslip, Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. and Manu Lecomte** have all gone on to professional careers after redshirting.
- **Adam Flagler** and **Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua** redshirted in 2019-20 while sitting out to satisfy NCAA transfer rules, while **Jordan Turner** elected to redshirt in 2019-20. **Langston Love** redshirted last season.

BAYLOR BASKETBALL ON THE RADIO

- Baylor basketball is aired live via the Baylor Sports Network from Learfield on ESPN Central Texas and flagship station 1660AM/92.3 FM ESPN Radio (KRZI) in Waco, worldwide on Sirius/XM Radio and The Varsity Network App.
- Games are broadcast by the "Voice of the Bears" John Morris, who was named NSMA 2019 Texas co-Sportscaster of the Year on Jan. 13, 2020, and former Baylor basketball standout Pat Nunley.
- Morris is in his 38th year doing BU broadcasts (27th full-time), and Nunley is in his 41st season as analyst.
- All of Baylor's games can be heard live on the Internet at www.BaylorBears.com and via the TuneIn App.

OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING A BAYLOR STAPLE

- Baylor has ranked top-13 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage in all nine seasons since 2013-14, including six times ranked in the nation's top-5. The Bears only cracked the top-20 once in Drew's first 10 years.
- Baylor finished ranked No. 13 nationally in 2021-22, No. 5 nationally in 2020-21, No. 8 in 2019-20, No. 2 in 2018-19, No. 9 in 2017-18, No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16, No. 1 in 2014-15 and No. 3 in 2013-14. Prior to that top-10 streak, BU's best rank was No. 16 in 2011-12.

SECOND-MOST WINS AMONG BIG 12 TEAMS IN LAST DECADE

- Baylor's 272-106 record since 2011-12 trails only Kansas (319-78) among Big 12 teams (entering 2022-23).
- West Virginia (227-146) is 3rd, Iowa State (219-148) is 4th, Oklahoma (215-144) is 5th, Texas (211-155) is 6th, Kansas State (205-159) is 7th, Texas Tech (204-159) is 8th, Oklahoma St. (199-159) is 9th and TCU (185-177) is 10th.
- Baylor has averaged 24.1 wins per season over the last nine full seasons since 2011-12.

BREAKTHROUGH IN BIG 12

- BU is 156-89 in Big 12 play in 13 seasons since 2010 after going 59-149 in the league's first 13 seasons.
- BU is 169-106 in Big 12 play in 15 seasons since 2008 after going 45-131 in the league's first 11 seasons.
- Baylor is 62-45 in Big 12 road games since 2012, second-best in the league behind only Kansas (68-40).
- BU has won 8+ Big 12 games in 11-straight seasons after winning 8+ just 3 times in the league's first 15 years.
- BU has double-digit Big 12 wins in 7 of the last 8 years and 9 of the last 13 seasons. BU didn't reach double-digit Big 12 wins in any of its first 13 years in the league before reaching 10+ for the first time since 2010.

DREW IS THIRD BIG 12 COACH TO REACH 150 CONFERENCE WINS

- **Scott Drew** joined Rick Barnes and Bill Self as the only coaches to reach 150 Big 12 wins on March 4, 2021 vs. OSU.
- Drew needed 136 games over 2,940 days for his first 50 Big 12 wins (50-86), 88 games over 1,821 days for his next 50 Big 12 wins (50-38) and only 77 games over 1,493 days for his next 50 Big 12 wins (50-27).

IMPRESSIVE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS AT HOME

- Baylor is 72-4 in its last 76 non-conference home games dating back to Dec. 12, 2012.
- Baylor is 137-16 in non-conference home games in the **Drew era**, including 109-8 since 2007-08.
- Baylor is 47-7 in home games against unranked opponents (including Big 12 play) since 2016-17.

BEST IN TEXAS

- Baylor is 60-17 against in-state opponents since the start of the 2011-12 season, and the Bears have advanced deeper into postseason play than any of Texas' 23 Division I team in five of the last nine seasons.
- BU is a combined 88-24 against Lone Star State teams over the last 13 seasons after going 10-27 against in-state teams in Scott Drew's first six seasons at Baylor (5-2 in 2021-22, 4-0 in 2020-21, 6-1 in 2019-20, 4-5 in 2018-19, 6-3 in 2017-18, 7-1 in 2016-17, 9-3 in 2015-16, 10-1 in 2014-15, 6-3 in 2013-14, 7-1 in 2012-13, 10-0 in 2011-12, 5-3 in 2010-11 and 9-1 in 2009-10).
- Additionally, ten of the 20 NBA Draft picks from Texas colleges since 2012 have come from Baylor. Texas (seven), SMU (three), Texas Tech (three), Texas A&M (two), Houston (two), North Texas (one), TCU (one) and UT Arlington (one) have also had players selected in the last ten NBA Drafts.

BIG 12 BOASTS SOME OF THE BEST

- The Big 12 has won the last two NCAA men's basketball national championships, played in the last three national championship games and appeared in the last four Final Fours.
- It's the only conference to have a representative in the title game in three-straight seasons.
- The Big 12 is the first conference to win back-to-back national championships since the ACC in 2009 and 2010.
- Sixty percent of Big 12 institutions have advanced to the Final Four since 2002, the highest percentage among conferences.
- The Big 12 finished first in conference NET average last season and has led the nation in NET/RPI ratings six of the last nine seasons. The Big 12 also led all leagues in strength of schedule.
- The Big 12 led the nation in winning over 80% of its non-conference games last season and also had the best win percentage against the other power leagues.

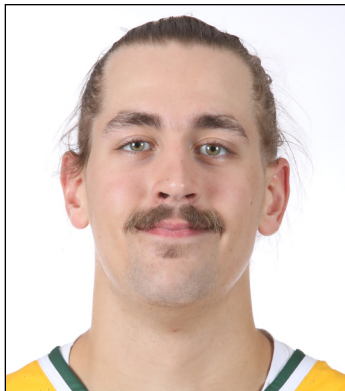

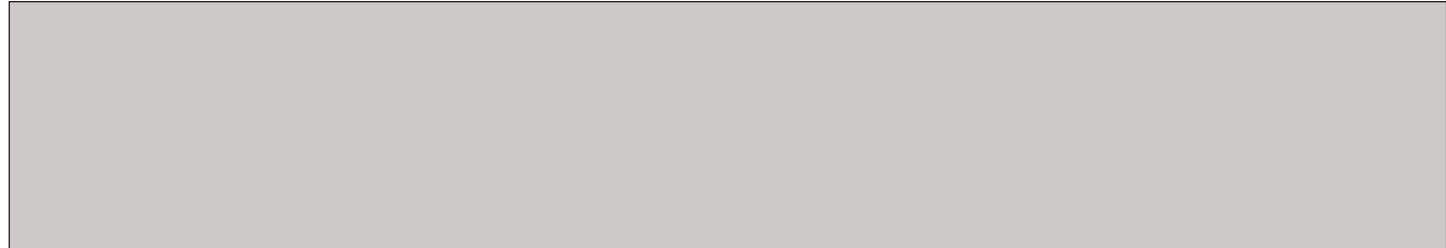

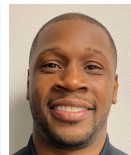
