Storylines

HERE KITTY KITTY

- The Bears are looking for their fifth series sweep of the season, this time against Kansas State.
- BU will conduct senior ceremonies post-match, celebrating Cassie Davis, Lauren Harrison, Kara McGhee and Mallory Talbert. They will also honor senior manager Fire Lasater.

ONE SHINING MOMENT

- Baylor looks to make their 10th NCAA Tournament appearance, seventh in a row, for the 2022 season.
- The NCAA Selection Show for DI Volleyball is set for 6:30pm CT on Sunday, 11/27, on ESPNU.
- Baylor is 12-10 in NCAA Tournament matches all-time, 9-6 under McGuyre.

BIG 12 BEARS

- BU is 91-36 all-time in the Big 12 under McGuyre's tutelage.
- The Bears are 5-3 in overall Conference openers and 6-2 in Big 12 openers at home under head coach McGuyre. In road openers, BU is 4-4.
- The Longhorns and Bears have been picked to finish No. 1 and No. 2 respectively in the past five years.
- The Big 12 leads the nation in the NCAA volleyball RPI for three weeks running.

MILESTONES FOR McGUYRE

- McGuyre is 6 wins away from becoming the winningest Baylor volleyball coach with 182. He currently sits at 176. Jim Barnes, McGuyre's predecessor, currently holds the title with 181 over his 10 years at Baylor
- · Head coach Ryan McGuyre, in his eighth season at the helm of the Bears' program, earned his 500th career win on 9/21 against TCU, making his all-time record 500-191 across his 21 years as a women's HC as of that match. He spent three years at Biola and 10 at Cal Baptist. His last at Cal Baptist was the Lancers' first year as a DII women's program.

MASTERY BY MCGHEE

- Senior MB Kara McGhee had her 500th career block against lowa State. She became the sixth all-time and third in the rally scoring era to hit the milestone.
- She earned her second Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week honor on 11/22 after her blocking milestone and her consistency on the week against Iowa State & top-ranked Texas.
- McGhee earned her first accolade of the season on 10/11 after her prowess against Oklahoma and West Virginia.

SMARTIES

 Senior Cassie Davis and sophomore Elise McGhee were named Academic All-District on 11/22 for their academic success by College Sports Communicators. Davis has a perfect cumulative GPA at 4.00.

LONGHORNS

- BU held their own against top-ranked Texas, handing them their first set loss at home since late Sept. and snapping a 12-set win streak for the Longhorns.
- The series with UT is one of the oldest matchups for BU, with matches recorded in 1974 and '75 before Baylor's varsity team was sponsored.
- The series is one of the most-played for the Bears with 93 matches thus far.
- The Bears hadn't played a regular-season match in Austin since the 2020-21 season.
- Texas were just the third ranked team BU played this season, the last being Minnesota (#5) and Wisconsin (#3) in the Big Ten/Big 12 Challenge.

Quick Hits

TEXAS HOLD 'EM

- The BU team held WVU to the lowest point total in a set in program history in a 25-point set, with only 5pts in set two.
- The record was set earlier in the season against North Texas, with UNT having 6pts in set one on 9/13.
- Baylor held West Virginia to a negative hitting percentage in both matches of the season: -.011 in Morgantown (10/8) and -.044 in Waco (10/30).

GET YOU MIDDLES WHO CAN DO BOTH

- Of course McGuyre's middles are producing when it comes to defense, but both Kara McGhee and Mallory Talbert are also holding their own on the offensive side of the ball.
- The upperclassmen have both consistently been top-5 in the conference and top-25 in the NCAA for their hitting percentages. They are within the high .300s and low .400s range of hitting percentage.

SHATTERED

- The Bears broke records with their .677 attack percentage against Evansville in the final match of the Baylor Invitational (9/10). It replaced the 1999 school record, set against Jackson State (.556).
- The attack percentage was also the highest in an NCAA DI match since the 2011 season.
- It broke the Big 12 record for highest attack percentage as well, with the previous being .597 over three sets when Kansas played West Virginia in 2015.

SIGNING CLASS

- . BU signed five and added two walk-ons for the 2023 squad.
- The Bears welcome two Texans, two Californians, one Georgian, one Arizonian and one Cameroonian to the team.
- · Had three top-25 ranked recruits in the class.
- Kyndal Stowers' mom is a Baylor graduate.
- Harley Kreck is the daughter of former player of Sarah Sivertson Kreck, cousin of former player Callie Williams and niece of former All-American Cory Sivertson Williams & former assistant Jason Williams.

AWESOME, AVERI

- Freshman setter Averi Carlson raked in her fourth Rookie of the Week accolade on 11/8 after leading the league in assists the previous week. The only other Baylor player to have four rookie honors was Yossiana Pressley
- Carlson earned her third Rookie of the Week honor on 10/24 after recording her third-straight doubledouble against Kansas State with 54 assists and 12 digs.
- The last player to have three double-doubles in a row was Pressley, who recorded three-straight to start the 2021 season (Minnesota-Wisconsin-Tennessee).
- Carlson earned her second Big 12 Rookie of the Week Honor on 9/13 after being named Baylor Invitational MVP for her 106 assists over three matches.
- She was named Big 12 Rookie of the Week on 8/30 after she led the entire Big Ten/Big 12 Challenge in assists with 78 and was one of two freshmen to be named to the All-Tournament Team.
- Carlson is the reigning Gatorade National Volleyball Player of the Year.

SCZECH IT OFF THE LIST

- Freshman opposite Allie Sczech earned her first conference weekly award, named Rookie of the Week for Sept. 27.
- Against the Frogs, she led the team in kills (12), blocks (6) and points (15) to help get the win (9/21). It was just her second time recording 10+ kills on the season.

BACK TO SERVE IS BRISEÑO

- Sophomore libero Lauren Briseño is the only returning server for BU from the 2021 squad and she served up six aces against the Frogs on Sept. 21.
- The last Bear to have six aces in a match was 2022 Baylor Hall of Fame inductee Taylor Barnes (Fallon) against Texas Tech on Oct. 31, 2009 in the Ferrell Center.

STREAKING

2

- The Bears went on a 10-match winning streak, starting with San Diego State in the Pepperdine Asics Classic (9/2). The streak ended on the road against Iowa State on Sept. 28.
- BU won 27 sets in a row, with the first of the streak being set four against SDSU and the last in set three against TCU on 9/21.

- . Baylor won eight matches in a row that were straight sweeps of their opponent, all but one coming at home in the Ferrell Center. The stretch ran from UCSB to McNeese.
- The Bears are on a 14-match winning streak at home currently, dating back to 11/6/21 when BU beat Texas, 3-1.

RILEY'S ROCKIN' IT

- Redshirt sophomore Riley Simpson led the team for two out of three matches at the Pepperdine Asics Classic in both points and kills. For her performances in Malibu, she was named Big 12 Rookie of the Week, her first weekly award from the conference (9/6).
- She had two matches hitting double-digit kills and had the second-highest hitting percentage on the team for the weekend at .329.

BIG TEN, BIG WIN

 BU's win over the then-No. 3 Badgers, 3-2, was the first time since 2020 that the defending national champions had lost within their first three matches of the following season. The last time was in 2020 when Stanford went 0-3 on opening weekend after winning the Championship in 2019.

NEW CREW

- Head coach Ryan McGuyre has an all-new staff, with assistant coaches Yajaira Cadet and Joshua Walker entering their first seasons as D1 WVB coaches.
- Across the three of them, the coaches have collectively won 12 national championships, including 10 NAIA and two NCAA.
- Cadet previously was a club volleyball coach. Cadet was a student-athlete under McGuyre for the '04 & '05 NAIA national champion Cal Baptist squads.
- Walker was an assistant for the Hawaii men's vb team. Walker won back-to-back NCAA national championships with the Rainbow Warriors in '21 and '22 (men's teams compete in the spring).
- There's a Hawaiian connection for McGuyre, as his wife, Jennifer (Roberts), is a Rainbow Wahine alumna.

THE RETURNERS

- The Bears return nine of their letterwinners from the 2021 season, having graduated 11 seniors.
- Lauren Harrison, Kara McGhee, Elise McGhee and Lauren Briseño all saw significant playing time last season.
- Cassie Davis played in five matches in 2021 with three kills to her name as an outside hitter.
- Alicia Andrew & Riley Simpson both redshirted for the Bears, while Ava Grace Haggard and Faith Lynch each saw action in one set.

Head Coach

RYAN McGUYRE

8th season at Baylor 21st season overall (w) 30th season overall (w/m)

Through seven seasons at the helm of Baylor volleyball, head coach Ryan McGuyre has put the program amongst the sport's biggest names and into the national spotlight. After narrowly missing the postseason in his first year, McGuyre and the Bears marched their way to the program's first Big 12 title and the NCAA National Semifinals in 2019 while earning the school's first No. 1 AVCA national ranking and No. 1 overall seed in the NCAA Tournament.

McGuyre followed up the historic 2019 campaign by leading the Bears to their second consecutive NCAA Regional Semifinal berth in 2020, marking just the third time in program history that the program has reached the Sweet 16 (2009, 2019, 2020).

In his seventh season at BU, McGuyre compiled his seventh-consecutive winning season, sixth-straight 20-win season and a program-best six-consecutive NCAA appearances since his arrival in 2015. The Bears made the Regional Semifinals again in 2021 and finished the season ranked 10th by the AVCA with a 22-6 record. Powerhouse Yossiana Pressley recorded her 2,000th career kill to become the all-time leader at Baylor, while Hannah Sedwick also recorded her 4,000th career assist during the season. Pressley, Sedwick and All-American transfer Avery Skinner boosted BU to top-15 rankings throughout the year.

Named the 2019 AVCA and VolleyballMag.com National Coach of the Year, 2019 AVCA Southwest Region Coach of the Year, 2017 and 2019 Big 12 Coach of the Year, McGuyre has coached 11 AVCA All-America selections, 15 All-Region honorees, 22 All-Big 12 awardees and 48 Academic All-Big 12 selections throughout his time at Baylor.

McGuyre's teams continue to lock down home court advantage behind record-breaking crowds at the Ferrell Center. Baylor topped its own attendance record in three straight seasons from 2017-2019. BU's 2019 win against No. 1 Texas on Nov. 20 drew 7,357 fans, almost double the old attendance record set earlier that season against Tennessee in September.

Baylor has gone an impressive 28-2 over the last two seasons at home, collecting nine ranked wins. In 2019, Waco hosted through the NCAA Regional final as the Bears booked their spot in Pittsburgh, Pa., for the NCAA Final Four.

Along with matching the most home wins in program history with 13 in 2017, BU's season opener against LSU in 2018 drew a record crowd of 3,858. The team has had 10 top-10 crowds at the Ferrell Center under McGuyre.

McGuyre has coached at the collegiate level for both men and women since 1999 including head-coaching stints at California Baptist (CBU) and Biola University, both of which are faith-based institutions.

As associate head coach for two seasons, McGuyre and the Florida State Seminoles finished a 2014 NCAA Tournament run reaching the Sweet 16 before a loss to national runner-up, BYU. Prior to his arrival at Florida State, McGuyre was an assistant at Maryland for one season following a 10-year head coaching stint at CBU. There, he was the head coach for both the men's and women's programs, and he crafted a men's program that won six NAIA national championships and three women's national titles.

Among many accolades at CBU, McGuyre was named the 2005 NAIA Men's National Coach of the Year and in 2011 the NCCAA Division I National Coach of the Year, in 2010, he made history by being named both the AVCA Men's and Women's NAIA National Coach of the Year in the same calendar year.

A 1998 graduate of Biola, McGuyre is married to former University of Hawaii volleyball standout and USA National Team member Jennifer (Roberts) McGuyre. The couple has three children: sons, Tryston and Ryder, and a daughter, Kitana.




