## STORY LINES

### STARTING STRONG

- The Bears are looking for their 14th-straight season-opening victory on Monday against Southern at the Ferrell Center.
- Baylor's last season-opening loss was during the 2009-10 season to then-No. 9 Tennessee on the road, falling 74-65. The Bears were ranked No. 7 to start that year.
- Baylor's matchup with Southern marks the 14th-consecutive year the Bears are starting their season at home. Baylor has won 18-straight home openers, dating back to the 2005-06 campaign.

### BACK IN THE RANKS

- Baylor heads into the 2023-24 season as the 19th-ranked team in the country, as announced by the Associated Press. The Bears are sitting at No. 20 in the WBCA/USA Today Top-25 Poll.
- The Bears' appearance in the preseason AP poll marks the 19th-straight season BU has been ranked to start the year.
- The Bears have been ranked in 365 of the last 374 AP Top-25 weekly polls, including 10-straight weeks to start the 2022-23 campaign.
- Baylor is one of just two Big 12 schools to be ranked in the preseason poll, with Texas joining the Bears as the No. 13 team.

### PLAYERS TO WATCH

- Four Bears were named to preseason watch lists published by the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame and Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) as part of the Women's Starting Five.
- For the first time in her career, **Sarah Andrews** landed a spot on the Nancy Lieberman Award Watch List, which recognizes the top point guards in women's NCAA Division I basketball.
- Additionally, **Aijha Blackwell** and **Dre'Una Edwards** were selected to the Cheryl Miller (small forward) and Katrina McClain (power forward) Award Watch Lists, respectively, for the second-straight year.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** joined Edwards on the McClain Award list, marking the first-career preseason award for the returning all-conference performer.

### NOTHIN' NEW

- **Jada Walker** was voted the league's Preseason Newcomer of the Year by the conference's head coaches.
- Her selection marks the fifth-straight year a Baylor Bear has earned the preseason distinction.
- Walker joins Jordan Lewis (2021-22) and Aijha Blackwell (2022-23) as selections under the direction of third-year head coach **Nicki Collen**.

### SEASONED SARAH

- **Sarah Andrews** was a unanimous preseason All-Big 12 selection and brings back the most experience in a Baylor uniform.
- She is the only Bear to have played more than two seasons at BU.
- The two-time all-conference pick averaged a team-leading 14.7 points per game in 2022-23 and is just 11 points shy of 1,000 in her career.
- When she reaches this milestone, she will be the 39th player in program history to accomplish this feat.

### A LEAGUE OF HER OWN

- **Lety Vasconcelos** is the lone freshman on the 2023-24 Baylor women's basketball roster.
- With that, BU is one of just eight Division I schools with a solo rookie, while an additional five programs in the country don't have a single freshman.
- Baylor and Houston are the only two Big 12 women's basketball programs with one or no freshmen.
- Being the only freshman on a team is not new to Vasconcelos, as she was the lone rookie at Hamilton Heights Christian Academy in Chattanooga, Tennessee.

**ROOKIES? MORE LIKE VETS**

- A trio of Bears played significant minutes as freshmen during the 2022-23 season, as returners **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** and **Bella Fontleroy** joined newcomer **Denae Fritz** on the Big 12 All-Freshman Team a year ago.
- The three combined for 923 points, averaging 28.0 points per game as a group.
- Littlepage-Buggs led the way with eight Big 12 Freshman of the Week honors, while Fontleroy and Fritz each earned a pair to account for 12 of the 17 weekly awards handed out by the league during the 2022-23 season.

**ON THE BIG SCREEN**

- The Bears were selected for eight national TV broadcasts this season, including a non-conference battle against Oregon at the Ferrell Center on Dec. 3.
- Baylor will make its national debut at SMU on Nov. 30, playing on ESPNU.
- The regular-season finale at home against Oklahoma State is slated for ESPN 2.

**FAREWELL TO FERRELL**

- The Ferrell Center has been home to Baylor basketball for the last 35 years and the Bears are finishing up construction on a new facility, Foster Pavilion, set to open in January 2024.
- The women's basketball team is 430-100 all-time in the Ferrell Center.
- The building will remain the primary home for Baylor volleyball and acrobatics and tumbling after basketball's departure.

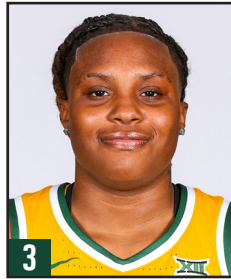

HEAD COACH NICKI COLLEN • 3RD SEASON



Nicki Collen was introduced as the fifth head coach in Baylor women's basketball history on May 5, 2021. She enters her third season at the helm in 2023-24.

In her first season with the Bears, Collen recorded the most wins by a rookie head coach in the country with 28. She helped lead the Bears to their 12th-straight Big 12 regular-season title and their

11th-straight top-two seed in the NCAA Tournament.

Collen implemented her system, which featured more perimeter shooting. Baylor went from the bottom of the list nationally to just outside the top 50 in 3-pointers made. In her first season, the Bears set new program records for 3-pointers made (233) and attempted (678).

From her introductory press conference, the Naismith Coach of the Year semifinalist said the Bears would be playing their best basketball late in the season, and she was right. Baylor became the first team to defeat a ranked opponent twice in a three-day span since 1999 when the Bears downed Texas two times to open the month of February. Two weeks later, exactly a month after sitting at the bottom of the conference standings with an 0-2 record, BU was back atop the league's leaderboard.

Collen implemented the 1-0 mentality that paid off with a 25-point win at No. 8 Iowa State in front of a nearly soldout crowd of 13,000 raucous fans which clinched the conference crown. Baylor became the first team since Texas Tech in 2000 to start a Big 12 season 0-2 and go on to win the league.

After her first season ended in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, Collen saw three of her players be selected in the 2022 WNBA Draft, tying a program record. Two of them - NaLyssa Smith (No. 2) and Queen Egbo (No. 10) marked the first duo to be taken in the top 10 in program history.

Collen's first recruiting class was ranked No. 9 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz.

In year two, Collen mentored two all-conference selections, two unanimous Big 12 All-Freshman Team picks and the unanimous Big 12 Freshman of the Year, Darianna Littlepage-Buggs. Littlepage-Buggs earned eight Big 12 Freshman of the Week awards during the 2022-23 campaign, becoming the first BU rookie to earn it eight-or-more times in program history. Additionally, she ranked second in the Big 12 all-time in freshman of the week honors.

The Bears secured 20 wins for the 23rd-straight year, which is the second-longest active streak among Division I programs behind UConn's 30-straight 20-plus win seasons. Collen led Baylor to its 19th-straight NCAA Tournament appearance in 2022-23 and 21st overall, as the Bears erased an 18-point deficit to win their opening-round game against Alabama.

Collen came to Baylor from the WNBA's Atlanta franchise, where she spent the last three seasons at the helm for the Dream. Her rookie season in Atlanta resulted in a 23-11 season in 2018, where she earned WNBA Coach of the Year honors and helped the franchise to the WNBA Playoff Semifinals.

Prior to her arrival in Atlanta, she spent two seasons under former head coach Curt Miller of the Connecticut Sun, helping the franchise improve from fifth in the East Division to second from 2016 to 2017, respectively.

Collen's collegiate coaching career spanned for nine seasons prior to her WNBA arrival. She spent two seasons as an assistant at Colorado State from 2000-2002, one season at Ball State from 2002-2003, one at Louisville from 2003-2004, three at Arkansas from 2011-2014 and two at Florida Gulf Coast from 2014-2016.

Her teams' combined record in nine seasons as an NCAA Division I assistant was 214-74, good for a .743 win percentage. As an assistant, Collen guided four different squads to the NCAA Tournament, reaching the second round in three of those seasons.

She spent six of her nine seasons as an assistant under

her husband, Tom Collen's head-coaching tenures at Colorado State, Louisville and Arkansas. She also coached under Tracy Roller at Ball State and Karl Smesko at Florida Gulf Coast. Collen helped the FGCU program to a 64-9 record and the school's first NCAA Tournament win in her two-year tenure.

In her nine seasons at the collegiate level, Collen coached three All-Americans and saw three players selected in the WNBA Draft.

Collen's collegiate playing career began at Purdue in 1993-94, when the Boilermakers made an NCAA Final Four run with a 29-5 overall record and a 16-2 mark in the Big Ten. Her sophomore season, Purdue made another deep run with an Elite Eight appearance to go with a 24-8 overall record. She transferred to Marquette, where she tallied 421 assists in her final two seasons, averaging 7.0 per game in her last 60 collegiate games. She helped the Golden Eagles to two-straight NCAA Tournament appearances in 1997 and 1998.

Nicki and her husband, Tom, have three children, Connor, Reese and Logan. Connor and Reese are currently freshmen at Baylor.

**TEAM NOTES**

- Baylor has out-rebounded its opponents in 207 of the last 232 games, and 20 of 33 games in 2022-23.
- Baylor is 259-2 all-time when shooting 50 percent or better from the field and 40-0 when shooting 60 percent or higher. The Bears' last loss when shooting over 50 percent was to No. 22 Michigan on 11/27/22.
- 348 of Baylor's wins since 2010-11 have been by 10 or more points, and only 24 times in that span has its winning margin been five or fewer points.
- Since the 2010-11 season, Baylor is 44-9 vs. Top 25 opponents at the Ferrell Center.
- Baylor is 348-108 (.770) vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season all-time.

**THE BAYLOR BEARS REGIME**

**2019 NCAA CHAMPIONS**

The 2018-19 Bears became just the third women's program in NCAA history to win three titles when Baylor beat Notre Dame, 82-81, April 7 in Tampa, Florida. **Chloe Jackson's** go-ahead scoop layup with under five seconds left propelled her to NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player honors to go along with a team-high 26 points in the game. The Bears rode the wave of two All-American posts with **Kalani Brown** and **Lauren Cox**, each earning multiple all-America honors. The pair led Baylor to its 10th regular-season and tournament championship in the Big 12 and **Kim Mulkey** was honored as national coach of the year by the USBWA, the Associated Press and the WBCA.

**2012 NCAA CHAMPIONS**

The 2011-12 Bear season was as perfect as it could be. En route to claiming its second NCAA Championship in seven years, Baylor ran the table, posting an unprecedented 40-0 mark and claiming both Big 12 Conference crowns. **Brittney Griner** and Mulkey swept player of the year and coach of the year honors, earning WBCA, USBWA, Associated Press, Naismith and Big 12 Conference recognition. Baylor was ranked No. 1 wire-to-wire in both polls and raced through conference play with a Big 12-record 18-0 mark. Griner and **Odyssey Sims** were named consensus All-Americans, while **Destiny Williams** was a WBCA All-America honorable mention honoree.

**2005 NCAA CHAMPIONS**

The squad posted a 33-3 record and claimed the Big 12 Conference title with a 14-2 mark. En route to the program's first NCAA Championship, the Bears defeated three No. 1 seeds. **Steffanie Blackmon** and **Sophia Young** were both named All-Americans. In addition to earning Big 12 Coach of the Year honors, **Mulkey** received the New York Athletic Club's prestigious Winged Foot Award.

**NCAA TOURNAMENT STAPLE & 11-PLUS YEAR DOMINANCE**

- The Bears have made 19-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and 21 overall. Those appearances have resulted in three national championships (2005, 2012, 2019), four Final Fours (2005, 2010, 2012, 2019), 10 Elite Eights and 14 Sweet Sixteens.
- The Bears are 24-time Big 12 Champions-- most in Big 12 history --capturing 12 of the last 13 regular season titles, 13 overall & 11 tournament titles.
- Baylor is 415-47 (.898) over the past 12 seasons while posting a 212-20 mark in Big 12 play and 29-3 in Big 12 Tournament play.
- 348 of Baylor's 416 wins since 2010-11 have been by 10 or more points, and only 24 times in that span has its winning margin been five or fewer points.

**BIG 12 DYNASTY**

- Baylor women's basketball has won a league-leading 24 Big 12 Conference titles -- 13 regular season and 11 tournament championships.
- Baylor has run the table in the conference four times (2012, 2013, 2018, 2019). It has only happened six times in Big 12 history (Oklahoma: 16-0 in 2006; Nebraska: 16-0 in 2010).
- Baylor has advanced to the Big 12 Championship game 15 times in program history.
- The Bears have won nine of the last 12, and seven of the last 10 Big 12 Championship titles, last besting No. 17/20 West Virginia, 76-50, in the 2021 final.
