**Cross Country**

- The Bears compete in the NCAA South Central Regional meet on Friday morning the Fayetteville for a spot in the NCAA Championships.
- The men's race is scheduled to begin at 10:30.

**Equestrian**

- No. 8 Baylor claimed its first win of the season in a raw-score tiebreaker over Fresno State on Thursday.
- BU moves to 1-1 in conference play and four Bears remain undefeated in conference play through two Big 12 matchups.
- Baylor faces No. 1 TCU Friday.

**Football**

- The Bears fell in an overtime thriller vs. Houston on Saturday, 25-24. BU rallied to tie the game with a late TD to force overtime, and scored on the first possession of extra time.
- The Cougars answered with a TD drive on their possession and completed a two-point conversion for the walk-off win.
- Baylor looks to extend its winning streak in Manhattan vs. Kansas State to three games, facing off with the defending Big 12 Champs on Saturday at 2 p.m. on ESPN+.

**Men's Basketball**

- No. 20/17 Baylor opens the season against RV/RV Auburn tonight at the Sanford Pentagon in Sioux Falls, S.D.
- It's BU's first opener against a power-conference team since opening with Colorado in 2013.
- Tuesday's game with Auburn marks the first of four games in the opening week: 11/9- vs. John Brown 11 a.m., 11/12 vs. Gardner-Webb 4 p.m. and 11/14 vs. Kansas City 9 p.m.

**Women's Basketball**

- No. 19 Baylor opened the 2023-24 campaign with an 85-53 win over Southern.
- Senior Sarah Andrews eclipsed 1,000 career points while Dre'Una Edwards recorded a team-high 20 points in her Baylor debut

**Men's Tennis**

- BU wrapped up the Hagedorn Hidden Dual tournament over the weekend and kicked off the ITF Austin Pro Circuit on Monday with a 4-0 record across singles play.
- The team splits to close the fall schedule this weekend at the Big 12/Pac-12 Challenge in Stillwater and the San Antonio International Team Championships.

**Women's Tennis**

- This past weekend, Baylor competed at the Texas A&M Fall Invitational.
- Danielle Tuhten picked up a pair of singles victories and a doubles win with Sierra Berry.
- The Bears wrap up fall competition this weekend when they host the Big 12 Individuals.

**Volleyball**

- No. 20 Baylor won a pair of matches last week, including a five-setter vs. Oklahoma and a sweep at Texas Tech.
- Baylor has won seven of its last nine matches with the lone setbacks coming vs. No. 5 Texas in Austin.
- Coach Ryan McGuyre earned his 100th win in Big 12 play.
- The Bears host a pair vs. TCU on Friday and Saturday, before venturing to Lawrence to face KU.
- Sophomore setter Averi Carlson is one of four players in the league averaging double-digit assists per set and Manuela Bibinbe ranks third in the Big 12 with a .364 hitting percentage.
