Equestrian

- Baylor dropped its final two meets of the fall season.
- BU is headed into the break as four Bears remain undefeated in conference play.
- BU returns to action Saturday, Jan. 27 against No. 5 Georgia

Football

- Baylor fell to 2-2 on the road in 2023, as TCU posted a win over the Bears in Fort Worth on Saturday.
- Drake Dabney upped his season total of 529 yards receiving, tops in program history among tight ends.
- The Bears conclude the 2023 season on Saturday, hosting West Virginia at 6 p.m. at McLane Stadium.

Men's Basketball

- No. 13/12 Baylor hits the road for the second time this season for the NIT Season Tip-Off at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y.
- With a win over Kansas City last week, the Bears won four games in eight days to start a season for the first time since 1992-93.
- Baylor is 40-13 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including titles in 4 of the last 5 tournaments.
- BU has won 13 of its last 14 regular-season neutral-site contests.

Women's Basketball

- The Bears jumped seven spots in the AP Top 25 Poll after their 84-77 win over then-No. 4 Utah last Tuesday and a 10-point victory over Harvard on Sunday to No. 14.
- It marked the largest jump in the poll this week and the highest ranking for the Bears since finishing the 2021-22 season at No.
 7.
- Additionally, it was the largest jump for BU in one week to the next since going from 19 to 10 at the beginning of the 2008-09 campaign.
- Baylor continues its five-game homestead this weekend, hosting McNeese (Friday) and Alcorn State (Sunday).

Volleyball

- No. 25 Baylor split the week with a 3-0 loss at No. 17 Kansas and a 3-0 win at home over West Virginia.
- Baylor is hosting No. 22 Houston on Wednesday to close out the regular season.
- Selection show for NCAAs is Sunday at 5 p.m. CT on ESPN.
