THE OPENING TIP

Michigan State's men's basketball team returns to Motown this weekend, playing No. 6/6 Baylor at Little Caesars Arena in the Continental Tire Motor City Invitational (2 p.m., FOX) ... The Spartans are coming off a 77-70 loss at Nebraska on Sunday evening in Lincoln ... MSU enters the game on Sunday with two-straight losses, including a 70-57 decision to No. 23 Wisconsin at home to start Big Ten Conference play ... Of the team's five losses, four of them are to ranked teams and by an average of 7.8 points per game, including an overtime loss ... Graduate guard Tyson Walker is third in the Big Ten in scoring, and ranks No. 20 in the country, with 20.3 points per game ... Walker was selected to the National Association of Basketball Coaches Division I Player of the Year Watch List, as well as the Wooden Award Top 50 and the watch list for the Naismith Trophy Division I Player of the Year ... Walker, who needs 38 points to reach 1,000 at Michigan State, has scored in double figures in 20-straight games, dating back to last year ... MSU ranks No. 23 in the country in FG% defense (38.5%) and No. 46 in scoring defense (63.2 ppg).

THE STARTING FIVE

1. Series History

Michigan State and Baylor meet for the third time in program history when the teams play on Sunday at Little Caesars Arena in Detroit ... The Bears have won both games between the teams and both games in the Battle 4 Atlantis ... The last time the teams played (read more below) was in the championship game of the Battle 4 Atlantis in the Bahamas, a 75-58 Baylor win ... The first meeting was a 73-58 Bears win in the 2016 event.

2. Last Meeting with Baylor

Michigan State trailed by just two points at halftime, 38-36, but then-No. 6 Baylor used an early run in the second half to break open a close game en route to a 75-58 win over the Spartans in the championship game of the Battle 4 Atlantis on Nov. 26, 2021 ... Gabe Brown scored 13 points and had five rebounds to lead the Spartans, while then-freshman guard Jaden Akins added 12 points and three rebounds off the bench ... Malik Hall scored three points and had four rebounds, while Tyson Walker scored five points and had two rebounds and two assists ... A.J. Hoggard came off the bench and had one point and two assists in 12 minutes.

3. At Little Caesars Arena

Michigan State returns to play in Motown for the sixth time ... The Spartans have a 4-1 all-time record at Little Caesars Arena ... MSU's last game at LCA was a 90-78 win over in-state rival Oakland on Dec. 21, 2021, with Tyson Walker scoring 10 points and A.J. Hoggard finishing with 7 points and 7 assists ... Michigan State has played the Golden Grizzlies three times at the home of the Detroit Pistons, posting a 72-49 win on Dec. 14, 2019 ... The teams first played at LCA on Dec. 16, 2017, with MSU posting an 86-73 win ... Then-sophomore guard Cassius Winston scored all of his 19 points in the second half and Michigan State used a 12-2 run late in the game to pull away for the win ... The Spartans were the No. 2 seed in the 2018 NCAA Tournament held at LCA, beating Bucknell in the first round and falling to Syracuse in the second round.

4. About the Spartans

Michigan State enters Saturday's game against Baylor with a 4-5 overall record (0-2 B1G) following a 77-70 loss at Nebraska on Sunday ... The Spartans entered the 2023-24 season ranked No. 4 in the Associated Press and the ESPN Coaches preseason polls ... The Spartans have three players scoring in double figures, four averaging at least 9.0 points and nine with at least 3.0 points, while 10 players average at least 10 minutes per game ... Through eight games, graduate guard Tyson Walker leads the team in scoring with 20.3 points per game, connecting on 47.4 percent of his shots ... Senior guard A.J. Hoggard is tied for second on the team with 10.3 points, while adding 3.4 rebounds and 4.3 assists, which ranks fifth in the Big Ten Conference ... Graduate forward Malik Hall, who scored a season-high 22 points against Nebraska, is tied for second on the team with 10.3 points, while adding 5.4 rebounds and 2.3 assists ... Junior guard Jaden Akins is averaging 9.7 points and 5.0 rebounds ... Sophomore guard Tre Holloman is averaging 5.2 points and is second on the team with 3.0 assists, while senior forward Mady Sissoko adds 4.4 points and 5.3 rebounds ... Freshman forward Coen Carr contributes 4.8 points and 2.9 rebounds, freshman guard Jeremy Fears Jr. is averaging 3.9 points and 2.6 assists and sophomore center Carson Cooper adds 3.2 points and 5.3 rebounds.

4. Shoot to Get Hot, Shoot to Stay Hot

Tyson Walker has gotten off to a quick start this season for the Spartans ... The graduate guard is leading the team with 20.3 points per game, which is third in the Big Ten Conference and ranks No. 20 in the country ... He is also 11th in the conference in field goal percentage, connecting on 47.4 percent of his shots ... He scored 35 points in the season opener against James Madison and has scored at least 18 points in three of the last four games, dropping 22 in a loss to No. 9 Duke, 21 against Butler and 18 in a loss to then-No. 3 Arizona ... In his last 7 games, he is shooting 45.2 percent from the floor (47-of-104) and 37.1 percent from 3-point land (13-of-35).

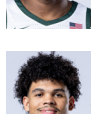

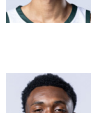

ABOUT THE BEARS

» Baylor, ranked No. 6 in the Associated Press and ESPN Coaches polls, enters Saturday's game with a 9-0 overall record following a 78-60 win over Seton Hall on Dec. 5.

» The Bears have played six games at home and are 3-0 in neutral site games, with wins over Auburn (88-82, at the Sanford Pentagon in Sioux Falls, S.D.) and over Oregon State (88-72) and Florida (95-91) in the NIT Season Tip Off in Brooklyn, N.Y.

» Baylor has six players scoring in double figures for an offense that ranks No. 4 in the country in scoring offense (91.1 ppg), No. 2 in 3-point field goal percentage (43.2%) and No. 6 in field goal percentage (52.0%)

» The Bears also rank No. 22 in the country in bench points, with 32.1 points per game coming from its reserves, with Langston Love averaging 12.0 ppg.

SPARTANS FALL TO WISCONSIN IN BIG TEN OPENER, 70-57

» Michigan State had a three-point lead with just over three minutes left in regulation but could not hang on as Nebraska beat the Spartans, 77-70, at Pinnacle Bank Arena on Dec. 10.

» Malik Hall scored a season-high 22 points and had seven rebounds to lead four players in double figures.

» Tyson Walker scored 15 of his 17 points in the second half, while adding four rebounds and two assists, A.J. Hoggard finished with 12 points, five rebounds and three assists and Jaden Akins had 10 points and four rebounds.

» The Spartans led by three at the half (34-31), but an early run from the Huskers gave the hosts a six-point lead twice as it neared the mid-point of the second half, the last at 46-40 on a layup from Juwan Gary.

» Michigan State tied the game at 52-all on a layup from Hoggard at 10:03, but Nebraska pushed the lead back to four points, 56-52, on a layup from C.J. Wilcher.

» That's when Walker caught fire, scoring 11-straight points and hitting back-to-back 3-pointers as the Spartans used an 11-4 burst to take a 63-60 lead at 5:10.

» A jumper from Walker made it 65-62 with 3:11 to play, but off baskets from Gary and Brice Williams, Nebraska took a 67-65 lead.

» Free throws from Hall tied the game at 67-all with two minutes left but the Huskers scored six-straight points and took a 73-67 lead on free throws from Williams with 39 seconds left.

» MSU has held three opponents to below 60 points per game and ranks No. 4 in the Big Ten in scoring defense (63.3 ppg).

» The Spartans are second in the league in field goal percentage defense (37.1%), which ranks No. 12 nationally.

» Michigan State defensive efforts have been at the forefront for the team in the early portion of the season ... MSU ranks among the top-75 in the country in several defensive categories ... The Spartans are:

FIRST STARTS

- » A pair of Spartans have earned their first career starts this season.
- » Against Butler on Nov. 17 at home, sophomore center Carson Cooper moved into the starting lineup in MSU's 74-54 win over the Bulldogs ... Cooper scored only 3 points, but grabbed a game-high and career-best 11 rebounds and blocked two shots ... Cooper had played 20 minutes off the bench in the team's loss to Duke in the Champions Classic, finishing with 4 points and a team-high 8 rebounds.
- » Classmate Tre Holloman started in place of Tyson Walker (illness) on Nov. 19 in an 81-49 win over Alcorn State ... Holloman hit all 5 of his 3-point attempts and scored a career-high 17 points ... His 17 points were the fifth-most by a Spartan making his first career start in the last 10 years.

CENTER OF ATTENTION

- » Sophomore center Caron Cooper earned the first start of his career in Michigan State's 74-54 win over Butler on Nov. 17.
- » He responded with only 3 points, but grabbed a game-high and career-best 11 rebounds and blocked two shots.
- » Cooper had played 20 minutes off the bench in the team's loss to Duke in the Champions Classic, finishing with 4 points and a team-high 8 rebounds.
- » He came to Michigan State from IMG Academy in Florida, but grew up in nearby Jackson, Mich., where he played at Jackson Northwest.
- » The 6-11 center started playing basketball primarily after growing up playing soccer and was an honorable mention all-state selection as a goalkeeper at Jackson Northwest, helping the team to a state runner-up title.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- » Any one, any time, any place and any where has always been a mantra of MSU Coach Tom Izzo.
- » The Spartans annually play one of the nation's toughest schedules and that trend continues this year as MSU will play three teams ranked in the Associated Press Preseason Top 25 in the non-conference portion of the schedule.
- » The Spartans played preseason No. 2 Duke in the Champions Classic in Chicago on Nov. 14, current No. 1 Arizona in the Acrisure Classic on Nov. 23 in Palm Spring, Calif, and host No. 6 Baylor on Dec. 16 at Little Caesars Arena in Detroit.
- » In addition, the Spartans played preseason No. 9 Tennessee in a charity exhibition game on Sunday, Nov. 29.

WHAT'S BACK

- » Michigan State returns four starters and 11 letterwinners from last year's team that reached the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament.
- » The Spartans expected starting lineup – guards Tyson Walker, A.J. Hoggard and Jaden Akins and forwards Malik Hall and Mady Sissoko – have combined to start 533 games (287 starts) in their college careers ... Walker leads the way with 128 games played (118 starts), while Hall has played in 127 games.
- » This year, the Spartans return 74.9 percent of the team's scoring (1,805 of 2,411 points), 66.9 percent of the team's rebounds (606 of 906) and 85.1 percent of the team's assists (423 of 497).
- » With 11 letterwinners back, the Green & White return 75.9 percent (5,234 of 6,900) of the team's minutes played from last year.

SPARTANS EARN PRESEASON RECOGNITION

- » Michigan State was ranked No. 4 in the country in the Associated Press Preseason Poll.
- » It was the highest the Spartans had been ranked in the AP preseason poll since 2019-20, when MSU was the preseason No. 1 team.
- » The Spartans were also ranked No. 4 in the country in the 2023-24 preseason poll from The Almanac, and a pair of players earned recognition ahead of the season.
- » Graduate guard Tyson Walker was ranked No. 10 in a ranking by The Almanac of the nation's Top 100 players and he was named a preseason Third Team All-American.
- » Walker was named to the Watch List for the National Association of Basketball Coaches Division I Player of the Year and was also selected as a Second Team Preseason All-American by FOX Sports.
- » Senior guard A.J. Hoggard was rated No. 42 in the country in the Top 100 by The Almanac.

SPARTANS SHARE THE BALL

- » Unselfishness has always been a trademark of all Tom Izzo teams.
- » That has been especially true for nearly the last decade as MSU established the top-five school record for assists during that span.
- » In 2018-19, the Spartans led the country in total assists and handed out the second-most in a single season in MSU history (715), recording an assist on 66.8 percent of their field goals that season.
- » In 2017-18, MSU led the country in assists per game (19.1) and handed out 670, then the second-best mark in program history.
- » In 2015-16, MSU tallied a school record 719 assists, good for the 22nd-best total in NCAA history ... MSU's nation's-best assist average of 20.5 was the 23rd-best average in NCAA history.
- » ***This year, the Spartans have handed out at least 20 three times and at least 15 on five occasions, while averaging 16.3 per game (5th in the Big Ten, No. 48 nationally) ... MSU ranks No. 30 nationally per KenPom in Assist Rate at 60.7% (147 assists on 242 made field goals).***

SPARTANS MAKE FOURTH APPEARANCE IN THE GAVITT TIPOFF GAMES

- » Michigan State's 74-54 win over Butler in the Gavitt Tipoff Games gave the Spartans a 4-0 record in the series.
- » Previously, MSU had wins over Villanova in 2022-23 (73-71 at home), at Butler in 2021 (73-52) and at Seton Hall in 2019 (76-73).
- » The Gavitt Tipoff Games are an annual early-season series of eight games played between the Big Ten and BIG EAST Conferences and named in honor of BIG EAST founder and basketball visionary Dave Gavitt.

- » Michigan State is No. 23 in the country in the NET Strength of Schedule, including No. 47 in non-conference SOS.



EXHIBITION RECAP

- » Michigan State played a pair of exhibition games prior to the start of the regular season, beating Division II Hillsdale, 85-43, on Oct. 25 and losing to preseason No. 9 Tennessee, 89-88, in a charity exhibition on Oct. 29 (benefitting the Maui Strong Fund following the wildfires in Hawaii in August).
» Against Hillsdale, Carson Cooper led the way with 13 points and seven rebounds, while Tyson Walker added 13 points and a team-high seven rebounds ... Jaden Akins added 10 points, six rebounds and three steals and Coen Carr scored 12 points with three rebound and two blocks.
» In the Tennessee game, MSU fell behind 17-1 early, narrowed the gap to three points at halftime (40-37) and tied the game on a 3-pointer from A.J. Hoggard with 4.1 seconds before a free throw from the Vols with 1.9 seconds left gave UT the win.
» Tyson Walker scored 22 points had had four assists and five steals to lead the Spartans, while Malik Hall had a double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds, Hoggard finished with 14 points and Jaden Akins had 12 points and a team-high six assists.

HOGGARD, WALKER EARN PRESEASON ALL-BIG TEN HONORS

- » A.J. Hoggard and Tyson Walker were among a group of 10 players selected to the Preseason All-Big Ten Team by the media.
» Walker, who was a Second Team All-Big Ten Conference selection by the coaches and the media in 2022-23, led the team in scoring with 14.8 points per game, which ranked 11th in the Big Ten, adding 2.9 assists and 2.5 rebounds per game.
» Hoggard was an honorable mention All-Big Ten selection by the coaches and a third team honoree from the media last year ... A 6-4 guard, he was third on the team in scoring with 12.9 points per game and led the team, and ranked second in the Big Ten, with 5.9 assists per game.

HALL OF FAME CONNECTIONS

- » Michigan State's roster includes several players with Hall of Fame connections.
» The Spartans have the sons of a Pro Basketball Hall of Famer (Steven Izzo) and the son of an NFL Hall of Famer (Nick Sanders, the son of long-time Detroit Lions standout Barry Sanders) on the roster ... They are the only school in the country with the sons of a basketball and football Hall of Famer on the roster.
» In addition, senior Davis Smith is the son of Michigan State Hall of Famer Steve Smith.

DEFEND, REBOUND, RUN

- » Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo has always said that if his teams can defend and rebound, it will lead to positives.
» The Spartans have led the Big Ten in rebounding 10 times in the last 20 years and led the nation in rebounding four times (in 2009, 2010, 2016 and 2019) since 2009.
» In 2019-20, MSU led the Big Ten in rebounding offense (40.6 rpg) and tied for the league lead in rebounding margin (+7.5 rebounds) ... That same year, the Spartans led the Big Ten in field goal percentage defense, limiting opponents to 37.9 percent shooting.
» Last year, the Spartans were 8th in rebounding offense (35.68 rpg), 3rd in rebounding defense (32.65 rpg) and 3rd in rebounding margin (+3.03 rpg) overall ... In Big Ten games, the Spartans were 7th in rebounding offense (34.37 rpg), 3rd in rebounding defense (31.79 rpg) and 4th in rebounding margin (+2.58 rpg).

- » Michigan State 2023-24 roster features 15 players (13 scholarship student-athletes) representing 10 states as well as Mali, West Africa.
» There are four Spartans from Michigan, two from Illinois and Georgia and one each from Utah, New York, Minnesota, Texas, Pennsylvania and Indiana and one from West Friday.

Ranked as the No.8 shooting guard in the class and the top player in Massachusetts by 247 Sports ... The Circuits 2023 3SSB Most Valuable Player ... NBPA Top 100 and adidas Eurocamp selection ... Named Most Valuable Player at the adidas 3SSB 17u Open Championships ... In 2023 adidas #3SSB circuit, Teng shot 48.8 percent from 3-point land while averaging 18.1 points per game and 5.3 rebounds per game ... Has scored 1,615 varsity points entering his last season at Bradford Christian Academy (Lawrence, Mass.) ... New England Prep School Athletic Conference (NEPSAC) AA first team selection twice.

COACHING STABILITY

- » Michigan State has had just two basketball coaches in the last 48 seasons and three in the last 55.
- » Tom Izzo is in his 29th season, having taking over from his mentor Jud Heathcote, who spent 19 years as head coach (1976-95).
- » Before Heathcote, Gus Ganakas spent seven seasons as head coach ... The late Ganakas provided commentary on Spartan radio broadcasts for 31 seasons before his passing in 2019.

HEAD COACH TOM IZZO

- » Now in his 29th season at Michigan State, Hall of Fame coach Tom Izzo has built the Spartans into one of the elite programs in the nation ... The Spartans' 25-straight NCAA Tournaments are a Big Ten record, the second-longest active streak in Division I and tied for the third-longest in NCAA history.
- » He's been able to accomplish this while playing more ranked teams than anyone else since 1998.
- » Michigan State has appeared in eight Final Fours since 1999, the most in the nation.

EXPERIENCED COACHING STAFF

- » For 11 years (2010-21), Michigan State had one of the longest-tenured coaching staffs in Division I basketball.
- » The Spartans staff changed over the last two years, but still has more than 100 (108) years of experience combined, including two assistant coaches – Doug Wojcik and Mark Montgomery – who have head coaching experience:
 - Tom Izzo – 29th year at Michigan State, 45 years overall
 - Doug Wojcik – 6th year at MSU (2 previously), 32 years overall
 - Mark Montgomery – 3rd year back at MSU (9 previously), 25 years overall
 - Thomas Kelley – 2nd year back at MSU (previously a graduate assistant), 6 years overall

MICHIGAN STATE MOURNS PASSING OF JUMPIN' JOHNNY GREEN

- » Michigan State's men's basketball program mourns the passing of Jumpin' Johnny Green, who passed away on Thursday morning at the age of 89.
- » Green, who was born in Dayton, Ohio, came to Michigan State in 1955 after serving in the United States Marine Corps during the Korean War. He played three years with the Spartans, helped lead the team to the 1957 Final Four and was one of four players in program history to finish his career with at least 1,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds.
- » As a sophomore, Green earned a spot on the NCAA All-Tournament Team as MSU advanced to the 1957 Final Four.
- » That performance led to two of the strongest seasons in Spartan history. In 1958, he averaged an MSU single-season record 17.8 rebounds to go along with 18.0 points. He was a Second Team All-American by the NABC, the International New Service, the Converse Yearbook and The Sporting News and earned third team honors from the Associated Press, UPI and the Helms Foundation.
- » One year later, as senior in 1959, he averaged 18.5 points and 16.6 rebounds and was a Consensus Second Team All-American.
- » Green, who had his number retired at Michigan State in 2009 and was inducted into its Athletic Hall of Fame, finished his career with 1,062 points and 1,036 rebounds. He still ranks 47th all-time in scoring at MSU and is third all-time in rebounding.

Coach Izzo

In his 29th year, Tom Izzo (Northern Michigan, '77) is 691-284 (.708), and 333-161 (.673) in the Big Ten, as the head coach of the Michigan State basketball program. He ranks as the winningest coach in Michigan State history, having passed his mentor Jud Heathcote with his 341st career victory on Nov. 28, 2009. In his 28-plus seasons as a head coach, Izzo has captured eight National Coach of the Year awards, including the Clair Bee Award in 2005 and NABC honors in 2001 and 2012. In 1999, Izzo was named National Coach of the Year by Basketball Times, while earning similar honors from The Associated Press, Basketball News and the USBWA in '98. He also earned National Coach of the Year accolades from CBSSports.com in 2012. He earned Big Ten Coach of the Year honors in 1998, 2009 and 2012. Izzo was enshrined in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on September 9, 2016, cementing his status as one of the game's all-time greats.

Among The Big Ten's Best

Tom Izzo's .674 winning percentage in Big Ten games ranks fourth all-time among league coaches with at least 10 years of service, behind former Wisconsin coach Bo Ryan (.717), former Indiana coach Bob Knight (.700), and former Purdue coach Ward Lambert (.685). In all games, Ohio State's Thad Matta ranks first at .748, followed by Ryan (.737), Knight (.734), Wisconsin's Walter Meanwell (.712), Lambert (.709) and Izzo (.708). With 333 conference victories, Izzo ranks second all time. When MSU beat Maryland on March 6, 2022, Izzo reached 663 wins, passing Knight (662) for most overall wins as a head coach at a Big Ten school.

Izzo Among Best Ever

Through his first 28 seasons, Tom Izzo won 687 games, ranking fifth in college basketball history for most wins by a college coach in his first 28 years.

Final Fours

Tom Izzo led MSU to eight Final Four appearances between 1999 and 2019, becoming just the fourth school in college basketball history to do it in any 21-year span, including just the third since the tournament field expanded to 64 teams in 1985. Izzo's eight Final Fours are the most by any coach since his first season in 1996 and he ranks fifth all-time, including third among active coaches. The eight Final Fours are also the most by any Big Ten coach.
