STORY LINES

- No. 10/10 Baylor returns home for the final game at the Ferrell Center against Mississippi Valley State.
- Over 80 former players are expected to be in attendance to help close down the home of Baylor basketball for the last 35 years.
- The Bears have played in the Ferrell Center since 1988, and hold a 400-169 record in the building.
- The team scoring record at the Ferrell Center is 118 points by BU against Savannah State on 12/17/2017. The Bears got within one point of that in a 117-53 win over MVSU in the season opener last season (11/7/22).
- The Bears are 4-O all time against the Delta Devils with their most-recent win coming last year in Waco. The 64-point win ranked as the third largest margin of victory in program history.
- Baylor is 87-15 vs. unranked teams over the last four seasons (.853%).
- Baylor is 60-6 in home games over the last five seasons.
- Baylor is 86-4 in its last 90 non-conference home games dating back to Dec. 12, 2012.
- Entering on just one day of rest, Baylor is third in the nation with a 26-4 record when faced with a rest disadvantage since 2020-21.
- The Bears are 2nd in the nation in 3-point FG% (42.3), 4th in offensive efficiency (120.7) and rank 13th in points per game (86.7).
- Last time out, the Bears fell to No. 21 Duke 78-70, dropping its second-straight game.
- The matchup with Duke was BU's third game this season against a team that has made the Final Four since 2019. They will have five more this season when they get to conference play.
- The Bears are 126-101 following a loss under Scott Drew
- BU is 87-22 over the last four seasons, the nation's second best record by a Power-6 team in that span.
- Baylor has posted a combined 195-39 record in November and December games during the Drew era, including a 121-17 mark in November and December games since 2013.
- **RayJ Dennis** ranks 12th in the nation in assists per game (6.4), with the Bears getting 14.4 points per game from **Ja'Kobe Walter** to lead the offense, the most among Big 12 Conference Freshmen.
- Six Bears are averaging at least 10 points per game, including Dennis (14.2), Langston Love (10.5), Jalen
- Bridges (10.5), Yves Missi (10.2) and Jayden Nunn (10.0). Missi leads the team with 6.5 rebounds per game.
 Missi's 2.3 blocks per game are tops among freshman in Division I.
- BU has had six players win Big 12 Sixth-Man of the Year, no other conference school has more than two.
- Baylor is 113-26 over the last five seasons, the nation's second-best winning % among Power-6 teams in that span (.819%).
- BU is playing its 358th game as a ranked team under Scott Drew Baylor was ranked in just two of 2,197 games over the program's 97 seasons prior to Drew.
- Baylor has built leads of 10 + points in 59 of 84 games since the start of the 2021 NCAA Tournament (56-3 record).
- BU has won 86-straight when shooting a higher percentage than its opponent (last loss March 2, 2019 at K-State).

QUICK HITS

- With back-to-back Big 12 titles in 2020-21 & 2021-22, BU became one of just three Big 12 teams to win back-to-back conference titles
- Selected 16th overall by the Utah Jazz in June's NBA Draft, Keyonte George gave BU three-straight top-16 picks for the first time in program history (Jeremy Sochan 9th overall to San Antonio in 2022 Davion Mitchell 9th overall to Sacramento in 2021).
- The Bears have had 11 picks in the last 11 drafts, which is the most in the state of Texas and second-most in the Big 12 since 2012
- Baylor is one of two schools to have three-straight top-20 picks in the NBA Draft (Duke).
- The Bears have now been ranked in the top-10 for a fifth-straight year, one of just four programs (Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas) to accomplish that feat.
- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 11-consecutive postseason appearances, the nations fifth-longest active streak
- The Bears have gone to nine NCAA Tournaments and two National Invitation Tournaments since 2012.
- BU is 60-6 in home games over the last five seasons.
- Baylor will play its final games at the famed Ferrell Center this season, before opening up brand new Foster Pavilion in January.
- The Ferrell Center has been home to Baylor basketball since 1988-89
- Baylor holds 400-169 record with over 3.2 million men's basketball fans coming through the turnstyles in the building's 35-year history.
- Baylor has reached the 25-win milestone in three of the last four seasons and in 7 of the last 14 years. Prior to that, BU reached 25 wins just once in the program's first 103 years (25-5 in 1945-46).
- Baylor is 27-12 against ranked teams over the last four seasons, including a 16-5 mark away from home.
- Baylor's 54-14 Big 12 record over the last four seasons is the best record of any Power-5 team.
- Head coach Scott Drew is in his 21st season at Baylor with a school-record 429 career victories.
- Drew is tied for the eighth longest tenured head coach in Division I men's college basketball.
- Baylor is playing its 664th game of the 21-year Drew era more than half (358) have been as a ranked team.
- Over the last 4 seasons, Baylor is 88-10 when leading at the half and 109-14 when taking a 2nd-half lead.
- Baylor spent a school-record 54-straight weeks ranked in the top-10 of the AP Poll, from Dec. 16, 2019-Dec 5, 2022.
- BU set a school-record streak of 65-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 (previous record was 25). The streak lasted from Nov. 5, 2019 to Jan 9, 2023 (1,161 Days).
- Baylor has been ranked in all 25 spots in the AP Top 25 at some point in the last 8 years.
- Baylor has been No. 1 ranked in 4 of the last 7 seasons (Gonzaga, Duke and Kansas are only others).
- Baylor and Kansas are the only Power-5 schools to win 18+ games every year since 2008.
- BU has built double-digit leads in 103 of 134 games over the last four seasons (98-5).
- Baylor has won 89% of its games when leading at the half since 2011-12 (237-28).
- Entering 2023-24, Baylor is 295-117 over the last 12 seasons, averaging 24.5 wins per season since 2011-12.
- Baylor's 304 wins since 2011-12 are second-most in the Big 12 behind only Kansas (342).
- Baylor is 395-166 since 2007-08, the first year Drew's staff had a full allotment of scholarships.
- Twelve of Baylor's 13 starting point guards under Drew have earned All-Big recognition (17 of last 18 seasons).
- Baylor is 113-26 over the last five seasons, the nation's best winning percentage among Power-6 teams in that span (.813%).

ONE OF THE GREATEST REBUILDS IN NCAA HISTORY

- Scott Drew became Baylor's head coach in 2003, starting of one of the greatest rebuilds in NCAA history.
- Drew is one of 10 active men's Division I coaches with at least 400 wins at their current school.
- Drew is one of 2 active coaches to have won an NCAA Title and an NIT Title. He is the only active coach to have won both at the same school (John Calipari NCAA: Kentucky, NIT: Memphis).
- Drew was named 2020 NBC Sports National Coach of the Year and 2017 Basketball Times National COY.
- Drew is now in his 21st season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (429).
- Baylor has a .705 winning percentage (395-166) since Drew's first year with no scholarship restrictions in 2007-08 and a .719 winning percentage (304-119) over the last 12 seasons since 2011-12.
- Drew (52) is the second-youngest active collegiate head coach to win a National Championship.
- \bullet In Drew's first 20 seasons at Baylor, 54 players have gone on to professional careers.
- Was announced as a member of the Texas Sports Hall of Fame Class of 2023.
- He is the 23rd BU player or coach to be inducted into the Texas Sports Hall of Fame

NATION'S-BEST 27-12 VS. RANKED TEAMS OVER LAST FOUR SEASONS

- Baylor is a nation's-best 27-12 against AP Top-25 ranked teams since 2019-2020.
- BU is 11-3 at home vs. ranked teams in the last 3 seasons wins vs. #12 Arizona (Dec. 2019), #18 Butler (Dec. 2019), #14 West Virginia (Feb. 2020), #9 Kansas (Jan. 2021), #17 Oklahoma State (March 2021), #18 Texas Tech (March 2021), #6 Villanova (Dec. 2021), #20 Texas (Feb. 2022), #5 Kansas (Feb. 2022), #9 Kansas (Feb. 2023) and #8 Texas (Feb. 2023) and losses by 3 points to #3 Kansas (Feb. 2020) and #19 Texas Tech (Jan. 2022).
- The record includes 16-7 away from home, with neutral wins vs. #17 Villanova (Nov. 2019), vs. #5 Illinois (Nov. 2020), vs. #18 Villanova (March 2021), vs. #10 Arkansas (March 2021), vs. #6 Houston (April 2021), #1 Gonzaga (April 2021), #8 UCLA and #14 Gonzaga, with road wins at #22 Texas Tech (Jan. 2020), at #4 Kansas (Jan. 2020), at #15 Texas Tech (Jan. 2021), at #6 Texas (Feb. 2021), at #6 West Virginia (March 2021), at #8 Iowa State (January 2022), at #21 Texas (Feb. 2022) and at #17 TCU (Feb. 2023).

WALKING THROUGH THE VALLEY

- Baylor meets Mississippi Valley for the fifth time, with BU holding a 4-0 advantage in the series.
- The Bears beat the Delta Devils 117-53 last year in the season-opener, which stands as the third-largest win in program history.
- The Bears hold a 3-0 series lead in games played in Waco.
- The Delta Devils have made five NCAA Tournament apperances in program history (0-5), with its most recent coming in 2012.

FAREWELL TO FERRELL

- BU has played in the Ferrell Center since 1988, and holds a 400-169 record all-time.
- LaceDarius Dunn holds the individual scoring record at the Ferrell Center when he scored 43 against Morgan State on 1/4/2011.
- The team record is 118 points by BU against Savannah State on 12/17/2017. The Bears got within one point of that in a 117-52 win over MVSU in the season opener last season (11/7/22).
- Three of the top six crowds in Ferrell Center history have come in the last four seasons (10,628 vs. KU 2/26/22, 10,627 vs. Arkansas 1/28/23 and 10,627 vs. Kansas 2/22/20)

BAYLOR PARTNERS WITH CITY OF WACO ON \$700 MILLION RIVERFRONT PROJECT

- Baylor and the City of Waco have partnered on a \$700 million riverfront development project, headlined by the \$212 million Foster Pavilion, the future home for Baylor's national champion basketball programs.
- Foster Pavilion (capacity 7,500) will be located along the Brazos River on the opposite side of I-35 from McLane Stadium.
- BU is set to begin playing games in the new Pavilion beginning on Jan. 2, 2024, as the Bears welcome in Cornell.
- Development Centers for both basketball programs are included in the 245k square foot Foster Pavilion project
- and is expected to be completed in the summer of 2024.

NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER SUCCESS

- Baylor has posted a combined 195-39 record in November and December games during the Drew era, including a 121-17 mark in November and December games since 2013.
- The Bears are 98-17 in November games and 97-21 in December contests during the Drew era.
- BU is 51-9 in November games since 2013, with the only losses to No. 8 Syracuse (2013), vs. Illinois (2014) in Las Vegas, at No. 25 Oregon (2015), at No. 21 Xavier (2017), vs. Texas Southern (2018), vs. Ole Miss (2018) in Florida, vs. Washington (2019), vs. No. 16 Virginia (2022) and Marquette (2022)
- BU is 55-7 in December games since 2013, with the only losses at No. 24 Texas A&M (2015), vs. No. 8 Wichita State (2017), at No. 22 Texas Tech (2017), at Wichita State (2018), vs. SFA (2018), at Iowa State (2022), vs. Michigan State (2023) and vs. Duke (2023).

MILESTONE WATCH

- With 15 points against Auburn, **RayJ Dennis** eclipsed the 1,500 point mark for his career (1,642), and dished out his 500th career assist (548) against Kansas City.
- Dennis ranks in the top-11 among active players in career games played (140), and his 548 assists are the fifthmost among active Power Six players.
- Jalen Bridges has 497 rebounds in his career and is 93 points away from 1,000 for his career (907).
- Bridges played his 100th career game on against Oregon State. (11/22/23)
- Caleb Lohner played in his 100th-career game against Kansas City (11/14/23)
- Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua played in his 100th career game against Kansas City after making his careerfirst start at BU in the season-opener against Auburn.
- Tchatchoua is 31 points away from 500 in his Baylor career (469).

NOTABLE STREAKS

- BU has won 86-straight when shooting a higher percentage than its opponent (last loss March 2, 2019 at K-State).
- Baylor has won 50-straight games when shooting 50% or higher (last loss March 18, 2018 vs. Mississippi State).
- BU has appeared in 17-straight AP Polls, the 11th-longest active streak in the nation, and the fourth-longest in the Big 12.

WALKED THE WALK, NOW TALKING THE TALK

- Former BU Player Pat Nunley (1978-81) is entering his 43rd season as a radio analyst for Baylor men's basketball.
- Nunley was named to the Baylor Hall of Fame class of 2023, enshrined on Nov. 3, 2023.
- Playing alongside Southwest Conference Hall of Famer Terry Teagle and first-round pick Vinnie Johnson, Nunley averaged a career-best 12.3 points per game as a junior in 1979-80.
- Nunley started for four years with the Bears, and was named the Bill Henderson SWC Sportsman of the year in 1981.
- His fellow 2023 inductees include J.D. Walton (Football), Ken Quesenberry (football), Max Muncy (baseball), Denes Lukacs (tennis), Stan Curry (track and field), Sandy Forsythe Massey (track and field) and Tiffany Townsend (track and field).

DOWNED BY THE BLUE DEVILS

- Baylor dropped to 9.2 on the season and 3.3 in Madison Square Garden
- Baylor's 12-0 run in the first half was its second longest of the year and its longest since a 13-0 run against John Brown on Nov. 11.
- With 11 points and 10 rebounds, Yves Missi recorded his third double-double of the season, the most in a singleseason by a Baylor player since James Akinjo had 3 in 2021-22.
- With his team-high 17 points, Dennis scored in double figures for the 58th time in his last 60 games. Dennis pulled down a season-high 7 rebounds.

STUMBLE VS. SPARTY

- BU allowed Michigan State to shoot .633, Baylor's highest opponent FG % allowed since Oklahoma shot .661 from the field on Feb. 26, 2005.
- Baylor failed to take the lead at any point in the game for the first time since Dec. 2, 2018 at Kansas State, snapping a 164 game streak.
- The Bears scored just 17 points in the first half, its fewest since it scored 15 against Wichita State on 12/1/2018.
- RayJ Dennis scored in double figures for the eighth time at Baylor and the 57th time in the last 60 games.

400 WINS AT FERRELL

- With a 78-60 win over Seton Hall in the Big East-Big 12 Battle BU recorded its 400th- all-time win at the famed Ferrell Center.
- BU Improved to a league-best 14-4 in Conference Challenges, and 3-1 in the Big East-Big 12 Battle.
- Baylor is second in the nation and improved to 26-3 when faced with a rest disadvantage.
- RayJ Dennis had a team-high 17 points, with seven assists and five rebounds in 36 minutes.

LOCKED DOWN THE DEMONS

- BU limited Northwestern State to just 14 first-half points, the second-fewest allowed in a half by BU in the Big 12 era (1996-97).
- 40 points were Baylor's fewest allowed since holding No. 6 Villanova to 36 on 12/12/21.
- BU's 51-point win tied for the 12th widest margin of victory in program history and the largest since beating Mississippi Valley by 64 in the season opener last season.
- BU improved to 45-1 under Drew when holding teams under 50 points.
- Yves Missi recorded his second career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds, Baylor's third double-double this season.

CRUSHED THE COLONELS

- BU's 108 points were its most since scoring 117 in the season opener against MVSU last year in the season opener.
- Baylor allowed zero second-chance points for the first time since Jan. 4, 2022 when they held Oklahoma scoreless in that category.

- BU's 25 assists were its most since it had 26 against Texas Tech last season (2/4/23).
- Baylor finished the month of November with an undefeated record for the third time in the last four seasons.
- The Bears won seven games in November for the third time in school history (2021 & 2016).

GIVING THANKS FOR ANOTHER REGULAR-SEASON TOURNEY TITLE

- With a win over Florida, BU won it's fifth regular-season tournament title in it's last six opportunities.
- BU improved to 20-11 against SEC opponents during the Drew era, including 15-7 since 2012-13, and six of the last seven games.
- RayJ Dennis took home tournament MVP Honors highlighted by his 24 points and 8 assists against the Gators. • Jalen Bridges hit five threes and averaged 18.5 points in two games to join Dennis and Ja'Kobe Walter on the all-tournament team.
- Walter averaged 17.5 points per game, including 11 against the Gators in the championship game.

BEARS BEAT THE BEAVERS AT BARCLAYS

- BU improved to 5-0 to start a season for the fourth time in the last six years.
- Ja'Kobe Walter has the most points by a freshman through five games in the Scott Drew Era (96).
- Yves Missi recorded his career-first double-double, BU's first since Flo Thamba had 12 points and 12 rebounds against Texas last season (2/25/23).
- Missi's 14 rebounds are the most by a Baylor player since Mark Vital had 15 vs. Oklahoma State on March 12, 2021.

CRUISING PAST THE 'ROOS

- Jayden Nunn scored 14-straight first-half points en route to a season-high 25 to lead the Bears past Kansas City
- Ja'Kobe Walter poured in 23 for his second 20-point game of the season.
- It marked the first game with two 20-point scorers for BU since Adam Flagler and Keyonte George did it at Kansas 2/18/23
- RayJ Dennis scored 11 points and dished out 8 assists to reach 500 career assists.
- Baylor improved to 4.0 for the fourth time in the last six seasons.

FINDING OTHER WAYS TO WIN

- Despite snapping a streak of 1,032 straight games with at least one 3-pointer, the Bears found a way to win a 77-62 contest against Gardner-Webb.
- Baylor also snapped a streak of 181-straight games of making 2-plus three-pointers.
- Ja'Kobe Walter had a team-high 14-points to lead the Bears for a second time in three games.
- Yves Missi established a career high in points (11), blocks (5) and rebounds (8).

HOLDING OFF JOHN BROWN

- BU improved to 19-2 in home openers under Scott Drew (five straight)
- Baylor shot .563 from the field it's highest shooting percentage, since it shot .567 from the field against McNeese last season (11/23/22).
- The Bears pulled down 21 offensive rebounds, the most since they secured 22 in the season opener against Mississippi Valley last season
- Langston Love matched a career high with 20 points on a career high eight field goals.
- With 15 points, Jayden Nunn scored in double figures for the 26th time in his career and the first time at Baylor.

CAUGHT THE TIGERS BY THE TAIL

- Trailing by 9 at the half and 6 with 6-minutes to play, BU used a 13-2 run over the next five minutes to take control of the game and open the season with a win against a power conference opponent for the first time since Colorado in 2013.
- BU improved to 19-2 in season openers under Scott Drew (five-straight wins).
- Five-star freshman Ja'Kobe Walter burst out of the gates with 28-points, the most by a freshman in a debut in program history.
- Walter is one of four freshman in Big 12 history to score at least 28 points in his debut, and the only one to do it against a power conference opponent.
- Walter went a perfect 10-for-10 from the free throw line making him the ninth different player in program history to shoot 1.000 percent from the line [min, 10 attempts]

ELEVEN CONSECUTIVE POSTSEASON BERTHS

- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 11-consecutive postseason berths and has appeared in 14 of the last 15 postseasons. BU made seven postseason appearances in the program's 97 seasons prior to the Scott Drew era.
- Baylor is 1 of 8 teams to appear in every postseason since 2012, joining Gonzaga, Iona, Kansas, Michigan State, Oregon, Saint Mary's and Virginia.
- BU earned NCAA bids in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2019, 2021, 2022, and 2023 and NIT bids in 2013 and 2018.
- Baylor has appeared in 13 of 14 postseasons since 2008. Prior to that, Baylor's only postseason berths were in 1946 (NCAA), 1948 (NCAA), 1950 (NCAA), 1987 (NIT), 1988 (NCAA), 1990 (NIT) and 2001 (NIT).

THREE-STRAIGHT TOP-THREE SEEDS

- Last season, Baylor earned its third-straight top-three seed for a third-straight NCAA Tournament joining Kansas, Gonzaga and Purdue as the only four teams to accomplish that.
- 2023 marked the fourth time BU has earned a No. 3 seed after also doing it in 2010, 2012, 2015 and 2017.
- Baylor has earned a top-3 seed in 7 of the last 13 NCAA Tournaments.
- BU is 17-6 in NCAAT games as the higher seed, but 2021 was the first time as a higher seed after the Sweet 16.
- BU is 3-5 in NCAAT games as the lower/same seed, though four of those five losses were to top-2 seeds.

A TOP-25 STAPLE

- BU has now been ranked in 79 of the last 80 AP Polls.
- Ranked as high as No. 6 this year, The Bears have now been ranked in the top-10 for a fifth-straight year, one of just four programs (Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas) to accomplish that feat.
- BU spent a school-record 54 weeks in the AP Top-10 from Dec. 16, 2019-Dec. 5, 2022.
- Baylor set a school-record streak of 65-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 (previous record was 25). The streak lasted from Nov. 5, 2019 to Jan 9, 2023 (1,161 Days).

THE BIG 12'S MOST WINS IN CONFERENCE CHALLENGES

Baylor is 14-4 in conference challenges – 8-2 in Big 12/SEC Challenge, 3-1 in Big 12/Pac-12, 3-1 in Big 12/Big East.
Baylor's 14-4 record in conference challenges (Big 12-Big East, Big 12/SEC, Big 12/Pac-12) is best in the Big 12, followed by Kansas at 12-7, OSU at 11-8, Iowa State at 10-8, Texas Tech at 10-9, OU at 10-9, Texas at 8-9, TCU at 7-7, K-State at 7-11 and WVU at 5-10.

SUCCESS IN TOURNAMENTS

- Baylor is 42-13 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including titles in 4 of the last 5 tournaments.
- BU is 29-5 in its eight regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, going 3-1, 3-1, 3-1, 4-0, 4-0, 3-1, 3-0, 3-0, 1-1 and 2-0.
 BU advanced to championship games in the 2007 Paradise Jam (won), 2008 76 Classic (lost), 2011 Las Vegas
- Classic (won), 2013 Maui Invitational (lost), 2014 Las Vegas Invitational (lost), 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis (won), 2017 Hall of Fame Classic (won), 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational (won) and 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis (won).
- Baylor has won seven regular-season tournament titles under Drew 2023 NIT Season Tip-Off, 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational, 2017 Hall of Fame Classic, 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2011 Las Vegas Classic and 2007 Paradise Jam.

- Baylor has been ranked in every AP Top 25 spot at some point in the last 8 years (since March 2, 2015).

SCOTT DREW COACHING TREE

- Four current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew's BU staff.
- Jerome Tang is in his second year as head coach at Kansas State. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 19 years with Drew.
- Grant McCasland is in his first season as head coach at Texas Tech. He spent five years as a Baylor assistant before taking over as Arkansas State head coach for one season in 2016-17.
- Matthew Driscoll is in his 15th season as head coach at North Florida after six seasons as a Baylor assistant.
- Paul Mills is in his first season as head coach at Wichita State. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 14 years with Drew, the final eight as an assistant coach.
- All four former assistants have led their teams to NCAA Tournaments Driscoll led UNF to the 2015 NCAA Tournament, while McCasland took UNT to the 2021 Second Round and Mills took ORU to the 2021 Sweet 16.
- Additionally, McCasland led North Texas to the NIT Championship in 2023, prior to leaving for Texas Tech.
- Drew is 0-2 all time when facing a former assistant as a head coach.

PROTECTING HALFTIME LEADS

- Baylor is 120-12 when leading at halftime since the start of 2017-18.
- Baylor has won 89% of its games (238-29) when leading at the half in the last 10+ seasons ... **7-0** in 2023-24, **19-5** in 2022-23 **20-3** in 2021-22, **24-0** in 2020-21, **21-2** in 2019-20, **15-3** in 2018-19, **15-0** in 2017-18, **18-3** in 2016-17, **18-2** in 2015-16, **21-7** in 2014-15, **18-2** in 2013-14, **17-1** in 2012-13 and **26-1** in 2011-12.
- BU has won 42% of games in which it's been tied or trailing at the half since 2011-12, going 63-86 in those.

SECOND-MOST WINS AMONG BIG 12 TEAMS IN LAST 11 YEARS

- Baylor's 304-119 record since 2011-12 trails only Kansas (342-87) among Big 12 teams.
- Houston (295-118) is third, Cincinnati (291-121) is fourth, BYU (286-132) is fifth, Texas (248-166) is sixth, lowa State (246-164) is seventh, West Virginia (248-168) is eighth, Oklahoma (239-162) is ninth, Kansas State (240-171) is 10th, Texas Tech (229-176) is 11th, Oklahoma St. (223-181) is 12th UCF (217-166) is 13th and TCU (215-192) is 14th.
- Baylor has averaged 24.6 wins per season over the last 11 seasons since 2011-12.

NON-CONFERENCE HIGHLIGHTS

- Baylor is 14-3 against the Big East during the Drew era.
- The Bears are 20-11 against the SEC during the Drew era, including 15-7 since 2012-13.
- Baylor is 5-0 against Big Ten teams since 2016 with two wins over Michigan State and Wisconsin, along with a win over Illinois.

- Eight Bears are currently on NBA rosters Kendall Brown (Pacers), Jared Butler (Wizards), Keyonte George (Jazz), Davion Mitchell (Kings), Royce O'Neale (Nets), Taurean Prince (Lakers), Jeremy Sochan (Spurs) and Ishmail Wainright (Trail Blazers).
- In addition to the eight current NBA players, eight more of Drew's former players have played in the NBA (most recent team) Quincy Acy (Raptors), Freddie Gillespie (Raptors), Pierre Jackson (Mavs), Cory Jefferson (Suns), Perry Jones III (Thunder), Quincy Miller (Kings), Johnathan Motley (Clippers) and Ekpe Udoh (Jazz).
- With his selection to the rookie team in the Rising Stars Challenge in 2023, Jeremy Sochan became the first player in program history to be a participant in the NBA's All-Star Weekend.

- Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua redshirted in 2019-20 while sitting out to satisfy NCAA transfer rules,
- Langston Love redshirted during the 2021-22 season and Dantwan Grimes elected to redshirt for 2022-23.
- Freshman Omar Adegbola has elected to use a redshirt year in 2023-24.

OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING A BAYLOR STAPLE

- BU is 2nd in the conference (9th in the nation) in offensive rebound % (38.5%) according to KenPom.
- Baylor has ranked top-13 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage in nine of the last 10 seasons since 2013-14, including six times ranked in the nation's top-5. The Bears only cracked the top-20 once in Drew's first 10 years.
- Baylor finished ranked No. 13 nationally in 2021-22, No. 5 nationally in 2020-21, No. 8 in 2019-20, No. 2 in 2018-19, No. 9 in 2017-18, No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16, No. 1 in 2014-15 and No. 3 in 2013-14. Prior to that top-10 streak, BU's best rank was No. 16 in 2011-12.

BREAKTHROUGH IN BIG 12

- BU is 152-92 in Big 12 play in 14 seasons since 2010 after going 59-149 in the league's first 13 seasons.
- BU is 166-110 in Big 12 play in 16 seasons since 2008 after going 45-131 in the league's first 11 seasons.
- Baylor is 71-55 in Big 12 road games since 2012, second-best in the league behind only Kansas (81-47).
- BU has won 8+ Big 12 games in 12-straight seasons after winning 8+ just 3 times in the league's first 15 years.
- BU has double-digit Big 12 wins in five-straight seasons, 8 of the last 9 years and 10 of the last 14 seasons. BU didn't reach double-digit Big 12 wins in any of its first 13 years in the league before reaching 10+ for the first time in 2010.

BEST IN TEXAS

• Baylor is 81-22 against in-state opponents since the start of the 2011-12 season, and the Bears have advanced deeper into postseason play than any of Texas' 23 Division I teams in five of the last ten seasons.

• BU is a combined 93-26 against Lone Star State teams over the last 14 seasons after going 10-27 against in-state teams in Scott Drew's first six seasons at Baylor (5-2 in 2022-23, 5-2 in 2021-22, 6-0 in 2020-21, 6-1 in 2019-20, 4-5 in 2018-19, 6-3 in 2017-18, 7-1 in 2016-17, 9-3 in 2015-16, 10-1 in 2014-15, 6-3 in 2013-14, 7-1 in 2012-13, 10-0 in 2011-12, 5-3 in 2010-11 and 9-1 in 2009-10).

FERRELL CENTER

The Ferrell Center, home to Baylor's basketball and volleyball programs for more than 30 years, continues to undergo upgrades to maintain its standard as one of the region's finest facilities. The improvements have given the Bears the type of arena necessary to compete in the Big 12 Conference.

The most recent upgrade to the Ferrell Center was a new hardwood floor installed prior to the 2014-15 season. Baylor also added a state-ofthe-art, center-hung video board built by Mitsubishi in October 2010. The video board includes four LED screens, each measuring 8.53 feet by 16.01 feet. The lower LED ring is 2.93 feet by 15.96 feet and the upper LED ring is 2.13 feet by 25.82 feet. Weighing in at nearly 22,000 pounds, the total project cost \$3.2 million. In addition to the center-hung video board, Baylor also installed four upper corner boards that have video capability; those boards display in-game individual and team statistics. Four floorlevel boards were installed as well as 12 upper arena ribbon boards located at each of the arena entrances.

Another major upgrade was the construction of the Lt. Jack Whetsel Jr. Practice Facility. The 42,990 square-foot addition includes the Hawkins practice courts, the Getterman Office Suites for the coaching staffs, and Gray's Gym, named by R.T. Gray in memory of his son, R.B. Gray. Other improvements include the Hall of Honor entry, the Stone Reception Room VIP area, as well as upgrades to the training room, media room and visiting locker room. The \$8 million Whetsel Practice Facility was dedicated on September 8, 2006. Previous upgrades to the Ferrell Center have included: new state-of-the-art locker rooms in 2004.

Built in 1988 at a cost of \$12.5 million, the gold-domed Ferrell Center is located on a 14-acre tract on the corner of University Parks Drive and Texas Highway 6 (LaSalle Avenue).

Capacity for basketball events is 10,284 and 6,000 for volleyball matches, while conventions, concerts, graduation exercises and convocations can seat 12,000.

The Ferrell Center is named in memory of Charles Robert Ferrell, who

died in 1967 during his sophomore year at Baylor. The arena is named in honor of Paul J. Meyer Sr., of Waco.

A major portion of the construction cost was provided by the estate of the late Mr. and Mrs. Monroe Ferrell of Houston, in memory of their son. Monroe Ferrell, a 1938 graduate of Baylor, operated a concrete pipe business in Houston until his death in December 1981, seven years after the death of his wife.

Other significant contributions came from Paul J. Meyer Sr., Emil H. Meyerhoff and the late J.E. and L.E. Mabee Foundation of Tulsa, Okla. Meyer is founder and chairman of the board of Success Motivation International, Inc., and of the Eureka Corporation. The Meyerhoff estate, through the auspices of executor Bill Patterson of McAllen, provided the University with a large gift.

Groundbreaking for the Ferrell Center was held July 1, 1987, and a women's basketball game between Baylor and Texas State on Nov. 25, 1988, was the first sporting event held. The first men's basketball game was Nov. 29, 1988, a loss to San Diego State.

The height of the facility is 111 feet, and the dome covers three acres and weighs 175 tons. Lighting capacity on the floor is 150-foot candles. The arena is designed with 42-tiered levels of seats, including nine rows of retractable seats at courtside. Banquet accommodations can be arranged for 1,000 people on the main floor.

The lower level of the building houses some of the finest basketball locker rooms in the country. Customized wooden cabinet lockers have been built for both the men's and women's locker rooms. Also, on the lower level are visiting team locker rooms, coaches' and officials dressing rooms, a warming kitchen, media room, interview room and general storage.

The Ferrell Center has been the site of Dallas Mavericks exhibition games, and the facility has also hosted the Mavericks' and Phoenix Suns' training camps. Former President Ronald Reagan spoke to a Republican political rally in the first event held under the golden dome in 1988.
