### NOTABLES

• **DEFENSE WINS:** In UT's 12 wins, the Longhorns have held their opponents to 61.8 ppg on 38.3-percent FG shooting including a 31-percent mark from three-point range. During Texas' five losses, the Horns have allowed 79.6 ppg on 49.5-percent FG shooting including a 38.5-percent mark from beyond the arc.

• **ABMAS AMONG LEGENDS:** Graduate G **Max Abmas** moved past Larry Bird (Indiana State) into the No. 17 spot on the NCAA all-time career scoring chart (2,865 points). Next up are Tyler Hansbrough (UNC) at 2,872 and Elvin Hayes (Houston) at 2,884.

• **HORTON BREAKS OUT:** Graduate G **Ithiel Horton** moved back into the starting lineup against UCF on Wednesday and posted a season-high 20 points (8-14 FG, 4-10 threes) in 37 minutes.

**Head Coach:** Rodney Terry, 34-13 at Texas (2nd year); 197-169 overall (12th year)

## BAYLOR SERIES INFO

- Saturday's contest marks the **262nd** meeting between Texas and Baylor.
- UT owns a **164-97** lead in the all-time series entering Saturday's game.
- Texas is 34-25 against Bears since the formation of the Big 12 Conference (prior to start of 1996-97 season).
- Baylor was UT's first opponent in the program's inaugural 1906 season. The Horns won the first game of the series, 27-17, on March 10, 1906, in Austin. The Longhorns won all four games played against the Bears that season.
- Baylor is UT's most common opponent in program history. Texas and Baylor have competed in the same conference since 1915 (Southwest Conference and Big 12). The only season Texas and Baylor did not meet since 1906 was in 1908, when the Longhorns did not field a team.
- **Texas is 90-34 all-time against the Bears in games played in Austin during the series, including a 76-71 victory over No. 11/11 Baylor last year in Moody Center (Jan. 30, 2023).**

## DEFENSE WINS

- In Texas' 12 victories this season, the Longhorns have held their opponents to an average of 61.8 ppg on a combined 38.3-percent FG shooting including a 31-percent mark from three-point range.
- During UT's five losses this year, the Longhorns have allowed 79.6 ppg on 49.5-percent FG shooting including a 38.5-percent mark from three-point range.

## IN THE POLLS

- Texas is not ranked in the latest AP poll (Jan. 15) and not ranked in the latest USA TODAY Sports Coaches poll (Jan. 15).
- Prior to Monday's poll release, the Longhorns had been ranked in the top 25 of The AP poll for **36** consecutive weeks, dating back to the rankings on Jan. 31, 2022.
- Texas began the 2023-24 season ranked No. 18 in the preseason AP poll and No. 18 in the preseason USA TODAY Sports Coaches poll.

## THE CORRAL

- Prior to the 2022-23 season, UT Athletics and Matthew McConaughey joined forces to launch the new official student section for Texas Men's Basketball, **the Corral**.
- UT students get the best seats for games at Moody Center, 270-degrees around the court. The seating capacity for the Corral is 1,100.
- There is also an overflow standing-room only section (the Upper Corral) in the upper concourse that can fit approximately 550 students.

## BLESS THE MOOD, YEAR TWO

- Texas is **25-3** all-time in games played in Moody Center.
- In the first year of Moody Center, the Longhorns registered a 16-1 mark. Texas went 6-0 against AP Top 25 opponents last season, including a 3-0 record against AP Top 10 foes with wins over No. 2 Gonzaga, No. 3 Kansas and No. 7 Creighton.
- The \$375 million world-class arena opened for concerts in April 2022.
- Moody Center is the first of its kind in the industry with an unrivaled partnership between Oak View Group (OVG), Live Nation/C3 Presents, The University of Texas and the MOC (Minister of Culture) Matthew McConaughey.
- Moody Center is named in honor of a \$130 million grant to The University of Texas at Austin from the Moody Foundation, the single-largest gift from a foundation in the university's history. The Moody Foundation has supported museums, libraries, universities and hospitals throughout the state of Texas for over 75 years.

## UCF RECAP

- The game was played in front of a sellout crowd of 11,235 fans.
- Texas led by as much as 16 points (22-6) at the 12:34 mark of the first half and by 15 points (55-40) with 14:30 remaining in the contest.
- The Longhorns held the lead for a total of 34:03 on the night.
- UT converted 10-of-26 (.385) from three-point range. This marked the sixth time this season (17 games) that the Longhorns have reached double digits in three-point field goals made.
- The Longhorns tallied 17 assists (against 11 turnovers) on 27 made field goals.
- Texas converted 68.0-percent (17-25) from the floor, including a 5-of-10 (.500) mark from three-point range, in the opening 20 minutes while building a 44-32 halftime lead.
- **Max Abmas** reached double figures in scoring (15 points) for the 17th time this year (17 games) and 129th time in his career (140 games). He has reached double figures in scoring in 39 consecutive contests.

- **Ithiel Horton** set season highs in scoring (20 points), field goals made (8-14) and minutes (37) and tied his season high in assists (3). He topped the 20-point mark for the first time this year (17 games) and 14th time in his career (119 games). Horton reached double figures in scoring for the eighth time this season and 68th time in his career. In 18 minutes of action in the first half, he registered 12 points (5-7 FG, 2-4 threes), three rebounds and two assists.
- **Tyrese Hunter** set his season high in steals (4) and tied his season high in assists (7).
- **Dillon Mitchell** reached double figures in scoring (15 points) for the 10th time this year (17 games) and 16th time in his career (55 games).

#### TEXAS IN THE BIG DANCE

- Texas has made a total of **37** all-time appearances in the NCAA Tournament (39-40 overall record).
- Texas is one of **six** schools to appear in at least 29 of the last 34 NCAA tourneys.
- UT is one of **seven** schools to appear in at least 21 of the last 24 NCAA tourneys.
- The Longhorns have advanced to the Final Four three times in program history (1943, 1947 and 2003), the Elite Eight a total of eight times and the Sweet 16 a total of 14 times.

#### OUR GUY, RT - YEAR TWO

- **Rodney Terry** was named the 26th head coach in Men's Basketball program history at The University of Texas on his 55th birthday - March 27, 2023. Terry was tabbed Acting Head Coach a few hours prior to the Dec. 12, 2022 home game against Rice. He was named Interim Head Coach for the remainder of the 2022-23 season on Jan. 5.
- A former head coach at Fresno State and UTEP for a combined 10 years, he sports an overall head coaching record of **197-169** (.538) in **12** seasons.

- Terry was tabbed the 2023 Sporting News National Coach of the Year, becoming the first coach in program history to earn the prestigious honor. He also was named the Clarence "Big House" Gaines College Basketball Division I Coach of the Year by the National Sports Media Association (NSMA).
- Terry, who has 28 years of collegiate coaching experience including nine as an assistant previously with the Longhorns from 2002-11, was in his second year as Associate Head Coach at Texas prior to being named Interim Head Coach.
- He spent three years (2018-21) as head coach at UTEP and posted a 37-48 (.435) mark, including a 29-27 record in his final two seasons. In his second year in El Paso (2019-20), the Miners went 17-15 to post their first winning season in four years and claim nine more wins than the previous season.
- Terry worked for seven years (2011-18) as the head coach at Fresno State, guiding the Bulldogs to a 126-108 (.538) mark. He posted 20-win seasons in four of his last five years and double-digit win totals in Mountain West Conference play in each of his last four years.
- During the 2015-16 season, Terry led the Bulldogs to a 25-10 record and the MWC Tournament title. Fresno State advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2001, and the 25 wins marked the third-most in school history.
- Terry spent nine seasons (2002-11) as an assistant coach under Rick Barnes at The University of Texas. The Longhorns posted an overall record of **232-80** (.744) and made nine NCAA Tournament appearances, including four trips to the Sweet 16 (2003, 2004, 2006 and 2008), three Elite Eights (2003, 2006 and 2008) and one Final Four (2003). Texas also claimed two Big 12 Conference regular-season titles (2006 and 2008).
- A total of 10 McDonald's All-Americans made their way to the UT campus during Terry's time. Texas' five-man freshman class in 2004 featured three McDonald's All-Americans and was tabbed the No. 1 class in the nation by Hoop Scoop.
- The Longhorns claimed two National Player of the Year winners (T.J. Ford in 2003 and Kevin Durant in 2007) and 13 players drafted by the NBA in the nine years under Terry, including nine first-round selections and five lottery picks.

#### TERRY AT TEXAS

- Now in his second year as the head coach at Texas, **Rodney Terry** has guided the Longhorns to a **34-13** (.723) record.
- Texas is **10-2** under Terry in games decided by five points or less OR in overtime.
- Terry is **8-8** against AP Top 25 opponents while at Texas.

#### HEAD COACHING EXPERIENCE ON THE STAFF

- **FOUR** members of the Texas coaching staff have a combined **46** years of **Division I collegiate head coaching** experience.
- Head Coach **Rodney Terry** has **11-plus** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at UTEP for three years (2018-21) and head coach at Fresno State for seven seasons (2011-18) in addition to his one previous year at Texas.
- Assistant Coach **Frank Haith** has **18** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at Miami (Fla.) for seven seasons (2004-11), Missouri for three years (2011-14) and Tulsa for eight seasons (2014-22).

- Assistant Coach **Steve McClain** has **14** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) for five years (2010-15) and head coach at Wyoming for nine seasons (1998-2007).
- General Manager **Chris Ogden** has **three** years of Division I head coaching experience. Ogden served as the head coach at UTA for three seasons (2018-21).

### GET OLD AND STAY OLD

- The 2023-24 Texas roster includes **five** players who have already earned their undergraduate degrees: Max Abmas, Brock Cunningham, Dylan Disu, Ithiel Horton and Kadin Shedrick.
- **Seven** individuals have played in at least **77** career games and **four** players have started at least **87** career contests.
- **Two** players have already surpassed the **1,000-career point mark**: **Max Abmas** (2,865 points) and **Ithiel Horton** (1,311 points).
- The **12** players who brought previous collegiate experience to this year's roster have combined career totals of **912** games played (**581** starts).

### GETTING OFFENSIVE

- Texas has topped the **80**-point mark in six of its first 17 games this season and is averaging 77.3 ppg while hitting at a 48.2-percent (482-1000) clip from the floor, including a 37.0-percent (129-349) mark from three-point range.
- Four Longhorns are averaging in double figures in scoring (all over 11.3 ppg).
- **Nine** different Longhorns have reached double figures in scoring this year, while **five** UT players have recorded at least **21** points in a contest.
- The Longhorns have reached double digits in three-point field goals made a total of **six** times in their first 17 games this year (5-1 record in those contests).
- UT hit 50.9-percent (29-57) from the floor during its 74-73 victory at Cincinnati (Jan. 9).
- Texas recorded a season-high 96 points while converting 54.2-percent (32-59) from the floor, including a 50-percent (10-20) mark from three-point range, and 22-of-25 (.880) free throws in the 96-85 win over LSU (Dec. 16) in Houston.
- UT hit 55.7-percent (34-61) from the floor in the 86-63 victory against Wyoming (Nov. 26).
- The Longhorns converted 60.4-percent (29-48) from the floor, including a 45.5-percent mark (10-22) from three-point range, in their 80-64 win over Rice (Nov. 15).

### SUCCESS AT THE STRIPE

- The Longhorns have converted **73.7**-percent (221-300) from the free throw line through their first 17 contests this season.
- During the win in Houston over LSU (Dec. 16), Texas hit 88.0-percent (22-25) from the free throw line. **The Longhorns went a perfect 12-of-12 from the stripe in the second half.** This marked the 11th time in program history (since the 1965-66 season) that Texas was perfect from the line in a half while attempting at least 10 free throws.
- UT converted a season-high 92.3-percent (12-13) from the free throw line in the home victory against Wyoming (Nov. 26).
- The Longhorns were 9-of-10 (.900) from the free throw line in the win at Cincinnati (Jan. 9).

### MID-COURT MAX

Graduate G **Max Abmas** (pronounced: ACE-miss) has played and started **140** career games during his five years at Oral Roberts and Texas. He owns five-year collegiate totals of **2,865** points, **469** assists, **456** rebounds and **155** steals. Abmas has reached double figures in scoring **129** times, topped the 20-point mark **72** times, eclipsed the 30-point mark **19** times and topped the 40-point mark **twice** in his career. He has reached double digits in points in **39** consecutive games.

- In his first 17 contests at Texas, Abmas leads the team in scoring (17.8 ppg), assists (73, 4.3 apg) and minutes (34.5 mpg). Abmas has hit 45.6-percent (104-228) from the floor, including a **40.9**-percent (54-132) mark from three-point range, and **89.1**-percent (41-46) from the free throw line. He also sports a **1.70**-to-1 (73-43) assist-to-turnover ratio.
- He tallied 15 points (5-13 FG, 4-11 threes) and three assists in a season-best 39 minutes against UCF (Jan. 17).
- Abmas recorded a season-high 32 points (9-17 FG, 7-13 threes, 7-8 FT), three assists and three steals in 37 minutes at West Virginia (Jan. 13). He earned **Big 12 Newcomer of the Week honors** (Jan. 15) for his efforts in the games against Cincinnati and WVU.
- He registered 15 points (3-7 threes), five assists and three rebounds in 35 minutes at Cincinnati (Jan. 9). He hit the game-winning jumper from the right baseline with 6.2 seconds left.
- Abmas tallied 18 points (6-12 FG, 4-7 threes), five assists, four boards and one steal in 37 minutes against Texas Tech (Jan. 6).
- He posted a game-high 18 points (5-5 FT) and tied a season high with seven assists while adding one steal and one block in 37 minutes against UTA (Jan. 1).
- Abmas registered a game-high 17 points (5-10 FG, 6-7 FT) and five assists in 37 minutes against Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (Dec. 22).
- He tallied a team-high 20 points (6-13 FG, 4-9 threes, 4-4 FT), seven assists and a season-high six rebounds in 35 minutes against LSU in Houston (Dec. 16). He earned **Big 12 Newcomer of the Week honors** (Dec. 18) for his efforts in the victory.
- Abmas posted a game-high 16 points (7-12 FG) and a season-high seven assists against just one turnover in 30 minutes against Houston Christian (Dec. 9).
- He recorded a team-high 25 points (10-19 FG, 3-8 threes, 2-2 FT) and two steals in 38 minutes at No. 8/7 Marquette (Dec. 6).
- Abmas tallied a game-high 26 points (9-18 FG, 5-12 threes, 3-3 FT) and six assists against just one turnover in 38 minutes against Texas State (Nov. 30).

- He registered a game-high 23 points (8-14 FG, 3-6 threes), three assists and four boards in 32 minutes vs. Wyoming (Nov. 26).
- Abmas posted 10 points and five assists against one turnover in 35 minutes against No. 5/4 UConn (Nov. 20).
- He recorded 14 points in 38 minutes against Louisville (Nov. 19). Abmas knocked down the game-winning jumper from the right elbow with 0.4 seconds left.
- Abmas tallied 13 points (5-9 FG, 3-6 threes), five boards and four assists in 27 minutes against Rice (Nov. 15).
- He had a team-high 19 points (6-12 FG, 4-8 threes, 3-3 FT) and five assists in 35 minutes against Delaware St. (Nov. 10).
- Abmas posted 12 points (5-10 FG, 2-4 threes), five rebounds, three assists and one steal in 30 minutes during his Texas debut against UIW (Nov. 6).
- Abmas earned his BS in Mathematics from Oral Roberts in Spring 2023 and is pursuing a graduate certificate in Strategic Communication.

#### DISU'S DOMAIN

Graduate F **Dylan Disu** has played in **119** career games (**87** starts) during his five seasons at Vanderbilt and Texas. He has registered career totals of **1,021** points, **607** rebounds and **127** blocked shots. In his career, Disu has reached double figures in scoring **50** times, including **five** 20-point performances, and double digits in rebounds **19** times. He has tallied **15** career double-doubles.

- In his first eight games (three starts) this year since returning from injury (missed the first nine contests due to left foot surgery), he ranks second on the team in scoring (14.1 ppg), fourth in rebounding (3.5 rpg) and fifth in blocked shots (9) in 22.5 mpg. He has converted **13-of-24** (.542) threes and 16-of-19 (.842) free throws.
- Disu tallied 18 points (7-12 FG, 2-4 threes, 2-3 FT), six rebounds and two steals in 27 minutes at West Virginia (Jan. 13). He topped the 1,000-point mark in his collegiate career with a turnaround jumper at the 17:55 mark of the second half.
- In his first start of the year, he registered a **collegiate career-high 33 points** (13-23 FG, 4-10 threes, 3-4 FT), six rebounds, four steals and one block in 34 minutes at Cincinnati (Jan. 9). His previous career high was 29 points (while at Vanderbilt) against Kentucky (Feb. 17, 2021).
- Disu had 11 points (5-9 FG, 1-1 threes), four boards and three blocks in 22 minutes vs. Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (Dec. 22).
- He returned to the court vs. LSU (Dec. 16) for the first time since he played two minutes against Xavier in last year's NCAA Sweet 16 (March 24, 2023) - a span of over eight months. He posted 17 points (4-8 FG, career-high 9-9 FT), a career-best five assists without a turnover, four boards and one block in 20:23 of game action. He had a team-best plus-minus total of plus-16.
- As a senior at Texas in 2022-23, Disu played and started 36 games and led the squad and ranked second in the Big 12 in blocks (46, 1.3 bpg). He ranked second on the team in rebounding (4.4 rpg) and fifth in scoring (8.8 ppg) in 19.0 mpg.
- In the 2023 NCAA First and Second Round games, Disu averaged 22.5 points and 10.0 rebounds in 26.3 mpg while hitting 71.0-percent (22-31) from the floor. During UT's five postseason games in which he was healthy, he averaged a team-best 17.8 ppg and 9.0 rpg in 25.8 mpg.

- He tallied a season-high 28 points (14-20 FG) and 10 rebounds in 31 minutes against Penn State (Mar. 18) in the Second Round. Disu set the UT NCAA Tournament single-game record for most field goals made (14). His 28 points was the highest single-game scoring output by a Longhorn in a NCAA tourney contest since Kevin Durant had 30 in a Round of 32 loss to USC in 2007.
- Disu claimed **Most Outstanding Player** honors at the 2023 **Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship**. He averaged a team-best 14.7 ppg and 8.3 rpg in 25.5 mpg while hitting 73.9-percent (17-23) from the floor and 10-of-12 (.833) free throws in the three games.
- Disu earned his BA in Human Dimensions of Organizations in Spring 2023 and is currently in the Sport Management Graduate Program.

Sophomore F **Dillon Mitchell** is in his second season in the UT program and has played and started all **55** games. Mitchell has reached double figures in scoring **16** times, double digits in rebounds **10** times and posted **seven** career double-doubles.

Junior G **Tyrese Hunter** has played and started **89** career games during his three seasons at Iowa State and Texas. He has registered career totals of **970** points, **336** assists and **121** steals. Hunter has reached double figures in scoring **52** times, including **eight** 20-point efforts in his career. The 2022 Big 12 Freshman of the Year at Iowa State, he guided the Cyclones to the NCAA Sweet 16 as a freshman in 2021-22 and Texas to the NCAA Elite Eight last season.

- The last time Texas did NOT convert a 3-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc that day.
- **The Longhorns enter Saturday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 1,109 consecutive games.**
- UT has converted at least one 3-pointer in 1,237 of 1,245 games since the 3-pointer was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season.
- The Horns have failed to ATTEMPT at least one 3-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988 in a 69-55 win at TCU).

## HORNS IN THE NBA

A total of 11 former University of Texas players appeared on NBA rosters when the league opened the 2023-24 regular season.

- Texas ranked in a tie for **FIFTH** nationally in most players on 2023-24 NBA opening-night rosters.
- In addition to the 11 former Longhorns on NBA rosters, Royal Ivey is an assistant coach for the Houston Rockets.

## STAFF INKS IMPRESSIVE FALL SIGNING CLASS

A trio of top-45 national recruits signed National Letters of Intent during the fall signing period. **Tre Johnson, Cam Scott** and **Nic Codie** will join the Longhorns for the 2024-25 season. The three-man class is currently No. 4 nationally in the Class of 2024 team rankings by 247 Sports Composite.

- **Tre Johnson** (6-6, 190), a guard from Dallas, Texas, who plays at Link Academy (Branson, Mo.), is ranked as the No. 4 prospect in the nation by ESPN, No. 4 by Rivals, No. 4 by 247 Sports and No. 4 by 247 Sports Composite. He played at Lake Highlands HS in Dallas during his freshman through junior seasons. As a junior in 2022-23, Johnson averaged 21.8 points, 6.4 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game while leading Lake Highlands to a 34-3 record and the UIL Class 6A state championship. The National Junior of the Year by MaxPreps and Mr. Basketball in the state of Texas last year, he converted 53-percent from the floor, including a 42-percent mark from three-point range, and 91-percent from the free throw line as a junior. Johnson surpassed the 2,000-career point mark during the quarterfinals of the state tourney last year and recorded a game-high 29 points in his team's 55-44 victory over Beaumont United HS in the Class 6A state title game. Lake Highlands won its first state championship since 1968.
- **Cam Scott** (6-5, 185), a guard from Lexington, S.C., who plays at Lexington HS, is ranked as the No. 24 prospect in the nation by ESPN, No. 27 by 247 Sports Composite, No. 29 by On3, No. 30 by Rivals and No. 37 by 247 Sports. In his junior year in 2022-23, he averaged 19.2 points, 6.1 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 2.4 steals per game while leading Lexington to a 20-7 record and a trip to the Class AAAAA state semifinals. Scott was named the South Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year following his junior season. He earned co-MVP honors in June at the Pangos All-American Camp in Las Vegas after averaging 24.6 points per game while hitting 57-percent from three-point range.
- **Nic Codie** (6-8, 200), a forward from Carrollton, Texas who plays at Newman Smith HS, is ranked as the No. 40 prospect in the nation by On3, No. 41 by Rivals, No. 45 by 247 Sports Composite and No. 46 by 247 Sports. The top-ranked player in the state of Texas in the Class of 2024, Codie averaged 16 points and nine rebounds per game as a junior in 2022-23 while leading Newman Smith to a 22-8 record and the District 9-5A championship.

Dylan earned his BA in Human Dimensions of Organizations in Spring 2023 and is currently in the Sport Management Graduate Program.
- **Ithiel Horton** is the first player in UT program history to wear jersey No. 9. In Hebrew, the name "Ithiel" means "God is with me." His mother, Hattie, is an evangelist, and his father, Kevin, plays the organ in church. His uncle, Lenny Horton, played basketball at Georgia Tech. His uncle, Brian Horton, played basketball at Fairleigh Dickinson and Morgan State.
- **Tyrese Hunter** lost both his father and mother during his childhood. His father, Brian, passed from sudden cardiac arrest when Tyrese was six years old. His mother, Ida, died of kidney failure when Tyrese was 13. Tyrese is the third-youngest of 12 children in the family (eight brothers and three sisters). He credits his grandmother, Annie Williams, and his oldest brother, Brian Jr., with raising him after the loss of his parents. Annie passed away this spring. Tyrese wears jersey No. 4 to honor his mom's birthdate (born on August 4, 1971).
- **Ze'Rik Onyema** has previously lived in Savannah, Ga.; Houston, Texas; Germany; El Paso, Texas; San Antonio, Texas; and Hawaii. His father, Kingsley, is a native of Owerri, Nigeria. Kingsley works in logistics for the U.S. Army and is based at the Pentagon. His mother, Mary, is an eighth-grade teacher. He wears jersey No. 21 to pay tribute to his mother's birthday (April 21) and his parents' anniversary (June 21).
- **Gavin Perryman's** father, Brandy Perryman, was a four-year letterwinner in basketball at Texas (1995-98) and finished his career as UT's all-time most accurate free throw shooter (89.7-percent, 183-204). His mother, Mandie Perryman, worked in the Texas Basketball office as a student assistant.
- **Kadin Shedrick** has a younger sister, Kari, who plays softball at Radford University (Radford, Va.). He played baseball as his primary sport until the age of 15. Kadin grew from 6-2 to 6-8 between his freshman and sophomore year of high school. His mother, Cindy, competed for the club Rowing team at the University of Cincinnati.
- **Chendall Weaver** wears jersey No. 2 to honor the memory of his best friend, Nevaeh Lopez who passed in 2020 (she attended Mansfield Timberview HS and wore jersey No. 2). His older sister, Chennedy Carter, played basketball at Texas A&M (2016-19) and was the No. 4 pick of the 2020 WNBA Draft by the Atlanta Dream. She played two seasons with the Atlanta Dream (2020-21) and one season with the Los Angeles Sparks (2022).

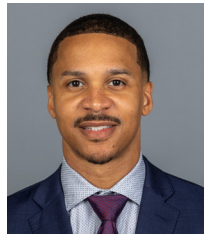
