STORY LINES

STARTING FIVE

- Baylor is playing in its 20th-straight NCAA Tournament in 2024. The Bears hold the fourth-longest active streak in the country in consecutive appearances behind Tennessee (42), Stanford (36) and UConn (35).
- The Bears are making their first appearance in the Sweet 16 since 2021 and first under the direction of head coach **Nicki Collen**.
- Baylor is 57-18 all-time in the NCAA Tournament with three national championships, four Final Four appearances, 10 trips to the Elite Eight and 16 Sweet 16 appearances. BU's 16 Sweet 16 appearances are the third-most in the last two decades behind only UConn and Stanford.
- The Bears rank ninth nationally in three-point percentage defense, holding their opponents to 26.2% from behind the arc this season. Baylor has held its opponent to below 20% shooting from 3-point range in five of the last eight games.
- Baylor is an impressive 21-1 this season when outrebounding its opponents. The Bears have recorded 50-plus rebounds in six contests this season, eclipsing 60 boards in wins over McNeese (68) and Delaware State (64).

QUEENS OF THE CASSELL

- No. 5-seeded Baylor outlasted the No. 4 seed Virginia Tech Hokies, 75-72, in the second round of the NCAA Tournament on Sunday.
- The win by the Bears snapped a 26-game home winning streak for the Hokies, which was a program record. Virginia Tech dropped to 32-2 at Cassell Coliseum in the last two seasons.
- Jada Walker paced the Baylor offense with a career-high 28 points, going a team-leading 9-for-10 from the charity stripe. She notched 26 of her 28 points in the second half, including 14 in the fourth quarter. Additionally, she went without a turnover and dished out three assists in the outing.
- Team captains **Sarah Andrews** (16) and **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** (10) joined Walker in double figures while **Bella Fontleroy** led the Bears on the boards for the second-straight game, grabbing nine.

FIGHTING IN THE FIRST ROUND

- Baylor earned the 80-63 victory over Vanderbilt in its opening-round game on March 22.
- The game marked the 100th career game for head coach **Nicki Collen**. She holds a 74-27 record at the helm of the Bears.
- The Bears have won their opening-round game 21 times in 22 showings in the Big Dance.
- **Bella Fontleroy** turned in her third double-double of the year, and sixth of her career, with a 19-point, 11-rebound performance to lead the Bears in both categories.
- Baylor's 80 points marked the 11th time this year that the Bears have put up at least 80 and first time since scoring 83 at Houston on Feb. 4.

BEARS IN THE BIG DANCE

- Baylor is making its 20th-straight NCAA Tournament appearance, and 22nd overall, in 2024.
- The Bears hold the fourth-longest active streak in the country in consecutive appearances behind Tennessee (42), Stanford (36) and UConn (35).
- This marks the second time in program history that Baylor has been a five seed in the Big Dance. The only other time was in 2007 when the Bears went 1-1 with a loss to NC State in the second round in Raleigh, making this the first time BU has advanced to the Sweet 16 as a five seed.
- Baylor is 57-18 all-time in the NCAA Tournament with three national championships (2005, 2012, 2019), four Final Four (2005, 2010, 2012, 2019) appearances, 10 trips to the Elite Eight and 16 Sweet 16 appearances.

SIGNATURE WINS

- Baylor is one of seven programs in the country with seven-or-more AP top-25 wins this season, and the only team in the Big 12.
- Baylor has signature wins over Virginia Tech, Utah, Miami, Texas, TCU and a pair over West Virginia. Two of those victories were top-five wins by the Bears.
- A win over No. 3 USC would be the highest-ranked victory for head coach **Nicki Collen** in her head coaching career.
- Heading into the tournament, the Bears were tied for fourth nationally in win percentage (.667) versus the NET Top 25 (with a minimum two games played).
- Baylor has a 4-2 record in those contests and its winning percentage (.667) is tied with USC and Oklahoma. The only teams with better win percentages in those games are South Carolina (1.000), Texas (.714) and Notre Dame (.700).

STORY LINES

SCOUTING THE SERIES WITH USC

- The series between the Bears and the Trojans is locked at one win apiece.
- Saturday's meeting between the two programs will be the first on a neutral court and first in nearly 25 years.
- In a home-and-home, USC took the opener, 71-53, in Los Angeles on Dec. 19, 1999.
- Nearly a year to the date later, Baylor bested USC, 79-55, in Waco, on Dec. 20, 2000.

THREATENING (AND PROTECTING) FROM THREE

- For the third-straight season, the Bears have made at least 230 3-pointers, sitting at a program-record 220 on the year.
- In **Nicki Collen's** first season at the helm (2021-22), Baylor broke the pre-existing record of 210 set in 2016-17 with 233.
- The Bears followed that up, connecting on 230 treys in 2022-23.
- Senior **Sarah Andrews** has a team-leading 70 treys on the year, ranking fifth in a single season in program history. For her career, the guard ranks second in BU women's basketball history with 234 made 3-pointers.
- Baylor has protected the 3-point arc just as much as it has capitalized from it this year. Heading into Sunday's game, the Bears rank ninth in NCAA Division I and lead the Big 12 in three-point percentage defense (26.2%).

NUMBERS TO WATCH

- Newcomer **Jada Walker** is 8 points away from 1,000 in her career.
- Senior **Sarah Andrews** is 36 assists away from 500 in her career. If she reaches this milestone, she will be just the fifth player to reach 500 in program history. She is also 25 3-pointers away from breaking the all-time career record at BU.

REBOUNDING MACHINES

- Baylor is 21-1 this season when outrebounding its opponents, and finished 11-1 in Big 12 action when grabbing more rebounds than its conference foes.
- The Bears have recorded 50-plus rebounds in six contests this season, eclipsing 60 boards in wins over McNeese (68) and Delaware State (64).
- Baylor ranks 23rd in the country in rebounding margin (7.4) and 44th in rebounds per game (40.2), sitting at No. 3 in the Big 12 in both categories.
- **Aijha Blackwell** has led the Bears in rebounding 14 times this season. She has finished in double figures on the glass in 11 contests this year and nine times in Big 12 play.

SEASONED SARAH

- For the third time in her career, **Sarah Andrews** earned an all-conference nod with a selection to the 2024 All-Big 12 Second Team.
- She is the only Bear on the current roster to have played more than two seasons at BU. With her four-year tenure, she has more experience at Baylor than anyone on the coaching staff.
- In Baylor's season-opening win over Southern on Nov. 6, she eclipsed 1,000-career points, becoming the 40th player in program history to accomplish this feat.
- This season, Andrews is averaging 11.3 points per game in nearly 30 minutes of action per contest.
- The senior guard leads the Bears with 129 assists and 70 made 3-pointers. Her 70 treys are tied for the fifth-most in program history for a single season, and she has connected on two-or-more from range in 22 games and has at least one 3-pointer in all but three contests.
- Andrews ranks second all-time in BU women's basketball history with 234 made 3-pointers. Odyssey Sims holds the record at 258.

STACKING WINS AT THE END

- The Bears won their fifth-straight game at home against Oklahoma State to wrap up the regular season on March 3. The win streak is the longest for BU since starting the year a perfect 14-0.
- **Dre'Una Edwards** (11.8) and **Jana Van Gytenbeek** (10.2) led the Bears in scoring in the five-game span, both coming off the bench for BU.
- On the glass, **Aijha Blackwell** (10.6) and **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** (8.4) led the way while **Sarah Andrews** (22) and **Van Gytenbeek** (21) led the team in assists.
- In their final five contests of the regular season, the Bears were shooting 42.9% from the floor while holding their opponents to 18.3% from behind the 3-point arc.

SHARING THE SUGAR

- Baylor ranks 15th in NCAA Division I and fourth in the Big 12 in assists per game, averaging 18.2. Iowa leads the country at 21.4 assists per contest while Oklahoma leads the conference at 20.1.
- Baylor has 599 assists on 930 made baskets this season (64%). **Sarah Andrews** (129), **Jada Walker** (105) and **Jana Van Gytenbeek** (84) lead the Bears in the category while all 13 players have recorded an assist.

STORY LINES

GIDDY UP

- Baylor swept the two-game series against Oklahoma State with a 22-point win over the Cowgirls in the regular-season finale on March 3 at Foster Pavilion.
- The sweep marked the third of the conference season, also taking the two-game set from Houston and West Virginia.
- **Aijha Blackwell** put up massive numbers in the series, averaging 13.5 points and 18.5 rebounds against the Cowgirls.
- In her first game at Oklahoma State on Jan. 28, she finished with a season-high 19 rebounds, becoming the first Bear to record that many in a game since NaLyssa Smith recorded 20 against Iowa State on Feb. 28, 2022.
- In Sunday's regular-season finale, Blackwell turned in her fifth double-double of the year with a 20-point, 18-rebound performance. The 20 points marked a season-high for the graduate senior, and it was the 32nd time in her career she recorded at least 20 points.

MASTERING THE MOUNTAINEERS

- Baylor's win at West Virginia on Feb. 24 helped the Bears pull off their second two-game sweep of a conference opponent in three tries as the Bears earned their league-high sixth top-25 win of the year.
- With hard contact on **Jada Walker** with less than five seconds left on the clock, and a one-point deficit, **Jana Van Gytenbeek** subbed into the game and drilled a pair of game-winning free throws.
- Five Bears finished in double scoring marking the first time since BU's game at Houston on Feb. 4 that at least five players notched double figures. Additionally, it marked the third time this year that five-or-more scored in double digits against a ranked foe.

GETTING EVEN

- After Kansas handed BU its first loss of the season in Lawrence on Jan. 10, the Bears used a 69-61 win at Foster Pavilion on Feb. 21 to split the season series.
- With the win, the Bears earned their 20th win of the season. Baylor has turned in 24-straight 20-plus win seasons which marks the second-longest streak in the country behind UConn (31).
- Baylor's bench scored 35 points while the Bears held Kansas' bench to zero points marking the fourth time this season, and third time in league play, the Jayhawk reserves went scoreless.
- A trio of Bears finished in double figures led by **Dre'Una Edwards'** 20-point outpouring. The 20-piece marked the second of the season for the graduate senior and 16th of her career.

SEASON SWEEP OF THE COOGS

- Baylor used a 23-point victory to sweep the two-game series against Houston on Feb. 4, charging past the Cougars, 83-60.
- The 23-point win marked the fourth 16-plus point victory by Baylor in Big 12 action this season.
- With her fourth rebound of the game, **Aijha Blackwell** hit 1,000 rebounds in her career.
- Baylor moved to 15-2, and 60-6 in the **Nicki Collen** era, when leading at the half.
- **Yaya Felder** contributed 14 of BU's 28 points off the bench, leading the Baylor reserves for the second-straight game.

GOOD KNIGHT

- Baylor outlasted the UCF Knights, 77-74, on Jan. 20 at Foster Pavilion to jump back in the win column after a pair of losses at Kansas (Jan. 10) and Iowa State (Jan. 13).
- The Bears played in front of their second-largest crowd of the season and at the new facility with over 5,000 in attendance.
- Baylor shot 50% (27-of-54) from the floor as a team and moved to 18-1 in the **Nicki Collen** era when shooting 50% or better from the field. Additionally, Baylor is 266-2 all-time when shooting at least 50% from the floor.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** finished in double figures for the eighth time this season with her second-career 20-point outing matching a season-high 24 points.
- **Aijha Blackwell** turned in her fifth double-digit rebound outing this year, and third in four games, with a season high 13 boards.
- **Sarah Andrews** dished out a season high 10 assists, finishing in double figures in the category for just the second time in her career. She added 11 points for her second-career double-double.

HOT START

- The Bears pieced together their best start to a season since the perfect 40-0 season put together by the 2012 national championship team, starting the year at 14-0.
- With BU's undefeated record in non-conference play, it marked just the fifth time in program history that the Bears have gone perfect in non-con action since the turn of the century. The other seasons were: 2000-01, 2001-02, 2011-12 and 2015-16. Additionally, it marked the sixth time entering Big 12 play unbeaten, doing so in the 2005-06 season as well.

TAKING DOWN TEXAS

- Baylor's 85-79 conference-opening win at Texas on Dec. 30 marked the 14th-straight win in Austin for the Bears.
- The win marked the Bears' second top-five win of the year after a non-con victory over then-No. 4 Utah.
- The last time Baylor picked up two top-five wins in the regular season was during the 2012-13 campaign, beating No. 3 UConn and No. 5 Notre Dame on the road.
- Baylor forced Texas to commit 23 turnovers - the most in a game by the Longhorns this season and the most in a Big 12 game since turning the ball over 24 times at Oklahoma on Jan. 29, 2022.
- Baylor's nine 3-pointers were the most given up by the Longhorns this year. Senior **Sarah Andrews** went a team-best 4-for-8 from deep and moved into second all-time at Baylor in made 3-pointers.

KEEPIN' IT 100

- Baylor used an 80-point win to take down McNeese on Nov. 24 at the Ferrell Center. The 124 points scored by the Bears in the 124-44 victory were the most in a game in the **Nicki Collen** era and most since notching 136 against Northwestern State on Dec. 18, 2020. Additionally, it ranked fifth all-time in points recorded in a game by BU.
- It was just the eighth time in program history Baylor had put up 120-plus points, including overtime games.
- The team combined for 17 3-pointers, surpassing the previous record of 15 made 3-pointers set against Arkansas State on Dec. 18, 2019. The Bears were 17-for-32 (53.1%) and moved to a perfect 7-0 in the Collen era when shooting 50% or better from range.
- Baylor dished out 43 assists as a team - the second-most in program history - and were led by senior **Jana Van Gytenbeek** in the category with a career-high 12 dishes.
- As a team, Baylor grabbed 68 rebounds, which sits just outside the top-five all-time in program history. Of the 68 boards, 34 of them were offensive, marking the most since at least the 2014-15 campaign when the Bears recorded 35 in a win over Prairie View A&M.

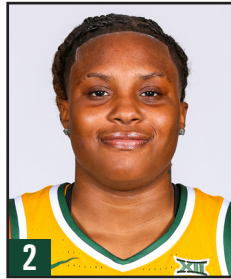
UPSETTING THE UTES

- Baylor, ranked No. 21 in the AP Top 25 Poll at the time, defeated the then-No. 4 Utah Utes, 84-77, at the Ferrell Center on Tuesday, Nov. 14.
- The victory marked the first Big 12 win versus a top-four opponent since Kansas State topped No. 4 Iowa, 84-83, on Nov. 17, 2022, and the Wildcats have since had one, knocking off No. 2 Iowa on Nov. 16.
- Baylor's win over the Utes marked the Bears' first top-four win since beating No. 1 UConn, 74-58, on Jan. 9, 2020, and it was the first top-four win at home since beating the Huskies, 68-57, on Jan. 3, 2019.
- The 84 points scored by the Bears are the most against a top-10 opponent in a regular-season, non-overtime game since scoring 87 at No. 9 Iowa State on Feb. 28, 2022. Additionally, it's the most points scored against a top-five opponent in the regular season since netting 94 against No. 2 Notre Dame on Nov. 20, 2011.
- The win marked the highest-ranked victory for head coach **Nicki Collen** in her head coaching career and she moved to 3-3 all-time against top-10 foes.

HEAD COACH NICKI COLLEN • 3RD SEASON



Nicki Collen was introduced as the fifth head coach in Baylor women's basketball history on May 5, 2021. She enters her third season at the helm in 2023-24.

In her first season with the Bears, Collen recorded the most wins by a rookie head coach in the country with 28. She helped lead the Bears to their 12th-straight Big 12 regular-season title and their

11th-straight top-two seed in the NCAA Tournament.

Collen implemented her system, which featured more perimeter shooting. Baylor went from the bottom of the list nationally to just outside the top 50 in 3-pointers made. In her first season, the Bears set new program records for 3-pointers made (233) and attempted (678).

From her introductory press conference, the Naismith Coach of the Year semifinalist said the Bears would be playing their best basketball late in the season, and she was right. Baylor became the first team to defeat a ranked opponent twice in a three-day span since 1999 when the Bears downed Texas two times to open the month of February. Two weeks later, exactly a month after sitting at the bottom of the conference standings with an 0-2 record, BU was back atop the league's leaderboard.

Collen implemented the 1-0 mentality that paid off with a 25-point win at No. 8 Iowa State in front of a nearly soldout crowd of 13,000 raucous fans which clinched the conference crown. Baylor became the first team since Texas Tech in 2000 to start a Big 12 season 0-2 and go on to win the league.

After her first season ended in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, Collen saw three of her players be selected in the 2022 WNBA Draft, tying a program record. Two of them - NaLyssa Smith (No. 2) and Queen Egbo (No. 10) marked the first duo to be taken in the top 10 in program history.

Collen's first recruiting class was ranked No. 9 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz.

In year two, Collen mentored two all-conference selections, two unanimous Big 12 All-Freshman Team picks and the unanimous Big 12 Freshman of the Year, Darianna Littlepage-Buggs. Littlepage-Buggs earned eight Big 12 Freshman of the Week awards during the 2022-23 campaign, becoming the first BU rookie to earn it eight-or-more times in program history. Additionally, she ranked second in the Big 12 all-time in freshman of the week honors.

The Bears secured 20 wins for the 23rd-straight year, which is the second-longest active streak among Division I programs behind UConn's 30-straight 20-plus win seasons. Collen led Baylor to its 19th-straight NCAA Tournament appearance in 2022-23 and 21st overall, as the Bears erased an 18-point deficit to win their opening-round game against Alabama.

Collen came to Baylor from the WNBA's Atlanta franchise, where she spent the last three seasons at the helm for the Dream. Her rookie season in Atlanta resulted in a 23-11 season in 2018, where she earned WNBA Coach of the Year honors and helped the franchise to the WNBA Playoff Semifinals.

Prior to her arrival in Atlanta, she spent two seasons under former head coach Curt Miller of the Connecticut Sun, helping the franchise improve from fifth in the East Division to second from 2016 to 2017, respectively.

Collen's collegiate coaching career spanned for nine seasons prior to her WNBA arrival. She spent two seasons as an assistant at Colorado State from 2000-2002, one season at Ball State from 2002-2003, one at Louisville from 2003-2004, three at Arkansas from 2011-2014 and two at Florida Gulf Coast from 2014-2016.

Her teams' combined record in nine seasons as an NCAA Division I assistant was 214-74, good for a .743 win percentage. As an assistant, Collen guided four different squads to the NCAA Tournament, reaching the second round in three of those seasons.

She spent six of her nine seasons as an assistant under

her husband, Tom Collen's head-coaching tenures at Colorado State, Louisville and Arkansas. She also coached under Tracy Roller at Ball State and Karl Smesko at Florida Gulf Coast. Collen helped the FGCU program to a 64-9 record and the school's first NCAA Tournament win in her two-year tenure.

In her nine seasons at the collegiate level, Collen coached three All-Americans and saw three players selected in the WNBA Draft.

Collen's collegiate playing career began at Purdue in 1993-94, when the Boilermakers made an NCAA Final Four run with a 29-5 overall record and a 16-2 mark in the Big Ten. Her sophomore season, Purdue made another deep run with an Elite Eight appearance to go with a 24-8 overall record. She transferred to Marquette, where she tallied 421 assists in her final two seasons, averaging 7.0 per game in her last 60 collegiate games. She helped the Golden Eagles to two-straight NCAA Tournament appearances in 1997 and 1998.

Nicki and her husband, Tom, have three children, Connor, Reese and Logan. Connor and Reese are currently freshmen at Baylor.

- Baylor is 268-2 all-time when shooting 50 percent or better from the field and 40-0 when shooting 60 percent or higher. The Bears' last loss when shooting over 50 percent was to No. 22 Michigan on 11/27/22.
- 366 of Baylor's wins since 2010-11 have been by 10 or more points, and only 27 times in that span has its winning margin been five or fewer points.
- Since the 2010-11 season, Baylor is 48-10 vs. Top 25 opponents at home.
- Baylor is 360-114 (.761) vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season all-time.

THE BAYLOR BEARS REGIME

2019 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The 2018-19 Bears became just the third women's program in NCAA history to win three titles when Baylor beat Notre Dame, 82-81, April 7 in Tampa, Florida. **Chloe Jackson's** go-ahead scoop layup with under five seconds left propelled her to NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player honors to go along with a team-high 26 points in the game. The Bears rode the wave of two All-American posts with **Kalani Brown** and **Lauren Cox**, each earning multiple all-America honors. The pair led Baylor to its 10th regular-season and tournament championship in the Big 12 and **Kim Mulkey** was honored as national coach of the year by the USBWA, the Associated Press and the WBCA.

2012 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The 2011-12 Bear season was as perfect as it could be. En route to claiming its second NCAA Championship in seven years, Baylor ran the table, posting an unprecedented 40-0 mark and claiming both Big 12 Conference crowns. **Brittney Griner** and Mulkey swept player of the year and coach of the year honors, earning WBCA, USBWA, Associated Press, Naismith and Big 12 Conference recognition. Baylor was ranked No. 1 wire-to-wire in both polls and raced through conference play with a Big 12-record 18-0 mark. Griner and **Odyssey Sims** were named consensus All-Americans, while **Destiny Williams** was a WBCA All-America honorable mention honoree.

2005 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The squad posted a 33-3 record and claimed the Big 12 Conference title with a 14-2 mark. En route to the program's first NCAA Championship, the Bears defeated three No. 1 seeds. **Steffanie Blackmon** and **Sophia Young** were both named All-Americans. In addition to earning Big 12 Coach of the Year honors, **Mulkey** received the New York Athletic Club's prestigious Winged Foot Award.

NCAA TOURNAMENT STAPLE & 11-PLUS YEAR DOMINANCE

- The Bears have made 20-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and 22 overall. Those appearances have resulted in three national championships (2005, 2012, 2019), four Final Fours (2005, 2010, 2012, 2019), 10 Elite Eights and 16 Sweet Sixteens.
- The Bears are 24-time Big 12 Champions-- most in Big 12 history --capturing 12 of the last 14 regular season titles, 13 overall & 11 tournament titles.
- Baylor is 442-53 (.898) over the past 12 seasons while posting a 224-25 mark in Big 12 play and 30-4 in Big 12 Tournament play during that span.
- 366 of Baylor's 442 wins since 2010-11 have been by 10 or more points, and only 27 times in that span has its winning margin been five or fewer points.

BIG 12 DYNASTY

- Baylor women's basketball has won a league-leading 24 Big 12 Conference titles -- 13 regular season and 11 tournament championships.
- Baylor has run the table in the conference four times (2012, 2013, 2018, 2019). It has only happened six times in Big 12 history (Oklahoma: 16-0 in 2006; Nebraska: 16-0 in 2010).
- Baylor has advanced to the Big 12 Championship game 15 times in program history.
- The Bears have won six of the last 10 Big 12 Championship titles, last besting No. 17/20 West Virginia, 76-50, in the 2021 final.
