2023-24 TEAM NOTES

- Ranked No. 31 nationally in the latest Scoreboard rankings
- Made the postseason for the 25th time in the last 26 seasons
- Making its sixth championship appearance in the last eight full seasons
- Advanced to 11th NCAA Championship in program history (1960, 1966, 1967, 2002, 2010, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2023 and 2024)
- Baylor is one of 12 teams to play in six of the last eight NCAA Championships.
- BU's 15-under 825 at the Chapel Hill Regional came up just two shots shy of the program's all-time NCAA postseason scoring mark (823).
- Johnny Keefer is coming off a tie for second in Chapel Hill where he set the program's all-time NCAA postseason scoring record with a 12-under 198, three-shots better than the previous mark (201).
- BU has competed against 24 NCAA Championship opponents this season, combining for a 15-29-1 head-to-head record – (Arizona, 0-2-1, California 0-1, Clemson 0-1, ETSU 0-1, Florida (1-0), Florida State 0-2, Georgia Tech (0-2), Illinois (1-0), LSU (2-0), New Mexico (1-1), North Carolina (0-2), Oklahoma (2-1), Oklahoma State (2-2), Purdue (1-0), SMU (0-2), Stanford (1-2), Tennessee (0-1), Texas (0-2), Texas A&M (1-0), Texas Tech (1-4), (Utah 0-1), Vanderbilt (0-2), Virginia (1-0), West Virginia (1-0))


HEAD COACH MIKE MCGRAW

- 10th season at Baylor, led BU to NCAA Tournament appearances in 8 of 9 full seasons and to the NCAA Championship six times
- Notched his 50th-career win (20th at Baylor) last month at the Aggie Invitational.
- Three-time National Champion; one as a head coach (2006 @ Ok. State) and two as an assistant coach (2000 @ Ok. State & 2014 @ Alabama)
- 22nd appearance at the NCAA Championships as a head coach or assistant coach
- Has coached six BU players to 18 All-American Honors. In total, he's coached 31 All-Americans and 43 individual medalists
- In addition to his three titles, nearly half of McGraw's 25 potential championship seasons have ended with top-five finishes at the NCAA Championship, including 11 top fives and three runners-up finishes.



JONAS APPEL (<i>uh-PELL</i>)	SOPHOMORE	ENCITAS, CALIF. (LA COSTA CANYON)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sophomore from nearby Encitas, Calif., and grew up playing La Costa and considers it his home course. • Has played in 19 rounds across eight tournaments with a scoring average of 73.95. • Tied for third on the team in par-3 scoring average this season (3.10). • Has subbed in the final round of the last two events, and helped the Bears clinch an NCAA berth with a 1-over 71 in Chapel Hill. • Best finish of the season came last month at the Aggie Invitational where he tied for 17th. • Finished tied for eighth last season at the Prestige Individual Invite last season in Palm Springs, Calif. • Made match play in the 2021 and 2022 US Junior Amateur reaching the round of 32 in 2021. 		

LUKE DOSSEY (<i>DOSS-eee</i>)	FIFTH-YEAR SENIOR	AUSTIN, TEXAS (VANDEGRIFT)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Senior accounting major from Austin, Texas playing his final season at Baylor. • No. 391 in the latest Scoreboard national collegiate individual rankings. • Has appeared in the lineup in 10 of 11 events this season, with 10 rounds at par or better and a pair of top-10 finishes • Best finish this season was a tie for 8th at the Kapolei Invitational, where he shot a 12-under 204, one of 22 tournament scores of 204 or better in program history. • Opened the season with a tie for 10th at the inaugural Valero Texas Collegiate, played at TPC San Antonio, home to the PGA's Valero Texas Open. • His brother Cooper was an All-American at Baylor and currently plays on the Korn Ferry Tour. • His younger brother Sam is a sophomore on the team • Both parents are Baylor graduates, and his mom Trudi was a Baylor yell leader • His Aunt Kelli (Donaldson) Smith was a four-year letter winner on the Baylor women's basketball team from 1992-1995 		

ZACH HEFFERNAN (<i>HEFF-er-nen</i>)	JUNIOR	BOERNE, TEXAS (CHAMPION)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Junior communications major from Boerne (BURN-eee), Texas • Ranked 250 in the latest Scoreboard individual rankings • Has made eight appearances in the lineup including each of the last four events, highlighted by a tie for fourth at the Aggie Invitational last month. • Went 5-0 at the Big 12 Match Play in October, becoming the fifth player in the history of the event to go a perfect 5-0 in the event. • In his second-career regional in Chapel Hill, Heffernan played his final two rounds at 5-under for his career-best postseason finish (t-16th). • Made his NCAA Championship debut as a sophomore last year. • On pace to improve his stroke average for a third-straight season (72.41), while setting career highs in top-5s, top-10s and rounds at par or better. • McGraw says he is one of the hardest workers he has been around. • Likes to hunt and fish in his free time • Mom, Dana, was cheerleader at Baylor 		

TYLER ISENHART (<i>EYE-zen-heart</i>)	FIFTH-YEAR SENIOR	GENEVA, ILL. (GENEVA COMMUNITY)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Senior finance major from Geneva, Ill., one of three seniors on the team using a COVID fifth year. • No. 303 in the latest Scoreboard Individual rankings • Has been in the lineup for 19 tournaments over the past two seasons after only playing 11 tournaments, total, in his previous three seasons • Recorded his career-best NCAA postseason finish at the Chapel Hill Regional (t-16th) after opening with a 65, the lowest opening round and the fourth-best NCAA postseason round in program history. • Shot 65 twice this season (Chapel Hill Regional and DBU invitational in the fall. • Third on the team in total birdies (89) and par-or-better percentage (79.6%) • His best finish of the season came at the Aggie Invitational where he finished tied for ninth, one of two top-10s this season. • Has 10 top-25 finishes over the last two season after only having three in his previous three seasons • Father Kevin played golf at Division III Augustana College 		

JOHNNY KEEFER (<i>KEY-fer</i>)	FIFTH-YEAR SENIOR	SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS (JOHNSON HS)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fifth-year senior accounting major from San Antonio, has played at the No. 1 position in every event over the last three seasons • Enters the NCAA's as the program's career stroke-average leader (71.43), .12 strokes ahead of Jimmy Walker's all-time mark (71.55). • Ranked No. 36 in the latest scoreboard individual rankings, Johnny is a two-time All-American (2020 & 2023) • 2022 & 23 Big 12 Men's Golf Scholar Athlete of The Year, becoming the first men's golfer in conference history to win the award in back-to-back seasons. • Set the program's 54-hole scoring record at the Chapel Hill Regional with a 12-under 198, highlighted by a second-round 64. • Owns three of the top-11 rounds in program history, including his record-tying 63 at the Cabo Collegiate in 2022, one of just three 63s in BU history. • 71.38 career stroke average in the postseason, with nine of his 16 rounds at par or better. • Made the cut as an individual last year at the NCAA Championship en route to a tie for 52nd, becoming the second player in program history to compete as an individual in the NCAA Championship, and the first since 2009. • Holds a 16-5-4 career record in Match Play • Ranks fourth in career top-10 finishes (19), seventh in career top-5s (10) • Leads the team in birdie-or-better percentage (20.9%), par-4 scoring average (4.06), and total birdies (121). • Talented lacrosse player, before turning his attention solely to golf 		

DAVIS OVARD (<i>OH-vard</i>)	FRESHMAN	FRISCO, TEXAS (FRISCO)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A freshman from Frisco, Texas ranked No. 314 in the latest Scorecard individual rankings after ranking No. 997 in January. • Has been in the lineup for every event this spring, carding a pair of top-10 finishes at the All-American Intercollegiate (t-9) and The Aggie Invitational (t-8). • Leads the team in total pars (372), while ranking second on the team in: counting-score percentage (92.0), rounds at par-or-better (14), par-4 scoring average (4.04) and total birdies (112). • Played two rounds at par-or-better at the Big 12 Championship at Whispering Pines Golf Club. • Brother, Dawson, played collegiately at SMU.
