Men's Golf

- BU finished 14th at the NCAA Championship, notching its third-highest NCAA Championship finish in program history (t-7th in 2017 and t-9th in 1960).
- With his tie for 11th, Johnny Keefer now holds the highest finish by a Baylor individual in the NCAA Championship.
- Keefer now holds Baylor's career stroke-average record with his 71.45 average across 141 rounds, beating the previous mark set by PGA Tour winner and major champion, Jimmy Walker (71.55).
- Keefer finished his career with the seventh-most rounds played (141), the seventh-most top-5s (10) and the fourth-most top-10s (19).
- With his 11th-place finish, Johnny Keefer finished 25th in the final PGA Tour U rankings, earning him fully exempt status on PGA Tour America's for 2024 and for the Second Stage of 2024 PGA TOUR Q-School.

Softball

- Baylor finished with a 36-23 record and made its first trip to the Super Regionals since 2017.
- Baylor took No. 4 Florida to an if-necessary game three after a 5-3 upset win over the Gators on Saturday.
- Baylor carried the No. 1 strength of schedule for most of the season and faced 10 ranked opponents during the season, totaling 26 games.
- BU played 43 games against RPI top 75 teams and faced the No. 1 team in the country seven times during the 2024 season.
- Shaylon Govan led the Bears offensively and set program record in walks (48) and on-base percentage (.579).

Track & Field

- Bears qualified 10 entries to the NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships, held June 5-8 at the University of Oregon's Hayward Field.
- Chinecherem Prosper Nnamdi and the women's 4x100-meter relay squad posted top marks in the west region, with Prosper Nnamdi's javelin attempt breaking the meet record that stood for over 10 years. The women's 4x100-meter relay also posted the first sub-43 mark in program history, winning the event at 42.66.
- De'montray Callis leads BU going into the championship meet, qualifying in three events: 100, 200 and 4x100.
