- This is the second meeting in program history between Baylor and Utah.
 Utab defeated Paylor in Week 2 of 2022, 20 13 in Week
- Utah defeated Baylor in Week 2 of 2023, 20-13 in Waco.
- Baylor head coach Dave Aranda is 24-26 in his fifth year with Baylor.
 BU is 59-198-6 against top-25 foes all-time.
- Bo is 59-198-6 against top-25
 Baylor is 631-603-44 all-time.
- Baylor IS 531-503-44 all-time.

- Baylor is 16-15 in day games in the Aranda era.
 The Bears are 7-16 under Aranda when the opponent scores first.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- The Bears had 223 total offensive yards.
- 175 yards of those came in the second half.
- The Baylor offense outscored the Utes 12-0 since 5:21 in the second quarter.
- Sophomore RB Dawson Pendergrass rushed for 69 yards on nine carries.
- His 46-yard carry marked a career-long.
- Junior WR Josh Cameron recorded his first-career touchdown on a career long 47-yard reception.
- Cameron posted team high 59 yards on two receptions overall and 84 all purpose yards.
- Senior QB Dequan Finn finished with 115 passing yards, 9-21-0, with one passing touchdown to Cameron.
- Junior TE Michael Trigg led the team in receptions at four with 27 receiving yards.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Baylor held the Utes to 292 total yards of offense.
- The Bears held Utah to only 95 offensive yards in the second half.
- Utah only logged 27 passing yards in the second half compared to 95 in the first.
- Utah only logged 68 rushing yards in the second half compared to 102 in the first.
- In the third quarter, Baylor defense held Utah's offense to only four total yards and zero first downs.
- Redshirt sophomore LB Keaton Thomas led the Bears with a career high 12 total tackles, seven being solo.
- The sophomore had brought down eight total tackles by halftime.
- Senior LB Matt Jones was also in double-digits with 10 total tackles, six being solo.
- Jones picked up his first-career fumble recovery on a failed Utah two-point conversion.
- Junior S Devyn Bobby recorded seven tackles, five being solo, including an assisted TFL of three yards.
- Junior DL Jackie Marshall posted four tackles, two being solo, including his first-career sack.
- Marshall's first-career sack was for a loss of 11 yards.
- Senior DL Treven Ma'ae earned career high four total tackles, including an assist on a sack for a loss of four yards.
- Senior CB Lorando Johnson recorded a PBU with three solo tackles.
- Marked Johnson's 13th career PBU.

SPECIAL TEAM NOTES

- Sophomore P Palmer Williams punted six times for 376 yards, averaging 62.7, with a long punt of 79 yards and two inside the 20.
- Williams' 79-yard punt is a career long.
- Williams' 62.7-yard average on his six punts is a school record for yards per punt in a single-game.
- Tied a school record with six 50 + yard punts in a game.
- Williams broke his career-best four times in the game with a 57 yarder and a 60-yarder in the 1st, 76-yarder in the 2nd, and a 79-yarder in the 4th.
- First 70+ yard punt since Drew Galitz against Duke (9/16/17).
- Redshirt junior K Isaiah Hankins went 2-3 on FG.
- Hankins put the first points on the board for Baylor with a 44-yard field goal.
- Hankins is now tied at No. 6 in career field goals made with 34, tying John Mayers (2018-22).
- Junior WR Josh Cameron returned two punts for 25 yards with a long return of 18.
