- · Hosting Tarleton for another scrimmage on Sunday, Sept. 29 out at the Willis Family Equestrian Center.
- · First competition of the season will be on Oct. 10 at TCU

#### **Football**

- Colorado Buffaloes pulled out a 38-31 overtime victory over the Baylor Bears Saturday night before a homecoming crowd of 52,794 at Folsom Field in the Big 12 opener for both
- Baylor defense brought down 12 tackles for loss of 58 yards - the most TFLs since the 2021 Sugar Bowl (10)
- 52 of those yards came from eight sacks recorded by six different Bears
- Senior LB Matt Jones ended with 10 total tackles, nine being solo - his third consecutive double-digit tackle game.
- Senior WR Jamaal Bell returned a kick for a 100-yard touchdown - the first kick return touchdown in his career.

#### Men's Golf

- · Zach Heffernan lied the way with a 21st-place finish, his second top-25 in as many events this season
- The Bears return to action at the Big 12 Match Play Oct. 7-9 at the Clubs at Houston Oaks
- · The two-time champions of the event finished second a season ago

#### Men's Tennis

- Began competition at ITA All-American Championships in Tulsa
- · Marko Miladinovic made it through the prequalifying draw and advanced to the qualifying draw in singles
- Miladinovic and Devin Badenhorst begin the qualifying singles draw and hope to advance to the main draw in the next two days
- Miladinovic and Oskar Brostrom Poulsen begin doubles competition in the main draw on Wednesday, while Zsombor Velcz begins the main singles draw.

#### Soccer

- · Baylor softball went 1-1 last week falling to Arizona, 1-0, before turning around and shutting out Houston, 4-0.
- Four different Bears found the back of the net against the Cougars, three of them with their third goals of the season, while Tyler Isgrig leads the way with four.
