TEAM NOTES

- BYU leads the all-time series, 3-2, Baylor leads with a 2-1 record in Waco.
 - The last meeting between the two was on Sept. 10, 2022 in Provo, BYU winning 26-20 in double overtime.
- Baylor head coach **Dave Aranda** is 25-28 in his fifth year with Baylor.
 - Baylor is 15-23 in conference games in the Aranda era.
 - Baylor is 16-16 in day games in the Aranda era.
 - Baylor is 5-14 against AP ranked opponents underneath Aranda.
- Baylor is 632-605-44 all-time.
- Baylor captains: Devyn Bobby, Hal Presley, Sawyer Robertson, Josh White.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- The Bears finished with 387 total offensive yards, 324 passing and 63 rushing.
 - Baylor put points on the board in every quarter.
 - The 324 passing yards is the most Baylor has put up since at Cincinnati (10/21/23).
 - The 28 total points Baylor scored is the most BYU has allowed this season.
- Baylor offense went 4-7 on fourth downs.
- Baylor outscored BYU 14-3 in the second half.
- Junior QB Sawyer Robertson had a career-best day, going 27-48-2 and 324 passing yards with three passing touchdowns.
- Robertson recorded career best marks in passing attempts, completions, yards, passing touchdowns and carries.
- Marked first time Baylor has had at least three TD passes since Blake Shapen (4) at Kansas State (11/11/23).
- Robertson is the first 300-yard passer since Blake Shapen (316) at Cincinnati (10/21/23).
- Robertson went for 29 yards on 12 carries, including a 20-yard rushing TD on a fourth down conversion his third rushing TD in the season, fourth in his career.
- Redshirt junior WR Josh Cameron led the Bears with a career-high seven receptions for a best 125 receiving yards and two touchdowns.
 - Marked first multi-TD game in his career.
- First 100-yard receiver for Baylor since Drake Dabney (105) at Kansas State (11/11/23).
- Senior WR Ashtyn Hawkins made a 15-yard reception for his second TD of the season, 13th TD in his career.
- Hawkins finished with 74 receiving yards on five catches.
- Senior WR Hal Presley led the team in targets with 14, making a career-high eight receptions for 82 yards.
- Redshirt freshman RB Bryson Washington rushed for 31 yards on career high 13 carries.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Through five games, Baylor defense is holding its opponents in the second half to only 20 points, averaging 4.0, compared to 74 points in the first half, averaging 14.8.
 In the second half, opponents are averaging 107.6 total offense yards versus 185.4 in the first half.
- Baylor held BYU offense to only 81 total yards in the second half compared to 286 in the first.
- Redshirt sophomore LB Keaton Thomas led the team with seven total tackles, five being solo, inclduing a tackle for a loss of two yards.
- Second time this season Thomas has led team in tackles.
- Senior DL Treven Ma'ae had a career-high day with six total tackles, two being solo.
- Sophomore S Corey Gordon picked off his second interception of the season in the third quarter.
- Redshirt senior S Caleb Parker broke up his first pass of his career.
- Senior DL Elinus Noel III brought down his first TFL of the season, ending with three total tackles.
- Noel also snagged his first interception of his career in the fourth quarter.

SPECIAL TEAM NOTES

- Senior WR Jamaal Bell returned four kickoffs for a 106 yards, averaging 27.0 with a long return of 41.
- Sophomore P Palmer Williams punted three times for 148 yards with a long punt of 52.
- Freshman K Connor Hawkins made his second appearance of the season, going 0-1 on field goals and missing a 50-yard attempt.
