TEAM NOTES

- Baylor leads the all-time series, 42-40-1; Tech leads with a 24-16-1 record in Lubbock.
- The Bears have won five of the last seven meetings with Texas Tech.
- Baylor head coach Dave Aranda is 26-29 in his fifth year with Baylor.
 - Baylor is 16-24 in conference games in the Aranda era.
 - Baylor is 9-15 on the road in the Aranda era.
- Baylor is 633-606-44 all-time.
- Marked the most points Baylor has put up against Tech since 2015 where BU won 63-35 in Arlington.
- Last time BU scored 50 or more points was 69, vs. UAlbany (9/3/22).
- Last time BU score 50 or more points versus a Big 12 team was 61, at Kansas (11/30/19).
- Baylor captains: Josh Cameron, Kyler Jordan, Caleb Parker, Sawyer Robertson

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- The Bears finished with 529 total offensive yards, 274 passing and 255 rushing.
 - Most this season in total offense and rushing yards.
 - Last time Baylor surpassed 500-yards of total offense was vs. Texas State in 2023 (524).
- Junior QB Sawyer Robertson went 21-32-0 and 274 passing yards with an impressive five passing touchdowns.
 - Marked three consecutive games that Robertson has thrown for at least three passing touchdowns.
 - Last time BU had five TD passes was Seth Russell vs. WVU (10/17/15).
 - Marked new career-high in touchdown passes.
- Redshirt freshman RB Bryson Washington ended with 116 yards on 10 carries and two rushing TDs, averaging 11.6 per carry.
 - Career-high in yards; second 100+ yard game of career.
 - . Marked his first multi-TD game of the his career.
 - Put the first points on the board for Baylor on a one-yard rush up the middle.
- The play before, Washington recorded a 44-yard carry -- the longest rush of his career.
- Redshirt junior WR Josh Cameron added on three touchdowns of the season and career.
 - Cameron ended the night with 75 yards on six receptions on seven targets and three TDs.
 - New career-high in touchdowns. Now has seven for the season and career.
 - Cameron became the first wide receiver for Baylor to reel in seven or more touchdowns in a season since Tyquan Thornton (10) in 2021.
- Senior WR Ashyton Hawkins ended with six receptions on seven targets for 69 yards.
- Senior WR Hal Presley hauled in a 35-yard reception for his first catch of the game and for a touchdown.
 - His second TD of the season, sixth of his career.
- Senior WR Monaray Baldwin finished with two receptions for 26 yards and a touchdown.
 - Marked 10th TD of his career, second of the season.
- Senior QB Dequan Finn made his 48th career appearance, rushing twice for 40 yards and a touchdown.
 - The 34-yard rushing TD marked first rushing TD for Finn since the season-opener, 27th rushing TD career.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Senior LB Matt Jones led the defense with nine total tackles, seven being solo, one sack for a loss of six yards and two PBUs.
 - Marked 10th career sack.
 - Tied career-best PBUs.
- Sophomore CB Caden Jenkins picked off his first interception of the season, fourth of his career, for a nine-yard return.
 - Jenkins ended with seven tackles, six being solo.
 - Seven tackles ties career-best.
- Sophomore CB Carl Williams IV had a career-best night with seven tackles, four being solo, and 1.5 TFLs for a loss of four yards.
- Senior OLB Steve Linton, a Texas Tech transfer, ended with five solo tackles, three TFLs and a sack for a loss of eight yards.
 - Ties career-best in solo tackles and TFLs.
 - Last time Linton had 3.0 TFLs was facing off against Baylor (10/7/23).
- Redshirt sophomore LB Keaton Thomas ended with five tackles, three being solo.
 - Has had four games with at least five tackles this season.

SPECIAL TEAM NOTES

- Redshirt junior WR **Josh Cameron** returned a punt for 73 yards, just stopped the one-yard line, for a career-long return.
- Baylor recovered a muffed kickoff at the Texas Tech 19-yard line, recovered by Rara Dillworth for his first career FR, to put BU in scoring position for a 31-yard FG made by Isaiah Hankins.
- Hankins went 1-1 on FGs and now has a career line of 40-57 in FGs.
- Sophomore P Palmer Williams punted four times for 196 yards with a long punt of 63 and two inside the 20 and one 50+.
