TEAM NOTES

- Oklahoma State leads the all time series, 23-20; Baylor leads with a 10-8 record in Waco.
- In Waco, Oklahoma State has won just twice over the last 15 years.
- The Bears are 51-44-4 all-time on homecoming and have won five of their last six and 12 of their last 14 homecoming matchups.
- Baylor has faced OSU on homecoming just three times, going 2-1 against the Cowboys.
- Baylor is 5-2 all-time in Sailor Bear helmets; 5-1 in Sailor Bear on homecoming.
- Baylor head coach Dave Aranda is 27-29 in his fifth year with Baylor.
 - Baylor is 17-24 in conference games in the Aranda era.
- Baylor is 16-12 at home in the Aranda era.
- Baylor is 634-606-44 all-time.

• Baylor put the first touchdown on the board on a 99-yard drive that came from a forced fumble and recovery. The last time BU had a 99-yard scoring drive was versus Kansas in 2022 (10/22/22).

• Baylor captains: Josh Cameron, Micah Gifford, Sawyer Robertson, Carl Williams IV

OFFENSIVE NOTES

• The Bears finished with 565 total offensive yards, 222 passing and 343 rushing.

- Most this season in total offense and rushing yards.
- Last time Baylor had back-to-back games with 500+ offensive yards was in 2021 (vs. West Virginia, 525; vs. BYU, 534)
- 343 rushing yards is Baylor's most in any game since 419 vs. Texas Southern (9/11/21).
 - It's the most in a Big 12 game since 398 at Texas (10/29/16) under Jim Grobe.
- Last time Baylor had 300 rushing yards was at Kansas (9/18/21, 307).
- Baylor put the first touchdown on the board on a 99-yard drive. The last time BU had a 99-yard scoring drive was versus Kansas in 2022 (10/22/22).
- The Bears put up a season-high of seven long plays (25-plus yards); Pendergrass' 55 yard carry ranked at No. 1, Presley's 53 yard reception at No. 2, Pendergrass' 48 yard carry at No. 3, Robertson's 41-yard carry at No. 8.
- Junior QB Sawyer Robertson went 11-19-1 and 222 passing yards and three passing touchdowns. Ran on eight carries for 73 yards, including a 41-yard rushing touchdown.
 - Marked four consecutive games that Robertson has thrown for at least three passing touchdowns.
 - First Baylor quartback to pass for three touchdowns and rush for a 40 + yard touchdown in a Big 12 game since Robert Griffin III's Heisman-winning season, when Griffin threw for three TDs and ran for 103 yards and a score against Kansas (11/12/11).
- Sophomore RB Dawson Pendergrass had a career night with six carries for 142 yards and a touchdown, averaging 23.7 yards per carry.
- Broke his career long rush twice in the game, first in the 10 on a 48 yard carry. Followed with a 40 55-yard rushing TD.
- Broke career-highs in yards, longest rush.
- Recorded second 100-yard game in career, last being vs. Long Island (9/16/23, 111).
- Senior WR Hal Presley hauled in 65 yards on two receptions and a touchdown.
 - Recorded a 53-yard reception in 10 for longest career reception.
 - Marked the longest play of the season.
- Senior WR Ashtyn Hawkins went four-for-four with 74 yards and a touchdown.
- Scored on a 33-yard reception for his third TD of the season.
- Redshirt freshman RB Bryson Washington went for a career high of 17 carries on 78 yards.
- Sophomore TE Matthew Klopfenstein found the endzone for his first touchdown of his career on a one-yard reception.
- Freshman QB Nate Bennett made his second career appearance.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Baylor defense held OSU to 74 rushing yards, the second time this season Baylor has held an opponent to under 100 yards rushing.
- With a fumble recovery and an interception, Baylor extended its streak of four games forcing at least one turnover.
- Senior LB Matt Jones led the defense with 12 total tackles, 10 being solo a career high, 3.0 TFL, a sack for a loss of 13 yards, and a forced fumble.
- Now tied for 7th in all time tackles for loss (34.0). Tied with Mike Singletary (1977-80).
- Fifth time this season this season, ninth time in career, with double-digit tackle games.
- Last time BU had a defender with five double-digit tackle games in a season was Clay Johnston in 2018.
- Fourth forced fumble of career, first since 2021.
- \bullet Junior S Devyn Bobby second on the team with six total tackles, four being solo.
- Senior DL Treven Ma'ae brought down a sack for a loss of six yards, his fifth sack of his career.
 Ended with two tackles.
- Senior OLB Garmon Randolph brought down a sack for a loss of 16 yards, his 3.5 sack of the season.
- Finished with two tackles.

SPECIAL TEAM NOTES

- Redshirt junior WR Josh Cameron returned a punt for 21 yards.
- Sophomore K Isaiah Hankins went 1-1 on FGs, nailing a 30-yarder, and now has a career line of 41-58 in FGs.
- Sophomore P Palmer Williams punted three times for 140 yards, averaging 46.7 yards per punt, with a long punt of 57 and one inside the 20 and one 50+.
