TEAM NOTES

- This marks the 120th meet up between the two, the most-played rivalry game in the state of Texas.
- TCU leads the all-time series, 59-54-7; Baylor leads with a 35-34-5 record in Waco.
- Baylor's win tonight snapped TCU's previous five-game win streak over Baylor.
- It was Baylor's first win in Waco over TCU since 2014.
- Baylor head coach Dave Aranda is 28-29 in his fifth year with Baylor.
 - Baylor is 18-24 in conference games in the Aranda era.
- Baylor is 17-12 at home in the Aranda era.
- Baylor is 635-606-44 all-time.
- Baylor captains: Josh Cameron, Caden Jenkins, Jackie Marshall, Sawyer Robertson

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- The Bears finished with 499 total offensive yards, 242 passing and 257 rushing.
- Baylor's last minute field goal-winning drive marks the first time-expiring FG win for BU since John Mayers' 30 yarder against K-State 32-31 (11/28/20).
- Baylor responded for the first time this season with a touchdown on the following drive after the opposing team scores first.
- Redshirt freshman RB Bryson Washington had a career-night with 196 yards on 26 attempts and four rushing TDs.
- Washington's four rushing TD's is most since Terrance Ganaway vs. Washington, 2011, who had five.
- Washington is first player to rush for four TD's in a Big 12 game this season; happened four times in 2023.
- Marks the 10th time this has happened by an FBS player this season.
- Washington also had two receptions for 22 yards.
- Junior QB Sawyer Robertson went19-34-0 for 242 yards.
- Sophomore RB Dawson Pendergrass acheived his third TD of the season on a one-yard rush up the middle.
- Pendergrass finished with 33 yards on eight attempts.
- Senior WR Monaray Baldwin hauled in a season-long reception of 40 yards on his lone target of the night.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Baylor defense held TCU to go 4-12 on third downs.
- Redshirt sophomore LB Keaton Thomas led the defense and earned his second double-digit tackle game of the season with 11 tackles, seven being solo.
 Seven solo tackles ties Thomas' career-high.
- Senior LB Matt Jones ended with seven tackles, four being solo, one PBU and one QBH.
- Junior safety **Devyn Bobby** ended with seven tackles, five being solo.
- Marks the most tackles for Bobby since Air Force game (9/14/24).
- Junior DL Cooper Lanz brought down his first sack and TFL of the season, second of sack of career, for a loss of eight yards.
 Lanz finished with two tackles, the lone sack of the night and a QBH.
- Senior DL Elinus Noel III tied his season-high tackles with three, two being solo, including a TFL of two yards, a QBH and a forced fumble.
- Redshirt junior DL Jackie Marshall brought down his 4.5 TFL of the season for a loss of one yard, his first TFL since at Utah (9/7/24).

SPECIAL TEAM NOTES

- Sophomore K Isaiah Hankins went 1-1 on FGs, nailing a 33-yarder as the time expired to get Baylor the win.
- Became the first kicker since John Mayers' 30 yarder against K-State 32-31 (11/28/20) to earn a time-expring FG win.
- Sophomore P Palmer Williams punted four times for 192 yards, averaging 48 yards per punt, with a long punt of 62 and two inside the 20 and two 50+.
 - Palmer now tied 10th with Kyle Atteberry (1997) with 18 50+ yard punts in a season.
 - Has five 60+ yard punts this season, two of them being 70+.
- Redshirt junior WR Josh Cameron the nation's leading punt returner returned two punts for 12 yards, a long return of 14 yards.
