STORY LINES

- No.13/15 Baylor takes on No. 22/21 St. John's in the opening round of Continental Tire Baha Mar Hoops Bahamas Championship in Nassau, Bahamas.
- Thursday's matchup will be Baylor's third against a ranked opponent this season (1-1)
- Baylor is 14-3 against the Big East during the **Scott Drew** era
- BU is 33-17 against ranked teams over the last four seasons, including a 16-13 mark away from home
- The Bears are one of five programs to be ranked inside the top-10 in each of the last six seasons
- This meeting will be the second between **Drew** and Rick Pitino, with Drew and the Bears beating Pitino's Louisville Cardinals in the 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis Championship game 66-63
- Two of the winningest families in College basketball history, The **Drew's** (Scott, Bryce and Homer) have combined for 1,367 wins as a family, which trails only the Iba family for most wins by a father-son combination (1,632). Rick and Richard Pitino rank fifth with 958 career wins between the two of them
- The Drew's and Pitino's are the only coaching families among the top-8 that are still active
- Baylor is 42-13 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including titles in 4 of the last 5 tournaments
- The Bears have won seven regular-season tournament titles under Drew — 2023 NIT Season Tip-Off, 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational, 2017 Hall of Fame Classic, 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2011 Las Vegas Classic and 2007 Paradise Jam.
- BU is 29-5 in its eight regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, going 3-1, 3-1, 3-1, 4-0, 4-0, 3-1, 3-0, 3-0, 1-1 and 2-0
- The Bears are coming off back-to-back 100-point performances, marking the first time since 1989 they have hit the century mark in consecutive games
- Against Tarleton, Baylor allowed just 13 first-half points, the second fewest allowed by the Bears in the Big 12 era
- The 63-point margin of victory marks just the second 60+ point win over a D1 team (and fourth overall) for BU since 1980
- Sunday was the fourth time in the last ten seasons Baylor allowed 41 points or fewer
- A balanced scoring attack, all seven of the Bears in the starting rotation are averaging 8.8 points per game or better.
- Against Sam Houston, the Bears had seven players score in double figures, the first time since 2013 BU has accomplished that feat
- Baylor has not trailed since the end of the Gonzaga game, leading for a total of 116:54 of game time, while being tied for just 3:05 during that stretch.
- The last time Baylor didn't trail in three-straight games was Dec. 20, 2021-Jan. 1, 2022 (Alcorn State, Northwestern State & Iowa State)
- Baylor's 30 assists against SHSU were its most since it had 30 against McNeese Nov. 23, 2022
- **Norchad Omier** and **VJ Edgecombe** both recorded double-doubles against the Bearkats, the second time in a six-game stretch BU had multiple players notch a double-double in the same game
- With two double-doubles in his first three games this year, **Omier** is the first player since **Lawrence Roberts** in 2001 with two in the first three games of a Baylor career

QUICK HITS

- Baylor is the only team in the country to be a top-3 seed in each of the last four NCAA Tournaments
- BU joins Gonzaga, Kansas and Houston as one of four teams to win a game in each of the last five NCAA Tournaments.
- The Bears are the only team in the Big 12 with 11+ conference wins in a Power-5 conference in five-straight seasons.
- The Bears have now been ranked in the top-10 for a sixth-straight year, one of just five programs (Duke, Gonzaga, Kentucky and Kansas) to accomplish that feat.
- Selected 19th overall by the New Orleans Pelicans in June's NBA Draft, **Ja'Kobe Walter** gave BU four-straight top-19 picks for the first time in program history, the only school in the country to claim that distinction (**Keyonte George** 16th overall to Utah, **Jeremy Sochan** 9th overall to San Antonio in 2022 **Davion Mitchell** 9th overall to Sacramento in 2021).
- The Bears have had 13 picks in the last 12 drafts, which is the most in the state of Texas and second-most in the Big 12 since 2012
- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 12-consecutive postseason appearances, the nations fifth-longest active streak
- The Bears have gone to 10 NCAA Tournaments and two National Invitation Tournaments since 2012.
- BU is 71-8 in home games over the last six seasons.
- Baylor will play its first full season in the brand-new state of the art Foster Pavilion
- Baylor has reached the 25-win milestone in three of the last five seasons and in 7 of the last 15 years. Prior to that, BU reached 25 wins just once in the program's first 103 years (25-5 in 1945-46).
- Baylor is 32-17 against ranked teams over the last four seasons, including a 16-8 mark away from home.
- Baylor's 65-25 Big 12 record over the last five seasons is the second best record of any Power-5 team in that span.
- Head coach **Scott Drew** is in his 22nd season at Baylor with a school-record 447 career victories.
- **Drew** is tied for the eighth longest-tenured head coach in Division I men's college basketball.
- **Drew** is a part of the second-winningest college basketball family. Entering the 2024-25 season, Scott, his brother Bryce (GCU) and their Dad Homer combined for 1,367 wins, 256 wins behind the Iba Family for most wins among father/son combinations in division I college basketball.
- Baylor is playing its 723rd game of the 22-year Drew era – more than half (387) have been as a ranked team.
- Over the last six seasons, Baylor is 101-11 when leading at the half and 125-18 when taking a 2nd-half lead.
- The Bears have been ranked in the AP Poll for 33-straight weeks, the fourth-longest active streak in the Big 12 Conference. BU spent a school-record 54-straight weeks ranked in the top-10 of the AP Poll, from Dec. 16, 2019-Dec 5, 2022.
- BU set a school-record streak of 65-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 from Nov. 5, 2019 to Jan 9, 2023 (1,161 Days). In total, the Bears have been ranked in the AP Poll for 98 of the last 99 weeks
- Baylor has been ranked in all 25 spots in the AP Top 25 at some point in the last 8 years.
- Baylor has been No. 1 ranked in 4 of the last 9 seasons (Gonzaga, Duke and Kansas are only others).
- Baylor and Kansas are the only Power-5 schools to win 18+ games every year since 2008.
- BU has built double-digit leads in 119 of 156 games over the last five seasons (111-6).
- Baylor has won 90% of its games when leading at the half since 2011-12 (250-28).
- Entering 2024-25, Baylor is averaging 24.5 wins per season since 2011-12.
- Baylor's 322 wins since 2011-12 are second-most in the Big 12 behind only Kansas (358).
- Baylor is 413-176 since 2007-08, the first year Drew's staff had a full allotment of scholarships.
- Thirteen of Baylor's 14 starting point guards under Drew have earned All-Big recognition (17 of last 18 seasons).
- Baylor is 131-36 over the last six seasons, the nation's 2nd best winning percentage among Power-5 teams in that span (.781%)

ONE OF THE GREATEST REBUILDS IN NCAA HISTORY

- **Scott Drew** became Baylor's head coach in 2003, starting of one of the greatest rebuilds in NCAA history.
- Drew is one of eight active men's Division I coaches with at least 400 wins at their current school.
- Drew is one of 2 active coaches to have won an NCAA Title and an NIT Title. He is the only active coach to have won both at the same school (John Calipari NCAA: Kentucky, NIT: Memphis).
- Drew was named 2020 NBC Sports National Coach of the Year and 2017 Basketball Times National COY.
- Drew is now in his 22nd season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (447).
- Baylor has a .701 winning percentage (413-176) since Drew's first year with no scholarship restrictions in 2007-08 and a .714 winning percentage (322-129) over the last 12 seasons since 2011-12.
- Drew (53) is the second-youngest active collegiate head coach to win a National Championship.
- In Drew's first 21 seasons at Baylor, 58 players have gone on to professional careers.
- Was announced as a member of the Texas Sports Hall of Fame Class of 2023.
- He is the 23rd BU player or coach to be inducted into the Texas Sports Hall of Fame

NATION'S-BEST 32-16 VS. RANKED TEAMS OVER LAST FIVE SEASONS

- Baylor is 33-17 against AP Top-25 ranked teams since 2019-2020, the second-best mark in the nation.
- BU is 16-4 at home vs. ranked teams in the last five seasons – wins vs. #12 Arizona (Dec. 2019), #18 Butler (Dec. 2019), #14 West Virginia (Feb. 2020), #9 Kansas (Jan. 2021), #17 Oklahoma State (March 2021), #18 Texas Tech (March 2021), #6 Villanova (Dec. 2021), #20 Texas (Feb. 2022), #5 Kansas (Feb. 2022), #9 Kansas (Feb. 2023), #8 Texas (Feb. 2023), #18 BYU (Jan. 2024), #12 Iowa State (Feb. 2024), #23 Texas Tech, #25 Oklahoma, and No. 7 Kansas (March 2024), and losses by 3 points to #3 Kansas (Feb. 2020) and #19 Texas Tech (Jan. 2022).
- The record includes 16-13 away from home, with neutral wins vs. #17 Villanova (Nov. 2019), vs. #5 Illinois (Nov. 2020), vs. #18 Villanova (March 2021), vs. #10 Arkansas (March 2021), vs. #6 Houston (April 2021), #1 Gonzaga (April 2021), #8 UCLA and #14 Gonzaga, with road wins at #22 Texas Tech (Jan. 2020), at #4 Kansas (Jan. 2020), at #15 Texas Tech (Jan. 2021), at #6 Texas (Feb. 2021), at #6 West Virginia (March 2021), at #8 Iowa State (January 2022), at #21 Texas (Feb. 2022), at #17 TCU (Feb. 2023) and vs. Arkansas (Nov. 2024)

DREW AND PITINO BATTLE IT OUT ON THE ISLAND AGAIN

- Thursday will mark the second time the Bears have played St. John's as part of a mid-season MTE as the Bears notched a 97-78 win over the Red Storm as a part of the Charleston Classic in November of 2012
- The only other meeting between the two schools was an 83-82 St. John's win in Queens on Dec. 7, 1978
- **Scott Drew** and Rick Pitino will match wits in the Bahamas for a second time as Drew's Bears beat Pitino's Louisville Cardinals 66-63 in the championship game of the 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis
- The Bears fell down 32-10 in the first half, but stormed back to get the win and take it's first of two Battle 4 Atlantis titles.

UP NEXT

- The Bears will play either Virginia or No. 11 Tennessee in the second game
- A game against Virginia would be just the third between the two teams since 1968, but the second in the last three years as the Cavaliers beat Baylor 86-79 in the first round of the Continental Tire Main Event in Las Vegas in 2022
- BU has never played Tennessee, but UT head coach Rick Barnes spent 17 years at Texas compiling a 30-9 record against BU.

MILESTONE WATCH

- With 454 points, **Langston Love** is just 46 away from 500 for his career
- **Jayden Nunn** eclipsed the 1,000-point mark for his career against Sam Houston (1,010) and 14 assists away from 200
- **Norchad Omier** is 145 rebounds away from 1,500 for his career
- **Omier** has 1,876 points, 124 from 2,000 for his career
- **Jeremy Roach** has 420 career assists, 80 away from 500 for his career
- **Roach** eclipsed the 1,500-point mark with 12 points against Sam Houston (1,517)
- **Jalen Celestine** is 1 made three-pointer away from 100 for his career
- **Davidson Hubbard** has played in 95 career games and is 10 made three-pointers away from 100 for his career

NOTABLE STREAKS

- BU is 99-1 in its last 100 games when shooting a higher percentage than its opponent (only loss Feb. 20, 2024 at BYU)
- Baylor has won 61-straight games when shooting 50% or higher (last loss March 18, 2018 vs. Mississippi State).
- BU has appeared in 33-straight AP Polls, the 8th-longest active streak in the nation, the fourth-longest in the Big 12 and the second-longest in program history.

GETTING IT DONE ON BOTH ENDS AGAINST TARLETON

- Baylor's 63-point win was its largest since a 64-point victory over Mississippi Valley in the season opener of the 2022-23 season (11/7/22), and just it's fourth 60+ point margin of victory since 1980.
- BU scored 100 points in back-to-back games for the first time since 1989 when The Bears scored 100 against Texas State and then Mercer in back-to-back games
- Tarleton's 13 first-half points were the second-fewest first-half points allowed by Baylor in the Big 12 era. Arkansas Pine Bluff scored 12 against the Bears on 12/21/2020
- **VJ Edgecombe** established a career high in points for the fourth-straight game with 17 points
- **Jalen Celestine** scored 20 points on 6-of-9 shooting, one off his career-high of 21 points

A FUN ONE FOR THE HOME FANS

- Baylor eclipsed the 100-point mark for the 31st time in the Drew Era with a 104-67 win over Sam Houston
- BU had seven players score in double figures for the first time since 2013 against Long Beach State
- Baylor's 30 assists were its most since it had 30 against McNeese Nov. 23, 2022
- The Bears shot .586 from the field, it's best clip since shooting .672 against Mississippi Valley State in the final game at the Ferrell Center (12/22/23)
- Norchad Omier and VJ Edgecombe recorded double-doubles, the second Baylor duo in the last six games to accomplish that feat

BACK ON TRACK

- Baylor picked up its first win of the season with a 72-67 win over the Arkansas Razorbacks in the 4PT Dallas Duel, never trailing in the game
- Saturday was the first time since Jan. 1, 2022 (No. 8 Iowa State) Baylor never trailed in a game against a ranked opponent
- **Norchad Omier** scored 15 points and pulled down 12 rebounds, for his career-first double-double at Baylor and the 69th of his career
- **VJ Edgecombe** established a new career high in points (11), rebounds (8) and assists (5)

A TOUGH NIGHT IN THE PNW

- BU dropped its season opener against No. 6 Gonzaga 101-63, the largest loss for BU since a 91-51 setback against Oklahoma in 2007.
- The loss marked just the fourth time in the Drew Era the Bears have allowed 100 point in regulation, and the 38-point loss was Baylor's worst since a 91-51 setback against Oklahoma in January of 2007
- **Norchad Omier** led the way for BU scoring 15 points and grabbing nine rebounds, the first Baylor player with at least 15 pts and 9 rebs. in their debut since MaCio Teague has 18 pts and 10 rebs against UCA in 2019 season
- With his 12 pts and 6 assist on Monday, **Robert Wright** became the first freshman in the **Drew** era with 10+ points and 6+ assists in their debut, and the first Baylor player since **Manu Lecomte** in 2016 with those numbers in a Baylor debut.

TWELVE CONSECUTIVE POSTSEASON BERTHS

- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 12-consecutive postseason berths and has appeared in 15 of the last 16 postseasons. BU made seven postseason appearances in the program's 97 seasons prior to the **Scott Drew** era.
- Baylor is 1 of 7 teams to appear in every postseason since 2012, joining Gonzaga, Kansas, Michigan State, Oregon, Saint Mary's and Virginia.
- BU earned NCAA bids in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 and NIT bids in 2013 and 2018.
- Baylor has appeared in 14 of 15 postseasons since 2008. Prior to that, Baylor's only postseason berths were in 1946 (NCAA), 1948 (NCAA), 1950 (NCAA), 1987 (NIT), 1988 (NCAA), 1990 (NIT) and 2001 (NIT).

FOUR-STRAIGHT TOP-THREE SEEDS

- Baylor earned its third-straight top-three seed for a fourth-straight NCAA Tournament becoming the only team to accomplish that.
- 2024 marks the fifth time BU has earned a No. 3 seed after also doing it in 2010, 2012, 2015, 2017 and 2023.
- Baylor has earned a top-3 seed in 8 of the last 14 NCAA Tournaments.
- BU is 17-7 in NCAAT games as the higher seed, but 2021 was the first time as a higher seed after the Sweet 16.
- BU is 3-5 in NCAAT games as the lower/same seed, though four of those five losses were to top-2 seeds.

A TOP-25 STAPLE

- BU has now been ranked in 96 of the last 97 AP Polls.
- Ranked in the AP Top-25 for 31-straight weeks, Baylor has the eighth-longest active streak in the country and the fourth-longest in the Big 12 Conference. (Houston 86, Kansas 65).
- Ranked No. 8 to start the, The Bears have now been ranked in the top-10 for a sixth-straight year, one of just four programs (Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas) to accomplish that feat.
- BU spent a school-record 54 weeks in the AP Top-10 from Dec. 16, 2019-Dec. 5, 2022.
- Baylor set a school-record streak of 65-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 (previous record was 25). The streak lasted from Nov. 5, 2019 to Jan 9, 2023 (1,161 Days).

THE BIG 12'S MOST WINS IN CONFERENCE CHALLENGES

- Baylor is 14-4 in conference challenges – 8-2 in Big 12/SEC Challenge, 3-1 in Big 12/Pac-12, 3-1 in Big 12/Big East.
- Baylor's 14-4 record in conference challenges (Big 12-Big East, Big 12/SEC, Big 12/Pac-12) is best in the Big 12, followed by Kansas at 12-7, OSU at 11-8, Iowa State at 10-8, Texas Tech at 10-9, OU at 10-9, Texas at 8-9, TCU at 7-7, K-State at 7-11 and WVU at 5-10.

SUCCESS IN TOURNAMENTS

- Baylor is 42-13 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including titles in 4 of the last 5 tournaments.
- BU is 29-5 in its eight regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, going 3-1, 3-1, 3-1, 4-0, 4-0, 3-1, 3-0, 3-0, 1-1 and 2-0.
- BU advanced to championship games in the 2007 Paradise Jam (won), 2008 76 Classic (lost), 2011 Las Vegas Classic (won), 2013 Maui Invitational (lost), 2014 Las Vegas Invitational (lost), 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis (won), 2017 Hall of Fame Classic (won), 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational (won), 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis (won) and the 2023 Preseason NIT (won)
- Baylor has won seven regular-season tournament titles under Drew – 2023 NIT Season Tip-Off, 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational, 2017 Hall of Fame Classic, 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2011 Las Vegas Classic and 2007 Paradise Jam.

SCOTT DREW COACHING TREE

- Four current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew's BU staff.
- **Jerome Tang** is in his third year as head coach at Kansas State. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 19 years with Drew.
- **Grant McCasland** is in his second season as head coach at Texas Tech. He spent five years as a Baylor assistant before taking over as Arkansas State head coach for one season in 2016-17.
- **Matthew Driscoll** is in his 16th season as head coach at North Florida after six seasons as a Baylor assistant.
- **Paul Mills** is in his second season as head coach at Wichita State. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 14 years with Drew, the final eight as an assistant coach.
- **John Jakus** is set to begin his first season at Florida Atlantic after seven seasons on the Baylor bench as an assistant, also serving as a graduate assistant for **Drew** from 2012-14.
- All four former assistants have led their teams to NCAA Tournaments – Driscoll led UNF to the 2015 NCAA Tournament, while McCasland took UNT to the 2021 Second Round and Mills took ORU to the 2021 Sweet 16.
- Additionally, McCasland led North Texas to the NIT Championship in 2023, prior to leaving for Texas Tech.
- Drew is 1-4 all time when facing a former assistant as a head coach.

PROTECTING HALFTIME LEADS

- Baylor is 132-15 when leading at halftime since the start of 2017-18.

- Houston (318-124) is fourth, Cincinnati (307-134) is fifth, BYU (303-142) is sixth, Colorado (278-169) is seventh, Iowa State (269-170) is eighth, West Virginia (255-185) is ninth, Kansas State (253-184) is 10th, Texas Tech (247-185) is 11th, Utah (236-190) is 12th, Oklahoma St. (232-196) is 13th, TCU (231-205) is 14th, UCF (230-179) is 15th and Arizona State (230-194).
- Baylor has averaged 24.5 wins per season over the last 13 seasons since 2011-12.

NON-CONFERENCE HIGHLIGHTS

- Baylor is 14-3 against the Big East during the Drew era.
- The Bears are 21-11 against the SEC during the Drew era, including 16-7 since 2012-13.

- In Scott Drew's 21 years at Baylor, 58 of his players have gone on to professional careers.
- Ten Bears are currently on NBA rosters (Including two-way contracts)— Jalen Bridges (Suns), Jared Butler (Wizards), Adam Flagler (Thunder), Keyonte George (Jazz), Yves Missi (Pelicans), Davion Mitchell (Raptors), Royce O'Neale (Suns), Taurean Prince (Bucks), Jeremy Sochan (Spurs) and Ja'Kobe Walter (Raptors).
- In addition to the ten current NBA players, ten more of Drew's former players have played in the NBA (most recent team) — Quincy Acy (Raptors), Kendall Brown (Pacers), Freddie Gillespie (Raptors), Pierre Jackson (Mavs), Cory Jefferson (Suns), Perry Jones III (Thunder), Quincy Miller (Kings), Johnathan Motley (Clippers), Ekpe Udoh (Jazz) and Ish Wainwright (Portland)
- Sochan (2023 & 24) and George (2024) have each participated in the Rising Stars Challenge in each of the last two seasons, Baylor's first two All-Star Weekend participants.

BAYLOR BASKETBALL ON THE RADIO

- Baylor basketball is aired live via the Baylor Sports Media Network from Playfly on ESPN Central Texas and Flagship station 1660AM/92.3 FM ESPN Radio (KRZI) in Waco and worldwide on Sirius/XM Radio.
- Games are broadcast by the "Voice of the Bears" **John Morris**, who was named NSMA 2019 Texas co-Sportscaster of the Year on Jan. 13, 2020, and Baylor Hall of Famer **Pat Nunley**.
- In early November, **Morris** was awarded the 2024 Chris Schenkel Award by the National Football Foundation
- First presented in 1996, the award recognizes individuals who have had long, distinguished careers broadcasting college football with direct ties to a specific university or platform
- Morris is in his 41st year doing BU broadcasts (30th full-time), and Nunley is in his 44th season as analyst.
- A year after his Baylor Hall of Fame induction, **Nunley** was honored by the Baylor Chamber of Commerce with the Frank Fallon Award prior to the season.
- The award, named for Nunley's longtime broadcast partner, Frank Fallon, is presented annually to someone who has made a significant impact on basketball in McLennan County.
- At 30 years together, Morris and Nunley rank in the top-5 of the longest radio duo's in men's college basketball
- All of Baylor's games can be heard live on the Internet at <https://www.centextsportsfan.com>.

OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING A BAYLOR STAPLE

- Baylor ranks 18th in the nation in offensive rebounding percentage (40.4%)
- BU has ranked top-13 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage in nine of the last 11 seasons since 2013-14, including six times ranked in the nation's top-5. The Bears only cracked the top-20 once in Drew's first 10 years.
- Baylor finished ranked No. 24 nationally in 2023-24, No. 22 nationally in 2022-23, No. 13 nationally in 2021-22, No. 5 nationally in 2020-21, No. 8 in 2019-20, No. 2 in 2018-19, No. 9 in 2017-18, No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16, No. 1 in 2014-15 and No. 3 in 2013-14. Prior to that streak, BU's best rank was No. 16 in 2011-12.

BREAKTHROUGH IN BIG 12

- BU is 171-111 in Big 12 play in 14 seasons since 2010 after going 59-149 in the league's first 13 seasons.
- BU is 188-131 in Big 12 play in 16 seasons since 2008 after going 45-131 in the league's first 11 seasons.
- Baylor is 64-52 in Big 12 road games since 2012, second-best in the league behind only Kansas (70-46).
- BU has won 8+ Big 12 games in 13-straight seasons after winning 8+ just 3 times in the league's first 15 years.
- BU has double-digit Big 12 wins in six-straight seasons, 8 of the last 9 years and 10 of the last 14 seasons. BU didn't reach double-digit Big 12 wins in any of its first 13 years in the league before reaching 10+ for the first time in 2010.

DREW IS THIRD BIG 12 COACH TO REACH 150 CONFERENCE WINS

- **Scott Drew** joined Rick Barnes and Bill Self as the only coaches to reach 150 Big 12 wins on March 4, 2021 vs. OSU.
- Drew needed 136 games over 2,940 days for his first 50 Big 12 wins (50-86), 88 games over 1,821 days for his next 50 Big 12 wins (50-38) and only 77 games over 1,493 days for his next 50 Big 12 wins (50-27).

IMPRESSIVE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS AT HOME

- Baylor is 90-4 in its last 93 non-conference home games dating back to Dec. 12, 2012.
- Baylor is 154-16 in non-conference home games in the **Drew era**, including 124-8 since 2007-08.
- Baylor is 71-8 in home games against unranked opponents (including Big 12 play) since 2016.

GRADUATING 91 PERCENT OF SENIORS

- Since **Scott Drew** took over the Baylor Basketball program in 2003, 40 of 44 scholarship players who have played their final years of collegiate eligibility under Drew have graduated from Baylor.

BEST IN TEXAS

- Baylor is 86-25 against in-state opponents since the start of the 2011-12 season, and the Bears have advanced deeper into postseason play than any of Texas' 23 Division I teams in five of the last ten seasons.
- BU is a combined 100-29 against Lone Star State teams over the last 16 seasons after going 10-27 against in-state teams in Scott Drew's first six seasons at Baylor (2-0 in 2024-25, 3-3 in 2023-24, 5-2 in 2022-23, 5-2 in 2021-22, 6-0 in 2020-21, 6-1 in 2019-20, 4-5 in 2018-19, 6-3 in 2017-18, 7-1 in 2016-17, 9-3 in 2015-16, 10-1 in 2014-15, 6-3 in 2013-14, 7-1 in 2012-13, 10-0 in 2011-12, 5-3 in 2010-11 and 9-1 in 2009-10).
- Additionally, 13 of the 36 NBA Draft picks from Texas colleges since 2012 have come from Baylor. Texas (seven), Houston (five), SMU (three), Texas Tech (three), Texas A&M (two), North Texas (one), TCU (one) and UT Arlington (one) have also had players selected in the last 13 NBA Drafts.

FEELING FINE AT FOSTER

- Baylor and the City of Waco have partnered on a \$700 million riverfront development project, headlined by the \$212 million Foster Pavilion, the home of Baylor's national champion basketball programs.
- The Allison Development Centers for both basketball programs are included in the 245k square foot Foster Pavilion project were completed in the summer of 2024.
- Foster Pavilion (capacity 7,500) is located along the Brazos River on the opposite side of I-35 from McLane Stadium.
- BU MBB beat Cornell 98-79 in the first game at Foster Pavilion, while the BU women's team beat TCU 71-50 the following night in their first game in the new building.

BIG 12 BOASTS SOME OF THE BEST

- The new-look Big 12 is first conference to have 5 of the top 10 teams in the preseason AP Poll. In total, six Big 12 teams were ranked in the preseason top 25, which is the most in conference history.
- The league has led the way with four-straight years leading all conferences in average Net Rating
- The Big 12 has also led the nation in Conference RPI in each of the last four seasons and 9 of the last 11 seasons
- The conference had a Big 12 record eight teams make the NCAA Tournament last season
- The Big 12 is 47-8 through two weeks, with seven of the eight losses coming away-from-home.
- The conference remains tied with the Big Ten and SEC for the national lead with three AP Top 25 wins.

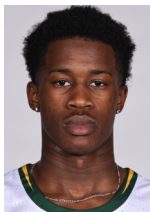

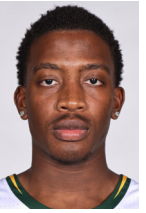
