STORY LINES

- No.13/14 Baylor takes on No. 11/9 Tennessee in the Continental Tire Baha Mar Championship Game on CBS Sports Network
- Thursday's matchup will be Baylor's fourth against a ranked opponent in six games this season (2-1)
- The Bears are the first team to have multiple ranked wins this season
- BU is 34-17 against ranked teams over the last six seasons, including a 17-13 mark away from home
- Baylor is 43-13 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including titles in 4 of the last 5 tournaments
- The Bears have won seven regular-season tournament titles under Drew 2023 NIT Season Tip-Off, 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational, 2017 Hall of Fame Classic, 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2011 Las Vegas Classic and 2007 Paradise Jam.
- BU is 30-5 in its eight regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, going 3-1, 3-1, 3-1, 4-0, 4-0, 3-1, 3-0, 3-0, 1-1, 2-0 and 1-0
- While Tennessee and Baylor have never met, the Bears are no stranger to Rick Barnes facing him 39 times from 1999-2015 when he was the head coach at Texas
- After Barnes and Texas won the first 24 meetings, Scott Drew and the Bears won nine of the next 15 meetings
 Barnes and Drew are two of the three winningest coaches in Big 12 history, and join Bill Self as one
- Barnes and Drew are two of the three winningest coaches in Big 12 history, and join Bill Self as one of three coaches with 150+ Big 12 wins
- Drew boasts a 21-11 against SEC foes, including a 16-7 mark since 2012-13
- Baylor is coming off a thrilling double-overtime win over No. 22 St. John's, thanks to **Jeremy Roach's** buzzer-beating three-pointer, BU's first buzzer-beater since **Lester Medford** hit a triple at the buzzer to beat Texas Tech in 2016
- Norchad Omier had a game-high in points (24) and rebounds (10) giving him 71 double-doubles for his career, building on his lead as the NCAA's active career-leader in that stat
- **Omier** is the first bear since **Ekpe Udoh** in 2009 to have three double-doubles in his first five games in a Baylor uniform
- BU's 14-point halftime deficit was its largest in a comeback win since it trailed by 15 at the break against Rick Pitino and the Louisville Cardinals in the Battle '4' Atlantis Championship in 2016.
- The Bears have scored 307 points in the last three games combined, the most points in a three-game stretch since December of 2017 (322)
- A balanced scoring attack, the Bears have six players in double figures, and welcomed back a key piece in **Langston Love**, getting his first game action since March in a double-overtime win vs. St. John's
- Through the early part of this season, BU has the toughest strength of schedule among power-five conference teams
- Ranked as the 24th-toughest schedule by Ken Pom, the next hardest schedule by a power-conference team is Alabama at No. 72.
- Against Tarleton, Baylor allowed just 13 first-half points, the second fewest allowed by the Bears in the Big 12 era
- The 63-point margin of victory over the Texans marked just the second 60+ point win over a D1 team (and fourth overall) for BU since 1980

QUICK HITS

- Baylor is the only team in the country to be a top-3 seed in each of the last four NCAA Tournaments
- BU joins Gonzaga, Kansas and Houston as one of four teams to win a game in each of the last five NCAA Tournaments.
 - The Bears are the only team in the Big 12 with 11 + conference wins in a Power-5 conference in five-straight seasons.
 - The Bears have now been ranked in the top-10 for a sixth-straight year, one of just five programs (Duke, Gonzaga, Kentucky and Kansas) to accomplish that feat.
 - Selected 19th overall by the New Orleans Pelicans in June's NBA Draft, Ja'Kobe Walter gave BU four-straight top-19 picks for the first time in program history, the only school in the country to claim that distinction (Keyonte George 16th overall to Utah, Jeremy Sochan 9th overall to San Antonio in 2022 Davion Mitchell 9th overall to Sacramento in 2021).
 - The Bears have had 13 picks in the last 12 drafts, which is the most in the state of Texas and second-most in the Big 12 since 2012
 - Baylor is on a school-record streak of 12-consecutive postseason appearances, the nations fifth-longest active streak
 - The Bears have gone to 10 NCAA Tournaments and two National Invitation Tournaments since 2012.
 - BU is 71-8 in home games over the last six seasons.
 - Baylor will play its first full season in the brand-new state of the art Foster Pavilion
 - Baylor has reached the 25-win milestone in three of the last five seasons and in 7 of the last 15 years. Prior to that, BU reached 25 wins just once in the program's first 103 years (25-5 in 1945-46).
 - Baylor is 34-17 against ranked teams over the last four seasons, including a 17-13 mark away from home.
 - Baylor's 65-25 Big 12 record over the last five seasons is the second best record of any Power-5 team in that span.
 - Head coach Scott Drew is in his 22nd season at Baylor with a school-record 448 career victories.
 - Drew is tied for the eighth longest-tenured head coach in Division I men's college basketball.
 - Drew is a part of the second-winningest college basketball family. Entering the 2024-25 season, Scott, his brother Bryce (GCU) and their Dad Homer combined for 1,368 wins, 255 wins behind the Iba Family for most wins among father/son combinations in division I college basketball.
 - Baylor is playing its 724th game of the 22-year Drew era more than half (388) have been as a ranked team.
 - Over the last six seasons, Baylor is 101-11 when leading at the half and 125-18 when taking a 2nd-half lead.
 - The Bears have been ranked in the AP Poll for 33-straight weeks, the fourth-longest active streak in the Big 12 Conference. BU spent a school-record 54-straight weeks ranked in the top-10 of the AP Poll, from Dec. 16, 2019-Dec 5, 2022.
 - BU set a school-record streak of 65-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 from Nov. 5, 2019 to Jan 9, 2023 (1,161 Days). In total, the Bears have been ranked in the AP Poll for 98 of the last 99 weeks
 - Baylor has been ranked in all 25 spots in the AP Top 25 at some point in the last 8 years.
 - Baylor has been No. 1 ranked in 4 of the last 9 seasons (Gonzaga, Duke and Kansas are only others).
 - Baylor and Kansas are the only Power-5 schools to win 18+ games every year since 2008.
 - BU has built double-digit leads in 119 of 157 games over the last five seasons (111-6).
 - Baylor has won 90% of its games when leading at the half since 2011-12 (250-28).
 - Entering 2024-25, Baylor is averaging 24.5 wins per season since 2011-12.
 - Baylor's 323 wins since 2011-12 are second-most in the Big 12 behind only Kansas (358).
 - Baylor is 414-176 since 2007-08, the first year Drew's staff had a full allotment of scholarships.
 - Thirteen of Baylor's 14 starting point guards under Drew have earned All-Big recognition (17 of last 18 seasons).
 - Baylor is 132-36 over the last six seasons, the nation's 2nd best winning percentage among Power-5 teams in that span (.786%)

ONE OF THE GREATEST REBUILDS IN NCAA HISTORY

- Scott Drew became Baylor's head coach in 2003, starting of one of the greatest rebuilds in NCAA history.
- Drew is one of eight active men's Division I coaches with at least 400 wins at their current school.
- Drew is one of 2 active coaches to have won an NCAA Title and an NIT Title. He is the only active coach to have won both at the same school (John Calipari NCAA: Kentucky, NIT: Memphis).
- Drew was named 2020 NBC Sports National Coach of the Year and 2017 Basketball Times National COY.
- Drew is now in his 22nd season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (448).

• Baylor has a .701 winning percentage (414-176) since Drew's first year with no scholarship restrictions in 2007-08 and a .714 winning percentage (323-129) over the last 12 seasons since 2011-12.

- Drew (53) is the second-youngest active collegiate head coach to win a National Championship.
- In Drew's first 21 seasons at Baylor, 58 players have gone on to professional careers.
- Was announced as a member of the Texas Sports Hall of Fame Class of 2023.
- He is the 23rd BU player or coach to be inducted into the Texas Sports Hall of Fame

NATION'S-BEST 32-16 VS. RANKED TEAMS OVER LAST FIVE SEASONS

- Baylor is 34-17 against AP Top-25 ranked teams since 2019-2020, the second-best mark in the nation.
- BU is 16-4 at home vs. ranked teams in the last five seasons wins vs. #12 Arizona (Dec. 2019), #18 Butler (Dec. 2019), #14 West Virginia (Feb. 2020), #9 Kansas (Jan. 2021), #17 Oklahoma State (March 2021), #18 Texas Tech (March 2021), #6 Villanova (Dec. 2021), #20 Texas (Feb. 2022), #5 Kansas (Feb. 2022), #9 Kansas (Feb. 2023), #8 Texas (Feb. 2023), #18 BYU (Jan. 2024), #12 Iowa State (Feb. 2024), #23 Texas Tech, #25 Oklahoma, and No. 7 Kansas (March 2024), and Iosses by 3 points to #3 Kansas (Feb. 2020) and #19 Texas Tech (Jan. 2022).

- BU has appeared in 33-straight AP Polls, the 8th-longest active streak in the nation, the fourth-longest in the Big 12 and the second-longest in program history.

A BATTLE AT BAHA MAR GOES TO THE BEARS

- Down five points with 8 seconds to play, BU won a double-overtime thriller against No. 22 St. John's
- A 14-point halftime deficit is the largest deficit overcome in a win since the Bears came back from down 15 at the half against Louisville in the 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis Championship
 - BU improves to 6-1 in double overtime games in the Drew Era
 - Jeremy Roach is the first Baylor player to hit a game-winning shot at the buzzer since Lester Medford beat Texas Tech at the gun on Jan. 16, 2016
 - Norchad Omier had a game-high in points (24) and rebounds (10) giving him 71 double-doubles for his career, building on his lead as the NCAA's active career-leader in that stat

GETTING IT DONE ON BOTH ENDS AGAINST TARLETON

- Baylor's 63-point win was its largest since a 64-point victory over Mississippi Valley in the season opener of the 2022-23 season (11/7/22), and just it's fourth 60+ point margin of victory since 1980.
- BU scored 100 points in back-to-back games for the first time since 1989 when The Bears scored 100 against Texas State and then Mercer in back-to-back games
- Tarleton's 13 first-half points were the second-fewest first-half points allowed by Baylor in the Big 12 era. Arkansas Pine Bluff scored 12 against the Bears on 12/21/2020
- VJ Edgecombe established a career high in points for the fourth-straight game with 17 points
- Jalen Celestine scored 20 points on 6-of-9 shooting, one off his career-high of 21 points

A FUN ONE FOR THE HOME FANS

- Baylor eclipsed the 100-point mark for the 31st time in the Drew Era with a 104-67 win over Sam Houston
- BU had seven players score in double figures for the first time since 2013 against Long Beach State
- Baylor's 30 assists were its most since it had 30 against McNeese Nov. 23, 2022
- The Bears shot .586 from the field, it's best clip since shooting .672 against Mississippi Valley State in the final game at the Ferrell Center (12/22/23)
- Norchad Omier and VJ Edgecombe recorded double-doubles, the second Baylor duo in the last six games to accomplish that feat

BACK ON TRACK

- Baylor picked up its first win of the season with a 72-67 win over the Arkansas Razorbacks in the 4PT Dallas Duel, never trailing in the game
- Saturday was the first time since Jan. 1, 2022 (No. 8 Iowa State) Baylor never trailed in a game against a ranked opponent
- Norchad Omier scored 15 points and pulled down 12 rebounds, for his career-first double-double at Baylor and the 69th of his career
- VJ Edgecombe established a new career high in points (11), rebounds (8) and assists (5)

A TOUGH NIGHT IN THE PNW

- BU dropped its season opener against No. 6 Gonzaga 101-63, the largest loss for BU since a 91-51 setback against Oklahoma in 2007.
- The loss marked just the fourth time in the Drew Era the Bears have allowed 100 point in regulation, and the 38-point loss was Baylor's worst since a 91-51 setback against Oklahoma in January of 2007
- Norchad Omier led the way for BU scoring 15 points and grabbing nine rebounds, the first Baylor player with at least 15 pts and 9 rebs. in their debut since MaCio Teague has 18 pts and 10 rebs against UCA in 2019 season
- With his 12 pts and 6 assist on Monday, **Robert Wright** became the first freshman in the **Drew** era with 10+ points and 6+ assists in their debut, and the first Baylor player since **Manu Lecomte** in 2016 with those numbers in a Baylor debut.

TWELVE CONSECUTIVE POSTSEASON BERTHS

- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 12-consecutive postseason berths and has appeared in 15 of the last 16
 postseasons. BU made seven postseason appearances in the program's 97 seasons prior to the Scott Drew era.
- Baylor is 1 of 7 teams to appear in every postseason since 2012, joining Gonzaga, Kansas, Michigan State, Oregon, Saint Mary's and Virginia.
- BU earned NCAA bids in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 and NIT bids in 2013 and 2018.
- Baylor has appeared in 14 of 15 postseasons since 2008. Prior to that, Baylor's only postseason berths were in 1946 (NCAA), 1948 (NCAA), 1950 (NCAA), 1987 (NIT), 1988 (NCAA), 1990 (NIT) and 2001 (NIT).

FOUR-STRAIGHT TOP-THREE SEEDS

- Baylor earned its third-straight top-three seed for a fourth-straight NCAA Tournament becoming the only team to accomplish that.
- 2024 marks the fifth time BU has earned a No. 3 seed after also doing it in 2010, 2012, 2015, 2017 and 2023.
- Baylor has earned a top-3 seed in 8 of the last 14 NCAA Tournaments.
- BU is 17-7 in NCAAT games as the higher seed, but 2021 was the first time as a higher seed after the Sweet 16.
- BU is 3-5 in NCAAT games as the lower/same seed, though four of those five losses were to top-2 seeds.

A TOP-25 STAPLE

- BU has now been ranked in 96 of the last 97 AP Polls.
- Ranked in the AP Top-25 for 31-straight weeks, Baylor has the eighth-longest active streak in the country and the fourth-longest in the Big 12 Conference. (Houston 86, Kansas 65).
- Ranked No. 8 to start the, The Bears have now been ranked in the top-10 for a sixth-straight year, one of just four programs (Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas) to accomplish that feat.
- BU spent a school-record 54 weeks in the AP Top-10 from Dec. 16, 2019-Dec. 5, 2022.
- Baylor set a school-record streak of 65-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 (previous record was 25). The streak lasted from Nov. 5, 2019 to Jan 9, 2023 (1,161 Days).

THE BIG 12'S MOST WINS IN CONFERENCE CHALLENGES

• Baylor is 14-4 in conference challenges – 8-2 in Big 12/SEC Challenge, 3-1 in Big 12/Pac-12, 3-1 in Big 12/Big East.

• Baylor's 14-4 record in conference challenges (Big 12-Big East, Big 12/SEC, Big 12/Pac-12) is best in the Big 12, followed by Kansas at 12-7, OSU at 11-8, Iowa State at 10-8, Texas Tech at 10-9, OU at 10-9, Texas at 8-9, TCU at 7-7, K-State at 7-11 and WVU at 5-10.

SUCCESS IN TOURNAMENTS

- Baylor is 43-13 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including titles in 4 of the last 5 tournaments.
- BU is 30-5 in its eight regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, going 3-1, 3-1, 3-1, 4-0, 4-0, 3-1, 3-0, 3-0, 1-1, 2-0 and 1-0
- BU advanced to championship games in the 2007 Paradise Jam (won), 2008 76 Classic (lost), 2011 Las Vegas Classic (won), 2013 Maui Invitational (lost), 2014 Las Vegas Invitational (lost), 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis (won), 2017 Hall of Fame Classic (won), 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational (won), 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis (won) and the 2023 Preseason NIT (won)
- Baylor has won seven regular-season tournament titles under Drew 2023 NIT Season Tip-Off, 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational, 2017 Hall of Fame Classic, 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2011 Las Vegas Classic and 2007 Paradise Jam.

- Four current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew's BU staff.
- Jerome Tang is in his third year as head coach at Kansas State. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 19 years with Drew.
- Grant McCasland is in his second season as head coach at Texas Tech. He spent five years as a Baylor assistant before taking over as Arkansas State head coach for one season in 2016-17.
- Matthew Driscoll is in his 16th season as head coach at North Florida after six seasons as a Baylor assistant.
- Paul Mills is in his second season as head coach at Wichita State. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 14 years with Drew, the final eight as an assistant coach.
- John Jakus is set to begin his first season at Florida Atlantic after seven seasons on the Baylor bench as an assistant, also sereving as a graduate assistant for **Drew** from 2012-14.
- All four former assistants have led their teams to NCAA Tournaments Driscoll led UNF to the 2015 NCAA
- Tournament, while McCasland took UNT to the 2021 Second Round and Mills took ORU to the 2021 Sweet 16.
- Additionally, McCasland led North Texas to the NIT Championship in 2023, prior to leaving for Texas Tech.
- Drew is 1-4 all time when facing a former assistant as a head coach.

• Baylor basketball is aired live via the Baylor Sports Media Network from Playfly on ESPN Central Texas and Flagship station 1660AM/92.3 FM ESPN Radio (KRZI) in Waco and worldwide on Sirius/XM Radio.

- Games are broadcast by the "Voice of the Bears" John Morris, who was named NSMA 2019 Texas co-
- Sportscaster of the Year on Jan. 13, 2020, and Baylor Hall of Famer **Pat Nunley**.
- In early November, Morris was awarded the 2024 Chris Schenkel Award by the National Football Foundation

• First presented in 1996, the award recognizes individuals who have had long, distinguished careers broadcasting college football with direct ties to a specific university or platform

- Morris is in his 41st year doing BU broadcasts (30th full-time), and Nunley is in his 44th season as analyst.
- A year after his Baylor Hall of Fame indiction, **Nunley** was honored by the Baylor Chamber of Commerce with the Frank Fallon Award prior to the season.

• The award, named for Nunley's longtime broadcast partner, Frank Fallon, is presented annually to someone who has made a significant impact on basketball in McLennan County.

- At 30 years together, Morris and Nunley rank in the top-5 of the longest radio duo's in men's college basketball

OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING A BAYLOR STAPLE

- Baylor ranks 31st in the nation in offensive rebounding percentage (38.2%)
- BU has ranked top-13 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage in nine of the last 11 seasons since 2013-14, including six times ranked in the nation's top-5. The Bears only cracked the top-20 once in Drew's first 10 years.
- Baylor finished ranked No. 24 nationally in 2023-24, No. 22 nationally in 2022-23, No. 13 nationally in 2021-22, No. 5 nationally in 2020-21, No. 8 in 2019-20, No. 2 in 2018-19, No. 9 in 2017-18, No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16, No. 1 in 2014-15 and No. 3 in 2013-14. Prior to that streak. BU's best rank was No. 16 in 2011-12.

BREAKTHROUGH IN BIG 12

- BU is 171-111 in Big 12 play in 14 seasons since 2010 after going 59-149 in the league's first 13 seasons.
- BU is 188-131 in Big 12 play in 16 seasons since 2008 after going 45-131 in the league's first 11 seasons.
- Baylor is 64-52 in Big 12 road games since 2012, second-best in the league behind only Kansas (70-46).
- BU has won 8+ Big 12 games in 13-straight seasons after winning 8+ just 3 times in the league's first 15 years.
- BU has double-digit Big 12 wins in six-straight seasons, 8 of the last 9 years and 10 of the last 14 seasons. BU didn't reach double-digit Big 12 wins in any of its first 13 years in the league before reaching 10+ for the first time in 2010.

DREW IS THIRD BIG 12 COACH TO REACH 150 CONFERENCE WINS

- Scott Drew joined Rick Barnes and Bill Self as the only coaches to reach 150 Big 12 wins on March 4, 2021 vs. OSU.
- Drew needed 136 games over 2,940 days for his first 50 Big 12 wins (50-86), 88 games over 1,821 days for his next 50 Big 12 wins (50-38) and only 77 games over 1,493 days for his next 50 Big 12 wins (50-27).

IMPRESSIVE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS AT HOME

- Baylor is 90-4 in its last 93 non-conference home games dating back to Dec. 12, 2012.
- Baylor is 154-16 in non-conference home games in the Drew era, including 124-8 since 2007-08.
- Baylor is 71-8 in home games against unranked opponents (including Big 12 play) since 2016.

GRADUATING 91 PERCENT OF SENIORS

- Since Scott Drew took over the Baylor Basketball program in 2003, 40 of 44 scholarship players who have played their final years of collegiate eligibility under Drew have graduated from Baylor.

BEST IN TEXAS

• Baylor is 86-25 against in-state opponents since the start of the 2011-12 season, and the Bears have advanced deeper into postseason play than any of Texas' 23 Division I teams in five of the last ten seasons.

• BU is a combined 100-29 against Lone Star State teams over the last 16 seasons after going 10-27 against in-state teams in Scott Drew's first six seasons at Baylor (2-0 in 2024-25, 3-3 in 2023-24, 5-2 in 2022-23, 5-2 in 2021-22, 6-0 in 2020-21, 6-1 in 2019-20, 4-5 in 2018-19, 6-3 in 2017-18, 7-1 in 2016-17, 9-3 in 2015-16, 10-1 in 2014-15, 6-3 in 2013-14, 7-1 in 2012-13, 10-0 in 2011-12, 5-3 in 2010-11 and 9-1 in 2009-10).

• Additionally, 13 of the 36 NBA Draft picks from Texas colleges since 2012 have come from Baylor. Texas (seven), Houston (five), SMU (three), Texas Tech (three), Texas A&M (two), North Texas (one), TCU (one) and UT Arlington (one) have also had players selected in the last 13 NBA Drafts.

FEELING FINE AT FOSTER

- Baylor and the City of Waco have partnered on a \$700 million riverfront development project, headlined by the \$212 million Foster Pavilion, the home of Baylor's national champion basketball programs.
- The Allison Development Centers for both basketball programs are included in the 245k square foot Foster Pavilion
 project were completed in the summer of 2024.
- Foster Pavilion (capacity 7,500) is located along the Brazos River on the opposite side of I-35 from McLane Stadium.
- BU MBB beat Cornell 98-79 in the first game at Foster Pavilion, while the BU women's team beat TCU 71-50 the following night in their first game in the new building.

BIG 12 BOASTS SOME OF THE BEST

- The new-look Big 12 is first conference to have 5 of the top 10 teams in the preseason AP Poll. In total, six Big 12 teams were ranked in the preseason top 25, which is the most in conference history.
- The league has led the way with four-straight years leding all conferences in average Net Rating
- The Big 12 has also led the nation in Conference RPI in each of the last four seasons and 9 of the last 11 seasons
- The conference had a Big 12 record eight teams make the NCAA Tournament last season
- The Big 12 is 47-8 through two weeks, with seven of the eight losses coming away-from-home.
- The conference remains tied with the Big Ten and SEC for the national lead with three AP Top 25 wins.




