STORY LINES

- No. 17/18 Baylor returns home for its second all-time meeting with the New Orleans Privateers
- The only other meeting between these teams was an 84-44 Bear victory in Waco on Dec. 29, 2018
 Baylor's Jayden Nunn will be honored prior to the game for scoring his 1,000th-career point last
- week against Tarleton
- Scott Drew is 15-1 against current Southland Conference teams during his 22 seasons at Baylor. The Bears lost to TAMU-CC in Drew's second season, but have won 14-straight against current Southland Conference teams.
- Drew is one of six active coaches who have won a national title, beating two of the other five already this season (Calipari & Pitino). Drew and the Bears will play two more in the regular season (Hurley & Self)
- BU enters Wednesday winners of four-straight at Foster Pavilion and coming off back-to-back 100-point outputs in front of the home fans
- In 22 years, Drew has never lost more than two games in the month of November
- Eclipsing the century mark against Sam Houston and Tarleton, the Bears put together back-to-back 100-point games for the first time since 1989
- In it's last home game, BU beat Tarleton by 63 points, the just the second 60 + point win over a D1 team (and fourth overall) for BU since 1980
- The Bears are coming off a second-place finish at the Baha Mar Bahamas Championship, improving to 30-6 in its eight regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, going 3-1, 3-1, 3-1, 4-0, 4-0, 3-1, 3-0, 3-0, 1-1, 2-0 and 1-1
- Baylor is 43-14 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including titles in four of the last 6 tournaments
- Norchad Omier led the way for Baylor, averaging 23 points and 10 rebounds against a pair of ranked opponents, earning a spot on the all-tournament team and Big 12 Player of the Week honors
- With two more double-doubles in the Bahamas, **Omier** now has 72 in his career, 10 ahead of Auburn's Johni Broom for the most among active players in the NCAA
- Omier is the first bear since Ekpe Udoh in 2009 to have four double-doubles in his first six games in a Baylor uniform
- The Miami transfer is one of just three players in the country with 1,500 + points and 1,000 + career rebounds
- Jeremy Roach also made the all-tournament squad averaging 14 points and 3.5 assists, highlighted by his game-winning buzzer-beater against No. 22 St. John's
- **Roach's** buzzer-beater was the first by a Baylor Bear since Lester Medford beat Texas Tech at the Gun in 2016.
- BU's 14-point halftime deficit was its largest in a comeback win since it trailed by 15 at the break against Rick Pitino and the Louisville Cardinals in the Battle '4' Atlantis Championship in 2016.
- Second-half surges have the Bears outscoring their last five opponents by a total of 221-151 in the final 20-minutes, an average of 14.0 points per game
- BU has the toughest strength of schedule among power-five conference teams
- Ranked as the 8th-toughest schedule by Ken Pom, the next hardest schedule by a power-conference team is Alabama at No. 43.

QUICK HITS

- Baylor is the only team in the country to be a top-3 seed in each of the last four NCAA Tournaments
- BU joins Gonzaga, Kansas and Houston as one of four teams to win a game in each of the last five NCAA Tournaments.
- The Bears are the only team in the Big 12 with 11+ conference wins in a Power-5 conference in five-straight seasons.
- The Bears have now been ranked in the top-10 for a sixth-straight year, one of just five programs (Duke, Gonzaga, Kentucky and Kansas) to accomplish that feat.
- Selected 19th overall by the New Orleans Pelicans in June's NBA Draft, **Ja'Kobe Walter** gave BU four-straight top-19 picks for the first time in program history, the only school in the country to claim that distinction (**Keyonte George** 16th overall to Utah, **Jeremy Sochan** 9th overall to San Antonio in 2022 **Davion Mitchell** 9th overall to Sacramento in 2021).
- The Bears have had 13 picks in the last 12 drafts, which is the most in the state of Texas and second-most in the Big 12 since 2012
- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 12-consecutive postseason appearances, the nations fifth-longest active streak
- The Bears have gone to 10 NCAA Tournaments and two National Invitation Tournaments since 2012.
- BU is 71-8 in home games over the last six seasons.
- Baylor will play its first full season in the brand-new state of the art Foster Pavilion
- Baylor has reached the 25-win milestone in three of the last five seasons and in 7 of the last 15 years. Prior to that, BU reached 25 wins just once in the program's first 103 years (25-5 in 1945-46).
- Baylor is 34-18 against ranked teams over the last four seasons, including a 17-14 mark away from home.
- Baylor's 65-25 Big 12 record over the last five seasons is the second best record of any Power-5 team in that span.
- Head coach Scott Drew is in his 22nd season at Baylor with a school-record 448 career victories.
- Drew is tied for the eighth longest-tenured head coach in Division I men's college basketball.
- Drew is a part of the second-winningest college basketball family. Entering the 2024-25 season, Scott, his brother Bryce (GCU) and their Dad Homer combined for 1,369 wins, 255 wins behind the Iba Family for most wins among father/son combinations in division I college basketball.
- Baylor is playing its 725th game of the 22-year Drew era more than half (389) have been as a ranked team.
- Over the last six seasons, Baylor is 101-11 when leading at the half and 125-18 when taking a 2nd-half lead.
- The Bears have been ranked in the AP Poll for 34-straight weeks, the fourth-longest active streak in the Big 12 Conference. BU spent a school-record 54-straight weeks ranked in the top-10 of the AP Poll, from Dec. 16, 2019-Dec 5, 2022.
- BU set a school-record streak of 65-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 from Nov. 5, 2019 to Jan 9, 2023 (1,161 Days). In total, the Bears have been ranked in the AP Poll for 99 of the last 100 weeks
- Baylor has been ranked in all 25 spots in the AP Top 25 at some point in the last 8 years.
- Baylor has been No. 1 ranked in 4 of the last 9 seasons (Gonzaga, Duke and Kansas are only others).
- Baylor and Kansas are the only Power-5 schools to win 18+ games every year since 2008.
- BU has built double-digit leads in 119 of 157 games over the last five seasons (111-6).
- Baylor has won 90% of its games when leading at the half since 2011-12 (250-28).
- Entering 2024-25, Baylor is averaging 24.5 wins per season since 2011-12.
- Baylor's 323 wins since 2011-12 are second-most in the Big 12 behind only Kansas (360).
- Baylor is 414-176 since 2007-08, the first year Drew's staff had a full allotment of scholarships.
- Thirteen of Baylor's 14 starting point guards under Drew have earned All-Big recognition (17 of last 18 seasons).
- Baylor is 132-37 over the last six seasons, the nation's 2nd best winning percentage among Power-5 teams in that span (.781%)

ONE OF THE GREATEST REBUILDS IN NCAA HISTORY

- Scott Drew became Baylor's head coach in 2003, starting of one of the greatest rebuilds in NCAA history.
- Drew is one of eight active men's Division I coaches with at least 400 wins at their current school.
- Drew is one of 2 active coaches to have won an NCAA Title and an NIT Title. He is the only active coach to have won both at the same school (John Calipari NCAA: Kentucky, NIT: Memphis).
- Drew was named 2020 NBC Sports National Coach of the Year and 2017 Basketball Times National COY.
- Drew is now in his 22nd season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (448).

• Baylor has a .701 winning percentage (414-177) since Drew's first year with no scholarship restrictions in 2007-08 and a .714 winning percentage (323-130) over the last 12 seasons since 2011-12.

- Drew (53) is the second-youngest active collegiate head coach to win a National Championship.
- In Drew's first 21 seasons at Baylor, 58 players have gone on to professional careers.
- Was announced as a member of the Texas Sports Hall of Fame Class of 2023.
- He is the 23rd BU player or coach to be inducted into the Texas Sports Hall of Fame

NATION'S-BEST 34-18 VS. RANKED TEAMS OVER LAST FIVE SEASONS

- Baylor is 34-18 against AP Top-25 ranked teams since 2019-2020, the second-best mark in the nation.
- BU is 16-4 at home vs. ranked teams in the last five seasons wins vs. #12 Arizona (Dec. 2019), #18 Butler (Dec. 2019), #14 West Virginia (Feb. 2020), #9 Kansas (Jan. 2021), #17 Oklahoma State (March 2021), #18 Texas Tech (March 2021), #6 Villanova (Dec. 2021), #20 Texas (Feb. 2022), #5 Kansas (Feb. 2022), #9 Kansas (Feb. 2023), #8 Texas (Feb. 2023), #18 BYU (Jan. 2024), #12 Iowa State (Feb. 2024), #23 Texas Tech, #25 Oklahoma, and No. 7 Kansas (March 2024), and Iosses by 3 points to #3 Kansas (Feb. 2020) and #19 Texas Tech (Jan. 2022).
- The record includes 18-14 away from home, with neutral wins vs. #17 Villanova (Nov. 2019), vs. #5 Illinois (Nov. 2020), vs. #18 Villanova (March 2021), vs. #10 Arkansas (March 2021), vs. #6 Houston (April 2021), #1 Gonzaga (April 2021), #8 UCLA and #14 Gonzaga, with road wins at #22 Texas Tech (Jan. 2020), at #4 Kansas (Jan. 2020), at #15 Texas Tech (Jan. 2021), at #6 Texas (Feb. 2021), at #6 West Virginia (March 2021), at #8 Iowa State (January 2022), at #21 Texas (Feb. 2022), at #17 TCU (Feb. 2023) and vs. Arkansas (Nov. 2024)

• Scott Drew is 15-1 against current Southland Conference teams during his 22 seasons at Baylor. The Bears lost to TAMU-CC in Drew's second, but have won 14-straight against current Southland Conference teams.

• Drew's teams have faced Incarnate Word (1-0), McNeese (2-0), New Orleans (1-0), Nicholls (4-0),

Northwestern State (5-0) and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (2-1).

• Baylor is 51-13 all time against current Southland Conference teams.

NOTABLE STREAKS

- BU is 99-1 in its last 100 games when shooting a higher percentage than its opponent (only loss Feb. 20, 2024 at BYU)
- Baylor has won 61-straight games when shooting 50% or higher (last loss March 18, 2018 vs. Mississippi State).
- BU has appeared in 34-straight AP Polls, the 8th-longest active streak in the nation, the fourth-longest in the Big 12 and the second-longest in program history.

ANOTHER SLOW START DOOMS THE BEARS

- Down 15-2 at the first media timeout, BU trailed by 27 at the half it's largest halftime deficit since trailing by 28 at Michigan State Dec. 16, 2023.
- Baylor outscored the Vols 42-30 in the second half, but the hole was too deep to dig out of as BU dropped its second game of the season
- Norchad Omier recorded his fourth double-double in six games this season, the first Bear since Epke Udoh to
 accomplish that feat in their first six games at Baylor
- VJ Edgecombe established a career high in points with 20, the fifth time in the first six games he netted a careerhigh on points

A BATTLE AT BAHA MAR GOES TO THE BEARS

- Down five points with 8 seconds to play, BU won a double-overtime thriller against No. 22 St. John's
- A 14-point halftime deficit is the largest deficit overcome in a win since the Bears came back from down 15 at the half against Louisville in the 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis Championship
- BU improves to 6-1 in double overtime games in the Drew Era
- Jeremy Roach is the first Baylor player to hit a game-winning shot at the buzzer since Lester Medford beat Texas Tech at the gun on Jan. 16, 2016
- Norchad Omier had a game-high in points (24) and rebounds (10) giving him 71 double-doubles for his career, building on his lead as the NCAA's active career-leader in that stat

GETTING IT DONE ON BOTH ENDS AGAINST TARLETON

- Baylor's 63-point win was its largest since a 64-point victory over Mississippi Valley in the season opener of the 2022-23 season (11/7/22), and just it's fourth 60+ point margin of victory since 1980.
- BU scored 100 points in back-to-back games for the first time since 1989 when The Bears scored 100 against Texas State and then Mercer in back-to-back games
- Tarleton's 13 first-half points were the second-fewest first-half points allowed by Baylor in the Big 12 era. Arkansas Pine Bluff scored 12 against the Bears on 12/21/2020
- VJ Edgecombe established a career high in points for the fourth-straight game with 17 points
- Jalen Celestine scored 20 points on 6-of-9 shooting, one off his career-high of 21 points

A FUN ONE FOR THE HOME FANS

- Baylor eclipsed the 100-point mark for the 31st time in the Drew Era with a 104-67 win over Sam Houston
- BU had seven players score in double figures for the first time since 2013 against Long Beach State
- Baylor's 30 assists were its most since it had 30 against McNeese Nov. 23, 2022
- The Bears shot .586 from the field, it's best clip since shooting .672 against Mississippi Valley State in the final game at the Ferrell Center (12/22/23)
- Norchad Omier and VJ Edgecombe recorded double-doubles, the second Baylor duo in the last six games to accomplish that feat

BACK ON TRACK

- Baylor picked up its first win of the season with a 72-67 win over the Arkansas Razorbacks in the 4PT Dallas Duel, never trailing in the game
- Saturday was the first time since Jan. 1, 2022 (No. 8 Iowa State) Baylor never trailed in a game against a ranked opponent
- Norchad Omier scored 15 points and pulled down 12 rebounds, for his career-first double-double at Baylor and the 69th of his career
- VJ Edgecombe established a new career high in points (11), rebounds (8) and assists (5)

A TOUGH NIGHT IN THE PNW

- BU dropped its season opener against No. 6 Gonzaga 101-63, the largest loss for BU since a 91-51 setback against Oklahoma in 2007.
- The loss marked just the fourth time in the Drew Era the Bears have allowed 100 point in regulation, and the 38-point loss was Baylor's worst since a 91-51 setback against Oklahoma in January of 2007
- Norchad Omier led the way for BU scoring 15 points and grabbing nine rebounds, the first Baylor player with at least 15 pts and 9 rebs. in their debut since MaCio Teague has 18 pts and 10 rebs against UCA in 2019 season
- With his 12 pts and 6 assist on Monday, Robert Wright became the first freshman in the Drew era with 10+ points and 6+ assists in their debut, and the first Baylor player since Manu Lecomte in 2016 with those numbers in a Baylor debut.

TWELVE CONSECUTIVE POSTSEASON BERTHS

- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 12-consecutive postseason berths and has appeared in 15 of the last 16
 postseasons. BU made seven postseason appearances in the program's 97 seasons prior to the Scott Drew era.
- Baylor is 1 of 7 teams to appear in every postseason since 2012, joining Gonzaga, Kansas, Michigan State, Oregon, Saint Mary's and Virginia.
- BU earned NCAA bids in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 and NIT bids in 2013 and 2018.
- Baylor has appeared in 14 of 15 postseasons since 2008. Prior to that, Baylor's only postseason berths were in 1946 (NCAA), 1948 (NCAA), 1950 (NCAA), 1987 (NIT), 1988 (NCAA), 1990 (NIT) and 2001 (NIT).

FOUR-STRAIGHT TOP-THREE SEEDS

- Baylor earned its third-straight top-three seed for a fourth-straight NCAA Tournament becoming the only team to
 accomplish that.
- 2024 marks the fifth time BU has earned a No. 3 seed after also doing it in 2010, 2012, 2015, 2017 and 2023.
- Baylor has earned a top-3 seed in 8 of the last 14 NCAA Tournaments.
- BU is 17-7 in NCAAT games as the higher seed, but 2021 was the first time as a higher seed after the Sweet 16.
- BU is 3-5 in NCAAT games as the lower/same seed, though four of those five losses were to top-2 seeds.

A TOP-25 STAPLE

- BU has now been ranked in 99 of the last 100 AP Polls.
- Ranked in the AP Top-25 for 34-straight weeks, Baylor has the eighth-longest active streak in the country and the fourth-longest in the Big 12 Conference. (Houston 89, Kansas 68).
- Ranked No. 8 to start the, The Bears have now been ranked in the top-10 for a sixth-straight year, one of just four programs (Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas) to accomplish that feat.
- BU spent a school-record 54 weeks in the AP Top-10 from Dec. 16, 2019-Dec. 5, 2022.
- Baylor set a school-record streak of 65-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 (previous record was 25). The streak lasted from Nov. 5, 2019 to Jan 9, 2023 (1,161 Days).

THE BIG 12'S MOST WINS IN CONFERENCE CHALLENGES

Baylor is 14-4 in conference challenges – 8-2 in Big 12/SEC Challenge, 3-1 in Big 12/Pac-12, 3-1 in Big 12/Big East.
Baylor's 14-4 record in conference challenges (Big 12-Big East, Big 12/SEC, Big 12/Pac-12) is best in the Big 12, followed by Kansas at 12-7, OSU at 11-8, Iowa State at 10-8, Texas Tech at 10-9, OU at 10-9, Texas at 8-9, TCU at 7-7, K-State at 7-11 and WVU at 5-10.

SUCCESS IN TOURNAMENTS

• Baylor is 43-14 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including titles in 4 of the last 6 tournaments.

- BU is 30-6 in its eight regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, going 3-1, 3-1, 3-1, 4-0, 4-0, 3-1, 3-0, 3-0, 1-1, 2-0 and 1-1
- BU advanced to championship games in the 2007 Paradise Jam (won), 2008 76 Classic (lost), 2011 Las Vegas Classic (won), 2013 Maui Invitational (lost), 2014 Las Vegas Invitational (lost), 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis (won), 2017 Hall of Fame Classic (won), 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational (won), 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis (won), the 2023 Preseason NIT (won) and the Baha Mar Bahamas Championship (Lost)
- Baylor has won seven regular-season tournament titles under Drew 2023 NIT Season Tip-Off, 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational, 2017 Hall of Fame Classic, 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2011 Las Vegas Classic and 2007 Paradise Jam.

SCOTT DREW COACHING TREE

- Five current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew's BU staff.
- Jerome Tang is in his third year as head coach at Kansas State. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 19 years with Drew.
- Grant McCasland is in his second season as head coach at Texas Tech. He spent five years as a Baylor assistant before taking over as Arkansas State head coach for one season in 2016-17.
- Matthew Driscoll is in his 16th season as head coach at North Florida after six seasons as a Baylor assistant.
- Paul Mills is in his second season as head coach at Wichita State. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 14 years with Drew, the final eight as an assistant coach.
- John Jakus is set to begin his first season at Florida Atlantic after seven seasons on the Baylor bench as an assistant, also sereving as a graduate assistant for Drew from 2012-14.
- All four former assistants have led their teams to NCAA Tournaments Driscoll led UNF to the 2015 NCAA Tournament, while McCasland took UNT to the 2021 Second Round and Mills took ORU to the 2021 Sweet 16.
- Additionally, McCasland led North Texas to the NIT Championship in 2023, prior to leaving for Texas Tech.
- Drew is 1-4 all time when facing a former assistant as a head coach.

PROTECTING HALFTIME LEADS

- Baylor is 132-15 when leading at halftime since the start of 2017-18.
- Baylor has won 90% of its games (249-28) when leading at the half in the last 14 seasons ... 3-0 in 2024-25, 19-2 in 2023-24, 19-5 in 2022-23 20-3 in 2021-22, 24-0 in 2020-21, 21-2 in 2019-20, 15-3 in 2018-19, 15-0 in 2017-18, 18-3 in 2016-17, 18-2 in 2015-16, 21-7 in 2014-15, 18-2 in 2013-14, 17-1 in 2012-13 and 26-1 in 2011-12.
- BU has won 42% of games in which it's been tied or trailing at the half since 2011-12, going 71-97 in those.

THIRD-MOST WINS AMONG BIG 12 TEAMS IN LAST 14 YEARS

- Baylor's 323-120 record since 2011-12 trails only Kansas (360-97) and Arizona (346-108) among Big 12 teams.
- Houston (319-124) is fourth, Cincinnati (309-134) is fifth, BYU (304-142) is sixth, Colorado (278-169) is seventh, lowa State (269-170) is eighth, West Virginia (256-185) is ninth, Kansas State (255-185) is 10th, Texas Tech (248-186) is 11th, Utah (237-190) is 12th, Oklahoma St. (233-198) is 13th, TCU (232-205) is 14th, UCF (231-181) is 15th and Arizona State (231-194).
- Baylor has averaged 24.5 wins per season over the last 13 seasons since 2011-12.

NON-CONFERENCE HIGHLIGHTS

- Baylor is 15-3 against the Big East during the Drew era.
- The Bears are 21-12 against the SEC during the Drew era, including 16-8 since 2012-13.
- Drew is 6-6 against the ACC since BU's first year without scholarship restrictions in 2007-08.

POINT GUARDS THRIVE IN DREW'S SYSTEM

- Thirteen of Baylor's 14 starting point guards during the Scott Drew era have earned All-Big 12 recognition.
- Baylor's starting point guard has earned All-Big 12 recognition in 17 of 18 seasons since 2004-05.
- Adam Flagler (2023), James Akinjo (2022), Jared Butler (2019, 2020, 2021), Davion Mitchell (2020, 2021), Makai Mason (2019), Manu Lecomte (2017, 2018), Lester Medford (2016), Kenny Chery (2014, 2015), Pierre Jackson (2012, 2013), Tweety Carter (2010), Curtis Jerrells (2007, 2008, 2009) and Aaron Bruce (2005, 2006, 2007) have earned All-Big 12 recognition.

58 PRO PLAYERS IN DREW ERA

- In Scott Drew's 21 years at Baylor, 58 of his players have gone on to professional careers.
- Ten Bears are currently on NBA rosters (Including two-way contracts)– Jalen Bridges (Suns), Jared Butler (Wizards), Adam Flagler (Thunder), Keyonte George (Jazz), Yves Missi (Pelicans), Davion Mitchell (Raptors), Royce O'Neale (Suns), Taurean Prince (Bucks), Jeremy Sochan (Spurs) and Ja'Kobe Walter (Raptors).
- In addition to the ten current NBA players, ten more of Drew's former players have played in the NBA (most recent team) – Quincy Acy (Raptors), Kendall Brow (Pacers), Freddie Gillespie (Raptors), Pierre Jackson (Mavs), Cory Jefferson (Suns), Perry Jones III (Thunder), Quincy Miller (Kings), Johnathan Motley (Clippers), Ekpe Udoh (Jazz) and Ish Wainright (Portland)
- Sochan (2023 & 24) and George (2024) have each particpated in the Rising Stars Challenge in each of the last two seasons, Baylor's first two All-Star Weekend particpants.

BAYLOR BASKETBALL ON THE RADIO

• Baylor basketball is aired live via the Baylor Sports Media Network from Playfly on ESPN Central Texas and Flagship station 1660AM/92.3 FM ESPN Radio (KRZI) in Waco and worldwide on Sirius/XM Radio.

• Games are broadcast by the "Voice of the Bears" John Morris, who was named NSMA 2019 Texas co-Sportscaster of the Year on Jan. 13, 2020, and Baylor Hall of Famer Pat Nunley.

• In early November, Morris was awarded the 2024 Chris Schenkel Award by the National Football Foundation • First presented in 1996, the award recognizes individuals who have had long, distinguished careers broadcasting college football with direct ties to a specific university or platform

• Morris is in his 41st year doing BU broadcasts (30th full-time), and Nunley is in his 44th season as analyst.

 A year after his Baylor Hall of Fame indiction, Nunley was honored by the Baylor Chamber of Commerce with the Frank Fallon Award prior to the season.

• The award, named for Nunley's longtime broadcast partner, Frank Fallon, is presented annually to someone who has made a significant impact on basketball in McLennan County.

• At 30 years together, Morris and Nunley rank in the top-5 of the longest radio duo's in men's college basketball

OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING A BAYLOR STAPLE

- Baylor ranks 18th in the nation in offensive rebounding percentage (39.1%)
- BU has ranked top-13 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage in nine of the last 11 seasons since 2013-14, including six times ranked in the nation's top-5. The Bears only cracked the top-20 once in Drew's first 10 years.
- Baylor finished ranked No. 24 nationally in 2023-24, No. 22 nationally in 2022-23, No. 13 nationally in 2021-22, No. 5 nationally in 2020-21, No. 8 in 2019-20, No. 2 in 2018-19, No. 9 in 2017-18, No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16, No. 1 in 2014-15 and No. 3 in 2013-14. Prior to that streak, BU's best rank was No. 16 in 2011-12.

BREAKTHROUGH IN BIG 12

- BU is 171-111 in Big 12 play in 14 seasons since 2010 after going 59-149 in the league's first 13 seasons.
- BU is 188-131 in Big 12 play in 16 seasons since 2008 after going 45-131 in the league's first 11 seasons.
- Baylor is 64-52 in Big 12 road games since 2012, second best in the league behind only Kansas (70-46).
- BU has won 8+ Big 12 games in 13-straight seasons after winning 8+ just 3 times in the league's first 15 years.
- BU has double-digit Big 12 wins in six-straight seasons, 8 of the last 9 years and 10 of the last 14 seasons. BU didn't reach double-digit Big 12 wins in any of its first 13 years in the league before reaching 10+ for the first time in 2010.

DREW IS THIRD BIG 12 COACH TO REACH 150 CONFERENCE WINS

- Scott Drew joined Rick Barnes and Bill Self as the only coaches to reach 150 Big 12 wins on March 4, 2021 vs. OSU.
- Drew needed 136 games over 2,940 days for his first 50 Big 12 wins (50-86), 88 games over 1,821 days for his next 50 Big 12 wins (50-38) and only 77 games over 1,493 days for his next 50 Big 12 wins (50-27).

IMPRESSIVE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS AT HOME

- Baylor is 90-4 in its last 94 non-conference home games dating back to Dec. 12, 2012.
- Baylor is 154-16 in non-conference home games in the Drew era, including 124-8 since 2007-08.
- Baylor is 71-8 in home games against unranked opponents (including Big 12 play) since 2016.

GRADUATING 91 PERCENT OF SENIORS

- Since Scott Drew took over the Baylor Basketball program in 2003, 40 of 44 scholarship players who have played their final years of collegiate eligibility under Drew have graduated from Baylor.

• Baylor is 86-25 against in-state opponents since the start of the 2011-12 season, and the Bears have advanced deeper into postseason play than any of Texas' 23 Division I teams in five of the last ten seasons. • BU is a combined 100-29 against Lone Star State teams over the last 16 seasons after going 10-27 against in-state teams in Scott Drew's first six seasons at Baylor (2-0 in 2024-25, 3-3 in 2023-24, 5-2 in 2022-23, 5-2 in 2021-22, 6-0 in 2020-21, 6-1 in 2019-20, 4-5 in 2018-19, 6-3 in 2017-18, 7-1 in 2016-17, 9-3 in 2015-16, 10-1 in 2014-15, 6-3 in 2013-14, 7-1 in 2012-13, 10-0 in 2011-12, 5-3 in 2010-11 and 9-1 in 2009-10).




