POSTGAME NEWS CONFERENCE AREA

All coaches and student-athletes will be available for interviews following a 10-minute cooling off period. The postgame news conference will take place in the Ferrell Center media room. There will be signage directing you to this location. The advancing team and at least two student-athletes (but no more than three student-athletes) will report to the interview room after the cooling off period ends, followed by the non-advancing team.
