### Dayton Head Coach Tim Horsmon

#### *Opening Statement...*

"Wow, what a day, what a night? What a weekend. Just incredibly proud of our our group and the hard work. Just to celebrate this group. We have some some alumni in our locker room right now. They kind of started this whole process and we talk a lot about legacy and family and there are just so many generations now that I think are gonna be incredibly proud and happy of this program. Just a cool night. Just great volleyball. Baylor played great. They were tough. We knew they would be. They're well coached, which made it even better, made it sweeter. I know they had a heck of a season and I'm sure they are disappointed. I know we beat a really good team. These three were unbelievable - the heart and soul of of our group tonight and performed in a really high level. I'm just excited about what the what the program did today."

#### *On the difference in a tight match ...*

"We were just really consistent in our our process. I think we we lived in the moment. I think we we never got too far ahead of ourselves or got too down on what was happening, even when things weren't going the way we wanted. We kept hammering away from the service line. I thought we were really aggressive. Brooke Smith turned her ankle this morning and we didn't know if she was gonna go. Then our other outside, Taylor Russell, had shoulder issues, so we kind of came into this thing feeling like, we're in a tough spot and we just talked about being fearless. We just we just wanted to come out and try to be the aggressor in every single point and we knew how physical they they were. Again, they are well coached and we just knew we had to had to keep coming at them, and I think again, this group did."

#### *On if Lexi Almodovar is the best 5-foot-8 outside hitter in the nation ...*

"I challenge, if there's been a better 5-foot-8 player ever. I know there have been some some really good ones, but I got to coach this one and and she's ours. I will ]go to the grave saying she's the best one that I've seen."

#### *On Alyssa Miller's performance ...*

"She's being really humble. She was really she was really good tonight. Again, to beat a team like that and and have your your L1 struggling with with her injury and finding ways to score points. Liana (Sarkissian) could be in here after having a great just an unbelievable night as wel. Brooke (Nichols) kind of mustering up enough energy and toughness to be able to play and kill balls today and and do that. It was it wasn't easy for her and she found a way to do it."
