STORY LINES

- No. RV/RV Baylor puts its nine-game home winning streak on the line when it hosts No. xx/xx Cincinnati at 7 p.m. on ESPN+
- Baylor holds a 3-0 series edge after sweeping two games from the Bearcats last season in Waco and the Big 12 Championship Quarterfinals in Kansas City
- In the last meeting, BU scored just 24 first-half points, but outscored the Bearcats 44-30 in the second half to claim its first win at the Big 12 Championship since 2021
- In the last meeting in Waco, the Bears survived their second-lowest scoring output of the season (59 points)
- Tied at 27 at the half, The Bears outscored Cincy 35-32 behind 14 second-half points from Ja'Kobe Walter
 - According to KenPom. BU has played the seventh-hardest schedule in the Power-5
- BU is 164-100 in Big 12 play in 15 seasons since 2010 after going 59-149 in the league's first 13 seasons
- Baylor is 34-19 against ranked teams over the last four seasons, including a 18-16 mark away from home
- Baylor is the only team in the Big 12 with 11 + conference wins in a Power conference in 5-straight seasons BU is coming off its first Big 12 loss of the season, 74-55, it's lowest offensive output since scoring 54 in a loss against Oklahoma State on Jan. 15, 2022
- With just eight turnovers against the Cyclones, BU matched its second-lowest turnover total of the season
- The Bears lead the conference and rank 15th nationally with 14.5 offensive rebounds per game
- Sitting at +4.2 BU is third in the Big 12 and 14th in the Power-5 in turnover margin
- Baylor is one of three Big 12 teams with 5+ players averaging double figures (ISU (6), BYU (5))
- Scott Drew secured his 450th win at Baylor and the 470th of his career overall earlier this month against ACU, and now sits just 12 wins shy of 200-career Big 12 wins
- Drew is one of just seven active coaches with at least 450 wins at their current institution (Mark Few, Tom Izzo, Bill Self, Greg Kampe, Randy Bennett, Matt Painter)
- One of six active coaches who have won a national title, Drew will see four of the five other coaches as a part of its regular season schedule. Drew has wins against John Calipari & Rick Pitino, with his only loss coming to Dan Hurley in Dec.
- Hailing from basketball families, the Drews are the second winningest father son combination in NCAA history, compiling 1,382 wins between Scott, Bryce and Homer, trailing only the lba family (1,624) for the most by a family in NCAA history.
- Over the last six seasons the Bears are 137-39, the second-best record among power-conference teams for the duration of that span
- Baylor is one of five programs to be ranked inside the top-10 in each of the last six seasons
- The Bears are led by Miami transfer, Norchad Omier, The NCAA's active leader in career rebounds (1,456), double-doubles (75) and rebound average (11.0), while sitting 10th in career points (2,025)
- The senior is just 44 rebounds from becoming the 14th player in NCAA history with 2,000 points and 1,500 rebounds
- Freshman Rob Wright ranks second on the team in scoring averaging 12.8 points and has a teamleading 5.1 assists. With 66 assists, Wright is on pace to shatter the freshman assists record held by John Lucas (120)
- Duke Transfer Jeremy Roach is averaging 15.5 points per game in conference play, which leads the Bears and ranks among the top-15 in the Big 12

QUICK HITS

- Baylor is the only team in the country to be a top-3 seed in each of the last four NCAA Tournaments
- BU joins Gonzaga, Kansas and Houston as one of four teams to win a game in each of the last five NCAA Tournaments.
- The Bears are the only team in the Big 12 with 11 + conference wins in a Power-5 conference in five-straight seasons.
- The Bears have now been ranked in the top-10 for a sixth-straight year, one of just five programs (Duke, Gonzaga, Kentucky and Kansas) to accomplish that feat.
- Selected 19th overall by the New Orleans Pelicans in June's NBA Draft, **Ja'Kobe Walter** gave BU four-straight top-19 picks for the first time in program history, the only school in the country to claim that distinction (**Keyonte George** 16th overall to Utah, **Jeremy Sochan** 9th overall to San Antonio in 2022 **Davion Mitchell** 9th overall to Sacramento in 2021).
- The Bears have had 13 picks in the last 12 drafts, which is the most in the state of Texas and second-most in the Big 12 since 2012
- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 12-consecutive postseason appearances, the nations fifth-longest active streak
- The Bears have gone to 10 NCAA Tournaments and two National Invitation Tournaments since 2012.
- BU is 76-8 in home games over the last six seasons.
- Baylor will play its first full season in the brand-new state of the art Foster Pavilion
- Baylor has reached the 25-win milestone in three of the last five seasons and in 7 of the last 15 years. Prior to that, BU reached 25 wins just once in the program's first 103 years (25-5 in 1945-46).
- Baylor is 34-19 against ranked teams over the last four seasons, including a 18-15 mark away from home.
- Baylor's 65-23 Big 12 record over the last six seasons is the second best record of any Power-5 team in that span
- Head coach Scott Drew is in his 22nd season at Baylor with a school-record 453 career victories.
- Drew is tied for the eighth longest-tenured head coach in Division I men's college basketball.
- Drew is a part of the second-winningest college basketball family. Entering the 2024-25 season, Scott, his brother Bryce (GCU) and their Dad Homer combined for 1,382 wins, 250 wins behind the Iba Family for most wins among father/son combinations in division I college basketball.
- Baylor is playing its 702nd game of the 22-year Drew era more than half (392) have been as a ranked team.
- Over the last six seasons, Baylor is 106-12 when leading at the half and 130-19 when taking a 2nd-half lead.
- The Bears have been ranked in 102 of the last 106 AP Polls, after having it's 36-week streak snapped on Dec. 9th
- BU spent a school-record 54-straight weeks ranked in the top-10 of the AP Poll, from Dec. 16, 2019-Dec 5, 2022.
- BU set a school-record streak of 65-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 from Nov. 5, 2019 to Jan 9, 2023 (1,161 Days).
- Baylor has been ranked in all 25 spots in the AP Top 25 at some point in the last 8 years.
- Baylor has been No. 1 ranked in 4 of the last 9 seasons (Gonzaga, Duke and Kansas are only others).
- Baylor and Kansas are the only Power-5 schools to win 18+ games every year since 2008.
- BU has built double-digit leads in 125 of 161 games over the last five seasons (118-7).
- Baylor has won 90% of its games when leading at the half since 2011-12 (255-29).
- Entering 2024-25, Baylor is averaging 24.5 wins per season since 2011-12.
- Baylor's 328 wins since 2011-12 are second-most in the Big 12 behind only Kansas (364).
- Baylor is 419-178 since 2007-08, the first year Drew's staff had a full allotment of scholarships.
- Thirteen of Baylor's 14 starting point guards under Drew have earned All-Big recognition (17 of last 18 seasons).
- Baylor is 137-39 over the last six seasons, the nation's best winning percentage among Power-5 teams in that span (.783%)

ONE OF THE GREATEST REBUILDS IN NCAA HISTORY

- Scott Drew became Baylor's head coach in 2003, starting of one of the greatest rebuilds in NCAA history.
- Drew is one of eight active men's Division I coaches with at least 400 wins at their current school.
- Drew is one of 2 active coaches to have won an NCAA Title and an NIT Title. He is the only active coach to have won both at the same school (John Calipari NCAA: Kentucky, NIT: Memphis).
- Drew was named 2020 NBC Sports National Coach of the Year and 2017 Basketball Times National COY.
- Drew is now in his 22nd season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (453).

• Baylor has a .702 winning percentage (419·179) since Drew's first year with no scholarship restrictions in 2007-08 and a .715 winning percentage (329·132) over the last 12 seasons since 2011-12.

- Drew (54) is the second-youngest active collegiate head coach to win a National Championship.
- Drew is one of just seven active coaches with at least 450 wins at their current institution (Mark Few, Tom Izzo, Bill Self, Greg Kampe, Randy Bennett, Matt Painter)
- In Drew's first 21 seasons at Baylor, 58 players have gone on to professional careers.
- Was announced as a member of the Texas Sports Hall of Fame Class of 2023.
- He is the 23rd BU player or coach to be inducted into the Texas Sports Hall of Fame

NATION'S-BEST 34-20 VS. RANKED TEAMS OVER LAST FIVE SEASONS

• Baylor is 34-20 against AP Top-25 ranked teams since 2019-2020, the second-best mark in the nation.

• BU is 16-4 at home vs. ranked teams in the last five seasons – wins vs. #12 Arizona (Dec. 2019), #18 Butler (Dec. 2019), #14 West Virginia (Feb. 2020), #9 Kansas (Jan. 2021), #17 Oklahoma State (March 2021), #18 Texas Tech (March 2021), #6 Villanova (Dec. 2021), #20 Texas (Feb. 2022), #5 Kansas (Feb. 2022), #9 Kansas (Feb. 2023), #8 Texas (Feb. 2023), #18 BYU (Jan. 2024), #12 Iowa State (Feb. 2024), #23 Texas Tech, #25 Oklahoma, and No. 7 Kansas (March 2024), and Iosses by 3 points to #3 Kansas (Feb. 2020) and #19 Texas Tech (Jan. 2022).

- Baylor has won nine-straight home games, the longest streak in the brief history of Foster Pavilion

NO MAGIC FOR THE BEARS AT HILTON COLISEUM

- Without the services of Langston Love and Jalen Celestine, BU dropped its ciontest at Iowa State 74-55
- 55 points are Baylor's fewest scored in Big 12 Play since scoring 54 vs. Oklahoma State on Jan. 15, 2022
 - The Bears' eight turnovers are tied for their second-fewest this season and the fewest since turning it over eight times against Norfolk State on Dec. 12, 2024
 - Josh Ojianwuna Score 13 points and grabbed 10 rebounds for his second double-double in three games and the third of his career

BEARS CRUISE PAST THE UTES IN BIG 12 OPENER

- The Utes scored just 56 points, the fewest allowed by BU in Big 12 play since surrendering just 54 to TCU on Feb. 26 of last season
- The 25-point margin of victory is the largest in a Big 12 game since BU beat Texas Tech by 27 on Feb. 4, 2023
- The Bears held Utah's leading scorer, Gabe Madsen, to just three points, his fewest since netting just two at Washington on Jan. 27 last year
- Norchad Omier scored 15 points to go along with a game-high 14 rebounds, giving him 75 career double-double's which leads all active players
- Baylor had four players score 15-plus points for the second time this season, also pulling that off against Norfolk State on Dec. 11.

BEARS BEAT DOWN ARLINGTON BAPTIST

- Baylor scored a season high 107 points, in a 54-point victory over Arlington Baptist in its first game back from the break
- The 54-point margin of victory is tied for the 10th largest in program history and the second largest this season
- The Bears pulled down 66 rebounds, the fifth-most in program history and the most since grabbing 70 against Texas A&M at Jan. 23, 2008
- Norchad Omier scored a game-high 19 points to go along with a season-high 24 rebounds, eclipsing the 2,000 career-point mark
- His 24 boards are the most by a Baylor player since Rico Gathers had a program-record 28 against Huston-Tillotson on Jan. 21, 2015

NOT SCARED OF THE SPARTANS

- BU shot .554 from the field, marking the first time since Dec. 22 and Jan. 2 last year where they shot .550 or better in back-to-back games (.672 vs. MVSU and .554 vs. Cornell)
- Norchad Omier (19), VJ Edgecombe (16), Josh Ojianwuna (16) and Rob Wright (16) eclipsed the 15-point
 plateau, marking the first time four Bears have done that since Nov. 28, 2020, against Louisiana-Lafayette
- Wright dished out 13 assists, setting a new single-game freshman record previously held by L.J. Rose who dished out 12 dimes against Hardin Simmons on Jan. 19, 2013
- The freshman's 13 assists are the most by a Baylor player since Jared Butler had 13 at Kansas State on Dec. 19, 2020

MAKING QUICK WORK OF THE WILDCATS

- The Bears blistered the ACU Wildcats making each of their first 10 shots en route to a 74.1% [20-27] clip in the first half, its best shooting half since making 75.9% [22-of-29] against Mississippi Valley last season in the final game at the Ferrell Center (12/22/23)
- BU finished the game shooting .593 from the field, it's best clip this season and the best since shooting .672 last December against the Delta Devils (12/22/23)
- Jayden Nunn finished with a game-high 18 points, upping his average to 17.8 points per game at home this season

SHORT-HANDED BEARS COME UP JUST SHORT IN STORRS

- Without the services of freshman VJ Edgecombe, The Bears dropped a four-point contest in a tough road environment at UCONN it's fifth ranked opponent in eight games to start the season
- The Bears dropped to lost just its second game in six seasons when shooting a higher percentage than its opponent (99-2)
- Robert Wright led the team in scoring for the first time in his career-pouring in a career-high 22 points
- Josh Ojianwuna became just the second player since 2021 to have 14 rebounds in a game (Yves Missi, last yr vs. Oregon St.)

BEARS BLOW OUT NEW ORLEANS IN PRE-THANKSGIVING MATINEE

- Baylor improved its home win streak to five at Foster Pavilion including 11 of the last 13 games
- The Bears had just six turnovers, its fewest since only committing five against Oklahoma last season (2/13/24)
- Jayden Nunn finished with a game-high 23 points, his 8th-career 20-point game and his fourth at BU
- Going 6-for-7 from three to start the game, Nunn was the first player with six threes in a half since King McClure was 6-of-7 in the first half against Oklahoma State (1/14/19)
- Nunn was also the first player with 20 points in a half since McClure had 20 on that January day against Ok. State

ANOTHER SLOW START DOOMS THE BEARS

- Down 15-2 at the first media timeout, BU trailed by 27 at the half it's largest halftime deficit since trailing by 28 at Michigan State Dec. 16, 2023.
- Baylor outscored the Vols 42-30 in the second half, but the hole was too deep to dig out of as BU dropped its second game of the season
- Norchad Omier recorded his fourth double-double in six games this season, the first Bear since Epke Udoh to accomplish that feat in their first six games at Baylor
- VJ Edgecombe established a career high in points with 20, the fifth time in the first six games he netted a careerhigh on points

A BATTLE AT BAHA MAR GOES TO THE BEARS

- Down five points with 8 seconds to play, BU won a double-overtime thriller against No. 22 St. John's
- A 14-point halftime deficit is the largest deficit overcome in a win since the Bears came back from down 15 at the half against Louisville in the 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis Championship
- BU improves to 6-1 in double overtime games in the Drew Era
- Jeremy Roach is the first Baylor player to hit a game-winning shot at the buzzer since Lester Medford beat Texas Tech at the gun on Jan. 16, 2016
- Norchad Omier had a game-high in points (24) and rebounds (10) giving him 71 double-doubles for his career, building on his lead as the NCAA's active career-leader in that stat

GETTING IT DONE ON BOTH ENDS AGAINST TARLETON

- Baylor's 63-point win was its largest since a 64-point victory over Mississippi Valley in the season opener of the 2022-23 season (11/7/22), and just it's fourth 60+ point margin of victory since 1980.
- BU scored 100 points in back-to-back games for the first time since 1989 when The Bears scored 100 against Texas State and then Mercer in back-to-back games
- Tarleton's 13 first-half points were the second-fewest first-half points allowed by Baylor in the Big 12 era. Arkansas Pine Bluff scored 12 against the Bears on 12/21/2020
- VJ Edgecombe established a career high in points for the fourth-straight game with 17 points
- Jalen Celestine scored 20 points on 6-of-9 shooting, one off his career-high of 21 points

A FUN ONE FOR THE HOME FANS

- Baylor eclipsed the 100-point mark for the 31st time in the Drew Era with a 104-67 win over Sam Houston
- BU had seven players score in double figures for the first time since 2013 against Long Beach State
- Baylor's 30 assists were its most since it had 30 against McNeese Nov. 23, 2022
- The Bears shot .586 from the field, it's best clip since shooting .672 against Mississippi Valley State in the final game at the Ferrell Center (12/22/23)
- Norchad Omier and VJ Edgecombe recorded double-doubles, the second Baylor duo in the last six games to accomplish that feat

BACK ON TRACK

- Baylor picked up its first win of the season with a 72-67 win over the Arkansas Razorbacks in the 4PT Dallas Duel, never trailing in the game
- Saturday was the first time since Jan. 1, 2022 (No. 8 Iowa State) Baylor never trailed in a game against a ranked opponent
- Norchad Omier scored 15 points and pulled down 12 rebounds, for his career-first double-double at Baylor and the 69th of his career
- VJ Edgecombe established a new career high in points (11), rebounds (8) and assists (5)

A TOUGH NIGHT IN THE PNW

- BU dropped its season opener against No. 6 Gonzaga 101-63, the largest loss for BU since a 91-51 setback against Oklahoma in 2007.
- The loss marked just the fourth time in the Drew Era the Bears have allowed 100 point in regulation, and the 38-point loss was Baylor's worst since a 91-51 setback against Oklahoma in January of 2007
- Norchad Omier led the way for BU scoring 15 points and grabbing nine rebounds, the first Baylor player with at least 15 pts and 9 rebs. in their debut since MaCio Teague has 18 pts and 10 rebs against UCA in 2019 season
- With his 12 pts and 6 assist on Monday, **Robert Wright** became the first freshman in the **Drew** era with 10+ points and 6+ assists in their debut, and the first Baylor player since **Manu Lecomte** in 2016 with those numbers in a Baylor debut.

TWELVE CONSECUTIVE POSTSEASON BERTHS

- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 12-consecutive postseason berths and has appeared in 15 of the last 16
 postseasons. BU made seven postseason appearances in the program's 97 seasons prior to the Scott Drew era.
- Baylor is 1 of 7 teams to appear in every postseason since 2012, joining Gonzaga, Kansas, Michigan State, Oregon, Saint Mary's and Virginia.
- BU earned NCAA bids in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 and NIT bids in 2013 and 2018.
- Baylor has appeared in 14 of 15 postseasons since 2008. Prior to that, Baylor's only postseason berths were in 1946 (NCAA), 1948 (NCAA), 1950 (NCAA), 1987 (NIT), 1988 (NCAA), 1990 (NIT) and 2001 (NIT).

FOUR-STRAIGHT TOP-THREE SEEDS

- Baylor earned its third-straight top-three seed for a fourth-straight NCAA Tournament becoming the only team to
 accomplish that.
- 2024 marks the fifth time BU has earned a No. 3 seed after also doing it in 2010, 2012, 2015, 2017 and 2023.
- Baylor has earned a top-3 seed in 8 of the last 14 NCAA Tournaments.
- BU is 17-7 in NCAAT games as the higher seed, but 2021 was the first time as a higher seed after the Sweet 16.
- BU is 3-5 in NCAAT games as the lower/same seed, though four of those five losses were to top-2 seeds.

A TOP-25 STAPLE

- BU has now been ranked in 102 of the last 106 AP Polls.
- BU had it's 36-poll stretch in the AP Top-25 come to an end on Dec. 9, the streak was the eighth-longest active streak in the country and the fourth-longest in the Big 12 Conference.
- Ranked No. 8 to start the year, The Bears have now been ranked in the top-10 for a sixth-straight year, one of just four programs (Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas) to accomplish that feat.
- BU spent a school-record 54 weeks in the AP Top-10 from Dec. 16, 2019-Dec. 5, 2022.
- Baylor set a school-record streak of 65-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 (previous record was 25). The streak lasted from Nov. 5, 2019 to Jan 9, 2023 (1,161 Days).
- This is the first season since 2018-19 the Bears have spent more than one week ranked outside the top 25 in the AP or Coaches Poll

THE BIG 12'S MOST WINS IN CONFERENCE CHALLENGES

Baylor is 14-5 in conference challenges – 8-2 in Big 12/SEC Challenge, 3-1 in Big 12/Pac-12, 3-2 in Big 12/Big East.

• Baylor's 14-5 record in conference challenges (Big 12-Big East, Big 12/SEC, Big 12/Pac-12) is best in the Big 12, followed by Kansas at 12-8, OSU at 11-8, Iowa State at 11-8, Texas Tech at 11-9, OU at 10-9, Texas at 8-9, TCU at 8-7, K-State at 7-11 and WVU at 5-10.

SUCCESS IN TOURNAMENTS

- Baylor is 43-14 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including titles in 4 of the last 6 tournaments.
- BU is 30-6 in its 11 regular-season tournaments since 2013-14, going 3-1, 3-1, 3-1, 4-0, 4-0, 3-1, 3-0, 3-0, 1-1, 2-0 and 1-1
- BU advanced to championship games in the 2007 Paradise Jam (won), 2008 76 Classic (lost), 2011 Las Vegas Classic (won), 2013 Maui Invitational (lost), 2014 Las Vegas Invitational (lost), 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis (won), 2017 Hall of Fame Classic (won), 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational (won), 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis (won), the 2023 Preseason NIT (won) and the Baha Mar Bahamas Championship (Lost)
- Baylor has won seven regular-season tournament titles under Drew 2023 NIT Season Tip-Off, 2021 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2019 Myrtle Beach Invitational, 2017 Hall of Fame Classic, 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis, 2011 Las Vegas Classic and 2007 Paradise Jam.

SCOTT DREW COACHING TREE

- Five current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew's BU staff.
- Jerome Tang is in his third year as head coach at Kansas State. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 19 years with Drew.
- Grant McCasland is in his second season as head coach at Texas Tech. He spent five years as a Baylor assistant before taking over as Arkansas State head coach for one season in 2016-17.
- Matthew Driscoll is in his 16th season as head coach at North Florida after six seasons as a Baylor assistant.
 Paul Mills is in his second season as head coach at Wichita State. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 14 years with Drew, the final eight as an assistant coach.
- John Jakus is set to begin his first season at Florida Atlantic after seven seasons on the Baylor bench as an assistant, also sereving as a graduate assistant for Drew from 2012-14.
- All four former assistants have led their teams to NCAA Tournaments Driscoll led UNF to the 2015 NCAA Tournament, while McCasland took UNT to the 2021 Second Round and Mills took ORU to the 2021 Sweet 16.
- Additionally, McCasland led North Texas to the NIT Championship in 2023, prior to leaving for Texas Tech.
- Drew is 1-4 all time when facing a former assistant as a head coach.

PROTECTING HALFTIME LEADS

- Baylor is 137-16 when leading at halftime since the start of 2017-18.
- Baylor has won 90% of its games (252-29) when leading at the half in the last 14 seasons ... 8-1 in 2024-25, 19-2 in 2023-24, 19-5 in 2022-23 20-3 in 2021-22, 24-0 in 2020-21, 21-2 in 2019-20, 15-3 in 2018-19, 15-0 in 2017-18, 18-3 in 2016-17, 18-2 in 2015-16, 21-7 in 2014-15, 18-2 in 2013-14, 17-1 in 2012-13 and 26-1 in 2011-12.
- BU has won 42% of games in which it's been tied or trailing at the half since 2011-12, going 71-98 in those.

THIRD-MOST WINS AMONG BIG 12 TEAMS IN LAST 14 YEARS

- Baylor's 328-132 record since 2011-12 trails only Kansas (365-97) and Arizona (352-111) among Big 12 teams.
- Houston (326-126) is fourth, Cincinnati (314-137) is fifth, BYU (309-145) is sixth, Colorado (283-173) is seventh, lowa State (278-171) is eighth, West Virginia (264-186) is ninth, Kansas State (258-189) is 10th, Texas Tech (253-188) is 11th, Utah (241-194) is 12th, Oklahoma St. (237-201) is 13th, UCF (237-182) is 14th, Arizona State (236-196) is 15th, and TCU (236-209) is 16th.
- Baylor has averaged 24.5 wins per season over the last 13 seasons since 2011-12.

• Games are broadcast by the "Voice of the Bears" **John Morris**, who was named NSMA 2019 Texas co-Sportscaster of the Year on Jan. 13, 2020, and Baylor Hall of Famer **Pat Nunley**.

In early November, Morris was awarded the 2024 Chris Schenkel Award by the National Football Foundation
 First presented in 1995, the guard recognizer individuals who have had loss distinguished early had dealer.

• First presented in 1996, the award recognizes individuals who have had long, distinguished careers broadcasting college football with direct ties to a specific university or platform

• Morris is in his 41st year doing BU broadcasts (30th full-time), and Nunley is in his 44th season as analyst.

• A year after his Baylor Hall of Fame indiction, **Nunley** was honored by the Baylor Chamber of Commerce with the Frank Fallon Award prior to the season.

• The award, named for Nunley's longtime broadcast partner, Frank Fallon, is presented annually to someone who has made a significant impact on basketball in McLennan County.

At 30 years together, Morris and Nunley rank in the top-5 of the longest radio duo's in men's college basketball

OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING A BAYLOR STAPLE

- Baylor ranks 12th in the nation in offensive rebounding percentage (38.6%)
- BU has ranked top-13 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage in nine of the last 11 seasons since 2013-14, including six times ranked in the nation's top-5. The Bears only cracked the top-20 once in Drew's first 10 years.
- Baylor finished ranked No. 24 nationally in 2023-24, No. 22 nationally in 2022-23, No. 13 nationally in 2021-22, No. 5 nationally in 2020-21, No. 8 in 2019-20, No. 2 in 2018-19, No. 9 in 2017-18, No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16, No. 1 in 2014-15 and No. 3 in 2013-14. Prior to that streak, BU's best rank was No. 16 in 2011-12.

BREAKTHROUGH IN BIG 12

- BU is 164-100 in Big 12 play in 15 seasons since 2010 after going 59-149 in the league's first 13 seasons.
- BU is 178-118 in Big 12 play in 17 seasons since 2008 after going 45-131 in the league's first 11 seasons.
- Baylor is 64-53 in Big 12 road games since 2012, second-best in the league behind only Kansas (70-46).
- BU is 30-15 in Big 12 Road games since 2019-20, The best mark in the league in that span
- BU has won 8+ Big 12 games in 13-straight seasons after winning 8+ just 3 times in the league's first 15 years.
- BU has double-digit Big 12 wins in six-straight seasons, 8 of the last 9 years and 10 of the last 14 seasons. BU didn't reach double-digit Big 12 wins in any of its first 13 years in the league before reaching 10+ for the first time in 2010.

DREW IS THIRD BIG 12 COACH TO REACH 150 CONFERENCE WINS

- Scott Drew joined Rick Barnes and Bill Self as the only coaches to reach 150 Big 12 wins on March 4, 2021 vs. OSU.
- Drew needed 136 games over 2,940 days for his first 50 Big 12 wins (50-86), 88 games over 1,821 days for his

next 50 Big 12 wins (50-38) and only 77 games over 1,493 days for his next 50 Big 12 wins (50-27).

IMPRESSIVE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS AT HOME

- Baylor is 94-4 in its last 94 non-conference home games dating back to Dec. 12, 2012.
- Baylor is 158-16 in non-conference home games in the Drew era, including 125-8 since 2007-08.
- Baylor is 75-8 in home games against unranked opponents (including Big 12 play) since 2016.

GRADUATING 91 PERCENT OF SENIORS

- Since **Scott Drew** took over the Baylor Basketball program in 2003, 40 of 44 scholarship players who have played their final years of collegiate eligibility under Drew have graduated from Baylor.

BEST IN TEXAS

Baylor is 88-25 against in-state opponents since the start of the 2011-12 season, and the Bears have advanced deeper into postseason play than any of Texas' 23 Division I teams in five of the last ten seasons.
BU is a combined 102-29 against Lone Star State teams over the last 16 seasons after going 10-27 against in-state teams in Scott Drew's first six seasons at Baylor (4-0 in 2024-25, 3-3 in 2023-24, 5-2 in 2022-23, 5-2 in 2021-22, 6-0 in 2020-21, 6-1 in 2019-20, 4-5 in 2018-19, 6-3 in 2017-18, 7-1 in 2016-17, 9-3 in 2015-16, 10-1 in 2014-15, 6-3 in 2013-14, 7-1 in 2012-13, 10-0 in 2011-12, 5-3 in 2010-11 and 9-1 in 2009-10).
Additionally, 13 of the 36 NBA Draft picks from Texas colleges since 2012 have come from Baylor. Texas (seven),

Houston (five), SMU (three), Texas Tech (three), Texas A&M (two), North Texas (one), TCU (one) and UT Arlington (one) have also had players selected in the last 13 NBA Drafts.

FEELING FINE AT FOSTER

- Baylor and the City of Waco have partnered on a \$700 million riverfront development project, headlined by the \$212 million Foster Pavilion, the home of Baylor's national champion basketball programs.
- The Allison Development Centers for both basketball programs are included in the 245k square foot Foster Pavilion project were completed in the summer of 2024.
- Foster Pavilion (capacity 7,500) is located along the Brazos River on the opposite side of I-35 from McLane Stadium.
- BU MBB beat Cornell 98-79 in the first game at Foster Pavilion, while the BU women's team beat TCU 71-50 the following night in their first game in the new building.

BIG 12 BOASTS SOME OF THE BEST

- The new-look Big 12 is first conference to have 5 of the top 10 teams in the preseason AP Poll. In total, six Big 12 teams were ranked in the preseason top 25, which is the most in conference history.
- The league has led the way with four-straight years leding all conferences in average Net Rating
- The Big 12 has also led the nation in Conference RPI in each of the last four seasons and 9 of the last 11 seasons
- The conference had a Big 12 record eight teams make the NCAA Tournament last season
