### Men's Basketball

- Baylor wraps up its two game homestand against Kansas State in an 8 p.m. tip on ESPNU
- Wednesday is Baylor's "Immortal 10" game. where they will honor the 10 players killed in a bus accident in Georgetown, Texas on Jan. 22, 1927.
- Baylor welcomes in the Wildcats and Jerome Tang, who spent 19 years as an assistant at Baylor and was an original member of Scott Drew's staff.
- Five of Baylor's six losses have come against teams that have been ranked in the top-10 at some point this season, while Gonzaga, Tennessee, UConn and Iowa State have been ranked in the top 3.
- Robert Wright ranks fifth among Power-5 freshmen averaging 4.8 assists per game.
- With 82 assists, Wright is on pace to set the freshman assists record held by John Lucas III (120).

# Women's Basketball

- The Bears wrapped up a 2-1 week, including a ranked win over No. 23 Utah, 70-61, at Foster Pavilion in their first ranked match up of the season. Bella Fontleroy and Jada Walker each compiled double-doubles and Yaya Felder got her second start as a Bear.
- Against Houston, BU had a hot start that held the Coogs to nine in the first quarter en route to Baylor's fifth-straight and sixth overall conference win.
- WBB fell to the No. 1-ranked UCLA Bruins on Monday afternoon at the Prudential Center in Newark, N.J. UCLA had a quick 15-0 run that the Bears answered with a 7-0 run that kept BU within striking distance.
- Baylor is back in the grind with a roadtrip to Fort Worth to face No. 9 TCU at 2 p.m. on Sunday.
   The game will be broadcast on ESPN2 with Eric Frede and Rebecca Lobo on the call.
- BU is back in the AP Top 25 poll for the fourth time this season, moving in at No. 25, while getting bumped up to No. 23 in the Coaches Poll.
- Sarah Andrews moved to No. 2 all-time in games played as a Bear at 150 against Utah and took lone possession of No. 3 in assists against UH, passing Didi Richards' 568 from 2017-21.

# Track & Field

- T&F left the Corky Classic in Lubbock, Texas with a multitude of PRs and two new program records.
- Tiriah Kelley finished in 1st place and broke the program record in the women's 200m with a time of 22.73 which ranks her No. 1 in the World in the event for the 2025 season.
- Kelley won Big 12 Female Athlete of the Week.
- JL Van Rensburg, a freshman from South Africa, made his collegiate debut with a programbreaking throw of 62-3 in the men's shot put to finish 3rd overall.
- Molly Haywood continues to shine as she finished 1st in women's pole vault for the second meet in a row, breaking her indoor PR with a 14-5.5 mark.
- T&F takes the week to prepare for its next meet at the Deloss Dodds Invite in Manhattan, Kan., on Jan. 31-Feb. 1.

# Women's Golf

- No 27 WGOLF opens its spring season on Monday at the Match in the Desert.
- BU is one of seven teams in the one-day 36-hole shootout and are joined by No. 7 Arizona State, No. 14 Texas A&M and No. 24 Kansas.

# Men's Tennis

- MT hosted two top-5 teams over the weekend with No. 4 Wake Forest and No. 2 TCU to start out its season 2-2.
- Facing off against TCU as a non-conference match, the Bears put up a nearly three-and-halfhour battle but ultimately fell 4-1.
- Marko Miladinovic has started his spring going 3-0 in singles.
- The Bears prepare for their first away match as they travel to Dallas to face off against SMU on Sunday at 4 pm.

### Women's Tennis

- Baylor opened the season with a 7-0 victory over Harvard on Sunday morning at the Hawkins Indoor Tennis Center.
- The win gives BU its seventh lid-lifting dub in the last 10 seasons.
- 13th-ranked Luba Kostenko and Cristina Tiglea joined Bear newcomers Na Dong and Kennedy Gibbs in securing the doubles point for BU, with a dominating 6-1 decision for Kostenko and Tiglea.
- All six doubles points found straight-set wins, taking care of the Crimson in quick fashion.
- Freshmen No. 76 Dong and No. 118 Wenfei Yu had their first dual-match wins of their college career while Tiglea and Gibbs picked up their first dual match wins as Bears.
