# **Acrobatics & Tubling**

- Top-ranked A&T dominated No. 5 UMHB on the road on Saturday, winning by 20+ points.
- The Bears led throughout the meet, and dropped just two heats to the Cru.
- Baylor will host LIU on Saturday at 5 p.m. for the first time in program history for the home opener.

#### Baseball

- Opens its 2025 season with an eight-game homestand, beginning this weekend with a three-game series against Youngstown State.
- Baylor returns 22 players from its 2024 roster, including six position player starters, and welcomes 18 newcomers.
- BU has 17 seniors in their fourth season of college baseball or more, including six fifth-year players and three sixth-year players.
- The Bears are led by their outfield trio of Enzo Apodaca, Ty Johnson and Wesley Jordan, who accounted for nearly 36% of the team's offense a year ago.

# **Equestrian**

- The No. 10 Bears fell to No. 7 Fresno State on the road on Friday.
- Madison Mitchell earned the MOP in Fences with an 83.5 score, while Lauren Jorgensen had a team-high 84.5-point ride in the same event.
- BU has the second-to-last home meet on Saturday when they host No. 5 Oklahoma State for a conference meet at 12 p.m.

# **Indoor Track & Field**

- Molly Haywood had a historic day on Saturday, breaking the BU indoor program record in women's pole vault and also the meet and facility record at 15" 0.25'.
- Haywood broke her PR three times on Saturday and became the first Baylor woman to join the 15-feet club in indoor program history.
- After matching the program record three times already, Demario Prince finally overcame the hurdle and broke the meet, facility and program record in the 60-meter hurdles with a time of 7.57 and won his second consecutive title in the event.
- The Bears will compete in their final regular season meet this upcoming weekend at the Jarvis Scott Open in Lubbock.

# Softball

- BU went 3-2 during opening weekend at the Aggie Classic, defeating ACU, Purdue and Villanova.
- Turiya Coleman led the Bears offensively with a .583 batting average, as the team batted .341 as a whole.
- Up next the Bears will host the Getterman Classic Feb. 14-16 in Waco with Oklahoma and Hofstra.

# Women's Basketball

- Baylor piled on wins at Houston and against BYU last week to sit in a tie for first place in the Big 12 regular season standings. The Bears' 10-2 record knots them with No. 12 K-State and No. 9 TCU with six games to go.
- Within the first 30 seconds of play at Houston, Darianna Littlepage-Buggs became Baylor's seventh player on the 2024-25 roster to eclipse 1,000 career points.
- BU hosts No. 18 West Virginia as the highest ranked foe so far this season on Tuesday night at Foster Pavilion before heading to Lubbock to play Texas Tech on Saturday afternoon.

# Men's Basketball

- MBB hits the road for a Big Monday matchup with No. 5/5 Houston at 8 p.m. on ESPN.
- Last time out, Baylor cruised to a 91-76 over UCF, it's most points in a regulation Big 12 game since rolling up 93 on Texas on March 4, 2024.
- Baylor's VJ Edgcombe (1 game) and Langston Love (10 games) returned from injury to give Baylor 17 and 16 points, respectively.
- Norchad Omier led the way for Baylor with 18 points and 12 rebounds, securing his 80th career double-double, tying him with Drexel's Malik Rose for the eighth-most in NCAA history.
- Omier's 12 double-doubles are the most by a Baylor Bear in a season since Jo Lual-Acuil had 13 in 2017-18.

# Men's Tennis

- MT split road matches over the weekend 1-1, winning at Nebraska 4-2 and falling at #4 Ohio State 4-1
- Reigning Big 12 POTW Oskar Brostrom Poulsen remains undefeated in singles at 6-0.
- The Bears won the doubles point at OSU, grabbing wins over two ranked Buckeyes duos.
- BU now prepares to host the opening two rounds and backdraw third round of the ITA Indoor Championships this weekend with the Bears slated to begin at 6:30 pm on Feb. 14.

# Women's Golf

- No. 30 WG won the PDI Intercollegiate last week with a 30-under 834, which ranks as the secondbest score in relation to par in program history.
- BU's 834 is the third-best 54-hole tournament score in school history.

# Women's Tennis

- Baylor had a 2-0 trip on the west coast in San Diego, defeating SDSU 6-1 and USD 4-3 over the weekend.
- Freshman Na Dong continued her undefeated streak in dual match singles play, going five matches into her career without a loss.
- BU continues the roadtrip in a match against Illinois on Saturday afternoon. First serve is scheduled for 3:30 p.m.
