STORYLINES LEADING OFF

· Baylor Baseball returns to the friendly confines of Baylor Ballpark on Tuesday, embarking on a five-game homestand ahead of Big 12 Conference play.

• The Bears welcome Tarleton on Tuesday night, then host Loyola Marymount for a three-game weekend series, and round out the stretch in Waco against Sam Houston on Tuesday, March 11.

• BU is coming off a 1-2 weekend at the Amegy Bank College Baseball Series, where the Bears went toe-to-toe with No. 8 Oregon State on Friday night, defeated a scrappy Ohio State ballclub on Saturday and fell short to No. 25 Auburn in Sunday's weekend finale despite a late comeback bid.

• Baylor is off to an 8-3 start to begin the season, marking the 12th time in the last 30 seasons (since 1995) that the team has won at least eight of its first 11 games to open the year -- 1998 (8-3), 2000 (9-2), 2001 (8-3), 2003 (8-3), 2006 (8-3), 2008 (10-1), 2009 (9-2), 2012 (8-3), 2017 (10-1), 2019 (9-2) and 2020 (8-3).

• Baylor returns 22 players from its 2024 roster, including six position player starters, and welcomes 18 newcomers.

• BU has 16 seniors on its 2025 roster, including six fifth-year players and three sixth-year players.

• The Bears are led by the outfield trio of seniors -- Enzo Apodaca, Ty Johnson and Wesley Jordan, who accounted for nearly 36% of the team's offense a year ago (176 of 491 hits)

 Baylor plays a combined 13 games against five NCAA Tournament teams in 2025 and will face 10 30-game winners, including two squads that won 40 or more games last season.

• 46% of the schedule features opponents that finished 2024 with a top-75 RPI.

SERIES HISTORY AGAINST TARLETON

Baylor leads the all-time series against Tarleton, 3-1.

- BU has won each of the last two meetings, including an 11-4 victory last season in Waco.
- The Bears are 2-1 against the Texans under third-year head coach Mitch Thompson.

TUESDAY NIGHT LIGHTS

- Baylor is 18-10 in midweek ballgames under third-year head coach Mitch Thompson.
- BU has won each of its last seven midweek contests dating back to the 2024 season.
- The Bears are 2-0 in midweek games so far in 2025 and 2-0 against other teams from the state of Texas in 2025.

EARLY SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

• Baylor completed its first Opening Weekend sweep since 2019, outscoring Youngstown State 38-11.

 The Bears posted back-to-back shutouts against UTSA and Gonzaga, the team's first consecutive shutouts since April 1-2, 2021.

• BU's bullpen has allowed just 15 earned runs across 48.1 innings of relief, good for a 2.79 ERA.

• Junior LHP Ethan Calder was named the Big 12 Co-Pitcher of the Week after his outstanding Opening Day start in which he struck out 13 batters in just five innings against Youngstown State.

The squad's 3.06 team ERA ranks 24th in the country.

• For the third week in a row, Baylor is currently receiving votes in the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) Top 25 poll. Baylor has not been ranked in a major poll since 2019.

CONTROLLING THE RUNNING GAME

Opponents have attempted to run just three times on Baylor pitchers and catchers, and have been caught stealing twice.

 Meanwhile, the Bears have already stolen 15 bases as a team offensively, over a third of the squad's entire 2024 output (39 stolen bases).

HEALTH CAMP

- After suffering eight season-ending injuries in 2024 and having 17 players miss at least one game due to injury, the Bears are healthy entering the 2025 season.
- Fifth-year senior Hunter Simmons returns after suffering a gruesome lower leg injury in 2024. The former outfielder is expected to see time as a first baseman and designated hitter in 2025.
- After playing just one game in 2024, redshirt sophomore Gavin Brzozowski is back for BU and figures to see time at first base and in the outfield this season.
- Senior infielder Will Pendergrass is fully healthy entering his fifth season of collegiate baseball after suffering back-to-back season-ending injuries in 2023 and 2024.

• The Bears also return former Wichita State transfer Jack Little, who suffered a preseason injury and did not play in 2024.

PRESEASON PRAISE

• Senior outfielder Wesley Jordan was Baylor's lone representative named to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team. In a vote by the league's head coaches, Jordan was tabbed as the designated hitter on the 20-man team.

Two other Bears were tabbed to Perfect Game's list of top-75 players in their class, including fifth-year senior outfielder Enzo Apodaca (#56 Senior) and true freshman right-handed pitcher Brayden Bergman (#42 Freshman).
 Apodaca and Jordan were also each named to the Bobby Bragan National Collegiate Slugger Award Watch List, which

honors the nation's top collegiate hitter on the basis of on-field performance, academic strength and personal integrity.

TOP-TIER TRIO

Baylor is one of just three Big 12 schools (ARIZ, BYU) to return each of its top-three hitters from the 2024 season.
The Bears are led by the senior outfield trio of Enzo Apodaca (.333, 6 HR, 42 RBI), Ty Johnson (.313, 2 HR, 20 RBI) and Wesley Jordan (.331, 9 HR, 32 RBI), who combined to account for nearly 36% of the team's offense in 2024 (176 of 491 hits).

YOU GO, WE GO, 'ZO!

• In 2024, Enzo Apodaca served as a true tablesetter for the Bears, hitting in the leadoff spot in 37 of BU's 53 games.

- Apodaca either scored a run or drove in a run in 60 of the 108 times (56%) he reached base last season.
- In the 159 innings that Baylor scored a run in 2024, Apodaca reached base in 76 of them (48%).
- Apodaca ranked as the toughest Big 12 hitter to strike out, fanning once every 11.1 at-bats in 2024.

ON-BASE MACHINE

• Senior OF Wesley Jordan's 38-game on-base streak was snapped Friday (Feb. 21) against Gonzaga.

• Jordan's streak was the second-longest by a Bear in the StatCrew Era (since 2003), trailing only David Murphy's modern-era record of 42 straight in 2003.

CALLING ON CALDER

• Ethan Calder picked up Big 12 Co-Pitcher of the Week honors after his outstanding Opening Day start, in which he tossed five innings and allowed just one run on two hits and a walk, while striking out 13.

• His 13 strikeouts were the most by a Bear on Opening Day since at least 2003, and the most by a Bear in any start since Logan Verrett fanned 14 on March 11, 2011, in a complete game against Louisiana Tech.

- Calder followed up his Opening Day brilliance with seven shutout innings against Gonzaga, tying a career-high.
- A 2024 All-Big 12 honorable mention selection, Calder returned the second-lowest ERA among any returning qualified pitchers in the Big 12 (min. 1 IP/GP) after sporting a 3.23 ERA a year ago.

• A versatile weapon out of the bullpen in 2024, Calder racked up two scoreless streaks of six outings each last season and worked nine outings of at least two innings.

• He posted an impressive 41 strikeouts to just 12 walks (3.42 SO:BB ratio), just nearly cracking Baylor's all-time leaderboard for single-season strikeout to walk ratio.

• The junior southpaw slides into BU's Friday night starting role after making three starts last season (1-1, 4.70 ERA in 15.1 IP as a starter in 2024).

BALES JOINS THE BEARS

• Sixth-year senior left-handed pitcher Bryson Bales joins Baylor for his final year of eligibility after a stellar summer in the Cape Cod League, where he was a league champion with the Harwich Mariners and posted a 2.95 ERA with 21 strikeouts in 21.1 innings pitched.

• Bales comes to Waco after pitching two seasons at Division III Hendrix College in Conway, Ark., where he compiled a 3.96 ERA across 77.1 innings in two seasons. He went 5-2 across 15 career starts with 88 strikeouts and 41 walks with the Warriors.

• He punched out eight batters in four innings in his Baylor debut, including each of the first seven hitters he faced.

GRANDPA STASIO

• Fifth-year senior righty Cole Stasio returns from a season-ending injury and has earned the Sunday starter spot in Baylor's weekend rotation.

• Though Stasio struggled in three short appearances in 2024, he has been one of the more reliable relievers of the Thompson era with 33 appearances and 44.1 IP across 2022 and 2023.

• Stasio owns a career 4-2 record with one save and has struck out 36 batters and walked 25 in 47.1 career innings entering the 2025 season.

2025 BAYLOR BASEBALL GAME NOTES NEW IMPACT ARMS

• Three of BU's junior college additions were selected among the Top Impact JUCO Transfer pitchers this preseason in RHP Lucas Davenport (#45, D1Baseball), LHP Caleb Jameson (#10, D1Baseball; #22, Prep Baseball) and LHP Stefan Stahl (#8, D1Baseball; #18 Prep Baseball).

• Davenport brings a championship pedigree after serving as the staff ace for Blinn College, the 2024 junior college national champions. He posted a 3.75 ERA and 10-2 record across 16 starts and 103.1 innings pitched with 86 strikeouts and 23 walks.

• Jameson went 3-0 with a 1.59 ERA in 17 innings as a sophomore at Paris JC and was named a 2023 Texas-New Mexico JUCO All-Star.

• Stahl went a perfect 5-0 with 99 strikeouts across 67 innings in two seasons at Waco's McLennan CC.

A STABLE OF SOUTHPAWS

The Bears have seven left-handed pitchers on their 2025 roster, a drastic increase from carrying just one in 2023.
Ethan Calder, who began his career as a walk-on outfielder, headlines the stable of lefties. A 2024 honorable

mention All-Big 12 selection as a relief pitcher, Calder will slide into the Bears' rotation to start the 2025 campaign.
Also returning are sophomores Mason Green (15 appearances, 8 starts, 40.0 IP) and RJ Ruais (22 appearances, 2 starts, 34.2 IP), who were among BU's most used arms in 2024.

 BU added junior college transfers in junior Caleb Jameson (Paris JC) and junior Stefan Stahl (McLennan CC), as well as sixth-year senior Bryson Bales, a Division I bounceback from Hendrix College who began his career at Louisiana Tech.
 Talented freshman Carson Bailey rounds out the left-handed portion of Baylor's pitching staff.

THE RIGHT SIDE, WHERE OLD MEETS NEW

• All six of the returning right-handed arms on the Baylor pitching staff are seniors, including three fifth-years (Drew Leach, Andrew Petrowski, Cole Stasio) and two sixth-years (Gabe Craig, Patrick Hail). Will Glatch is the lone "traditional" senior right-hander returning to the roster.

• Seven newcomers make up the remainder of the RHPs, including four freshmen (Cayden Baker, Brayden Bergman, Camden Clewett, Jack Hickerson), two junior college transfers (Lucas Davenport, Grayson Murry) and one transfer portal addition (Caleb Bunch).

BEARS IN THE BIGS

• Baylor Baseball saw five of its alumni compete in Major League Baseball in 2024 -- Cody Bradford (TEX), Shea Langeliers (ATH), Nick Loftin (KC), Max Muncy (LAD) and Davis Wendzel (CIN), who debuted with the Texas Rangers.

- Muncy became the first Bear in program history to win two World Series titles.
- There have now been 48 Bears all-time that have reached the big leagues.

SNED EFFECT

• Baylor introduced Sean Snedeker as the program's new pitching coach on June 12, 2024. A 31-year coaching veteran, "Sned" brings 18 years of experience as a collegiate pitching coach to Waco after spending the last seven seasons at Lamar. Prior to his time with the Cardinals, Snedeker made stops at Oral Roberts (2013-17) and Duke (2007-12) after a 13-year career in professional baseball.

• During his time at the college level, Snedeker has produced 39 MLB draft picks, six All-Americans, five conference pitchers of the year and 29 all-conference selections.

• At each of his three previous collegiate stops, Snedeker has led a pitching staff to a top-10 ERA ranking nationally, including Lamar in 2024 (3.74, 2nd) and 2023 (3.96, 6th), Oral Roberts in 2017 (3.06, 6th) and Duke in 2008 (3.71, 6th).

THE DREAM TEAM

Head coach Mitch Thompson has assembled an all-star cast of assistant coaches and support staff members, bringing home former Baylor greats Zach Dillon and Jim Blair, as well as familiar faces in Darin Thomas and Brian Furlong.
Dillon, a 2005 Baylor graduate, was hired as Thompson's hitting coach and recruiting coordinator. The starting catcher on the Bears' '05 College World Series team, Dillon later served as the volunteer assistant coach for BU in 2012. As a player, he was an integral part of three NCAA Tournament squads, two NCAA Super Regionals, and the CWS berth in 2005. He was a two-time All-Big 12 selection and was named the 2006 Big 12 Player of the Year, as well as a semifinalist for the Johnny Bench Award.

• Blair, a member of Thompson's first recruiting class at Baylor, is a 2000 Baylor graduate who owns the program's longest hitting streak, a 31-game stretch that lasted over parts of two seasons.

• Thomas, the director of baseball operations, served as the head coach at UT Arlington for the last 15 years before joining his longtime friend, Mitch Thompson, in Waco. He won over 400 games as the Mavericks' head man.

• Furlong, the director of player development, is a longtime friend of Zach Dillon and teamed up with the Bears after four seasons as the pitching coach at Xavier.
