CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES

- Five Big 12 teams are ranked in this week's AP Top 25 Poll. No. 2 Houston, No. 9 Texas Tech, No. 15 Iowa State, No. 17 BYU and No. 21 Arizona comprise the Conference's ranked teams.
- Seven Big 12 teams were selected to the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship. It marks the 11th consecutive tournament that the Big 12 has sent at least six to the Big Dance.
- Six more teams were selected to the College Basketball Crown or the NIT, giving the Big 12 a total of 13 postseason teams.
- The Big 12 is a combined 16-5 in the First Round over the past three seasons, and has sent multiple teams to the second weekend in each of those seasons.
- During non-conference play, the Big 12 posted a 59-18 (.766) record against teams who made the field of 68.
- Houston was awarded a No. 1 seed, marking the fifth consecutive year and the 17th season out of 28 the Big 12 has had a team on the top seed line.
- The Cougars won the Big 12's automatic bid by virtue of their first Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship title, and representing the program's first postseason conference championship since 2022.
- Emanuel Sharp of Houston was the Most Outstanding Player of the 2025 Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship. He is joined on the all-tournament team by teammates LJ Cryer and Milos Uzan, plus Caleb Love (Arizona) and JT Toppin (Texas Tech).
- Houston won the Big 12 regular season title outright. The Cougars are the first team in a century to join an existing major conference and win a regular season men's basketball title its first two years in the league.
- Houston was the first major conference team to win 22 games in the regular season and conference championship combined. Duke matched the number a few hours after Houston in the ACC title game.
- All 16 Big 12 teams have an AP Top 25 win this season. The Big 12 is the only Conference with every member posting a Top 25 win.
- Five Big 12 players were named All-Americans by the Associated Press, and 18 Big 12 players were named to their respective NABC All-District teams. For a complete list of all awards and watch lists, see Page 6.
- Texas Tech's JT Toppin was named Big 12 Player and Newcomer of the Year to highlight the 2024-25 Phillips 66 All-Big 12 men's basketball awards, voted on by the league's head coaches.
- UH's Joseph Tugler (defensive player), LJ Cryer (Scholar-Athlete) and Kelvin Sampson (coach) earned league superlatives after a 19-1 regular season. BU's VJ Edgcombe (freshman), BYU's Richie Saunders (most improved) and ISU's Curtis Jones (sixth man) completed the Conference's superlatives.
