Acrobatics & Tumbling

- No. 1 A&T earned the top seed in the NCATA Championships, which are set for Thursday-Sunday at Augustana (South Dakota).
- This marked the fourth straight No. 1 seed for the Bears, who are looking to win a 10th consecutive national title.
- The Bears will face No. 8 seeded Limestone in the first round at 4:30 p.m. CT.

Baseball

- Went 3-1 last week, including a series win over Utah, and improved to 8-10 in Big 12 play, now sitting in a tie for 7th place in the league standings.
- Senior INF Tyriq Kemp was named to the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List, which honors the nation's top shortstop. He hit .500 on the week (7-for-14) and drove in all four Baylor runs on Friday night in the 4-3 victory, including the go-ahead home run in the bottom of the eighth.
- Sixth-year senior RHP Gabe Craig was named to the College Baseball Foundation National Pitcher of the Year Watch List and racked up his first two wins of the season this week. He owns a 0.95 ERA and a 30:2 strikeout to walk ratio.
- The Bears opened the week with a Tuesday night, 9-1 win over Houston Christian and will venture to face a stout TCU squad in a threegame series, starting Friday.

Track & Field

- T&F hosted the 2025 Michael Johnson Invitational on Friday and Saturday, April 18-19.
- The Bears took six titles over the weekend including a multitude of season-best and personal-best marks.
- Baylor recognized its 25 seniors on Saturday morning.
- The women's team is ranked No. 6 for the second week in a row, with four event groups (long jump, pole vault, 100m, 400mH) being ranked inside the top-5.
- The Bears head to UCF this weekend for the Knights Invite.

Softball

- The Bears went 1-2 last weekend in a series in Tempe, Ariz., facing Arizona State, and posted a midweek win on Tuesday over Texas State.
- Baylor has six games remaining in the regularseason, featuring three-game tests vs. BYU and lowa State.
- Senior 1B Shaylan Govan shattered the BU program standard for career walks in the win over Texas State, collecting her 134th walk of a decorated career.

Men's Golf

- MGOLF opened play as the No. 13 seed in the Big 12 Championship, which runs Tues.-Thurs., At Southern Hills Country Club in Tulsa, Okla.
- After day one on Tuesday, the Bears sit in 13th place and Davis Ovard led the way for BU with a tie for ninth place.
- BU is coming off a fourth-place finish at the 2024 Big 12 Championship, its best since 2002.

Women's Golf

- WGOLF finished 11th at the Big 12 Championship, clinching a .500 mark for the season at 67-67-3.
- The Bears will learn of their postseason destination on Wednesday at 12 p.m. during the NCAA Women's Golf Selection Show on Golf Channel.

Men's Tennis

- No. 18 BU went 1-1 on the weekend as the Bears hosted the Big 12 Tennis Championship.
- No. 3 seeded BU took down the No. 6 seeded Sun Devils in sweeping fashion 4-0 before falling to No. 2 seed Arizona 4-2.
- Baylor awaits to see its postseason fate for the NCAA First/Second Rounds, which will be held from May 2-4.

Women's Tennis

- The No. 22 Bears went 1-1 in the Big 12
 Championships last week in Waco, earning a 4-3 win over No. 30 Arizona, before falling to Big 12 co-champion No. 15 Texas Tech , 4-2 on Friday.
- Baylor now awaits NCAA Tournament selection, with the field revealed next week. The tournament starts on May 2 on 16 campus sites.
- BU men's and women's tennis teams will co-host the NCAA Team Championships May 15-18 in Waco.
