Baseball

- Went 2-2 last week with a 15-4 midweek win at Sam Houston and a 7-4 win over Arizona State in Friday's series opener.
- BU owns 11 come-from-behind victories this season.
- Senior INF Tyriq Kemp currently owns a 23-game on-base streak and redshirt senior OF Enzo Apodaca leads the team with an active 14-game hitting streak.
- Sixth-year senior closer Gabe Craig has not allowed a run over his last 12.1 innings pitched (seven-straight scoreless outings) and has lowered his season ERA to 0.75.

Track and Field

- Wrapped its regular outdoor season on Saturday in College Station at the Alumni Muster.
- The Bears won six event titles and broke seven meet records and two program records.
- Freshman thrower Igor Olaru shattered the hammer throw program record once again, this time earning gold with his 217-10 mark. Olaru holds seven of BU's top-10 hammer performances in just his freshman season
- Junior Tiriah Kelley ran for a collegiate wind legal time of 22.34 (3.5 m/s) in the 200m, breaking the program record and earning the No. 3 time in the NCAA this season.
- BU has an off-weekend to prepare for the postseason as the Big 12 Outdoor Championships run from May 15-17 in Lawrence, Kansas.

Softball

- Went 1-2 on the weekend dropping its last series of the regular season against lowa State.
- The Bears are now heading to the Big 12 Softball Championship as the No. 8 seed and will face No. 9 seed Kansas in its first game on Wednesday, May 7 at 2:30 PM.
- Shaylon Govan ended the regular season as the Big 12 Batting Champion for her .453 conference batting average, the highest in the Big 12.

Men's Tennis

- No. 19 Baylor dropped a heartbreaker in College Station in the Second Round of the NCAA Tournament on Sunday to No. 18 Texas A&M, 4-3
- The Bears competed in a nearly three-and-half-hour battle against the Aggies after dropping the doubles point and rallying back in singles but were unable to hold off the Aggie momentum with the match coming down to Court One.
- BU defeated No. 41 Nebraska 4-1 on Saturday in the First Round.
- Baylor had five Bears earn postseason All-Big 12 honors, including Alexandru Chirita being named Big 12 Newcomer of the Year. Additionally, Devin Badenhorst and Zsombor Velcz earned a spot on the All-Big 12 First Team in singles. Doubles pairs of Oskar Brostrom Poulsen/ Marko Miladinovic and Devin Badenhorst/Luc Koenig got a spot on the First Team in doubles

Women's Golf

- The Bears opened the NCAA Norman Regional on Monday morning at Jimmie Austin OU Golf Club.
- The threat of inclement weather forced the tournament to go to a 36-hole format on Monday, with the final round to follow on Tuesday or Wednesday.
- BU needs a top-5 finish to advance to its fifth-straight NCAA Championship.
- The Bears are one of just eight programs in the country to make six of the last seven NCAA Championships', and one of nine teams to make four-straight NCAA appearances.

Women's Tennis

- The Bears ended the 2024-25 season in a first-round loss to Boise State, 4-3, in Austin on Friday.
- Na Dong was named Big 12 Newcomer of the Year with a spot on the singles All-Big 12 second team and was joined in conference honors by Luba Kostenko (first team doubles, second team singles) and Cristina Tiglea (first team doubles). Dong ended the season with a 15-match winning streak in singles.
