TEAM NOTES

- This was the 121st all-time meeting in the series. TCU leads the all-time series 60-54-7 with Baylor.
 - This is the most played rivalry game in the state of Texas.
- Baylor head coach Dave Aranda is 35-33 in his sixth year with Baylor.
 - Baylor is 23-26 in conference games in the Aranda era.
 - Baylor is 13-16 in the road under Aranda.
- Baylor has won eight of its last 10 Big 12 Conference games and have won 11 of its last 15 games overall.
- Baylor is 642-630-44 all-time.
- The Bears are 4-1 in day games in 2025 and 24-18 under Aranda.
- BU is 1-1 on natural grass in 2025 and 4-9 under Aranda.
- Baylor is 1-1 in October and 9-10 under Aranda.
- The game was suspended three times for lightning delays for a total of 2 hours and 16 minutes of delayed time.
- Baylor captains: Josh Cameron, Jacob Redding, Kyland Reed, Kole Wilson

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Baylor put up 439 offensive yards, 318 through the air and 121 on the ground.
- Senior QB Sawyer Robertson threw for 25-52-3 and two touchdowns and 318 yards.
 - Robertson has 6,607 yards of total offense in his career, ranking fourth-best in program history and passing Nick Florence (2009-12) and JJ Joe (1990-93).
 - Robertson has been responsible for 57 career TDs, fifth-best in career history.
 - Robertson has 22 TDs responsible for in 2025, ranking one short of 12th place Blake Szymanski (2007).
 - Robertson has thrown for 6,311 yards in his career, ranking fourth-best in BU history and passing Nick Florence (2009-12) and JJ Joe (1990-93).
 - Robertson has 51 career TD passes, ranking fifth-best in BU history and shy of Seth Russell (60 TDs; 2013-16) for fourth.
 - Robertson has thrown 21 TD passes in 2025, entering the top-10 and tying for ninth with Charlie Brewer (2019).
 - Robertson has thrown for at least 300 yards in five games this season and nine times in his career.
- Senior WR Ashtyn Hawkins had his best game since versus SMU earlier this season with seven receptions and a team-leading 95 yards.
- Hawkins hauled in a Baylor career-long reception of 41 yards, his longest reception since 11/25/23.
- Senior WR Josh Cameron ended with a team-high of eight receptions for 86 yards.
 - Cameron has had five games this season with at least 50 receiving yards.
 - Cameron has a career of 141 receptions, ranking 15th in program history.
- Freshman RB Michael Turner had a career-best day with 68 rushing yards on 12 carries, including a long-rush of 13 yards.
- Freshman RB Caden Knighten tied his season/career-best on attempts with 10 carries and collected 42 yards.
- Sophomore RB Bryson Washington ran in for his sixth rushing TD of the season, 18th of his career.
 - Washington ended with 23 yards on 11 carries.
 - Washingon has 1,653 career rushing yards, which ranks 23rd best in program history.
- Sophomore WR Jadon Porter hauled in his first collegiate reception for an 18 yard touchdown, the first of his career.
- Senior WR Kole Wilson made his 37th consecutive game with a reception, third longest active streak in the country.
 - Wilson finished with 53 yards on three catches, including a 12 yard dart into the endzone in the fourth quarter.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- BU allowed TCU to 427 offensive yards, 231 passing and 196 rushing.
- Baylor defense held the Horned Frogs scoreless in the opening quarter, the first time since at Oklahoma State (9/27/25) that BU has held a team scoreless in a quarter.
 - Marked the first time since versus Air Force (9/14/24) that Baylor had allowed zero points in the first quarter.
 - Allowed the Bears to have their second lead of the season after the first 10 minutes.
- Junior LB Keaton Thomas led the team with eight tackles, four being solo, and an assist TFL.
 - Thomas scored his first defensive touchdown of his Baylor career on a fumble recovered for 24 yards into the endzone.
- Redshirt sophomore S Jacob Redding had a career-best day, leading the team along with Cameron, of eight tackles, including a career-best of six solo tackles.
 - Redding also picked up an onside kick recovery in the fourth quarter.
- Senior S Devyn Bobby was third in the lineup with seven total tackles, three being solo.
- · Redshirt junior CB Caldra Williford had a season-high of six tackles, including a team-leading solo tackles of five.
- Redshirt senior DL Cooper Lanz had his second consecutive game with a TFL, ending the day with five tackles, three being solo and a TFL for four yards.

SPECIAL TEAM NOTES

- Redshirt freshman K Connor Hawkins went 2-2 in FGs, making 42 yard and 41 yard field goals.
 - Hawkins is 9-10 in the season, 9-11 in his career, this year in field goal attempts.
 - Marked his first made field goals in the 40-49 range.
- Sophomore P Palmer Williams punted three times for 153 yards with two inside the 20 and two for 50 + yards.
- Williams' has punted nine 50+ yard punts this season, 37 in his career.
- Senior WR Josh Cameron returned for a total of 64 yards with a long return of 54 yards, his longest return of the season.
