STORY LINES

STARTING FIVE

- Baylor looks to bounce back as it continues its road trip at Cincinnati, with tipoff set for 5:30 p.m. CT on ESPN+ and the Baylor Sports Media Network.
- The Bears and Bearcats meet for the fifth time in the all-time series, with Baylor winning every contest after the first in 1982, when Cincinnati won in the 1982 WNIT.
- Ranked No. 1 nationally in 3-point defense, the Bears have held opponents to 22.9% shooting from beyond the arc this season, including 21.8% in Big 12 play.
- At 19-4 overall, Baylor is ranked No. 15 in both the AP Top 25 poll and the USA TODAY Coaches Poll, its 20th straight appearance in the AP poll and 361st over the past 20 seasons, the second most in that span behind UConn.
- BU is hunting its 14th Big 12 regular-season title, tied for the league lead with TCU at 8-2 through 10 games, with five more teams two or fewer games back.

BEARS IN THE NET

- Through games on Feb. 2, Baylor is ranked No. 26 in the NET.
- The Bears are 3-3 against Quadrant 1 opponents, with BU's top win coming against Duke in Paris to open the season.

LAST TIME OUT

- Baylor suffered its first setback in a true road game this season, dropping a league contest to West Virginia 70-60 on Sunday afternoon.
- The Mountaineers forced 30 BU turnovers (T-season high and second-most since 1999) and converted them into 38 points, and they held BU to its fewest field goals made (14) in the Nicki Collen era. Forty-five percent (27 points) of Baylor's 60 points came at the free-throw line.
- Darianna Littlepage-Buggs had a team-high eight rebounds and Taliah Scott led BU with 18 points.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Baylor is 5-1 this season in true road games, taking a non-conference win at UNLV before league victories at Oklahoma State, Iowa State, Utah and BYU.
- BU has won 16 of its last 19 road tests dating back to the 2023-24 campaign.

"A PROFESSIONAL SCORER"

- Taliah Scott has made an immediate impact for the Bears, scoring 444 points in 22 games, including 32 against No. 19 Iowa and 30 versus Alabama State.
- Scott's 232 points were the third most by a Baylor player through her first 10 games of a season this century (2013-14 Odyssey Sims - 304; 2014-15 Nina Davis - 236).
- The Auburn transfer began the season by scoring 20 or more points in seven consecutive games, the longest season-opening streak in the country. She also became just the third player since 2000 to score 20 or more points in each of at least her first seven games on a new roster, joining Buffalo's Dyaisha Fair (seven in 2019-20) and Idaho's Emily Faurholt (10 in 2003-04).
- Scott scored 12 points in the fourth quarter to lift the Bears over the Blue Devils, going 3-of-6 from the floor in that frame while adding six clutch free throws, earning Big 12 Player of the Week honors while being named a USBWA Ann Meyers Drysdale National Player of the Week.
- In a career first, Scott had a double-double against Southeastern Louisiana with 23 points and a career high 10 assists.
- Scott missed the second half against Texas, the full 40 minutes against Southern and all but 1:49 in the fourth quarter against Texas Tech due to a lower leg injury.
- With an award-winning first week back from injury, Scott was again named Big 12 Player of the Week and a USBWA Ann Meyers Drysdale National Player of the Week after leading Baylor to a top-10 road win with a game-winning jumper

STORY LINES

at Iowa State after sparking a 19-point comeback victory at Oklahoma State, where she went 13-of-15 from the free-throw line. **Scott** averaged 22.5 points per game on the road trip, with a combined 21 free throws and 15 drawn fouls.

- **Scott** is the only DI player this season averaging at least 20.0 points per game while having at least a 90.0 free-throw percentage (min. 100 attempts). No Big 12 player has ever finished a season with such marks.

A BUGGS' LIFE

- A returning honorable mention selection for WBCA All-America, **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** came back to the court for her senior season with a slew of preseason honors: Unanimous Preseason All-Big 12, AP Preseason Honorable Mention All-America, Katrina McClain Power Forward of the Year Watch List, Naismith Trophy Player of the Year Watch List, USBWA Ann Meyers Drysdale Player of the Year Watch List and the Wooden Award Watch List.
- The senior remains, for the second-straight season, the only player in the Big 12 Conference to average a double-double, with 11.0 points and 10.7 rebounds per game.
- The Oklahoma native tied her career-best rebounding mark at No. 10 Iowa State, grabbing 20 boards with seven coming off the offensive glass, powering Baylor to a top-10 road upset.
- **Buggs** had a strong showing against Le Moyne, scoring 20 points in the first half before a double-double finish with 26 points and 11 rebounds.
- **Buggs** picked up her 1,000th career rebound against Colorado, joining an exclusive list of eight other all-time Bears: Suzie Snider Eppers, Sophia Young-Malcolm, Brittney Griner, Kalani Brown, NaLyssa Smith, Nina Davis, Jackie Reiter and Maggie Davis-Stinnett. She currently sits at No. 7 in the BU record book for career rebounds.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE FOSTER

- Baylor went 8-0 at home in non-conference play, completing the third-straight and fourth overall undefeated home non-con schedule in the fifth year of the **Nicki Collen** era.
- BU holds a 27-game win streak in regular season non-league home games, last dropping a Nov. 20, 2022, contest against then-No.19 Maryland, 73-68, at the Ferrell Center.

FRESH FACES

- **Nicki Collen** welcomed six newcomers to the team after losing seven players following the 2024-25 campaign (six graduates, one transfer).
- Baylor returned just 30% of its scoring from last season, with **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** leading all returners with 385 points (46% of returning offense).

Collen's year-after-year scoring percentage returning:
 22-23: 57% > 23-24: 56% > 24-25: 80% > 25-26: 30%

- 529 of Baylor's 685 assists were also lost, with Jada Walker and Sarah Andrews claiming 373 combined. Walker's 170 were the seventh-most single-season assists in program history.
- **Collen** also welcomed three new coaches to the mix during the offseason: **Johnnie Harris**, **Jaelyn Richard Harris** and **Tez Dumars**.
- **Harris** came to Baylor after a head coaching stint at Auburn. **Harris** was an associate head coach on Vic Shaefer's staff at Texas and Mississippi State, making it to the NCAA title game with the Bulldogs in back-to-back 2017 and 2018 seasons while winning WBCA Assistant Coach of the Year in 2018. **Harris** won a national championship with Texas A&M (2011) and advanced to four Sweet 16 appearances with the Aggies.
- **Richard Harris** arrived in Waco after two seasons at Omaha, one season at Gulf Coast State College and a playing career at LSU.
- **Dumars** also joined the assistant coaching ranks, coming from stops at Louisiana Tech, North Texas and West Texas A&M, but spent the 2024-25 season at Kansas State as a graduate assistant manager under long-time Baylor men's associate head coach Jerome Tang.

FOURTH YEAR LEADERSHIP

- Baylor's roster features four players in their fourth season under head coach **Nicki Collen**, the most among Big 12 programs. BYU follows with two, while Kansas, Kansas State, Oklahoma State, TCU and Texas Tech each have one.
- UConn leads major basketball conferences (Power Four + Big East) with five returners in at least their fourth year, while Baylor's four are tied for second with Iowa, Minnesota and Washington.
- **Kyla Abraham**, **Bella Fontleroy** and **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** all signed straight out of high school in an unbroken 2022 recruiting class.
- **Jana Van Gytenbeek** missed Year No. 3 at BU because of injury, but regained a year of eligibility to finish out her collegiate career under Collen.

NIGHTY NIGHT, KNIGHTS

- Baylor defeated UCF, 73-48, at Foster Pavilion to improve to 7-1 in Big 12 play.
- It marked the Bears' 11th conference victory by 25 points or more during the Nicki Collen era.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** recorded her 10th double-double of the season with 13 points and 18 rebounds, knocking down two 3-pointers to tie her career high.
- **Taliah Scott** led all scorers with 22 points for another 20-point performance, while **Kyla Abraham** posted a career-high three steals.
- The Bears forced a season-high 24 turnovers and converted them into 24 points, including 11 off fast breaks, their most since the Oklahoma State game.

DEFENSE TRAVELS

- Baylor's defense dominated Utah in Salt Lake City, allowing eight first-quarter field goals from the Utes before holding the home team to just eight field goals in the remaining 30 minutes of play. It was the fourth time in the **Nicki Collen** era the Bears held a Big 12 opponent to 16 or fewer field goals in the regular season or conference tournament.
- Utah, the nation's eighth-best 3-point shooting team entering the game, was held to three makes from distance off 25 attempts (12%).
- **Bella Fontleroy** tallied her 100th career block in the matchup after three swats, with eight points including a pair of 3-pointers.
- The Bears sunk four first-quarter 3-pointers, their second-most of the season and most so far in league play.
- Triples from **Taliah Scott** and **Kiersten Johnson** and two-point buckets from **Scott** and **Jana Van Gytenbeek** fueled a game-high 10-point run as the second quarter came to a close.
- Redshirt sophomore **Ines Goryanova** made the first appearance of her career, playing 1:28 combined in the second and fourth quarters.
- A few days later, Baylor picked up its first win in Provo since 1978 in a 69-58 decision over the BYU Cougars.

THIS IS BEAR COUNTRY

Waco, Texas

- Waco's metro population is greater than 245,000.
- Baylor's campus spans about 1,000 acres on the Brazos River.
- Baylor moved from Independence, Texas, to Waco in 1886 after merging with Waco University.
- Dr Pepper was invented in Waco in 1885, and the city houses the Dr Pepper Museum in a century-old bottling plant.
- The Waco Suspension Bridge opened in 1870 and was the longest single-span suspension bridge west of the Mississippi River at the time.
- Completed in 1911, the ALICO (Amicable Life Insurance Company) Building was among the tallest skyscrapers west of the Mississippi River and survived the deadly 1953 Waco tornado.
- Waco Mammoth National Monument preserves fossils of 24 Columbian mammoths, the only known nursery herd in North America.
- More than 65% of Snickers, 80% of Skittles and all Starburst sold in North America are produced at the Mars Wrigley plant in Waco.

Chartered in 1845 by the Republic of Texas through the efforts of Baptist pioneers, Baylor is the oldest continually operating university in Texas. Located in Waco, Baylor welcomes students from all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and 90 countries to study a broad range of degrees among its 12 nationally recognized academic divisions.

STORY LINES

- **Scott** powered the Bears' offense with 25 points and five assists, scoring 12 in the final quarter to slam the door shut on the victory.
- BU held BYU to 32.3% shooting and 5-for-30 from three, including just 23.8% in the opening quarter.
- **Fontleroy** contributed 12 points and five rebounds, while **Littlepage-Buggs** collected a team-best nine boards to anchor the paint.

BLOCKED THE BUFFALOES

- Baylor got a four-point win over the Colorado Buffaloes at Foster Pavilion in the Bears' first home game of 2026.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** recorded rebound No. 1,000 in the win, joining an exclusive list of eight other Bears in program history to hit the 1K boards mark in a Baylor uniform:
- **Yuting Deng** paced BU with 13 points, 11 of which came in a three-minute span bridging the end of the third quarter and the start of the fourth when Baylor took the lead for the final time. The stretch was highlighted by a buzzer-beating three to end the third quarter off a **Jana Van Gytenbeek** assist.
- **Bella Fontleroy** and **Kiersten Johnson** each finished with five blocks, tying Fontleroy's career high and marking the first time since Feb. 17, 2016, that a Baylor duo recorded five or more blocks in the same game (Beatrice Mompremier (5) and Alexis Prince (5) vs. Oklahoma State).

HOORAY FOR (WINS IN) AMES

- Baylor picked up its third top-10 road win of the **Nicki Collen** era, and the first since beating Texas in Austin on Dec. 30, 2023, in a 72-70 defeat of No. 10 Iowa State.
- The victory extended BU's Big 12 road winning streak to seven games, dating back to Jan. 29, 2025, at UCF, and gave the Bears 12 wins in their last 13 road conference contests.
- **Taliah Scott** delivered the Bears' victory behind 21 points, all coming in the second half, and the game-winning jumper outside of the paint with two seconds remaining.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** dominated the glass, picking up a career-high-tying 20 rebounds while adding 13 points.
- Baylor had an eight-point lead, its largest of the game, after **Kiersten Johnson's** career-high third three-pointer of the game with 3:18 remaining in the fourth.
- The Bears held the nation's leading scorer to just four points in the second half and limited her to 55% from the field, her lowest shooting percentage of the season and worst since March 5, 2025.

THE LARGEST COMEBACK IN PROGRAM HISTORY

- Baylor erased a 19-point deficit with 11:34 left in the game to defeat the Oklahoma State Cowgirls, 77-68, in Stillwater.
- The 19-point comeback is the largest in Baylor history and at the time was tied for the fourth-largest in the NCAA during the 2025-26 season.
- Baylor became the fifth team in NCAA history to overcome a 19-point deficit with 12 minutes or less remaining in regulation without requiring overtime, and the first to do so since 2017. The Bears' nine-point margin of victory is also the largest among those teams.
- After Oklahoma State built its game-high 19-point lead, the Bears stormed back over the final 11 minutes, outscoring the Cowgirls 36-8. Baylor used a 25-4 run to take the lead on a **Jana Van Gytenbeek** 3-pointer with 3:14 remaining.
- Baylor held Oklahoma State scoreless for 7:34 in the fourth quarter and without a field goal for 7:54, allowing only a single 3-pointer in the final eight minutes.
- In a dominant 29-8 fourth quarter, Baylor shot 75% while holding Oklahoma State to 20%. **Van Gytenbeek**, **Taliah Scott** and **Kayla Nelms** each scored eight points in the quarter, with **Nelms** also grabbing four rebounds. **Yuting Deng** added a pair of steals.

A TRIPLE-DOUBLE FOR JVG

- **Jana Van Gytenbeek** recorded Baylor's eighth all-time triple-double, and the program's first since 2022, with 10 points, 13 assists and 10 rebounds in a 90-36 win over Alabama State. Her standout performance places her alongside Brittney Griner, Alexis Jones, and Jordan Lewis as the only Bears to achieve a triple-double.
- 13 assists were the most for a Bear since Feb. 7, 2023, when **Jaden Owens** had 14 dimes against Oklahoma.
- In a moment that has now gone viral on social media and earned on-air features across national broadcasts, **Taliah Scott's** three free throws pushed Baylor to 67 points, much to the amusement of more than 3,000 elementary and junior high students from 27 local schools attending the annual Future Bears Day game. The young Bear fans' noise peaked at 137.7 dB during the game, a level comparable to a jet engine during takeoff.
- **Scott** led the Baylor scoring efforts with 30 points, while **Kiersten Johnson** scored 13, **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** put up a 10-point, 10-rebound double-double and **Van Gytenbeek** had her stellar day that featured the 10 points.

A 63.5% LOOK VS SOUTHEASTERN LOUISIANA

- Baylor had its best shooting night in the **Nicki Collen** era, shooting 63.5% (47-of-74) in a 112-47 victory at Foster Pavilion.
- **Taliah Scott** recorded her first career double-double with 23 points and 10 assists, while she teamed up with **Jana Van Gytenbeek** (12 assists) as the first Bear duo to hit double-digit assists since **Niya Johnson** (14) and **Odyssey Sims** (13) did so against San Jose State in 2013.
- The Bears put up a 65-point first half, aided by a 32-point run in the first quarter that gave the Bears a 37-7 lead after the first frame.
- **Bella Fontleroy** joined **Scott** in scoring over 20 points, while **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** (fourth double-double of the season), **Kiersten Johnson**, **Marcayla Johnson** and **Yuting Deng** also had double-figure points.
- It was the fifth 100-point game under **Collen** and Baylor's best shooting night since Dec. 29, 2020, vs. McNeese

BALLIN' WITH THE MOUSE

- Baylor finished 1-1 at the WBCA State Farm Showcase in Orlando, falling in a tight contest to No. 19 Iowa before responding with an overtime win against Davidson fewer than 48 hours later.
- The tournament, in its second year, was hosted by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association at the Walt Disney World Resort's ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex.
- Against Iowa, **Taliah Scott** scored a season-high 32 points, including 12 of the Bears' 13 fourth-quarter points, in a second half plagued by an 18.8% shooting performance. The BU defense held Iowa to its lowest scoring output of the season at 34.4% for the game, its second lowest in the first 40 games under new head coach **Jan Jensen**.

STORY LINES

Baylor debuted new uniforms for the 2025 NCAA Tournament in collaboration with Nike. BU was one of three programs with the updated postseason look, joining UConn and Stanford, one of two in the NCAA Tournament. The updated Dri-FIT ADV material was first used with Team USA at the Paris Olympics, as both American squads brought home the gold medal.

- The Bears' 28.8% shooting for the game was their third-lowest so far in the **Nicki Collen** era and their lowest not coming against a top-10 opponent. At 17-of-59, the 17 made field goals tied the fewest under Collen, matching the loss to South Dakota in the 2022 NCAA Second Round.
- Baylor got its bounce-back win over Davidson in overtime, defeating the Wildcats by two points after outscoring them 11-9 in the extra period.
- BU led for just over 28 minutes in regulation by as many as seven points as the third quarter came to a close, but Davidson fought back with a 21-point fourth quarter to tie the game with four seconds left.
- Sophomore transfer **Yuting Deng** was named the game's Most Outstanding Player after driving down the lane to take the lead and win the game as time expired, capping her first double-digit scoring effort as a Bear.
- Four Bears scored in double figures for the first time this season, with **Scott** leading the way for the fifth time with 22 points. **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** added 12 points, **Deng** had 12, and **Kiersten Johnson** recorded her first career double-double with 10 points and 11 rebounds.

VIVAAAAAAA LAS VEGAS!

- Baylor secured an eight-point victory over UNLV on the road in front of a sellout crowd in its first true road game of the season.
- BU trailed 49-43 entering the fourth quarter but outscored the Lady Rebels 19-5 over that last frame, holding UNLV to just one field goal in the last nine minutes of play.
- **Taliah Scott** finished with yet another 20-point performance, with nine fourth-quarter points. The redshirt-sophomore had 23 points after shooting 8-of-18 from the field.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** led the Bears' rebounding efforts, claiming a season-high 12.
- **Scott** recorded a career-best five assists, while **Kiersten Johnson** led BU's 11-block showing with a career-high five swats.

OUI CAME, OUI SAW, OUI CONQUERED

- Baylor picked up its first top 10 win since December 2023 in the season opener against No. 7 Duke, 58-53, at Adidas Arena in Paris, France. The game marked the season's first ranked-vs.-ranked matchup and first nationally televised broadcast.
- With the victory, the Bears are 22-21 against AP Top 25 teams in the **Nicki Collen** era, including a 5-9 mark against top 10 opponents, breaking a six-game top 10 loss streak that began on Jan. 22, 2024, against Kansas State.
- The win marked BU's second top 10 season-opening victory since 2000, the first coming against No. 8 Georgia in 2005.
- The Bears are the first DI team this century to open a season with a win over an AP top-10 opponent while holding them to 30.0 percent or lower shooting from the field.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** opened the season with her 30th career double-double, while **Taliah Scott's** Baylor debut featured 24 points, 12 of them in the fourth quarter, to help the Bears pull away and seal the win.
- Baylor's defense held Duke to just 29.0% (20-63) from the floor, the Blue Devils' worst shooting performance since going 23.5 percent at No. 19 North Carolina in January.

WELCOME HOME, DOUG McNAMEE!

- Baylor named **Doug McNamee**, a two-time graduate of the institution, the Vice President and Director of Intercollegiate Athletics on Dec. 8, 2025.
- **McNamee** returns to Baylor after successful stints as President of Waco-based Magnolia, the nationally recognized lifestyle and media company, and most recently as President of the re-imagined Field & Stream, where he led the revitalization of the iconic outdoor brand into a modern, multi-platform media and consumer lifestyle company.
- In his previous stint at Baylor, **McNamee** was responsible for all major revenue-generating and brand-facing units, including fundraising, marketing, communications and premium ticketing. He also served on the search committee that hired former head football coach Matt Rhule, and he played a key role in the fundraising, planning and opening of McLane Stadium.
- Originally from Lake Jackson, Texas, **McNamee** earned his bachelor's degree in speech communications from Baylor in 2003. He went on to earn his master's degree in sport management, also from Baylor, in 2005. As a student, **McNamee** worked for Baylor Baseball, Men's Basketball and Baylor Student-Athlete Services.

HEARTS ON THE COURT

- **Nicki Collen** is one of the 19 coaches in the inaugural Hearts on the Court Collective, a part of the American Heart Association's Go Red for Women movement. **Collen** is committed to raising awareness of cardiovascular disease, the leading cause of death for women, while empowering student athletes and fans to take charge of their own cardiovascular health.
- For more than 20 years, the Heart Association's Go Red for Women movement has worked to close gaps in awareness and clinical care, providing women at every age and stage of life with trusted, relevant, science-backed health solutions.

- Currently fourth in program history for career 3-pointers made, **Fontleroy** is 19 3-pointers away from tying for third and 20 from claiming the spot outright.

- **Littlepage-Buggs** is 13 blocks away from 100 career blocks.
- **Littlepage-Buggs** is 3 starts away from joining the program's top 10 career starts list.
- **Taliah Scott** is 53 points away from 1,000 career points.
- **Scott** is 56 points away from 500 points this season.
- **Jana Van Gytenbeek** is 2 points away from 500 career points.

A PAIR OF TOP 10 APPEARANCES

- Baylor received two top-10 rankings in the AP poll this season, coming in Weeks 2 and 3, boosted by wins over No. 7 Duke in Paris, Lindenwood, UNLV on the road and Le Moyne.
- It was the Bears' 312th all-time ranking in the top 10, with 23 of those coming in five years under **Nicki Collen**.
- BU's all-time record as a top-10 team is 528-68, beginning with a win over Hawaii at the Hawaii Invitational in Honolulu on Dec. 7, 2001.

- During this stretch, Baylor extended its streak of 20-win seasons to 25 straight years, the second-longest active run in the nation behind UConn, and remained second only to UConn with 21 consecutive NCAA tournaments featuring at least one win.

PRESEASON PRAISE

- Baylor was picked to finish third in the league by the Big 12 head coaches with two first-place votes.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** had her second preseason mention come unanimously, joined by **Bella Fontleroy** as BU representatives.
- The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the WBCA picked **Taliah Scott** (Ann Meyers-Drysdale - Shooting Guard), **Fontleroy** (Cheryl Miller - Small Forward) and **Littlepage-Buggs** (Katrina McClain - Power Forward) to be on their preseason Starting Five watchlists, joining the top 20 position players in the country. Top 10 midseason and final five postseason announcements will follow for each award, with the winner being announced at the WBCA convention.
- **Littlepage-Buggs** was also announced as part of the 2025-26 Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Women's College Player of the Year Watch List Presented by AXIA Time and received a vote for AP Preseason All-America.

IDK ABOUT YOU, BUT WE'RE FEELING 22

- Baylor's No. 16 ranking in the AP's Preseason Poll release was the 22nd consecutive preseason mention, 25th overall, dating back to the national championship-winning season that had Baylor at No. 8 to tip off the 2004-05 season.
- In the 50 years of the AP Poll, the Bears have been ranked No. 1 47 times with the last top-5 ranking coming in 2023-24.
- Those 47 rankings at the top are sixth in the nation, behind UConn, Tennessee, South Carolina, Louisiana Tech and Texas.

BROW, A KAY YOW SERVANT LEADER

- **Ella Brow** was awarded the Kay Yow Servant Leader Award in its second season.
- The award honors student-athletes of great character who put the needs of others before their own, who uplift others and who do it with grace and humility. They are nominated by their coach and exemplify Coach Yow's spirit to reflect her resolve, grace, generosity and servant's heart.
- Brow joined **Jana Van Gytenbeek** as the second-straight Bear to be honored.

100 WINS FOR CNC

- Head coach Nicki Collen earned her 100th win as a head coach in BU's quarterfinal bout against Iowa State in the 2025 Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship.
- Getting win No. 100 in 134 games is the fastest of any head coach in Baylor WBB history in the NCAA era.
- Kim Mulkey achieved the 100-win feat in 136 games, Pam Bowers hit 100 wins in 211 games and Sonja Hogg's career at BU ended with 83 wins. Olga Fallen, Baylor's first head coach in AIAW play hit 100 wins in 131 games.

WINNING WAYS

- Baylor athletics is in the midst of a historic run of success, including national and conference titles in men's and women's basketball, and football coming off a Big 12 Conference Championship in 2021 and the 2022 Sugar Bowl.
- Since 2011, and as of the end of the 2024-25 athletics season, no other school can compete with Baylor's run, as the Bears lead the nation in wins combined among football, and men's and women's basketball. Baylor has 32 more wins than the next closest school, UConn. The next closest in the Big 12 is BYU, who has 732 wins, 150 shy of Baylor despite playing as an independent until the 2023 season.

- Baylor, Duke and Notre Dame are tied at the No. 5 spot for most first round picks at 11 all-time.

HEAD COACH NICKI COLLEN • 5TH SEASON



Nicki Collen was introduced as the fifth head coach in Baylor women's basketball history on May 5, 2021, and later received a contract extension through 2030. She enters her fifth season at the helm in 2025-26.

In her first season with the Bears, Collen recorded 28 wins, the most by a first-year head coach in the nation. She guided Baylor to its 12th consecutive Big 12 regular-season title and an 11th straight top-two seed in the

NCAA Tournament.

Baylor became the first team since 1999 to defeat a ranked opponent twice in a three-day span when the Bears knocked off Texas twice to open February. Two weeks later, exactly one month after beginning conference play 0-2, Baylor returned to the top of the Big 12 standings. The Bears became the first team since Texas Tech in 2000 to start league play 0-2 and still win the conference.

Following a second-round NCAA Tournament appearance in her first season, Collen saw three players selected in the 2022 WNBA Draft, tying a program record. NaLyssa Smith (No. 2) and Queen Egbo (No. 10) became the first Baylor duo selected in the top 10 of the same draft.

Collen's first recruiting class was ranked No. 9 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz.

In her second season, Collen coached two all-conference selections, two unanimous Big 12 All-Freshman Team honorees and the unanimous Big 12 Freshman of the Year, Darianna Littlepage-Buggs. Littlepage-Buggs earned eight Big 12 Freshman of the Week honors during the 2022-23 season, becoming the first Baylor freshman to reach that mark and ranking second all-time in the conference.

The Bears secured 20 wins for the 23rd consecutive season, the second-longest active streak among NCAA Division I programs behind UConn. Collen led Baylor to its 19th straight NCAA Tournament appearance and 21st overall in 2022-23, highlighted by an 18-point comeback win over Alabama in the opening round.

In her third season, Collen guided the Bears to the Sweet 16, highlighted by seven wins over AP-ranked opponents, the most among Big 12 programs. Baylor opened the 2023-24 season with the second-best start in program history, winning 14 consecutive nonconference games. The Bears christened Foster Pavilion on Jan. 3, 2024, with a 71-50 win over then-No. 23 TCU in their Big 12 opener.

The 2024-25 season saw Baylor finish as runner-up in both the Big 12 regular season and the Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship. Collen earned her 100th career win in just 134 games, the fastest to reach the milestone in Baylor's NCAA era. Baylor led the Big 12 in rebounds per game, powered by a standout season from Littlepage-Buggs, who earned WBCA honorable mention All-America honors and was the only conference player to average a double-double.

At the conclusion of the 2024-25 season, six Bears combined for seven All-Big 12 honors. Littlepage-Buggs earned first-team recognition, while Sarah Andrews and Aaronette Vonleh were named to the second team. Yaya Felder was selected as Sixth Player of the Year, and Bella Fontleroy earned All-Defensive Team honors while joining Jada Walker on the honorable mention list.

Collen came to Baylor from the WNBA's Atlanta Dream, where she spent three seasons as head coach. In her rookie season in 2018, she led the Dream to a 23-11 record, earned WNBA Coach of the Year honors and guided the franchise to the WNBA playoff semifinals.

Prior to Atlanta, Collen spent two seasons as an assistant coach with the Connecticut Sun, helping the franchise improve from fifth to second in the Eastern Conference from 2016 to 2017.

Collen's collegiate coaching career spanned nine seasons prior to her WNBA arrival. She served as an assistant coach at Colorado State (2000-02), Ball State (2002-03), Louisville (2003-04), Arkansas (2011-14) and Florida Gulf Coast (2014-16).

Her teams compiled a combined 214-74 record during her nine seasons as a Division I assistant coach. Collen helped guide four teams to NCAA Tournament appearances, including three trips to the second round. She coached three All-Americans and saw three players selected in the WNBA Draft.

Six of Collen's nine collegiate seasons were spent working under her husband, Tom Collen, at Colorado State, Louisville and Arkansas. She also worked under Tracy Roller at Ball State and Karl

Smesko at Florida Gulf Coast, where she helped lead the Eagles to a 64-9 record and the program's first NCAA Tournament win.

Collen began her collegiate playing career at Purdue, where she helped the Boilermakers to an NCAA Final Four appearance in 1994 and an Elite Eight run in 1995. She transferred to Marquette and totaled 421 assists over her final two seasons, averaging 7.0 per game while helping the Golden Eagles to NCAA Tournament appearances in 1997 and 1998.

Nicki and her husband, Tom, have three children, Connor, Reese and Logan.

PAUL AND ALEJANDRA FOSTER PAVILION



The Paul and Alejandra Foster Pavilion along with the Jay & Jenny Allison Development Center is the new home for Baylor's championship-winning Men's and Women's Basketball teams, having played 35 seasons inside the historic Ferrell Center. The Pavilion is a state-of-the-art contemporary field house seating 7,500 fans, located along the banks of the Brazos River on the west side of Interstate 35. Inside, fans are closer to the court to create a true home court advantage.

The Foster's location on the banks of the Brazos allows for the community to be a part of the building's foundation. As a stop on the Riverwalk, the pavilion will be woven into the established traditions of the Waco community. Our fans can enjoy time at local businesses before taking in a game. Just across the interstate from the new Mark & Paula Hurd Welcome Center, this transformative building bolsters the Baylor campus landscape.

The benefit of the new pavilion seating is a more dynamic fan experience. At a capacity of 7,500, fans feel closer to the action and make a dynamic impact on the competition. The new elevation will allow fans to directly access their seat from the concourse, whether you are in premium or standard seating. Fans with premium seating will have access to the Courtside or Sideline Club. The Foster Pavilion will house an exclusive premium entrance, unique to those with premium seating. The Courtside Club is reserved for Champions Row ticket holders. The Sideline Club is located underneath the Club and Loft seats.

The concourse features new concession opportunities as well as unique vendor activations. Fans are welcomed by an energetic atmosphere, cultivated by both the Baylor and Waco communities.

The project scope of the Foster Pavilion & Development Center includes:

- A 223,547-square-foot facility
- Capacity for 7,500 fans including standing-room-only areas for approximately 500 spectators
- Two separate premium club spaces at a combined 8,500 square feet
- Two 2,000-square-foot video end boards
- Visiting locker rooms with the flexibility to accommodate two to four teams
- The Jay & Jenny Allison Development Center for Baylor's championship women's and men's basketball teams, including:
 - Private entrance and elevator, separate practice courts, dedicated locker rooms and team lounges
 - Office facilities for each coach and administration
 - Shared sports performance-related spaces, including strength and conditioning, athletic training/treatment, hydrotherapy, nutrition and more
- Enhancements for the arena to support additional events, such as concerts, performances and public events, including stage rigging, full catering kitchen and cooking capability, additional dressing rooms for performers and related offices

Ground was broken on the state-of-the-art Foster Pavilion on May 2, 2022, with the playing floor installed on November 6, 2023. The inaugural men's basketball game came against Cornell on Tuesday, January 2, 2024, with BU winning 98-79. The inaugural women's basketball game was played on Wednesday, January 3, 2024, against TCU, BU winning 71-50.

TEAM NOTES

- Baylor is 383-2 all-time when shooting 50 percent or better from the field and 41-0 when shooting 60 percent or higher. The Bears' last loss when shooting over 50 percent was to No. 22 Michigan on 11/27/22.
- 412 of Baylor's wins since 2010-11 have been by 10 or more points, and only 31 times in that span has its winning margin been five or fewer points.
- Since the 2010-11 season, Baylor is 51-12 vs. Top 25 opponents at home.
- Baylor is 381-119 (.761) vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season all-time.

THE BAYLOR BEARS REGIME

2019 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The 2018-19 Bears became just the third women's program in NCAA history to win three titles when Baylor beat Notre Dame, 82-81, April 7 in Tampa, Florida. **Chloe Jackson's** go-ahead scoop layup with under five seconds left propelled her to NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player honors to go along with a team-high 26 points in the game. The Bears rode the wave of two All-American posts with **Kalani Brown** and **Lauren Cox**, each earning multiple all-America honors. The pair led Baylor to its 10th regular-season and tournament championship in the Big 12 and **Kim Mulkey** was honored as national coach of the year by the USBWA, the Associated Press and the WBCA.

2012 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The 2011-12 Bear season was as perfect as it could be. En route to claiming its second NCAA Championship in seven years, Baylor ran the table, posting an unprecedented 40-0 mark and claiming both Big 12 Conference crowns. **Brittney Griner** and Mulkey swept player of the year and coach of the year honors, earning WBCA, USBWA, Associated Press, Naismith and Big 12 Conference recognition. Baylor was ranked No. 1 wire-to-wire in both polls and raced through conference play with a Big 12-record 18-0 mark. Griner and **Odyssey Sims** were named consensus All-Americans, while **Destiny Williams** was a WBCA All-America honorable mention honoree.

2005 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The squad posted a 33-3 record and claimed the Big 12 Conference title with a 14-2 mark. En route to the program's first NCAA Championship, the Bears defeated three No. 1 seeds. **Steffanie Blackmon** and **Sophia Young** were both named All-Americans. In addition to earning Big 12 Coach of the Year honors, **Mulkey** received the New York Athletic Club's prestigious Winged Foot Award.

NCAA TOURNAMENT STAPLE

The Bears have made 21-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and 23 overall. Those appearances have resulted in three national championships (2005, 2012, 2019), four Final Fours (2005, 2010, 2012, 2019), 10 Elite Eights and 16 Sweet Sixteens.

BIG 12 DYNASTY

- Baylor women's basketball has won a league-leading 24 Big 12 Conference titles -- 13 regular season and 11 tournament championships.
- Baylor has run the table in the conference four times (2012, 2013, 2018, 2019). It has only happened six times in Big 12 history (Oklahoma: 16-0 in 2006; Nebraska: 16-0 in 2010).
- Baylor has advanced to the Big 12 Championship game 16 times in program history.
- The Bears have won six of the last 13 Big 12 Championship titles, last besting No. 17/20 West Virginia, 76-50, in the 2021 final.
