- No. 1 A&T posted a season lid-lifting win at No. 11 Saint Leo, 277.415-256.590 on Friday.
- The Bears won their 51st straight meet with the win and have won four straight vs. St. Leo.
- BU travels to California on Friday to take on Azusa Pacific at 6 p.m. CT.

Baseball

- Coming off a 33-win season a year ago, Baylor hosts New Mexico State in the season-opening series on Friday-Saturday-Sunday at Magnolia Field at Baylor Ballpark.
- NMST had a strong five-year run as a program from 2016-19 under Coach Brian Green and are coming off a 23-33 year in 2025 that featured an 11-15 mark in C-USA play.
- SS Travis Sanders has been named preseason All-Big 12 Conference.

Equestrian

- EQ fell in a tight contest in Waco vs. No. 5 Oklahoma State on Friday, 10-8.
- Jumping Seat senior Sofia Moskowitz earned her first career MOP in Fences.

Softball

- Baylor won four of five games in the Gettnerman Classic, including three consecutive wins in walk-off fashion.
- BU posted two wins over Wichita State and wins over New Mexico and Northwestern State.
- SS Amber Tovan hit .455 and cranked a pair of homers during the five-game homestand.
- A six-game road swing to San Diego looms, including two matchups with SDSU.

Men's Basketball

- MBB split a pair over the week, posting a resounding 86-67 over Colorado and a 72-69 loss at No. 7 Iowa State.
- The Bears got a 27-point outburst from Tounde Yessoufou in the win over CU and 19 points each from Obi Agbim and Cameron Carr.
- BU hosts No. 22 BYU on Tuesday and faces No. 23 Louisville in a non-conference clash on Saturday in Fort Worth.

Men's Golf

- MG is opening the spring season at the Bentwater Collegiate, hosted by Sam Houston in Montgomery, Texas on Monday and Tuesday.
- MG is under the direction of Interim Head Coach Ryan Murphy, who has taken over following the retirement of legendary head coach Mike McGraw.

Men's Tennis

- No. 19 MT suffered a 4-1 loss at No. 5 TCU on Thursday night. No. 106 Zsombor Velcz highlighted the match with a singles point on court 2, besting No. 49 Rolland De Ravel.
- TCU won the doubles point & singles on courts 4, 3, 1.
- BU hosts No. 8 Texas A&M on Monday at Hawkins Indoor, as a tune-up before welcoming seven of the nation's best teams to the Waco portion of the ITA Indoor Nationals.

Track & Field

- TF claimed five event titles at the Carolina Classic in Columbia, S.C., over the weekend. Tiriah Kelley led the way with the 200m title in the fifth-best time in program history.
- The Bears travel to Lubbock to take on the Jarvis Scott Open on Friday-Saturday.

Women's Basketball

- No. 12/15 Baylor sits atop the Big 12 standings by half a game following a 2-1 week that included wins at Cincinnati and vs. Arizona State.
- The Bears lead WVU by half a game and TCU and Texas Tech by one game, and host No. 17 TCU on Wednesday at 6 p.m. on ESPN, before traveling to face UCF on Sunday.
- Taliah Scott leads the Bears with 20.3 points per game, while Darianna Littlepage-Buggs averages 10.7 points and 10.8 rebounds per game.

Women's Golf

- No. 21 WG ventures to Tucson for the Arizona Thunderbird Intercollegiate on Monday and Tuesday.
- Baylor is searching for its seventh straight top-5 finish.
- UofA is led by former Baylor standout Giovana Maymon, who was on the 2015 BU national title runner-up team.

Women's Tennis

- WT hosted a pair of stiff tests over the weekend at Hawkins Indoor, falling vs. American Conference power Rice, 4-3 on Friday, before suffering a 4-0 loss to No. 23 Washington on Sunday.
- A two-match road swing through the Ivy League looms, including a Friday matchup at Brown and a Sunday matchup at Harvard.
