Acrobatics & Tumbling

- No. 1 A&T rolled to a 283.375-260.5 win over No. 10 Azusa Pacific on Friday in California.
- The Bears have now won 52 straight meets. BU opens its home slate on Sunday, hosting No. 8 UMHB at the Ferrell center at 3 p.m.

Baseball

- Baseball opened its 2026 season in historic fashion with a three-game sweep of New Mexico State, including a 15-2 win on Friday, a 5-2 win on Saturday and a 7-3 win on Sunday.
- The Bears made history on Friday night, as senior 1B Tyce Armstrong became the second player in college baseball history to belt three grand slams in a single game and the first since 1976.
- Armstrong's 12-RBI day ended the Friday-night game with a flourish, as his grand slam in the seventh inning gave BU a run-rule win in the season lid-lifter.

Equestrian

- EQ wraps up its home schedule with Senior Day on Saturday, hosting No. 7 TCU at 11 a.m.
- The Bears will have a pair of regular-season meets remaining, traveling to Fresno, Calif., to face UT Martin and Fresno State on March 6-7.

Softball

- Softball went 5-1 over a six-game week, which featured a 4-1 trip to San Diego.
- The Bears won a midweek tilt with South Dakota State, before venturing out to the SDSU tournament, which featured a split with the Aztecs, and a four-game winning streak to finish that included wins over Oregon State, Forham and North Dakota.
- Brooklyn Carter is off to a 13-for-23 start at the dish and Amber Tovan has cranked four homers and driven in 16 in 11 games, batting .441.

Men's Basketball

- MBB dropped a pair of ranked contests last week, falling vs. No. 22 BYU at Foster, before a 82-71 loss vs. No. 23 Louisville in Fort Worth.
- Freshman Tounde Yessoufou had a strong week, totaling 57 points over the two games that included a career-high 37 vs. BYU, the most points for a Bear vs. a ranked team in school history.
- BU takes on Kansas State in Manhattan at 8 p.m. on Tuesday on ESPN2.

Men's Tennis

- A historic week for the Bears saw BU advance to the Final 4 of the ITA National Indoor Championships, falling vs. No. 7 Texas on Monday night.
- The Bears rolled to wins over No. 8 Texas A&M, No. 9 UCF and No. 3 Wake Forest before running into the Horns on Monday in Dallas.
- BU's three wins marked the first time since the 2021 season to win three consecutive games vs. top-10 foes.

Track & Field

- The Bears competed in Lubbock, Texas at the Jarvis Scot Invite over the weekend.
- BU was highlighted again by Tiriah Kelley, who shattered her own program record in the 200m with a 22.53, which is tied for the fastest time in the nation.
- Baylor will return to action at the Big 12 Indoor Championships in Lubbock on Feb. 27-28.

Women's Basketball

- No. 15/11 WBB split a pair of games over the week, including a 93-63 beatdown of UCF in Orlando on Sunday.
- WBB fell vs. No. 17 TCU at Foster, 83-67, before the bounce-back win over the Knights.
- The Bears are now tied with TCU for first-place in the Big 12 Standings, owning a half a game lead over WVU. Clashes at No. 20 Texas Tech and home vs. Arizona loom this week as the Bears effort to move back into first place.

Women's Tennis

- WT traveled to face a pair of Ivy League foes over the weekend in Boston, posting a 5-2 win vs. Brown and a 4-0 win at Harvard.
- The Bears will host UTRGV in a double header, starting at 11 a.m. on the Hurd Tennis Center on Saturday.
