Acrobatics & Tumbling

- No. 1 A&T opened its home schedule with a 30-point win over UHMB at the Ferrell Center last week, using a pair of perfect 10s.
- The Bears have now won 53 straight meets and are poised for a Saturday clash in Waco vs. No. 2 Oregon.

Baseball

- Baseball posted a 1-3 week that included a midweek comeback win over upstart Texas State, before falling in three games at the Round Rock Classic over the weekend.
- Baylor will continue a rugged schedule this week, hosting SFA on Tuesday afternoon, before traveling to face No. 11 Ole Miss, No. 3 Texas and No. 23 UTSA this weekend in the Bruce Bolt Classic at the home of the Houston Astros.
- The Bears have posted a 3.43 team ERA to open the year.

Equestrian

- EQ posted a senior day win over No. 7 TCU in Waco on Saturday.
- The Bears got wins in Flat and Horsemanship, with Lauren Jorgensen earning MOP honors in Fences and Flat and Carley Rutledge earning MOP honors in Horsemanship.
- BU travels to Fresno, Calif., to take on UT Martin on Friday March 6 and No. 8 Fresno State on Saturday, March 7 to finish the regular season.

Softball

- Softball went 2-2 last week in a trip to Clemson, S.C., that featured wins over Lipscomb and Coastal Carolina, and a pair of losses at No. 24 Clemson.
- A midweek trip to Sam Houston on Tuesday sets up a three-game home series with McNeese this weekend.
- Brooklyn Carter is off to a torid pace, hitting .452 through 14 games and Amber Toven has cranked four jacks with 16 RBI and a .404 average.

Men's Basketball

- MBB posted a 1-1 week that included a loss at Kansas State on Tuesday and a home triumph vs. Arizona State on Saturday.
- The Bears will host No. 2 Arizona on Tuesday and will venture to Orlando to take on UCF on Saturday.
- BU has a No. 49 NET ranking, with a road clash at Houston on March 4 and a home finale vs. Utah on March 7 looming.
- Cameron Carr averages 18.7 points and 5.7 rebounds to lead the Bears, while Tounde Yessoufou sports 18.1 points and 5.6 rebounds per game.

Men's Tennis

- MT had a pair of tight losses last week, including a loss in the Final Four of the ITA Indoor National Championships vs. No. 7 Texas, and a road setback at No. 4 Wake Forest over the weekend.
- Wake Forest avenged the ITA Championships loss to the Bears in Waco, but Devin Badenhorst and Connor Van Schalkwyk won singles points.
- Badenhorst moved up to No. 13 in the singles rankings, Van Schalkwyk is No. 27, Zsombor Velcz is No. 39 and Alexandru Chirita is No. 73
- The Bears moved up to No. 6 in the latest ITA Rankings and will face No. 36 Illinois on the road on Friday.

Track & Field

- TF will travel to Lubbock to participate in the Big 12 Indoor Championships on Friday and Saturday.

Women's Basketball

- No. 18/16 WBB wrapped up its home schedule on Tuesday with an 80-54 rout of Kansas State. That completed a home, regular-season record of 15-2 at the Foster Pavilion.
- Last week, the Bears posted a 74-60 win over Arizona and fell 87-56 at No. 20 Texas Tech in Lubbock.
- The Bears have a No. 30 NET ranking and sit half a game short of first-place TCU in the league standings, with Sunday's regular-season finale in Fort Worth looming large for a chance at the Big 12 regular-season title. TCU plays at Cincinnati on Wednesday night before the clash with BU on ESPN.

- WT had a pair of home matches on Saturday postponed vs. UTRGV. BU will open conference play this week with Arizona and Arizona State.
