**Acrobatics & Tumbling**

- No. 1 A&T cruised to its lone tri-meet win over the weekend in Springfield, Mass., topping American International College and Long Island on Saturday.
- A challenging match at No. 4 Iona is set for Monday afternoon.
- The Bears have won 56 straight meets.

**Baseball**

- Baseball went 3-1 over the week, with a midweek loss at Tarleton before a sweep of Air Force over the weekend.
- The Bears open league play with a four-game homestand that culminates with a series vs. the defending Big 12 Champion No. 22 West Virginia over the weekend.
- Travis Sanders leads the Bears with a .439 average through 15 games with eight doubles and eight RBI, stealing six bases.

**Equestrian**

- A pair of away-from-home tests were split by No. 10 EQ in Fresno, Calif., on Friday and Saturday.
- BU posted a 12-4 win over UT Martin on Friday, before falling vs. host No. 8 Fresno State on Saturday in a league matchup.
- The Big 12 Championship is set for March 27-28 in Stillwater, Okla.

**Softball**

- SB opened its league slate with a sweep of Iowa State and a midweek win over SFA last week.
- The Bears rallied from behind for a game-two win on Friday after a rout in the first game. Weather impacted Saturday's game and pushed it to Sunday, which saw the Bears win in walk-off fashion.
- It was the first league-opening sweep for BU since 2021.

**Men's Basketball**

- MBB went 1-1 last week to conclude the regular-season, suffering a loss at No. 7/6 Houston before concluding the home slate with a resounding win over Utah.
- The Bears earned the No. 13 seed and will face No. 12 seed Arizona State in the first round of the Big 12 Tournament in Kansas City, Mo., on Tuesday at 11:30 a.m. The winner gets No. 5 seed Iowa State on Wednesday and the winner of that gets No. 4 seed Texas Tech in the quarterfinals on Thursday.
- Cameron Carr leads the club with 19 points per game, adding 5.5 rebounds per outing.

**Men's Golf**

- MG posted its highest tournament finish in two years in the Sam Ryder Intercollegiate in Daytona Beach, Fla., on Monday and Tuesday.
- The Bears were led by Evan Vo, who finished fourth, as BU posted a second-place finish.

**Men's Tennis**

- No. 10 MT had a historic week at the Hurd Tennis Center, posting a thrilling 4-2 win over No. 1 Ohio State on Thursday. BU also won at No. 71 Rice on Sunday, 4-3.
- The Bears swept the singles courts to earn the win, with Louis Bowden clinching the match on court 6. It was the first BU home win over No. 1 since 2011 vs. Tennessee.
- Three matches are on the docket this week, including home twinbill vs. No. 47 SMU and ACU, before a matchup vs. No. 51 Memphis in Indian Wells.

**Track & Field**

- A trio of TF Bears qualified for the NCAA Indoor Championships this week in Fayetteville, Ark.
- Junior pole vaulter Molly Haywood, senior sprinter Tiriak Kelley (200m) and junior Demario Prince (60m hurdles) will compete at the Tyson Track Center.
- Haywood won the Big 12 Championship in the pole vault, her fourth straight league crown.

**Women's Basketball**

- A sluggish shooting night allowed Colorado to post a 62-53 win over No. 20 WBB in the Big 12 Quarterfinals on Friday in Kansas City.
- WBB, sporting a NET ranking of No. 32, will find out its NCAA Tournament fate on Sunday, with ESPN bracketologist Charlie Creme slating the Bears as the No. 6 seed in Louisville's bracket.
- Taliah Scott continues to pace the Bears with 20.0 points and 2.6 rebounds per game.

**Women's Golf**

- No. 19 WG finished 10th in the UNLV's Lady Luck Invitational in Las Vegas last week, highlighted by a top-15 finish for Silje Ohma.
- It snapped a streak of eight straight top-five finishes for the Bears.
- The stout PING ASU Invite is next up for the Bears on March 23-25 in Tempe, Ariz.

**Women's Tennis**

- WT swept a two-match road swing over the weekend, posting a 4-0 win at Cincinnati in the Queen City on Friday, before an early morning win at West Virginia, 5-2, on Sunday.
- Two straight at home loom for the Bears, hosting Iowa State on Friday and Kansas on Sunday. Na Dong leads the Bears with an 8-2 mark in singles, including 6-2 at No. 1 singles.
