Acrobatics & Tumbling

- No. 1 A&T earned the top seed in the 2026 NCATA National Championships, set for Thursday-Saturday in Azusa, Calif.
- The Bears will open with No. 8 seed Duquesne at 9 p.m. CT on Thursday and pending wins would have a 9 p.m. match on Friday in the semifinals and a 7 p.m. showdown in the national championship on Saturday. Individuals are set for Sunday.
- The Bears have won 10 straight national championships.

Baseball

- Baseball went 2-2 last week with a midweek win over UTSA in 12 innings and a Friday night win over TCU, 11-4, before falling in a doubleheader sweep on Sunday.
- The Bears opened this week with a 7-5 loss at Sam Houston on Tuesday night in Huntsville.
- A series in Tempe, Ariz., looms, with the Bears facing No. 21 Arizona State in a three-game set.
- Freshman Brady Janusek has cranked nine homers and drive in 38 runs, while senior Tyce Armstrong has hit .305 with 14 homers and 45 RBI. Travis Sanders leads the club with a .353 average, owning 12 doubles, three homers and 28 RBI.

Softball

- SB posted a crucial conference win over Utah over the weekend at Getteman Stadium, earning a 9-1 win in the opener and a walk-off 3-2 win in the rubber match on Sunday. The Bears also fell on Wednesday vs. No. 11 Texas A&M, as part of a 2-2 week.
- The Bears own a No. 44 RPI entering a big week, traveling to Texas State on Wednesday, before hosting No. 14 Oklahoma State in a three-game set at Getteman.

Men's Golf

- MG wrapped up its regular-season schedule with a 10th place finish in the Mountaineer Invitational on April 13-14 in Bridgeport, W.Va.
- The Bears will return to the court on April 27-29 in Hutchinson, Kan., for the Big 12 Championships.

Men's Tennis

- No. 11 MT went 1-1 in the Big 12 Tournament in Orlando last week, posting an efficient dispatching of Utah in the opening round before falling vs. No. 2 TCU in the second round.
- The Bears are in line to host the first and second rounds of the NCAA Tournament and are poised to find out their postseason fate on Monday.

Track & Field

- Baylor ventured to the historic Tom Jones Invitational last weekend in Gainesville, Fla., hosted by Florida.
- The Bears were led by Molly Haywood's pole vault win and both the men's and women's 4x400 relay win.
- Baylor hosts the annual Michael Johnson Invitational this weekend at the Clyde Hart Track & Field Stadium on Friday and Saturday.

Women's Golf

- No. 26 WG opens its postseason run on Thursday-Saturday in Dallas, Texas, at the Big 12 Championships.
- Malena Castro's scoring average of 72.03 leads the Bears entering the postseason with 10 top-25 finishes in 11 tournaments for the sophomore from Argentina.
