#### STORY LINES

- Baylor heads to Manhattan, Kansas to face K-State in the Big 12 road opener. The Bears had a four-game winning streak in the series snapped last season with a 42-21 defeat by Kansas State in Waco.
- The Baylor defense has allowed only five touchdowns (38.5%/18th FBS) in 13 redzone trips.
- Thirteen of Baylor's 14 touchdown scoring drives and 16 of 20 scoring drives on the season have lasted 2:30 or less. The Bears are averaging 1:43 per scoring drive in 2017.
- Baylor leads the Big 12 in both tackles for loss (32.0, 14th NCAA) and sacks (11.0, 23rd NCAA).
- Underclassmen account for 62% (186 of 298) of Baylor's tackles through four games.
- Manning Star of the Week honoree Zach Smith has thrown for 200+ yards & at least 2 TDs in all 6 career starts. He was also named to the Davey O'Brien Great 8 after setting a career high with 463 yards & 4 TDs.
- The Bears' 21 first-time starters, including eight freshmen, thus far in 2017 are the most in FBS.
- BU recorded four touchdown passes against OU, the first four allowed by the Sooners in 2017.
- Big 12 Special Teams POTW Connor Martin tied the Baylor record with 4 FGs (32, 41, 46, 36) against OU.
- Clay Johnston ranks second in the Big 12 and sixth nationally with 7.5 tackles for loss.
- Baylor has had 15 true freshmen appear in a game in 2017, the eighth-largest total nationally.
- Freshmen & sophomores are responsible for 67.1% (1204 of 1794) of Baylor's all-purpose yards.
- Chris Platt leads the Baylor receiving corps with a reception in 10 straight games and 16 of the last 17 contests. He is the only player in the country with four receptions of 50+ yards.
- Baylor is playing its 116th season of football and first under Matt Rhule, who completed a successful fouryear term at Temple from 2013-16. Baylor holds a 588-561-44 (.511) record all-time.
- Blake Lynch leads the Big 12 with four passes broken up through four games.
- The Bears have scored in a school-record 129 straight games since Sept. 1, 2007 at TCU.
- Denzel Mims (406 yards) & Platt (401 yards) rank fourth and fifth in the Big 12 in receiving yards.
- Thirty-eight of Baylor's possible 88 starters through four games were freshmen or sophomores including 13-of-22 (seven offense, six defense) against Oklahoma.
- Punter **Drew Galitz** leads the Big 12 with an average of 45.2 yards per punt with six of 50+ yards. BU ranks first in Big 12 and second nationally in net punting (45.76).
- Baylor's four opponents from the first four weeks of 2017 currently hold a 14-1 record.

#### MORE STORY LINES

- The Baylor offense leads all of FBS with five passes of 60- and 70-plus vards.
- With Kyle Fuller's selection by Houston in 2017, Baylor has had at least one NFL draft pick for nine straight years. The Bears have had 25 players selected since 2011, including eight offensive linemen in the last nine years.
- The Bears capped the 2016 season with a Cactus Bowl win in their program-record seventh straight bowl appearance. BU had a program record 7+ wins in a season for the 7th straight year in 2016.
- Baylor has had seven consecutive seasons with a 1,000 yard rusher including junior Terence Williams (1,048 yds) who is back for 2017 as one of four returning 1K rushers in the Big 12.
- Just two months on the job, Rhule and his staff signed 27 players in February, a class that ranked 3rd in the Big 12. The Bears signed 20 players from the state of Texas, tops in the Big 12.

#### **UP NEXT**

Following a bye on October 7, Baylor hits the road to face another highly-ranked opponent when it squares off with No. 15 Oklahoma State October 14 at Boone Pickens Stadium in Stillwater, Okla. The Bears own victories in consecutive seasons over OSU and have won three of the last four. BU's consecutive wins over the Cowboys is a first in the series history since winning nine in a row from 1915-42. Television coverage of the contest will be announced October 2.

#### KANSAS STATE SERIES HISTORY

The Bears trail the all-time series with K-State 6-8, including a 2-4 mark in Manhattan. Baylor fell to the Wildcats 42-21 at McLane Stadium in 2016. Prior to that game, the Bears had won four-straight games and 6-of-8 against KSU. Last season against KSU, Baylor's Zach Smith made his first career start and staked the Bears to a 14-7 halftime lead before being out-scored 35-7 in the second half. The Wildcats have not won consecutive games in the series since taking the first five meetings bewteen 1959 and 2003. Legendary Kansas State coach Bill Snyder is 6-5 against Baylor.

#### **BAYLOR FRESHMAN FACTS**

- · Baylor has played 15 true freshman over the first four weeks, a total that ranks seventh nationally.
- BU has started eight true freshmen at least once over the first three weeks of 2017, second most in FBS. Those first-year players include C Ryan Miller, RB John Lovett, TE Rob Saulin, DE BJ Thompson, LB Jalen Pitre, CB Harrison Hand, OL Xavier Newman and WR RJ Sneed.
- The Bears have also started a pair of redshirt freshmen thus far in FS Jairon McVea and DE Deonte Williams.
- So far in 2017, BU has had 21 players make their first-ever collegiate starts and 21 players make first BU appearance.
- True freshman CB Harrison Hand has started all four games in 2017. LB Jalen Pitre has started three timse and C Ryan Miller has started twice.
- Baylor opened the 2017 season with four true or redshirt freshmen in the starting lineup (OL Ryan Miller, CB Harrison Hand, LB Jalen Pitre and S Jairon McVea).
- The Bears had 16 players make their first appearance in a BU uniform, including 13 true or redshirt freshmen, in the opener.
- Ten players made their first-ever start for Baylor in the opening week game. Additionally, two transfers Anu Solomon and Jayson Clements had their first Baylor action after playing time at their previous schools.
- · Baylor's 11 true freshman that played in the opener ranked sixth nationally and its three true freshman starters in the first game was behind only LSU's four.
- Twenty-two different freshmen or sophomores have started a game for Baylor through three games in 2017.

#### THIRD DOWN TURNAROUND

- After struggling on first down against Liberty and alllowing the Flames to convert on 15-of-24 third downs, the Baylor defense has turned the stat around over the last three games and particularly since halftime against UTSA. Baylor's mark of 23.5 percent over the last 10 quarters would rank sixth nationally.
- · In addition to the defensive improvement on third down, the Baylor offense took a step forward against Oklahoma completing 9-of-21 (42.8%) third down attempts after being successful on only 7-of-35 (20%) tries entering the game.
- Against FBS opponents, Baylor's third down defense mark of 34.09% ranks third in the Big 12.
- The improvement on third down has allowed the Baylor defense to hold its last three opponents to an average of 207.3 passing yards per game (3rd, Big 12) after giving up 447 yards through the air to Liberty in the opener.

#### ZACH SMITH SETTLING IN AT QB

- Making his second start of the season and sixth of his career, **Zach Smith** threw for a career-best 463 yards and four touchdowns (no INT) against OU. He has now thrown for at least 200 yards and two touchdowns in all six of his career starts.
- Smith had two passes of 70+ yards against the Sooners to move into the FBS lead with four on the season.
- The sophomore's four touchdowns against OU were the first passing touchdowns the Sooners had allowed in 2017
- The performance against Oklahoma was Smith's third career 300-yard passing game. It was the fourth-best single-game passing output by a Baylor quarterback and the 19th 400-yard game all-time at Baylor.
- His 463 yards were the most for a BU QB since Bryce Petty threw for 550 yards vs. Michigan St. in the 2015 Cotton Bowl.
- He finished with a career-best 33 completions, tying Shawn Bell and Robert Griffin III for 4th-most completions in a game.
- The Grandview, Texas native ranks fifth in the nation in yards per completion (16.13).

#### UNDERCLASS EXPLOSION

- Baylor has turned to its young players to provide key production through the season's first four games.
- Thirty-seven of Baylor's possible 88 starters through four games were freshmen or sophomores including 12-of-22 (six offense, six defense) against Oklahoma.
- Twenty-two different underclassmen have started a game for the Bears through four weeks. LIST: Offense Sam Tecklenburg, Ryan Miller, Rob Saulin, Denzel Mims, Zach Smith, JaMycal Hasty, John Lovett, Tony Nicholson, Kyle Boyd, Xavier Newman. RJ Sneed

- Underclassmen account for 62% (186 of 298) of Baylor's tackles through four games.
- Freshmen & sophomores are responsible for 67.1% (1204 of 1794) of Baylor's all-purpose yards.

#### **BEARS PILING UP SACKS, TFL**

- The Baylor defense led by sophomore linebacker Clay Johnston and junior defensive tackle Ira Lewis have piled up sacks and tackles for loss through three games.
- The Bears lead the Big 12 and rank 14th nationally in TFL with 32.0 for 122 yards (8.00 per game). Baylor also leads the Big 12 and ranks 23rd in FBS with 11.0 sacks (69 yards) on the season.
- Johnston is a big part as he ranks sixth nationally and second in the Big 12 with 7.5 TFL (24 yards). The sophomore is second in the Big 12 with 35 total tackles (25 solo). Lewis has added 4.5 TFL (8th, Big 12) and 2.5 sacks (3rd, Big 12).
- Five BU defenders have multiple sacks with four in the Big 12's top six: Lewis (2.5), Eric Ogor (2.0), Brian Nance (2.0) and Taylor Young (2.0). Xavier Jones has 1.5 sacks to rank 14th.
- BU totaled 12 TFL and 5 sacks at Duke, a first for the program vs. a P5 opponent since 12/27/12 vs. UCLA

#### EFFICIENCY ON OFFENSE FOR BEARS

- The Bears have had 16 scoring drives of 2:30 or less through the season's first four weeks, including 13-of-14 drives that resulted in a touchdown. The Bears are averaging 1:43 per scoring drive this season.
- Baylor has scored in less than a minute eight times and on the first or second play of a drive seven times.
- Five of Baylor's seven scoring drives against Liberty lasted two minutes or less including a 3-play, 75-yard drive that took only 22 seconds and a 1-play, 75-yard scoring drive that took only 11 seconds off the clock. Both of those drives included deep pass completions, a 49-yarder to **Pooh Stricklin** and a 75-yard scoring strike to **Chris Platt**.
- Baylor's only touchdown drive against UTSA was a first-play touchdown pass from Solomon to **Denzel Mims** and lasted only six seconds.
- Against Duke, Baylor scored three touchdowns on passes of 44 yards, 73 yards and 79 yards to cap drives that lasted 14,
   42 and 48 seconds each

#### DEPTH IN THE RECEIVING CORPS.

- A Baylor wide receiver has tallied at least three receptions in a game 12 times so far in 2017. **Chris Platt** (5th, 401 yards) and **Denzel Mims** (4th, 406 yards) both rank among Big 12's top 10 receivers.
- Platt has a pair of two-touchdown games and Mims has scored in all four games this season. Mims' streak is the longest for a BU wide out to open a season since **Corey Coleman** had a TD in first six games of 2015.
- Platt leads the Baylor receiving corps with a reception in 10 straight games and 16 of the last 17 contests. He currently ranks 25th on Baylor's all-time receiving list with 1.123 career yards.
- Tony Nicholson (7 rec., 74 yards) and Pooh Stricklin (6 rec., 85 yards) both had career days against Oklahoma.
- Baylor's 10 pass completions of 40+ yards are the most in the country.

#### **KEY CONTRIBUTORS RETURN**

- Baylor junior running back and 2016 1,000-yard rusher **Terence Williams** saw his first action of the 2017 season against Oklahoma following offseason shoulder surgery. Williams entered 2017 averaging 72.3 ypg over his career in Big 12 games where he received carries. He tallied 26 yards on 11 carries against OU.
- Senior safety Taion Sells also made his 2017 debut against the Sooners. He returned following a three-game suspension.
   Sells recorded six tackles (five solo) and forced a fumble while also tallying a pass breakup in his first game of 2017.

#### **KICKER MARTIN TIES BU RECORD**

- Sophomore place kicker Connor Martin had a career game against Oklahoma. The Frisco, Texas native tied the Baylor record with four field goals, a first for a BU place kicker since 2014.
- Converted a career long 41-yarder in the 3rd quarter and beat that mark with a 46-yard field goal later in the guarter.
- He is the first BU kicker with two field goals of 40 or more yards since Aaron Jones against Texas on Oct. 20, 2012.

- Additionally, former Bear Orion Stewart is a member of Buffalo's practice squad.
- Baylor had 21 former lettermen with NFL teams during the preseason, representing 17 different NFL teams.
- Baylor has had 21 players selected in the first round including four players selected No. 2 overall with Robert Griffin III the most recent selection at No. 2 by the Washington Redskins in 2012.
- The Bears have had 126 players drafted overall since 1970 and 40 players compete in the Super Bowl including Atlanta Falcon Matt Bryant in Super Bowl LI.

#### BAYLOR FOOTBALL ON THE RADIO

Baylor football is aired live via the Baylor IMG Sports Network, including locally on flagship station ESPN Central Texas 1660 AM/99.1 ESPN Radio (KRZI) in Waco, worldwide on Baylor-Bears.com, Sirius XM Radio and on the Tuneln Radio App. All games are broadcast by the "Voice of the Bears" John Morris and former Baylor standouts J.J. Joe (analyst) and Ricky Thompson (sideline reporter). Morris is in his 31st year in the Baylor broadcast booth and 23rd as the signature voice of Baylor Athletics, while Thompson and Joe are in their 18th and 14th years, respectively.

#### PLATT AND MIMS VS. THE NATION

- Baylor's receiving duo of junior **Chris Platt** and sophomore **Denzel Mims** are quickly establishing themselves as one of the top receiving tandems in the Big 12 and the nation. The duo is tied for the league lead with four receptions of 40+ yards.
- Platt and Mims are two of only three receivers in the Big 12 with five or more receiving touchdowns.
- Platt and Mims give Baylor the only duo in the country to each rank tied for first nationally with four receptions of 40 or more yards. Platt leads all of FBS with four receptions of 70-plus yards.
- Platt set a career high with 148 rec. yards at Duke. He has 10 career receiving touchdowns with five going for 70+ yards.
- Mims followed with a career-best 11 receptions for 192 yards and three touchdowns against No. 3 Oklahoma.

#### KILLING THE CLOCK

When Matt Rhule coached teams grab a seven-point lead at any point during a game, they consistently convert it into a victory. With a seven-point lead at any point during a game, they are 27-10, have won six of eight and 24 of the last 29. In the fourth quarter with a seven-point lead, his teams are 27-1 and have won 26 straight. When holding a 10-point lead at any point, Rhule has won six straight. With a 14-point lead, he has won 23 straight. Up 17, Rhule has won 19 straight. When leading by 20 or more he has won 16 straight.

#### NFL EXPERIENCE ABOUNDS

Including head coach Matt Rhule's 2012 stint with the New York Giants, there are six total coaches on the Baylor staff with 38 years combined experience in the National Football League. That total ranks fourth in college football. Four of the five coaches on offense spent time in the NFL including co-offensive coordinators Jeff Nixon (10 years) and Glenn Thomas (seven years). Bob Bicknell has 10 years of experience with four different teams. Phil Snow was a Detroit assistant for four seasons. George DeLeone has spent six seasons in professional football over three stints. Rhule, DeLeone and Bicknell have all served as NFL offensive line coaches. **BU's 37 years of NFL coaching by its assistant coaches lead the country.** 

#### RHULE TEAMS IN THE FOURTH QUARTER

In Matt Rhule's four seasons as head coach, he has sealed the deal when leading or tied entering the fourth quarter. Rhule-coached teams have won 25 straight games when leading or tied entering the fourth, and are 26-4 overall. All four losses came in his first season as head coach at Temple in 2013. When leading entering the fourth quarter, he has won 23 straight games and is 24-3 overall with all three losses coming in 2013 as well.

#### SHUTOUTS UNDER RHULE AND SNOW

Defenses coached by Phil Snow under head coach Matt Rhule have posted four shutouts, all since 2014. Those teams notched three shutouts in his last 12 games in Philadelphia including two in the final four, puncuated by a rare set of back-to-back shutouts on Nov. 4 at UCONN and Nov. 19 at Tulane in 2016. Rhule's teams have never been shutout on offense. All four shutouts are listed below.

#### RHULE'S PLAN TO WIN

#### **CONSISTENT RUNNING GAME**

Baylor's offense has churned out eight 1,000-yard rushers since 2010 - the second-best total in FBS. The Bears have had at least one player rush for 1,000 or more yards for a program-record seven consecutive seasons including junior Terence Williams' 1,048 yards in 2016. Williams was the 12th player in Baylor history to rush for more than 1,000 yards in a season. Baylor has rushed for a touchdown in 42 of its last 45 games and 73 of its last 78. #### **MULTIPLE TURNOVERS EQUALS WINS**

Matt Rhule defenses have forced two or more turnovers in 24 of 55 (44.4%) career games. His teams own a 17-7 record with two or more turnovers forced, have won 12 of the last 15, seven of the last nine and four of five when doing so. Rhule's teams are 7-0 when forcing four or more turnovers and 9-3 when creating three or more. His teams are 19-4 with a positive turnover margin.

#### BEARS RECORD STELLAR ACADEMIC SEMESTERS

In the first semester under head coach Matt Rhule, Baylor football produced its top academic semester in more than 10 years with a cumulative GPA of 2.87 during the spring of 2017. The Bears had 43 players named to the Big 12 Commissioner's Honor Roll, including three on the dean's list in Preston Heard, Marques Jones and Chad Kelly. Jones and Kelly both recorded perfect 4.0 GPAs. The Bears recorded a 3.11 GPA during the summer of 2017.

#### **BAYLOR'S O-LINE PIPELINE**

Baylor has a history of sending offensive linemen to the NFL over the past several years. The Bears have had eight linemen drafted in the last nine NFL Drafts including two first-rounders [list below]. Baylor offensive linemen won four straight Big 12 Offensive Linemen of Year honors from 2012-15 (2012-13 Cyril Richardson, 2014-15 Spencer Drango). The unit has also paved the way for a 1.000-yard rusher for seven consecutive seasons.

#### 2017 BAYLOR FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

#### DEEP CONNECTIONS FOR RHULE AND NIXON

Baylor head coach Matt Rhule and co-offensive coordinator Jeff Nixon have a relationship that dates back more than 20 years. Rhule and Nixon were teammates at State College (Pa.) High School, then college teammates and roomates at Penn State from 1995-96. The two worked together in 2006 at Temple. Rhule hired Nixon, who has 10 years NFL experience, as his running backs coach and play caller in January 2017.

#### **BAYLOR STAFF HAS TEXAS TIES**

Despite Matt Rhule taking the reigns of the Baylor program with no experience in the state of Texas, he assembled a staff that includes eight coaches and support staffers that have spent time in the state. Tight ends coach Joey McGuire won three state titles in 14 seasons at Cedar Hill (Texas) High School. Assoc. AD for football relations David Wetzel, a BU letterman, was head coach at San Antonio Reagan from 2003-16 as part of a 25-year career. He also served as head of the Texas High School Football Coaches Association. Glenn Thomas is a native of Eastland, Texas and a Texas Tech graduate. Offensive analyst Shawn Bell played quarterback at Baylor and spent 10 years on the Texas high school sidelines. Associate director of player development Stephen Smith is a Dallas native that served as an assistant under McGuire for seven seasons. Additionally, three of Baylor's graduate assistant coaches are Texas natives.

## SNOW BRINGS ONE OF NATION'S TOP DEFENSES

Following Matt Rhule to Baylor is defensive coordinator Phil Snow. A 38-year coaching veteran, Snow organized one of the top defenses in the country at Temple over the last four seasons. Since 2013, Snow's Temple unit ranked third nationally in red zone touchdown percentage (47.2 percent). Additionally, the Owls' defense allowed only 21.5 ppg in that stretch, the 10th lowest mark in Division I. Snow has served as a defensive coordinator for 26 seasons during his career at eight different stops.

Anu Solomon threw for 278 yards and three touchdowns, adding 97 yards on six rushes, but Baylor came up short, falling 48-45 to the Liberty Flames in the season opener.

Solomon was 14 of 29 on passing, connecting once with Denzel Mims and twice with Chris Platt. Platt finished with a team-high 102 yards on just three total receptions, while Mims totalted 85 on two catches

Baylor's ground game stacked up 254 rushing yards and three touchdowns, with Solomon's efforts complemented by true freshman John Lovett and sophomore JaMycal Hasty.

Lovett had 89 yards rushing and two touchdowns, while Hasty finished with 56 yards rushing and and one touchdown.

#### **POSTGAME NOTES**

- Solomon surpassed the 7,000-career passing yards milestone, throwing for 278 yards (14-29) vs. Liberty. His career total stands at (7,200).
- Junior Chris Platt scored a career-high-tying two touchdowns, surpassing the 100-yards receiving mark with 102 total yards for the second time in his career (114 vs. Oklahoma State on Sept. 24, 2016).
- Freshman Johnathan Lovett is Baylor's first true freshmen to rush for two touchdowns in a single game since quarterback Nick Florence vs. Kent State on Oct. 3, 2009.
- Freshman Harrison Hand led the Baylor defense with 11 tackles, including seven solo stops, in his debut.

Zach Smith made his first start of the 2017 season, throwing for 263 yards and three touchdowns, but Baylor (0-3) couldn't overcome its four turnovers, falling 34-20 to the Duke Blue Devils (3-0).

The big-play potential for the Bears was on full display, with Smith connecting with Denzel Mims on a 44-yard touchdown and Chris Platt on 73- and 79-yard scoring bombs.

Platt totaled 148 yards and two touchdowns on just four receptions.

Baylor's defense continued making strides, piling up five sacks, two turnovers, and holding Duke to just 4 for 18 on third-down conversions.

In the closing seconds of the third quarter, Platt's second touchdown of the game brought BU back to within four entering the fourth. Duke went on to score 10 unanswered points, halting the BU comeback bid.

#### POSTGAME NOTES

- Baylor held Duke to 4-of-18 on third-down conversions. Duke entered the game ranked 8th nationally going 21-of-36 on third-down conversions.
- Baylor forced its first turnover under Rhule on a fumble recovery by Deonte Williams in the first quarter.
- QB Zach Smith, who started for the first time this season, made his fifth career start and has thrown for at least 200 yards and 2 TDs in every start
- WR Chris Platt had a career-high 148 receiving yards for his second career 100-yard receiving game.
- WR Platt caught a 73-yard TD pass and 79-yard TD pass for his third and fourth TD catches of the season and second and third TD catches of 70 or more yards. He has nine career TD catches and four TDs of more than 70 yards.
- Underclassmen have accounted for 64% (157 of 245) of Baylor's tackles through three games. Underclassmen had 63 of 89 tackles (71%) at Duke.

Baylor's upset bid peaked in the third quarter when the Bears took a 31-28 lead. After a 21-point swing for the Sooners, BU took 10 points back, trailing by eight and driving in the fourth quarter

The drive was cut short by a fumble forced on a sack by the Sooners, leaving the Bears one score down.
