On improvements from the first half to the second...

On the punt fumble being a missed opportunity...

"I wouldn't say it felt like that. Obviously anytime the ball is on the ground we want to get it, but that was a good play by our special teams to get down there and pin them back, and I'm not really sure if they kneeled that drive or something like that, but yeah that was the end of it. Obviously it would have been nice to get some points out of that, but that's just kind of the way the game goes. You can't really pinpoint something like that and say if it would have gone that way then this would have happened, but obviously it's something we would have liked to have happened."

On if it was a step up in competition from non-conference...

"Always. I think so. Obviously they are a well-coached team and have talent all over the field. They are a solid Big 12 team. We didn't play our best today, but you have got to give them a lot of credit because they really came out and they knew what we were trying to do to them, and they played well."

On the attitude of the team...

"I mean obviously it's something we keep fighting for, so it's something we'll just go back to the drawing board, we take one game at a time. So we are looking forward to Oklahoma State, we are going to get ready for them. We are obviously going to make corrections on what we did today, but we're looking forward and getting ready for Oklahoma State."
