MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- Third 11 win season, tying for the most in school history. This is the third time in program history it has happened this decade (2013, 2014)
- First Power 5 program to go from 1-11 to 11-1 in two seasons.
- The Bears have now won 10 straight games vs. Kansas, including the last 5 trips to Lawrence.
- A ranked Baylor team is 5-0 against Kansas.
- BU has outscored the Jayhawks 486-115 since 2010.
- Baylor is now 16-5 all-time vs. the Jayhawks.
- Baylor is in its 118th football season and third under Matt Rhule -- the Bears are 607-575-44 all-time and Rhule is 47-41 in his career (19-18 at BU).
- The Bears are 117-56-2 as a ranked team in program history.
- Baylor has scored in a school-record 161-straight games -- the previous school record was 90 games from Dec. 31, 1979 Oct. 23, 1987.
- Baylor won the toss and defered to the second half.
- Jordan Williams, Sam Tecklenberg, Marques Jones, Cody George and Owen Rogers served as captains for today's game at Kansas.

TEAM NOTES

- BU defense has now allowed only 6 points on 12 opening drives this season two FGs, 9 punts forced, 1 turnover on downs.
- . The Bears scored on their opening drive of the game, third opening drive score for Baylor this season (all TDs SFA, at OSU, at KU).
- First time scoring 3 first-quarter touchdowns since Oct. 15, 2016 vs. Kansas.
- 34 first half points ties for BU's most points in the first half of a Big 12 game since scoring 42 at Kansas on Oct. 15, 2016.
- Bears are 11-11 in Red Zone over last 2.5 games (8 TDs, 3 FGs).
- Bears with 5 rushing scores on the day, the second time this season (first vs. UTSA).
- The Bears had a 14 play drive in the fourth quarter to make the score 55-6, the longest touchdown drive of season.
- With 4 interceptions today, Bears now have 16 interceptions on the season, most since having 17 in 2013.
- For the 11th time in 12 games the BU defense did not allowed a TD in the first quarter.
- Through 12 games the Bears have held opponents to just 54 total first half points and only 29 second quarter points.
- Through 12 games the Bears have held opponents to just 109 points through the first three quarters.
- The Bears had 6 rushing TDs in a game for first time since having 7 in 2015 Russell Athletic Bowl vs. North Carolina.
- The 55 point margin of victory is Baylor's 3rd-largest margin of victory in a Big 12 game. (64 vs. lowa State in 2013, 59 at Kansas in 2015)
- It's the 12th time Baylor has scored 60 + points in a conference game in program history (3rd-most in a road game behind 66 at KU in 2015 and 63 at WVU in 2012)
- 4 interceptions tie Baylor's record for a Big 12 game first time doing it in a Big 12 road game, 5th time overall 2016 vs KU, 2011 vs. UT, 2008 vs. TAMU, 2005 vs. OSU
- The 4 interceptions ties most interceptions since picking off 5 passes vs. TCU in 1989.
- First time with 6 rushing TDs in a conference game since rushing for 6 in a 49-28 win at lowa State on Sept. 27, 2014.
- First time Baylor defense has had 4 interceptions since having 4 vs. Kansas on Oct. 15, 2016.
- BU finished with 7.0 TFL, giving them 88.0 on the season, moving them up to 6th most in a single season in program history.
- Matt Rhule defenses have forced two or more turnovers in 36 of 87 career games coached, including eight times in 2019's first 12 games.
- Rhule coached teams own a 27-9 record with 2+ turnovers forced and have won 22 of the last 27 games when doing so.
- Rhule's teams are 8-0 when forcing 4+ turnovers and 14-4 when creating 3+.
- Rhule's teams are 28-5 in games where they have a positive turnover margin, including six 2019 victories (+5 today).
- Rhule coached teams at Baylor are now 17-1 when leading or tied entering the fourth quarter and 38-4 when leading entering the fourth quarter.
- Rhule coached teams are now 41-5 when leading or tied entering the fourth quarter.
- Rhule coached teams are 24-10 when posting a 4th quarter shutout.
- The Bears added to their Big-12 leading sack total with 2.0 at KU, giving them 40.0 on the season, tying the program record of 40 in 1992.
- With 6 takeaways in the game, the Bears have now had 31 in 14 games after only six in the previous 14 games.
- The Bears have now had at least one takeaway in 14 straight games.
- After totaling 10 interceptions in the first 25 games of the Rhule era, Baylor now has 16 interceptions in 2019, including 15 in the last 9 games.
- The Bears have 40.0 sacks through 12 games in 2019 after totalling just 25 in 2018.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- QB Charlie Brewer threw a 51-yd TD pass to WR Tyquan Thornton, his 7th career TD pass over 50 yards, 13th overall pass completion longer than 50 yards for his career.
- QB Charlie Brewer's TD pass to Thornton is the 20th of the season, a new career best.
- WR Tyquan Thornton scored is 4th TD of the season.
- RB JaMycal Hasty with 3 rushing TDs on the day, a new career high.
- QB Gerry Bohanon rushed for his 3rd TD of the season, a 6 yd rush to open up scoring for the Bears.
- RB Trestan Ebner 14-yd TD run is his 3rd rushing TD of the season, 4th overall. First TD since the season opener vs. SFA.
- S Henry Black hauled in his first interception of the season, 2nd of his career and first since 2017.
- LB Blake Lynch collected his second interception of the year, 3rd of his career.
- S Grayland Arnold hauled in his team-leading 6th interception of the season, tying him for 8th most in BU single-season history.
- S Zeke Brown collected his first career interception.
- QB Charlie Brewer remains ranked third all-time at Baylor with 7,516 passing yards in his career.
- QB Charlie Brewer's 1 TD pass on the day gives him 50 career TD passes and he remains in sole possession of 4th all-time.
- OB Charlie Brewer had 13 completions on the day and remains ranked second in program history with 603 career completions.
- QB Charlie Brewer 67 TD responsible for ranks fourth in Baylor history (17 rush, 50 pass)

- QB Charlie Brewer 30 TD responsible for this season is a new career high for Brewer, tying him for 5th most in BU single season history.
- WR Denzel Mims has had at least one catch in 36 consecutive games and now has 2,850 career receiving yards, keeping him at 6th-most in program history.
- WR Denzel Mims now has 181 career receptions, keeping him at 5th-most in program history.
- RB JaMycal Hasty now has 1,973 rushing yards in his career, 27 yards shy of 2,000 career yards and moving him up to 12th most in program history.
- RB John Lovett now has 1,636 career rushing yards, keeping him at 20th-most in program history.
- QB Jacob Zeno made his Baylor debut in the victory.
- OL Johncarlo Valentin made his first appearance of the season.
- OL Jason Moore made his first career start.
- WR Chris Platt appeared in his team-leading 55th career game, starting 36 of those. He has played in more games than anyone in Baylor history.
- OL Sam Tecklenburg made his 37th-consecutive start, 40th start overall, tops on the team.
