# K-STATE AT BAYLOR BY THE NUMBERS

**1,000** — All-purpose yards this year by **Deuce Vaughn...** He ranks second in school history among freshmen and top among true freshmen.

**517** — Rushing yards this season by **Deuce Vaughn**... He now ranks second in school history among freshmen.

**389** – Receiving yards this year **Deuce Vaughn**, which is now the fourth most in a season in school history by a running back.

**70** – Distance of a **Malik Knowles** rushing touchdown on a first-quarter end around... He is the second player in school history to have a rushing, receiving and kickoff return touchdowns of at least 70 yards in a career (Brandon Banks; 2008-09)... His previous career-long rush was 23 yards last year at Texas Tech.

**19.0** – Career sacks by **Wyatt Hubert**, who jumped into the top 10 in school history, ranking ninth.

**13** — Tackles by **Daniel Green**, a new career high and the most by a Wildcat since 2017... Green also set a new career best with 1.5 sacks.

- **7** Sacks by the Wildcats on Saturday, their most in a game since coming away with eight against Baylor in 2003.
- **6** Touchdown passes this year by **Will Howard**, which is tied for the most by a Wildcat freshman.
- **5** Touchdown rushes this year by **Deuce Vaughn**, tied for the fifth most by a K-State freshman.
- 2 Wildcats making their first-career starts on Saturday in left guard **Taylor Poitier** and right guard **Dawson Delforge**.

## **RECORDS**

Saturday was the 18th all-time meeting between Kansas State and Baylor with the Bears tying the series at 9-9, including a 6-4 tally in games played in Waco... BU extended its winning streak over K-State to three games, including two-straight in Waco.

## MEET ME AT THE QUARTERBACK

Kansas State tallied seven sacks on Saturday... It was two shy of the school record and the most in a game by the Wildcats since coming away with eight at Baylor in 2003... Included in the total was a career high for **Daniel Green** (1.5) and the first-career sacks by **Cody Fletcher** and **Jahron McPherson**.

## **HOWARD'S NUMBERS**

True freshman quarterback **Will Howard** threw for 88 yards and a touchdown on 9-of-18 aim, while he rushed for 41 yards and a touchdown on nine carries... He now has six touchdown passes this season to tie the school record among freshmen (Josh Freeman in 2006 and Allan Evridge in 2005).

# **DEUCE WAS LOOSE**

True freshman running back **Deuce Vaughn** carded 102 rushing yards and a touchdown on a career-high 19 carries, while he hauled in three receptions for 19 yards and a score... The Round Rock, Texas native - who carded his second 100-yard rushing game this season - moved into second place in school history in rushing yards by a freshman, a mark that now stands at 517... The record is 609 yards by Leon Patton in 2006... He now has 389 receiving yards this season to move into fourth place in school history among running backs... Vaughn improved his all-purpose vardage total to an even 1.000 vards. the second most in school history by a freshman and the most by a true freshman... He passed Tyler Lockett (957) in 2011) for the second most by all freshmen and the most by a true freshman... Vaughn is now 56 yards shy of the school all-purpose yardage record by a freshman, which is held by Patton (1,056).

## WYATT BEHIND THE LINE

Junior defensive end **Wyatt Hubert** finished the game with four tackles, including a pair of sacks... With his effort, Hubert entered the school's top-10 list for career sacks... He now has 19.0 sacks in his career to rank ninth in school history... It was the fifth time in Hubert's career he came away with at least two sacks and the second time in the last three games (2.5 vs. Oklahoma State).

## LONG PLAYS BY KNOWLES

Sophomore **Malik Knowles** took a first-quarter end around 75 yards for a touchdown... In his career, Knowles has also returned a kickoff 100 yards (2019 at Mississippi State) and caught a 70-yard touchdown pass (2019 at Texas) to become the second player in school history to score from at least 70 yards on a rush, catch and kickoff return in his career... The other is Brandon Banks (2008-09), who scored from distances of 93 yards (run), 77 yards (reception) and 98 yards (kickoff return)... Prior to Saturday, Knowles' previous career long rush was 23 yards last year at Texas Tech.

## **GREEN LEADS IN TACKLES**

Sophomore linebacker **Daniel Green** led the team with 13 tackles... It was the most by a Wildcat since linebacker Jayd Kirby also tallied 13 against Oklahoma in 2017... Green's previous career best was seven stops earlier this year at West Virginia and last year at Mississippi State... He also collected 1.5 sacks, as his previous best was 1.0 on three occasions.
