TEAM NOTES

- Baylor is 1-0 and UAlbany is 0-1.
- This was the first meeting in the series.
- Baylor captains: Jacob Gall, Matt Jones, Siaki Ika and Issac Power.
- The Bears improved to 18-1 all-time against FCS foes and earned their first win over an FCS team since besting Stephen F. Austin in 2019.
- The Bears have forced a turnover in 23 consecutive games. The Bears are +21 in turnover margin under Coach Dave Aranda.
- Baylor has won six consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the nation.
- Baylor improved to 10-2 under Aranda at McLane Stadium and have won eight straight at home.
- BU is 6-0 under Aranda in September games.
- Baylor is 10-3 under Aranda when scoring first.
- The Bears are 12-2 under Aranda when leading at halftime.
- Baylor rushed for seven TDs in the win, its most since going for seven vs. Kansas in 2019 and one shy of the program record set in 1969 vs. LSU.
- BU scored its most points in a season opener since going for 69 vs. Wofford in 2013.
- It marked the 10th most points in single-game BU history.
- A 59-point margin of victory is the 12th-largest in school history.
- Baylor played 89 total players in the contest.
- The Bears had 573 yards of total offense, eclipsing 500 yards for the fist time since besting No. 19/20 BYU in 2021, when they had 534 yards.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior WR Gavin Holmes returned a punt 72 yards for a TD in the first quarter.
 - It marked the 11th longest punt return in Baylor history and was the first punt return for a TD since Grayland Arnold had a 73-yard return against UTSA in 2019.
 - It was the 13th all-time Baylor punt return for a touchdown and the 30th all-time BU kick or punt returned for a score.
- Sophomore WR Monaray Baldwin caught a career-high four passes for a career-best 84 yards and a TD, and rushed twice for 46 yards and a score.
 - Baldwin caught his first-career TD, a 47-yard grab in the first quarter.
 - Baldwin had a 50-yard TD rush in the third quarter, his second career touchdown run.
 - Baldwin is the first BU player with a rushing and receiving TD in the same game since Dillon Doyle vs. BYU in 2021.
- Sophomore QB Blake Shapen was 17 of 20 for 214 yards and two TDs, also rushing four times for 11 yards and a score.
 - Shapen has thrown seven career TD passes.
 - Shapen went for his first-career rushing TD.
- Junior RB Craig Williams rushed for his fourth-career TD and his first since vs. TCU in 2020.
- Sophomore WR Seth Jones caught his first career passes, grabbing two balls for 25 yards.
- Senior LB Bryson Jackson forced and recovered his first-career fumble.
- Freshman QB Kyron Drones rushed for his first-career score.
 - Drones finished 5-of-7 in the air for 100 yards.
- Senior PK John Mayers passed Jeff Ireland for seventh place in Baylor career history in PATs made (81).
 - Mayers has 159 career points, ranking ninth in program history among kickers.
- Freshman RB Richard Reese rushed for his first two career TDs.
 - Reese rushed nine times for a team-leading 62 yards.
- Sophomore WR Hal Presley had three catches for 56 yards and a TD.
 - Presley nabbed his first-career TD catch, a 38-yard score in the second quarter.
- Junior DL Gabe Hall had half a sack and a pass break-up.
 - Hall has eight career tackles for a loss and 6.5 sacks.
 - Hall broke up his first-career pass.
- Senior DL Jaxon Player made his BU debut and had 1.5 tackles for a loss and half a sack.
 - Player has 33.5 career tackles for a loss and 8.5 sacks.
- Senior LB Dillon Doyle recorded his first QB hurry of the year and broke up his fourth-career pass.
- Sophomore RB Taye McWilliams rushed a team-high 12 times for 45 yards and caught four balls for 20 yards.
- Senior S Al Walcott has three career pass break-ups.
- Sophomore CB AJ McCarty has broken up two career passes.
- Freshman LB Jackie Marshall broke up his first-career pass.
- Freshman WR Armani Winfield caught his first-career pass, a 10-yard grab.
- Freshman S Alfonza Allen notched his first-career tackle for a loss in his collegiate debut.
- Senior TE **Ben Sims** tied his career high with five catches, going for 37 yards.
- Baylor senior OL Connor Galvin made his team-leading 38th-career start and made his team-high 27th-straight start.
- Jacob Gall and Chidi Ogbonnaya each played in their team-best 46th career games.
